

Saturday, February 20, 1904 DUNWOODY JONES YIELDS TO DEATH, Well-Known Citizen of Atlanta Dies of Pneumonia.

Yesterday morning at 8:30 o'clock Major JAMES DUNWODY JONES departed this life at his late residence on Jackson street, surrounded by his immediate family. Major Jones had many friends in Atlanta and throughout this state and Florida,...he was 62 years of age and until recently was as vigorous and active as any young man half his age. The early years of his manhood were spent in the confederate army from the beginning to the end of the war.

Dunwody Jones was born in 1842 in McIntosh county, at Hopesdale, the plantation home of his maternal grandfather, Colonel James DUNWODY, and upon it and the "Bonaventure" plantation of his father, much of his boyhood was spent.

In 1870 Mr. Jones was married to Miss Mary Cornelia, the daughter of Colonel William P. M. ASHLEY, C.S.A., of Liberty county, and shortly afterwards removed to Atlanta, since which time this place has been his home. Much of his time has been spent in Florida, however, where he was engaged in mining phosphate, being a pioneer in that industry.

His wife and the following children survive him: Messrs. John Ashley, James Logan, and William Percy, Mrs. William C. MASSEY, Mrs. William Hurd HILLYER and Miss Janie D. JONES of this city, and Mrs. Malcolm CUNNINGHAM and Mrs. Latham PRITCHARD of Savannah; also his brothers, Messrs. John and Joseph JONES of Orlando, Fla. The interment will be at Oakland and thefuneral notice will be seen elsewhere.

BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH OF JOHN A. JONES OF LA Contributed by Annette Carpenter Womack

From: "Biographical and Historical Memoirs of Northwest Louisiana," pub. 1890

JOHN A. JONES is a prominent young planter of Red River Parish, La., and since 1887 has identified himself with the progress and development of the agricultural interests of the parish. He was born in Nashville, Tenn., May 6, 1855, being the second of a family of six children - four sons and two daughters - three sons and one daughter being now alive, born to JOHN H. and SUSANNAH C. (Nebblet) JONES, the former a native of Wales, and the latter of Tennessee. The father who led the life of a merchant, died in Coushatta, La., in 1867, having located there in 1860, but his widow still survives him, her home being in this town. JOHN A. JONES, the immediate subject of this biography, was but five years old when his parents removed thither from Nashville, and all his youth and the first years of his manhood were spent in this town, in the schools of which he received his early education. During this time he was employed in the capacity of clerk, but in 1887 he determined to devote his attention to agriculture, and accordingly came to his present plantation, first leasing the 200 acres of excellent land, nearly half of it being under cultivation. Mr. Jones is a Democrat, politically, and while a resident of Coushatta, he served as deputy sheriff and deputy marshal several years, and upon another occasion was deputy clerk of the parish. The greater part of his life has been spent here, and he is, therefore, well known to her citizens and commands respect from all classes. His life has been characterized by many deeds of kindness and personally, and in every relation and duty of life he has been liberal, generous and high minded.

## JONES FAMILIES FROM MAINE TO MISSOURI By Gerald W. Newman

#### JOSEPH & MARY (Preston) JONES, SR.

Joseph Jones Sr. was born in Washington County, Maine on 14 February 1804. His father died when he was but a small boy. He had no early school advantages — the public school house was then an institution unknown. His youth covered the period of the War of 1812. Living on the coast of Maine, he was an eye-witness to some of the thrilling scenes of that memorable contest and he remembered distinctly the landing of the Red Coats on his native shore. His first presidential vote was cast for Andrew Jackson, in 1828. As a temperance man he was a firm believer in the ultimate triumph of the temperance cause till the day of his death.

He was married to Miss Mary Preston, November 24, 1825, at the place of their birth. Here was born to them eleven children, nine of which grew to adulthood.

