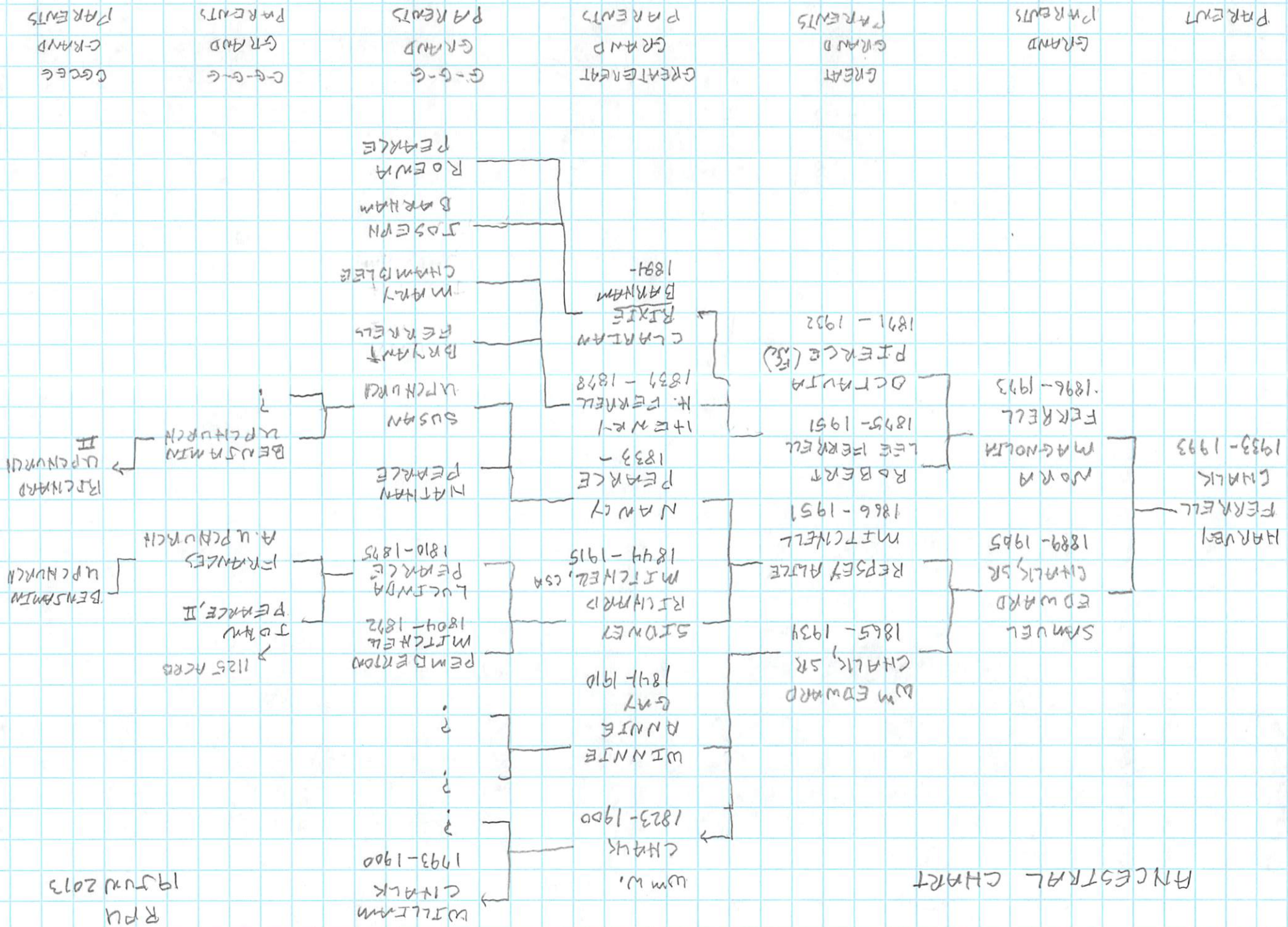

ANCESTRAL CHART



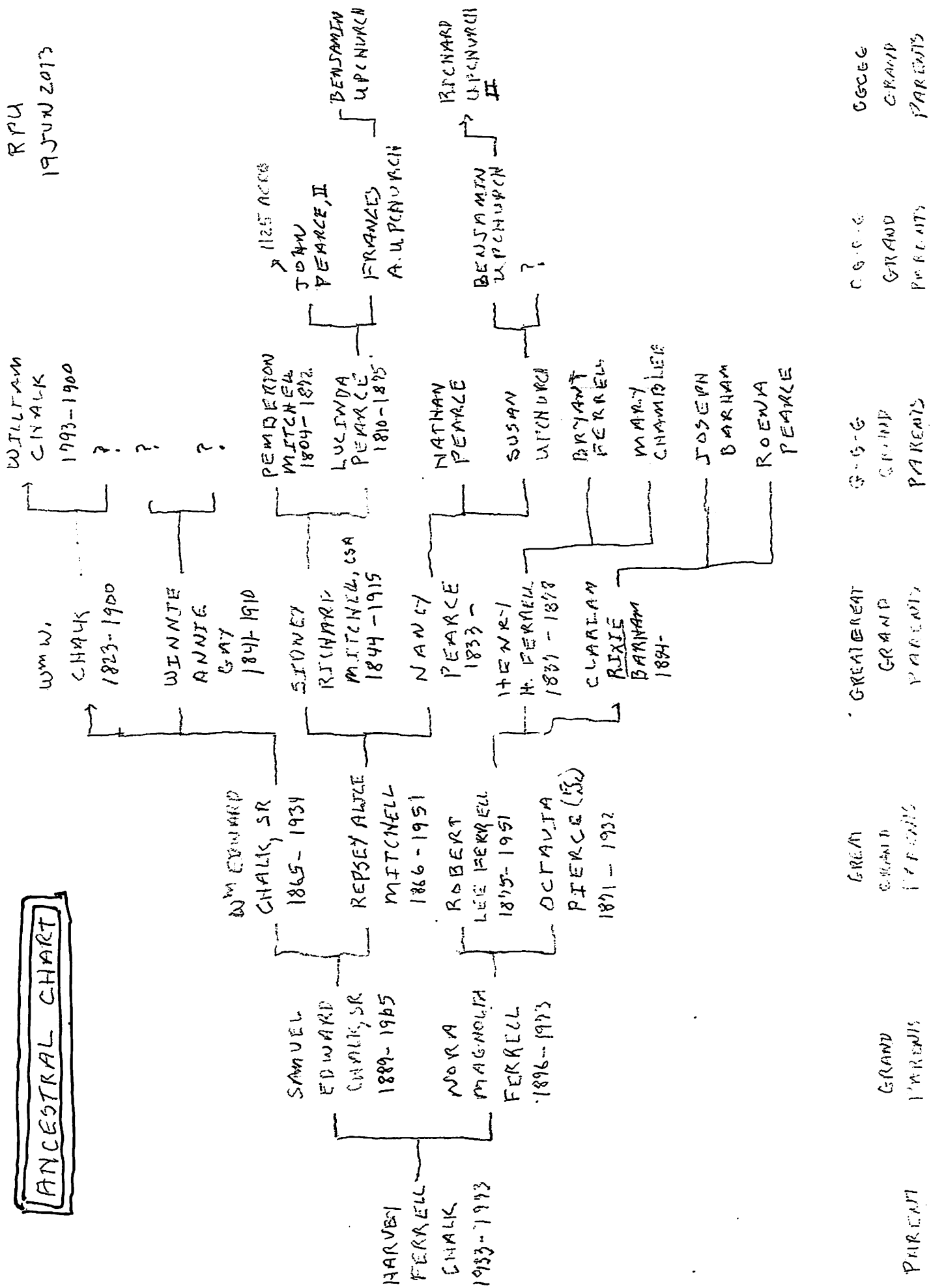

TRACING THE CHALK FAMILY OF CENTRAL NORTH CAROLINA

BACK TO THE REVOLUTIONARY WAR ERA

I. BACKGROUND.

The pursuit of family history draws people closer together. Such has been the case of myself and my niece by marriage, Teresa Nanette (Chalk) Hicks. She is the daughter of my wife's sister, nee: Mary Edith Sledge. As an old geezer I had trouble keeping my website <www.upchurchstory.com> active. Since the fall of 2012 Teresa has come to my rescue computer-wise and I am deeply indebted to her for the splendid job she has done in getting the website back up and greatly improving it by investing her skills and a large number of hours. Since she has some interest in her Chalk heritage and family history is my forte, I have prepared this report on the Chalk family for her and those with whom she chooses to share it.

As it turns out the Chalk heritage in Central NC unfolded in the same area as my Upchurch heritage, so what was uncovered in the Chalk research produced valuable additions to my family history files.

II. CHALK RECORDS ACCUMULATED.

Volumes I & II of the Franklin County, NC Heritage Book were very helpful. Articles 1039 and 1042 from Vol. I and Article 369 from Vol. II are provided. There are more interesting articles in the volumes.

