Raeford Native Writes Medical History

A history of medical practice in South Carolina's Marlboro County has been written by a native of Raeford now living in Bennettsville, S.C., and has been published.

The author is Suzanne Cameron Linder, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Tom Cameron of Raeford and wife of a Bennettsville surgeon. Bennettsville is the county seat of Marlboro.

Mrs. Linder is a graduate of Converse College of South Carolina and has a master's degree in history from Wake Forest University.

Her book, "Medicine in Marlboro County," is described by Dick Brown in his Cape Fear Country

column in the September 10 issue of *The Fayetteville Observer*.

He advises Mrs. Linder's book can be had for \$5 a copy from the Marlborough Historical Society, 117 S. Marlboro St., Bennettsville, 29512.

Brown says over half of Mrs. Linder's book is a narrative of pioneer, Civil War, post-Civil War and modern medicine and the men who practiced it. The rest is devoted to biographical sketches of over 100 past and present physicians, many as well known in border North Carolina counties as in Marlboro.

Raeford Native Honored

(Ed. Note: The following article appeared recently in a Bennettsville, S.C. paper. Mrs. Linder is the former Suzanne Cameron, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Tom Cameron of Raeford.)

A → Mrs. Suzanne Cameron Linder was recognized Monday night by the Junior Charity League as the Woman of the Year, 1980. Mrs. Pledger Hodges, president, honored her with the annual award as a highlight of the Bridge and Fashion Show held at the Marlboro Country Club.

In the presentation Mrs. Hodges said, "1980's Woman of the Year is one of many talents, tireless efforts, and outstanding accomplishments.

Our new library is tangible evidence of her good work for five years, during which time she has served as a trustee and an officer of the library board. In the eyes of at least one of her fellow board members, she is its most valuable resource.

The Marlboro Historical Society is indeed fortunate to have in her an active member, whose talks and programs are both popular and informative. She researched and wrote **The Medical History of Marlboro County** and is currently completing her second reference book. Through her writing, she has developed into a local authority on our history.

Perhaps her most recent efforts have been channeled into the organizing of a countywide group for the relief of child abuse and neglect. She is the first chairperson of this, The Multi-Disciplinary Committee composed of local professionals and interested citizens. She founded the committee's program "Mother's Morning Out," which gives mothers relief from stressful home situations by offering free day-care for little ones twice a week and providing professional counseling for parents.

Mrs. Linder has been a longtime member of the Bennettsville Music

Club and the Marlboro Arts Council and is also involved with the Marlboro Players. She is active in the Medical Auxiliary and has given many hours of volunteer work to Marlboro General Hospital. She has given of her outstanding musical talents often of various church and civic groups. She served with distinction on the Bennettsville Area School Board.

She is a loyal, working member of First United Methodist Church, where she is a circle member, works with the youth and often teaches an

adult Sunday School Class. She is not only a leader in organizing our church bazaars, but she is also a valuable contributor who makes and bakes very special items for sale each year.

She is a former member of the Bennettsville Junior Charity League and she's never told us no when we've called on her to help us as a sustaining member."

Mrs. Linder is married to Dr. → B James H. Linder and they have three children, Jimmy, Emily and Marion.