MATILDA (20 Jan. 1827 - 18 Feb. 1906) married Joseph JONES 2nd; WILLIAM (13 Feb 1829 - 10 Feb. 1887) married Catherine MANUEL; DAVID was born in 1833; REBECCA was born in 1835; NEHEMIAH was born in 1837; NANCY(12 Apr. 1839 - 22 Apr. 1886) married Wilson MOSHER; DANIEL (18 May 1841 - 14 June 1897) married Mary E. HILL; SEMANTHA was born in 1843; MARIETTA was born in 1849.

Mary Preston was born in Eastport, Washington County, Maine on 5 May 1805. In the War of 1812, Eastport was under British control from 11 July 1814 to 30 June 1818. At the time of her birth, Thomas Jefferson was President. Her parents were Nathan & Rebecca (Gardner) Preston, Jr. Nathan Preston's parents were Nathan & Elizabeth (Rumery) Preston, Sr., and Elizabeth's father was Demiticus Rumery.

Mary, as every other mother who has lived in the times of our peril, felt the shock and knew the cost of war. Two of her sons, Daniel & William, fought in the Civil War for the North. Her residence in Maine, then in Pennsylvania, and later in Missouri when the state was undeveloped had much to do with developing in her that herioc type of nature characteristic of our older generations.

On September 1st, 1851, the Jones family bid adieu to their friends and the scenes of their childhood and started for Potter County, Pennsylvania arriving there on the 10th day of the same month. They settled in the area of East Sharon, Pennsylvania near the New York State line, where Joseph and his sons engaged in the business of farming and lumbering, as they had in Maine. They remained in Pennsylvania until April 1869 when they moved to Caldwell County, Missouri, settling about two miles northwest of Hamilton in the area that was eventually to become known as the Jones neighborhood because so many Joneses owned land that bordered each other. With the Jones family on the move to Potter County, Pennsylvania and Caldwell County, Missouri were Joseph Jones 2nd and William Henry Jones, sons of Robert & Anna (Preston) Jones. It is believed that Joseph and William H. Jones were nephews to the senior Joseph Jones.

Joseph and Mary belonged to the Methodist Episcopal Church in Hamilton. Joseph died on 3 June 1885 in Hamilton. At the time of his death, Joseph and Mary had been married 59 years, 8 months and 9 days. Mary died on 30 July 1890 after a long (85 years) and active life. They are both buried in the Highland Cemetery west of town as are four of their children (sons, Daniel & William, and daughters, Matilda Jones & Nancy Mosher).

#### WILLIAM & CATHERINE (Manuel) JONES

William Jones was born in Washington County, Maine on 13 February 1829, the son of Joseph and Mary (Preston) Jones. William followed in his father's occupation of farmer and lumberman. He moved with the senior Joseph Jones and family to Potter Co., Pennsylvania, where they continued in the business of farming and lumbering. The area they settled in was near the New York State line where William met and married Miss Catherine Manuel on 21 January 1854 in Olean, Cattarauges County, New York. Catharine was born on 12 October 1827 in Lisbon, Portugal. To this marriage were born eight children of which six grew to adulthood.

ALLEN (8 Nov. 1855 - ?) married Dora Sissons; RUFUS (2 Feb. 1857 - 22 Nov. 1948) married Eliza Julia Cramblit; LILLY (Dec. 1859 - ?) married D. Pitt Martin: IDA (2 June 1861 - 4 Feb. 1923) married 1) John Guy, 2) L. M. Love; RUSSELL (1867 - 29 Aug. 1873); JAMES (10 June 1868 - 25 Sept. 1949) married Beatrice Toon; GILBERT (18 Aug. 1871 - 28 dec. 1884); SARAH ELIZABETH (1874 - ?) married Leslie Joiner.

