The cem is about 1 acre in size and enclosed by a 4' high chain link fence. There is an opening but no gate. Just inside the gate there is the marker in honor of James T. U. (although he is not buried here). The cem is well maintained. The monuments flush with the ground for each infant is about 1' x 1'. At each marker, row on row, there are two plastic flowers - one purple and one white - which appear to be about two years old (who places these). The day of our visit was fine.

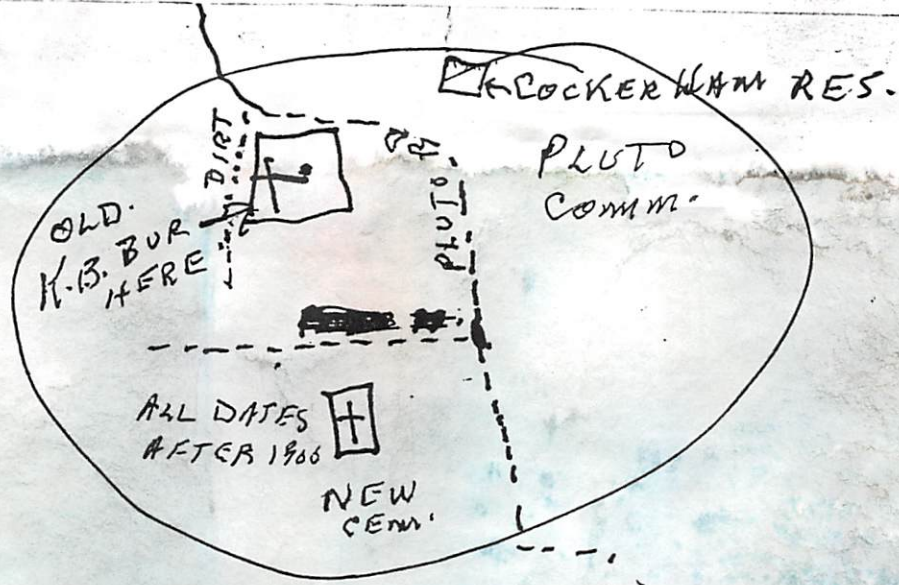

After our phone conversation last evening my curiosity went wild. This morning I decided to do something about it. I saddled up early and went to Itasca. From there I learned directions to the Pluto community. There are two cemeteries there but the first one I checked out yielded nothing. All the markers were dated after 1900. I obtained directions to the second and hit pay dirt. This is a very old cemetery and has been abandoned. It is grown up in brush and trees and is on the banks of a creek. I was told it floods frequently. I talked with a Mr. Cockerham who lives near this cemetery. [This is the same name as your number 10063] He did not know of any relative ever marrying an Upchurch. He is not into family research however and I may have opened another can of worms. She was the wife of James Everett Upchurch Sr. b. 11 Sept 1893, your number 10055.

Back to the Pluto cemetery. I found the marker for Kenyon Brannon Upchurch b. 3 May 1839 d. 7 Dec 1893 Husband of M.S. Upchurch but there was no marker for her, exactly. At the foot of K.B.s marker was another marker marked Sarah M. Upchurch b. 27 Aug 1829 d. 22 Feb 1894. These dates do not correspond with your biofile for the wife of Kenyon Brannon Upchurch. The initials are also backwards and the marker is at the foot of K.B. and not by side. Also in the same area is a marker R.E. Upchurch b 1854 d. 1897. Nothing else. Also in the same area is a marker Jennie L. Upchurch wife of J. H. Powers, daughter of W.A. & R.J. Upchurch, b. 1869 d. 1893. These were not in a family plot as such but all were in the same area with no markers between. I checked all the headstones in this cemetery that are visible and there were no more Upchurch