Ten extract sheets are provided. They originated from census records and public family trees found on Ancestry.com.

Excerpts for the Oak Grove and Beulah Cemeteries are provided - prominent Chalk burial sites.

Where the triangle symbol appears on any of the documents it is to show that a copy of the sheet was placed in the Biobfile of the person noted.

III. MASTER OUTLINE FOR THE FAMILY OF WILLIAM CHALK PROBABLY BORN ABOUT 1793 AND PROBABLY DIED ABOUT 1853.

The 13-page Master Outline provided is an initial attempt to portray this family. Corrections and additions are very much in order. The bulk of the Master Outline concerns the family of William Edward Chalk, Sr., 1865-1934. He had 49 grandchildren, one of whom was Harvey Ferrell Chalk, 1933-1963, the father of Teresa. The 49 were either his siblings or his first cousins.

IV. WHERE DID THE CHALKS LIVE?

Provided is a map of Franklin County, NC showing its 10 townships. The three that bordered Wake County were the principle places where the Chalk families lived. Some of the earliest records are from Harris and Dunn Townships. Note the green shaded area where the Upchurch family has lived since 1755. The Chalk family had a strong presence in Youngsville Township. Some parts of the Chalk family lived just across the county line in Wake County in places like Wake Forest and Zebulon and in Raleigh as well.

V. A CHALK PUZZLE.