When the Civil War broke out, William enlisted in Company D, 85 Regiment New York Infantry on 25 September 1861 in Elmira, NY, as a Private. He was in six regular

battles and eight skirmishes. William was reported missing in action on 20 April 1864 at the Battle of Plymouth, NC, where he was captured and taken immediately to the newly opened prison at Andersonville, Georgia. William was released from Andersonville Prison on April 1, 1865, a mere walking skeleton. As a paroled prisoner, he was first sent to Benton Barracks, Missouri, and then transferred to College Green Barracks at Annapolis, Maryland. He reached his home on May 5, 1865, broken in health never to see another well day upon earth.

In the fall of 1869, with his family and other Jones families, he moved to Hamilton, Caldwell County, Missouri. He subsequently purchased 139 acres northwest of town where the family lived in a sod house, until a frame house could be built, the only one known to have been built in Caldwell County.

William was a member of the Methodist Episcopal Church and a member of the G.A.R. He died at his home February 10, 1887 after a protracted and serious sickness from some mysterious disease resulting from exposure during confinment at the Andersonville Prison, Georgia, age 57 years, 11 months, and 27 days. Catherine died on 28 June 1914 and both are buried in the Highland Cemetery with their son, Russell.

#### RUFUS & ELIZA (Cramblit) JONES

Rufus Jones, son of William & Catherine (Manuel) Jones, first saw the light in South Bolivar, Alleghany County, New York, on February 2, 1858. In 1868, when Rufus was 10 years old, William moved his family to Hamilton, Caldwell County, Missouri. It was here that Rufus was principally reared and educated, farming having always been the occupation to which his attention had been directed. In 1886, he owned a good estate of 70 acres. On 27 March 1883, Rufus married Miss Eliza J. Cramblit, the daughter of William H. & Julia Ann (Honnold) Cramblit, and to this union three children were born.

IVY MAE (2 Nov. 1884 - 7 Nov. 1884); ORA FRANCIS (12 July 1886 - 4 Feb. 1978) married Emma Maude Connor; FLORENCE JULIA (3 Feb. 1889 - ?) married William Lewis McCrary.

Mr. Jones was a member of the Methodist Church for over 80 years where he was ever active in church work, while Mrs. Jones was a worth member of the Methodist Episcopal Church. Eliza passed away on 10 April 1916 in Hamilton and Rufus married Miss Susie Holsinger on November 10, 1920. Susie was born in 1869 and died on 24 May 1939. Rufus died on 28 November 1948 at the age of 91 years, 9 months and 26 days. All three are buried in the Highland Cemetery.

#### ORA FRANCIS & EMMA MAUDE (Conner) JONES

Ora Francis Jones was born July 12, 1886 in Caldwell County, Missouri, the son of Rufus & Eliza (Cramblit) Jones. He was reared on his father's farm and received his education in the district schools, and was graduated from Hamilton High School. After completing his education, Mr. Jones was connected with the Fidelity Trust Company of Kansas City, where he remained for almost two years, after which he worked as a railway mail clerk on the Burlington Railroad out of Kansas City. After working there for five years, Mr. Jones returned to Caldwell County and purchased a farm of 80 acres near Hamilton. He was a prominent stockman of the county, and a breeder of high-grade stock. On 4 January 1910, Mr. Jones married Emma Maude Connor, daughter of John & Luzette (Hill) Connor. John Connor was born 31 August 1855 in Claremont, New Hampshire, the son of Corneluis D. & Mary L. (Barrett) Connor. Corneluis was a native of Ireland. John's parents moved to Missouri when he was about 12 years of age. Luzetta Hill, daughter of Greenberry & Emaline (Teegarden) Hill, was born 3 May

1862 in Caldwell County. To Ora Francis & Emma Maude Jones the following children were born.

LUCILE (6 July 1911); RUSSELL (15 July 1913); CONNOR (9 May 1915) married Norma Ruth Merrell; ORA E. (17 Aug. 1916); STANLEY R. (15 June 1918); JEAN MARIE (25 July 1921); ANNA LAURA.

The Jones family were members of the Christian Church of Hamilton. Ora died on 4 February 1978 in Richmond, Missouri, and Emma died there on 17 March 1978.

