whether this an older (just born) child of William or possibly a brother of William or a brother of William's wife - or ?? - we just don't know.

Children (Kids Numbers 10, 11, 12 & 14) did actually exist (highlighted in red). The census records would lead us to conclude that these 4 are almost certainly children of William U b abt 1778. We may never learn anything more about them. We just need to be alert to add information to our Master Outline if anything on them does appear.

Now back to your \$64 question about - who was the father of William U b abt 1778? I don't know. I still anticipate doing the search of my records which could prove helpful in fitting him into the Upchurch Family Tree. I estimate this will take 30-40 hours of uninterrupted study time. I'll definitely get to this but just when I cannot promise. The sooner the better! When time allows I still need to make some phone calls to Jackson Co, TN to see if I can uncover some sources that might be helpful. In the meantime lets keep pulling in the data for more recent generations.

Last Sunday Sallaine and I found it convenient <sup>(3)</sup> to drive to Valhalla Cemetery. It is huge and I would estimate has 5-10 thousand burials. We spent about an hour slowly driving up & down each path reading the inscriptions but did not spot a BURRIS or UPCHURCH. We probably only read about 1/2 of the upright stones. The next step is to learn if the cemetery office has a listing of burials. The cemetery is reasonably well kept. There are three other large cemeteries in the immediate area - one of which is Jewish.

I have just checked my map for Franklin Co, MO and did locate BRUSH CREEK ROAD and BRUSH CREEK - but no Brush Creek Cemetery. However, my maps do not list cemeteries. One hopes that a ride through the area might allow one to find Brush Creek Cemetery.

When are you coming to MO?  
Let's keep exchanging information.

Not sure where we are on this, but I think we know that William Upchurch relocated to Jackson County, TN from \_\_\_\_\_? \_\_\_\_\_, N.C. in about 1809.

□ William (sr) is the only Upchurch in Jackson County in the 1820 Census of Middle Tennessee. Two of his children (Thomas and Elizabeth) are born in N.C. (1806 & 1808), and the remainder of his children are born in Tennessee, beginning with Gillum in abt. 1810.

△ By the 1850 Census, Elizabeth Upchurch, 42, is listed in the household of my 3<sup>rd</sup> ggrandfather, John Morgan Burris. We can assume she never married, as she is listed by my grandaunt May in her journal as being Miss Betty Upchurch and saving the "Hickory Hill" Burris Bible in 1864. In 1864 she would have been 56, and if still a "Miss" @ 56 I think it is safe to assume she never married.

△ In the 1850 Census, Craven Haywood Upchurch is listed as a 24 year old farmer in the household of Alfred Pryor.

□ + □ Brother to Elizabeth, William (jr) has married Francis and has children Washington, Job, Emily, Mary and Gillum.  
□ + □ Sister to Elizabeth, Mary "Polly" has married William Burris and has kids.

△ + □ + △ So when William Burris' dad has him evicted from the family farm in 1859, Mary "Polly" and sister "Miss" Elizabeth Upchurch move to Hickory Hill, MO.

□ + □ + □ Craven Haywood Upchurch (brother of Mary "Polly" Upchurch) marries Anna Bardell and one of their kids Nannie Newby Upchurch marries Craven Haywood Beck Burris (son of Mary "Polly").

□ + □ Craven Haywood Beck Burris, is the first cousin of Nannie Newby Upchurch.

Dear Cousin Steve,

It was great to have your call of 29 MAR 02 making a correction in your letter of 26 MAR 02 which did reach me later in the day. I have now extracted all the details you provided and placed them on the master outline and/or in the appropriate bifiles. We have made and keep making progress but have a long way to go.

It was a surprise to learn that you visit the St Louis Area in your work. We live about 5 minutes away from the MARK ANDY Company you visit so it will be no trouble for us to get together when you next come to town. Give me a little advance notice and I will keep the calendar free. We will be away 2-7 MAY 02 - on a trip to England - Lyburn Research.

I have now found Valhalla Cemetery on my map and it will be easy to get there. I will try to make a preliminary visit in April to see what it is like. I will also try to drive down to Gray Summit to see if we can locate Brush Creek Cemetery.

The Upshur gravesites you noted in Jackson Co, TN are of much interest to me. In due course I will hope to get more detail on the actual inscriptions - names of cemeteries, locations. We hope to make a trip to NC sometime in 2002 and we could detour for a visit to Jackson Co, TN without too much trouble. If we do go perhaps you could give me some pointers.


I have taken note of the fact that Craven Haywood Beck Basin named his cousin Nannie Newby & but that we need to establish whether or not they were first cousins (as my Master's outline now implies).

There are still several more actions I can undertake about the Jackson Co, TN Group & I am sure you have more to undertake.



As one bit of sharing I provide herewith a copy of my 10-Page, 19-Item **Biosketch** on **John Millet II**. He was the son of Gallium II b 1810. His middle initial is "M" and there is conflicting information on whether this stands for "MILLET" or "M'MILLAN". I have settled on "MILLET" for now. You will note that in the past I have had input from two Daughters-in-Law of John Millet II. I have not had contact with either of them in the last several years. They may still be alive - or not ?? I will welcome any comment on these records you may have.

I am excited about the prospect of you and I meeting in person and trust that in the meantime we can continue our exchange by mail and phone.

Stene called to say he has a letter in the mail to me (it arrived later in the day) that had an error. Paragraph 4 in this letter & PB reports that Elizabeth Burns b 1806 md (1st) William Stafford and md (2nd) Gilliam U. Stene says this is incorrect in that records show Elizabeth Burns was still married to William Stafford in 1877 according to a 1877 TN Supreme Court case

WILLIAM U b about 1778 (NC) who headed an Upland household in Jackson Co, TN in 1820 & 1830 according to census records for those years. We have reason to believe he was born in NC as one of his presumed sons reported on a later census.

