Fill, ~~22~~ ³¹ Pearce, 80, his children were: Halley, 70; Nathan, 86; Eley, 80; Hardy went to Alabama. Fill's wife was Nancy.

Benjamin Pearce's mother was Frankie Upchurch, 82, and Frankie Upchurch's mother was Nancy Ledbetter, 85. Nancy Ledbetter married Ben Upchurch.

Ben Upchurch's sisters -- Frankie, Bettie, Nancy. Frankie Upchurch's brothers: Juble Upchurch, 80; Frankie's sister Winnie Upchurch.

Benjamin Pearce's wife was Linda Denton, 47; Linda Denton's mother was Nancy Denton, 45; Nancy's mother was Cherry Denton, 75. Drew Denton was the father of Nancy Denton.