#### WILSON & NANCY (Jones) MOSHER (daughter of Joseph & Mary Jones)

Wilson Mosher was born on 10 February 1828 in Chenango County, New York. Nothing is known about his childhood or early life, but he moved to Potter County, Pennsylvania as a young man and worked as a lumberman. He settled near the town of East Sharon which was near the New York State line. He married Miss Nancy Jones, daughter of Joseph & Mary (Preston) Jones, Sr., on 31 December 1854. Nancy was born 12 April 1839 in Washington County, Maine. In September 1851, at the age of twelve, her parents moved to Potter County, Pennsylvania. Wilson & Nancy had at least nine children.

LEROY (17 Mar. 1858 - 30 Aug. 1891) died in Eau Claire, WI; EMMA (1 Dec. 1863 - 24 July 1937) married a Mr. George & died in Lewiston, ID; INEZ (26 Dec. 1867 - 18 Mar. 1906) married a Mr. Cramblit & died in Altoona, WI; BELLE (18 Sept. 1869 - 18 Aug. 1925) married a Mr. Lee & died in Prosser, WA; GEORGIA (21 May 1872 - 25 Dec. 1943) married a Mr. Shiner & died in Omaha, NB; EDSON (8 Oct. 1874 - ?); MATILDA (2 Oct. 1877 - 13 Dec. 1937) married Charles L. Ringer & died in Oakland, CA; ANGELINE (9 Dec. 1879 - 11 Mar. 1959) married Peter L. Newman & died in Pinole, CA; KATHRYN (27 Jan. 1883 - 21 Feb. 1932) married a Mr. Blake & died in Eau Claire, WI.

Wilson & Nancy moved from Potter County, Pennsylvania to Caldwell County prior to the birth of their fourth child, Belle. Although the exact date is not known, they probably moved at or near the same time as Nancy's parents and two brothers, Daniel & William, and sister, Matilda, which was in the spring of 1869.

Nancy died on 22 April 1886 of pneumonia at the age of 47. Wilson died on 1 October 1887 at the age of 57. At the time of their deaths, they lived two miles southeast of Hamilton. The untimely deaths so close together left many of the children to be raised by relatives. Both Wilson and Nancy are buried in the Highland Cemetery near Nancy's parents and her brother, Daniel.

#### DANIEL & MARY (Hill) JONES (son of Joseph & Mary Jones)

Daniel Jones, the seventh child of Joseph & Mary (Preston) Jones, Sr., was born on 18 May 1841 in Washginton County, Maine, where Joseph engaged in the farming and lumbering business and, earlier, in cod fisheries. Daniel's parents moved to Potter County, Pennsylvania in September 1851, settling near East Sharon which was near the New York State line. Daniel worked on the farm in the summer months, but in the winter seasons gave his attention to lumbering.

On March 16, 1864, Daniel enlisted in Company H, 184 Regiment Pennsylvania Infantry, serving 16 months in the Army of the Potomac, and was in line at Appomatox when Lee Surrendered. He also served in Company E a few months prior to his discharge on 14 July 1865 in Washington, DC. At the siege of Petersburg, after having taken part in the battles of Cold Harbor and the Wilderness, he was made 2nd Corporal of the Second Division, Second Brigade. At the close of the war, he returned to Pennsylvania. In October 1868, he decided to locate further west and accordingly settled in Caldwell County, Missouri, where he applied himself strictly to farming. Prior to leaving Penn-

sylvania, Daniel married Miss Mary E. Hill, daughter of Charles Hill, on 3 July 1866. Mary was born in Addison, Steuben County, New York on 13 January 1842. To them were born three children.

HARRIETT E. (b. ca 1868) married a Mr. Cooper; CLARA B. married a Mr. Plummer; CHARLES H.