We still don't know the father of William U b abt 1778 (NC) and I need to spend about 40 hours researching that issue. Given his approximate birth date there is an excellent chance he was a member of the 5th generation of the American Upland family and as such would be the head of an Upland clan (we have 22 identified so far).

Enclosed is a copy of my Master outline for the Jackson Co, TN Upland Family. This is a work in progress and needs much more effort. I hope you and I can work together on this matter.

Perhaps we can get others to work with us.

The first sheet of the Master outline starts with what we know about the family of William U. b. abt 1778 (NC) as shown on the 1820 & 1830 census of Jackson Co, TN. Bear in mind that these census records can sometimes be in error either because the census taker was given the wrong information, or he misunderstood, or the information has not been extracted correctly.

I have organized the first sheet as if William U. b. abt 1778 could have had as many as 14 children (by one or possibly two wives) born about 2 years apart - not uncommon for that era - also it was common for some of the children to die young. In the last column on the first sheet I have identified sections I → IX (which follow after the green sheet). Each of these sections represents an actual or likely or possible child of William U. b. abt 1778. I am more confident about some of these than some others on the list.

The IX sections have been organized as if each of the presumed children of William U about 1778 was actually a member of the 6th generation of the Upchurch family in America. These sections include successive generations down through the 9th generation. Descendants beyond this presumed 9th generation are covered in continuation sections as indicated by the numbers on the left hand side of the pages. These continuation sections appear after the pink sheet. This arrangement is used to be compatible with my other records (Master outlines).

I will welcome any corrections or additions you have for this Master outline.

It is great that you plan to visit Jackson Co, TN. Can you tell me when you might go? I could have some hints for you. Do you have a phone

number where I can reach you? (5)

It is of interest that some of your family history has been played out in MO given that I now live in MO. Have you visited the area of Eldon, MO? Do you know the location of the cemetery near Gray Summit, MO (Franklin Co, MO) where your relatives are buried. I could visit there easily. Do you know where Valhalla cemetery is in St Louis?

I am sure there is much more we can share and I look forward to hearing from you and to having your questions and any input you are able to make

Thanks so much for the Upchurch information you sent, but I am so new to this that I don't really know what it all means.

- Nannie Newby Upchurch was not born until 1860, so the other Upchurch's that you sent from Jackson County, TN are perhaps relatives, but ... I don't know how to "connect the dots".

Why is Craven Haywood Upchurch listed under Alfred Pryer? In the 1850 Census? And someplace one of Craven's sisters (Betty) is described as being born in NC.

I plan to go to Jackson County to see if my Burris side can shed some light on this, but don't even know what to look for. What do you do? Go to the courthouse and ask for what?

I'll be glad to reorder my priorities in order to put these records in some semblance of order. I have a fair amount of semi-processed records for this task. I have doubts that my records will all fit neatly into a family tree for all the Jackson Co, TN but we may eventually get there.

Enclosed sheet [B] shows some of my Jackson Co, TN records. It seems the Charles Washington U on this sheet is different from the Charles Washington U in the records you sent to me. Do you agree? And yet they probably trace back to a common ancestor. Enclosed sheet [C] shows a William U b DEC 1861. I presume this is the same as William L. U age 18 on sheet [B].

usually I can tie 90% of Upchurch descendants back to the main family right away. You fall into the other 10%.

At this point we need all the Upchurch data from Jackson Co, TN we can get to help fit the pieces together. I have never worked specifically on this matter. Perhaps you might be able to get some of the

items. If you don't know how to go about this I suggest a trip to your closest LDS (MORMON) Church. They can usually provide lots of help. We are talking about census, marriage, births, deaths, cemetery, etc records.

I'll work on organizing my Jackson Co, TN records as soon as I can get to it. Right now I am in the middle of writing the next Upchurch Bulletin. Details on my Upchurch publications are enclosed.

If you are willing to work cooperatively on this matter, I am sure we can make good progress. As we proceed I'll have more to tell you about the Upchurch family and how they moved about and how we might try to link the Jackson Co, TN Group into the main body of the family.

On January 1, 1900, Carl Ray Burris started to work for the Frisco Railroad as an engine crew "call boy" at the Choteau Avenue roundhouse in St. Louis. He was only 17, but lied about his age to get the job. He worked various jobs and was promoted to hostler. June of 1903, he resigned from the Frisco to attend Henderson Business College. His short academic career lasted only until September 3, 1903 when he went to work for the Rock Island Railroad at Union, MO. When he first moved away from home, his father (Craven Haywood Beck Burris) gave him \$5 to last him until the end of the month when he (Carl) would be paid. That was not enough money, so he bought loaves of bread and went back to the rooming house to eat lunch every day. Daniel Ulrey, noticed this, and gave Carl Ray Burris enough money to last him so that he could eat. Daniel Ulrey Burris is named in honor of Daniel Ulrey. He watched engines from Vigus, Versailles, Forsythe Junction and Windsor until about a year later he was promoted to fireman on September 6, 1904. He was later promoted to engineer and worked as an engineer until his retirement in January 1953. Once on a trip to New Orleans, he went down to the docks to buy some bananas. Carl Ray Burris loved bananas and he heard you could get them cheaper at the dock. He asked the man for a quarters worth and the man handed him the whole stalk. Carl Ray was too embarrassed to let on that this was unexpected, and he took the stalk home and began to eat and eat. He ate until they began to turn black, and still he ate some more. He ate bananas until he was so sick of bananas that until his death, he could not stand to be in a house that had a banana in it. The smell of a banana made him sick to his stomach.