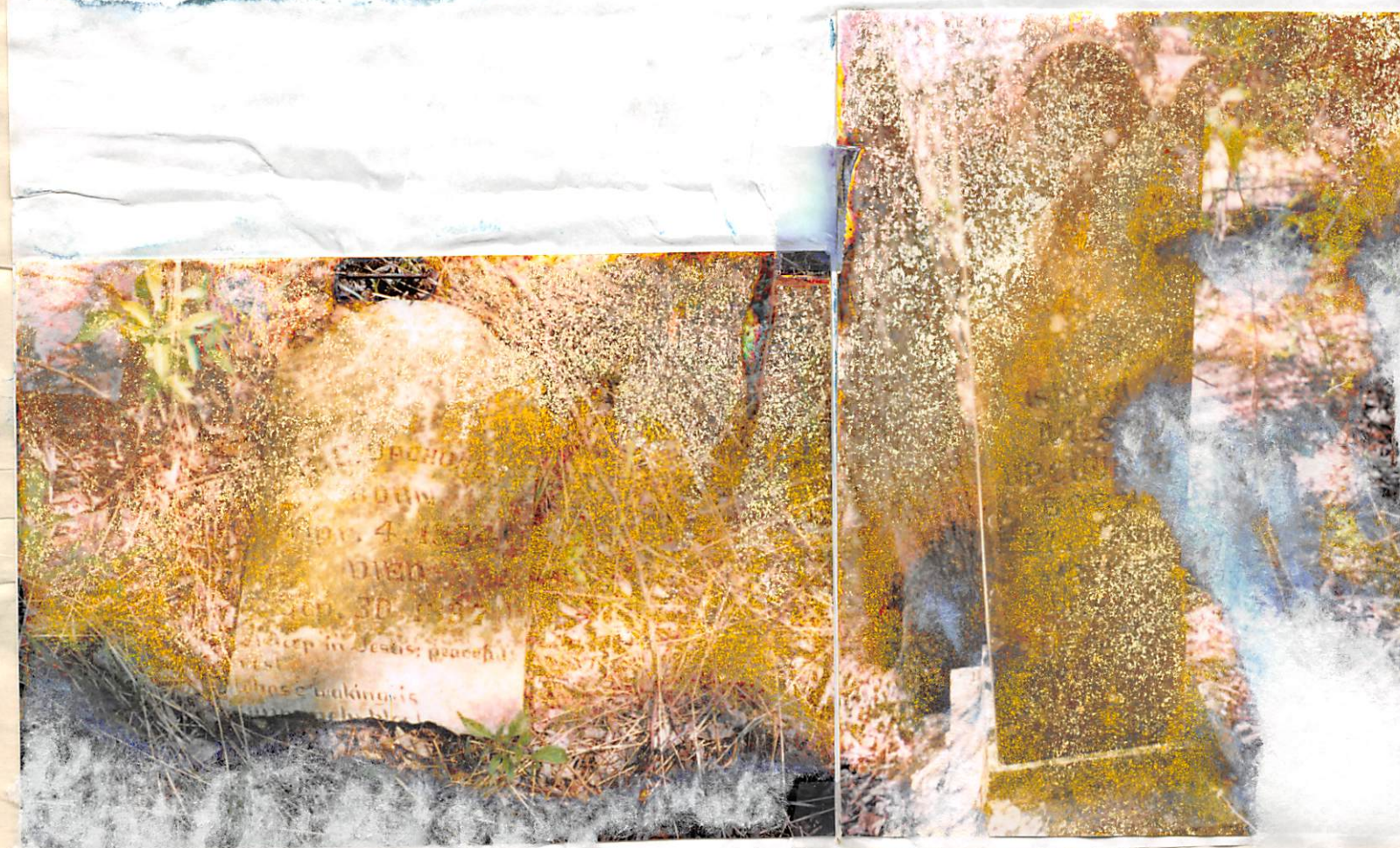
This cemetery and the Pluto community is in Ellis county by about a mile or so. It is just off F.M. Roads 934 & 66 between Itasca and Maypearl. I am enclosing a rough sketch of the area which should give you a general idea where The Pluto community lies. My Atlas shows a F.M. Road 916 but it runs from Grandview to Maypearl. 934 runs directly through the middle of Itasca.

I hope this is a big a relief to you as it is to me. Kenyon Brannon Upchurch has bugged me ever since you told me you were trying to locate his burial site. I suppose 25 years as a Tex. Ranger instilled in me the inability to give up. Now, like the ancient mathematician Pythagoras I can exclaim EUREKA!!!