Daniel & Mary resided for 19 years on their 116 acre farm in the Lovely Ridge neighborhood west of town. Nine years prior to his death they removed to Hamilton and lived in the East part of town until his death. Daniel was a member of the I.O. O.F. lodge and also of the G.A.R. In 1878, he united with the Baptist Church of Hamilton and at the time of his death he was a deacon of that church. He died at his home at 9 A.M. on Monday, June 14, 1897 of stomach trouble from which he had been suffering for ten weeks. His illness dates back a score of years and had its inception in his Army life. Mary died on 29 December 1915. They are buried in the Highland Cemetery next to Daniel's parents and near Daniel's sister, Nancy Mosher.

#### SONS OF ROBERT & ANNA (Preston) JONES

#### JOSEPH & MATILDA (Jones) JONES

Joseph Jones, 2nd, was born in Washington County, Maine on 27 April 1825, the son of Robert & Anna (Preston) Jones who were natives of the same state. He grew to manhood with an experience in both farming and lumbering. On 22 November 1846, he was united in marriage to Miss Matilda Jones, daughter of Joseph & Mary (Preston) Jones, Esq. Matilda was born in Washington County, Maine on 20 January 1827. It is believed that young Joseph and Matilda were first cousins. To this union were born three children.

JOHN P. (b. ca 1849) died at a young age; ANNA M. (16 Jan. 1855 - 25 Aug. 1900) married William M. Altman; FREDERICK (b. ca 1863).

In the fall of 1851, Joseph moved his vamily to East Sharon, Potter County, Pennsylvania where he continued in the same business as in Maine. During the Civil War, Joseph enlisted on 15 September 1864 in Company F, 210 Regiment Pennsylvania Infantry as a Private, and was discharged on 30 May 1865. His Regiment was connected with the Eastern Army. He was at Petersburg and Richmond, and was an eye witness of the surrender of General Lee at Appomattox. His enlistment papers state he had blue eyes, brown hair, a dark complexion and was five feet ten inches high. At the time of his death he was a member of Hurlbert Post No. 32 of the G.A.R.

In May of 1869, Joseph & Matilda moved along with other Jones families to Caldwell County, Missouri, settling on a farm about 2 miles northwest of Hamilton.

At the age of sixteen Matilda was converted and united with the Methodist Episcopal Church. She was also an honored member of the Daughters of Rebekah. Joseph had been a member of the Methodist Episcopal Church for 17 years prior to his death.

Joseph & Matilda lived on their farm from May 1869 until 12 November 1893, when on account of the failing health of Joseph they moved to Hamilton where he died at 2:30 o'clock, 15 December 1893. After a protracted illness of fourteen months, Matilda quietly fell asleep Sunday, February 18th, 1906 at 6 o'clock in the Morning. They are both buried in the Highland Cemetery. Matilda is listed on the tombstone of her daughter, Anna Altman, who died in 1900. Joseph is in a separate grave.

#### WILLIAM HENRY & PHEBE (Sherman) JONES

William Henry Jones, the sixth living child and fifth son of Robert and Anna

(Preston) Jones, was born on 22 July 1829 in Washington County, Maine. His father was also native to the county and during his lifetime worked assiduously at both farming and the lumbering business. At the age of 18, he moved to Potter County, Pennsylvania, settling near the town of East Sharon. He married Miss Phebe Sherman on 4 July 1860. She was born in New York state on 4 January 1836. Two children were born to them.

FRANKLIN O. (22 Feb. 1862 - 18 Feb. 1934) who never married; ELLA S. (26 Aug. 1868 - 29 Sept. 1942) married Judson D. Van Volkenburgh.

When the Civil War started, William enlisted as a Private in Company C, 148 Regiment Pennsylvania Infantry on 21 August 1863. His enlistment record reads that he had blue eyes, brown hair, florid complexion and height was 5 ft. 10 inches. He was honorably discharged June 5th, 1865, and returned to his home in Pennsylvania.

He moved to Caldwell County, Missouri, in 1869, when the other Jones families decided to move to this area, and eventually purchased forty acres about two miles northwest of Hamilton. He wasconverted January 1873 and was baptized and received into the Methodist Episcopal Church of Hamilton. He was a very active member of the G.A.R. In his early manhood, he was noted for superior physical powers, but army life undermined his constitution.