The records show William Edward Chalk, Sr. was born on 21 DEC 1865 in Lewisville, Henry County, IN. We need to learn if this is really true and, if so, just how it came to be. Maybe it is not true or could this event somehow tie into the fact that the Civil War had recently ended???

VI. THE ANCESTRAL CHART.

Provided is an Ancestral Chart for Harvey Ferrell Chalk going back several generations. It begs for more research, corrections and additions.

All of the people listed lived for many years in central North Carolina, mainly in Franklin and Wake Counties. For over forty years I have collected information on these and related families and have created a Biofile for each person. These Biofiles provide a rich source of information when researching any of the families listed.

No case has been found in which a CHALK married an UPCHURCH but it is the case that the females in both families married and produced descendants who married and who traced back to the UPCHURCH & CHALK families. More of these need to be identified.

Both the CHALK and UPCHURCH families intermarried with the other families listed.

Note that REPSEY ALICE MITCHELL traces back to both SUSAN UPCHURCH and to FRANCES UPCHURCH , who lived in Dunn Township in the late 1700s. It is my belief that both Upchurch females were daughters of Benjamin Upchurch, the son of Richard Upchurch, II, 1725-1798, who arrived in Dunn Township about 1755. My ancestor, Nathan Upchurch, I, was a brother of Benjamin.