William died at his residence in the north part of the city on Monday night, 16 January 1893, at eleven 1'clock, after a painful illness of constipation and inflamation of the bowels. Phoebe died on 14 April 1917, and both are buried in the Highland Cemetery.

#### JONES NOTES FROM REV. J. J. DICKEY DIARY

"...Evan Jones Sr. Laurel Co., Ky. 6-30-1898
I was born in L.C. Ky. 1833. My father was Evan Jones. He was born and raised near Wilmington in N. C.

His father was Robert Jones. He was born and reared in S. C. He was one of the first settlers of L.C. and settled on the head waters of Laurel River. His youngest brother Darling Jones came with him. Darling was 13 yrs old when the Rev. War was closed or began. I do not remember which. He settled on the head waters of Laurel or John Cr. He died aged 100 years. He said he would have been in the Revolution had he been old enough. I do not know whether my g-father Robert Jones was in that war or not but I suppose from the above remark of my Uncle Darling, he was. The Jones' are a Welsh family.

I cannot tell when the first of my ancestors came to America. Darling Jones talked a great deal about Charleston, S.C. There was another brother, Isom Jones, who located in Whitley County (KY). There is a numerous posterity there.

Robert Jones had children: (1) Wm. Ephraim, (2) Darling, (3) Evan, (4) Elizabeth (m. C. Norvell or Nowell), (5) Nancy (Wm. Trospers), (6) Louisa (John Ridgel) she was the oldest.

The Ridgells & Norvells or Nowells went west. Trospers are dead. My father Evan, had 11 children, lived to their majority. 8 yet live. Most of the children of the others are dead or have migrated. The descendants of Robert Jones are not numerous.

Darling Jones sons Cyrus and Evan Jones. He was a splendid man. My mother was Mary Weaver, daughter of Samuel Weaver who settled on Laurel River in the early history of this county. He drew a pension until his death. Though he obtained it only a few years before he died. He lived to old age. He had children: Hezekiah, Peter, James, Joseph, David the Preacher, several daughters, Sallie (Samuel Box), Elizabeth (Jesse Cain), Barbara (John Williams), my mother Mary married Evan Jones.

John, Peter, & Elizabeth's children are in the west. There are not many of the stock now in this county. Peter became Co. Judge of Shannon Co., Mo., a good man. David Weaver was perhaps the most influential Baptist preacher in this county. He was very, very, pious and very popular, a man of force.

Samuel Weaver, my g-father was so nearly starved in his return from the Army that his aunt fed him frist on soup and it was several days before she would give him a full meal. He would cry and so would she. His wife was a Bolling, Black Dutch. I do not know the nationality of the Weavers..."

#### THE JONES FAMILY OF TALLAPOOSA COUNTY, ALABAMA

Joseph Jones, born about 1790, married Jane Nelson and came to Tallapoosa, County, Alabama, shortly after it became a county in 1832. He was in the 1840 census, but went on to Shreveport, Louisiana, where his death was reported. He had four brothers known to some of his descendants: James Jones, Messick Jones, Elisha Jones and William Jones.

Joseph and Jane Nelson Jones had several children. They were: Marlyn Jones; Silas Jones; Lewis Jones; Adeline Jones who married William Powell; Bethany Jones who married a Mr. Kelly; and Ervin Jones b. 1818, married 1840 in Tallapoosa Co., AL, Harriet Messick (b. 1821). Ervin died in 1901. He remained in Tallapoosa County when the others of his family went on to Louisiana.

Henry Thomas 1878, d. 1917; 7) daughter, Martina Jones b. 1854, m. Richard Thomas, d. 1912 Goldville, AL; 8) daughter, Susan Jones b. 1851, m. 1884 Tallapoosa Co., Nathan Nelson, d. 1913; 9) daughter, Frances Jones b. 1853, m. David Daugherty; 10) son, Lloyd Jones, d. infant; 11) daughter, Aleatha Jones b. 1858, m. George Sims 1875; 12) son, Waymon Jones, b. 1864, m. Frances Lambert 1886; 13) son, Willard Jones b. 1843, died in the War between the States; 14) son, Ebeneza Jones b. 1844, died in the War Between the States.

within and for said County of Worcester, established as such by the laws of said Commonwealth, ABEL JONES aged sixty one years, resident in Winchindon in said County, who being first duly sworn according to law, doth, on his oath, declare that he served in the Revolutionary War as follows: Sometime in the year 1781, I enlisted in th 9th Mass. Regt. commanded by Col. Henry Jackson in Capt. Hunt's Company of Light Infantry, and served in that Regiment as near as I can recollect, till the latter part of the year 1782, when in consequence of the reduction of the Regiments in number from 10 to 7, I was transferred to the 7 Regt. commanded by Col. John Brook, now Gov. of the Com. I was thence transferred to the 4 Regt. commanded, I think, by Col. Jackson in the Company of Capt. Mills, and served in the Continental service till the time of my discharge in 1784, which discharge is lost. I applied for a pension April 17, 1818, and obtained it by certificate number 3421, dated Oct. 7, 1818...

That her maden name was LUCINDA HEYWOOD, tha she was married to ABEL JONES July eleventh, seventeen hundred and eighty two in the town of Rutland in said County by John Fessendon, Justice of the Peace, that her sai husband, the said ABEL JONES was a soldier in the Revolutionary war for about three years, that for said services he had a pension under the act of Congress passed 1818 and as evidenced the perticular services of her said Husband, she respectfully refer to the rools (sic) in the war department and to the evidence filed with his application by which he received said pension. She further declares her husband the said AF JONES deceased in said Winchendon August 29th 1836 at which place they mooved to in about three years after they married. She further says her husband the said ABEL ar herself were residents of Holden in said county from which place they mooved to Winchendon as before stated. She further declares she has remained a widow ever since the death of the said ABEL.

State of New Jersey, Cumberland County On this seventeenth day of August AD One Thousand Eight hundred Thirty three, personally appeared before me, one of the Judges of the Inferior Court of Common Pleas for said county, ABRAHAM JONES a resident of the Township of Maurice River in the County of Cumberland and State of New Jersey, aged Eighty years the twenty fifth day of November next...makes the following declaration...That he first entered the Militia Service in the Township of Maurice River, County & State aforesaid, where he then resided & continued to reside during the War of the Revolution, and ever since that period - he believes in the year 1776 under Captain Jonathan Smith by a draft for three months - that Colonel David Potter was the officer of the Regiment - that he entered the Militia in 1777 he believes under Captain Jonathan Beasley, that he served five tours of one month each under said Beesley - Potter was still the Colonel that he served under Captain Joseph Stokes in the same year, one Month - Colonel Joseph Hillman officer of the Regiment - that he was under Captain Samuel Wescott three tours of duty of one month each. That he was one month under Captain James Hollenshead he thinks in 1778. That he was one month tour of duty under Captain Derrick Peterson he thinks in 1779. That he was two months in the Militia under Capt. Job Glasby, Samuel Ogden Colonel, one tour of duty under Captain George Mc-Glaughlin of two months he believes in 1780 - Colonel Elijah Hand was the officer of the Regiment. That he served two tours of one month each under Captain John Peterson. That he served three months under Capt. Lummis he thinks his name was John Lummis - and that he also enlisted in the regular Service under Captain Seth Whilden for five months but served six months - his service during that enlistment was in the neighbourhood of East Jersey on the Routon River and Millstone the Commander of the division was Genl. Dickerson - the Major he thinks was \_\_\_\_ Smith, and cannot recollect the name of the Colonel. That he was in the following Battles, to-wit: Trenton, Mount Holly, Between the two timber Creeks near Gloucester. That he was in various skirmishes in Pennsylvania in the Neighbourhood of Philadelphia, and was with his Colonel Potter when he was taken Prisoner near Frankford - was also in Fort Mifflin during part of the seige. That the whole of his services was in New Jersey & Pennsylvania &c. He hereby relinquishes every claim whatever to a pension or annuity except the present and he declares that his name is not on the Pension roll of any Agency in any State. That he had a discharge for the regular service, but does not know what became of it. ABRAHAM JONES

Sworn & subscribed the day and year above Joshua Breek (Brick?)

Interrogation to the applicant by direction of the Commissioner of Pensions:

Where and in what year were you born? I was born in the Township of Maurice River in the County of Cumberland in the year Seventeen hundred fifty three.

Have you any record of your age, and if so where is it? My name is in the Church Book at Sweedsborough, also in the family Bible in the hand of my kinsman.

Where were you living when called into Service, where have you lived since the Revolutionary War, and where do you now live? In the Township of Maurice River all my life.

How were you called into service: were you drafted, did you volunteer, or were you a substitute and if a substitute for whom? I was drafted, volunteered once, ser-

ved my regular tour in the Militia, and enlisted for five months.

- State the names of some of the Regular officers who were with the troops where you served, such Continental and Militia Regiments as you can recollect, and the general circumstances of your service? I recollect General Putman, Genl. Dick son, Genl. Mifflin, Genl. Mercer, Col. Shreve, Colonel Hight, Col. Taylor, Co. Shute, Genl. Newcomb, Col. Preston, Captain Cummins, Capt. Hollenshead, Col. Howell, Col. Stillwell, Major Bloomfield, with many more which I knew in service beside those I served under, but from length of time, and the infirmities of age I do not now recollect the names of.
- Did you ever receive a discharge from the service, if so by whom was it given, and what has become of it? I did receive a discharge from the enlisted service, cannot recollect who signed by. Cannot say certain what became of it, but be lieves it was lost in his chest on Board of Captain Stillwell at sea.
- State the names of persons to whom you are known in your present neighbourhood and who can testify as to your character for veracity, and their belief of your svices as a Soldier of the Revolution. Jonas Vannemon, James Godfrey, Henry Reeves, Jerimiah Towser(?) are most of the men now living in this Township who were in the Service. David Davis, Thos. Lee Esqr. present member of Congress Rev. Benjamin Fisler, Rev. John Wishart, John Lee, with many more have known many years.

#### Dear Madam:

Reference is made to your letter in which you request information in regard t Revolutionary War soldier, Noah Miller, who was born in 1732 in New Jersey and mar ed in November, 1762, Mary Mills, also the record of Abraham Jones who served from Cumberland County, New Jersey, in that war, and also in the War of 1812.

A search of the Revolutionary War records of this office has been made in you behalf and no record found of a claim for pension or bounty land based upon the se vice of Noah Miller as described by you in that war...The record of Abraham Jones given below...

Abraham Jones was born November 25, 1753 in Maurice River Township, Cumberlan County, New Jersey, where he continued to live both before and after the Revolutio ary War.

He enlisted sometime in 1776, served as private at various times until someti in 1780, amounting in all to about twenty-nine months, in the New Jersey troops un der Captains Jonathan Smith, Jonathan Beesley, Joseph Stokes, Samuel Westcott, Jam Hollingshead, Derrick Peterson, Job Glassby, George McGlaughlin, John Peterson, Jo Lummes and Seth Whilden, and Colonel David Potter, Joseph Hillman, Samuel Ogden an Elijah Hand; during these tours of service, he was in the battles of Trenton, Moun Holly, the Siege at Fort Mifflin, and in many skirmishes.

Abraham Jones was allowed pension on his application executed August 17, 1833 at which time he was residing in his native township. It is not stated that the above named soldier rendered service in the War of 1812. There is no reference to wife or children in the papers...