△ There is one grave in the corner that has a marker but is not an

# THE CEMETERY LADY

FRANCES  
 JAMES  
 WORKS TO  
 GIVE OLD  
 GRAVEYARDS  
 NEW LIFE

Frances James drives her station wagon through an enclave of stately condominiums in North Dallas to get to a graveyard that is little-known and tucked away.

Finding the place is tricky; no signs point it out. Ms. James, who is a habitué of Dallas-area cemeteries, makes it her business to know where such places are.

"It's somewhere behind this batch of apartments," she says just before approaching the alley off Preston Oaks Road that leads to the White Rock Garden of Memories, a pioneer burial ground with graves dating back to 1852.

Ms. James is eager to show a visitor one of the places she hopes the state will recognize as a historic land-

mark.

She is helping the trustees of the property file the necessary papers to make it happen. But that is not all she does as a volunteer advocate of cemeteries.

She also works to see that developers don't encroach and vandals don't destroy and people don't forget how important graveyards are.

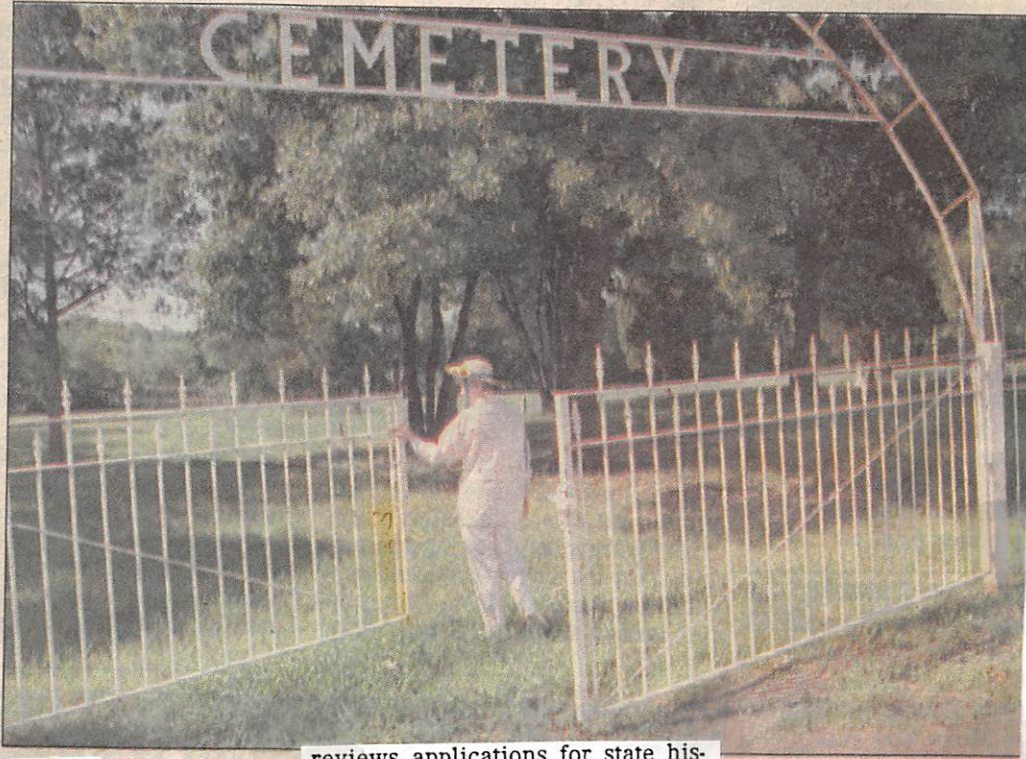
"Cemeteries are sacred places," says the 73-year-old grandmother, who lives in East Dallas. "I just want to see that they are taken care of."

Not everyone would appreciate having a moniker that conjures images of graves and their occupants, but Ms. James doesn't mind the reference.

"There are worse things they could call me," says Ms. James, who is a former member of the Dallas County Historical Commission.

Over the years, she has researched the history of dozens of graveyards and, when possible, helped cemetery associations secure historic markers for them. She has helped organize groups to

spruce up those that have fallen into disrepair and has fought developers who wanted to build over them.

She is particularly partial to gravesites that are old, relatively obscure and often neglected.

Private groups maintain most of the 200 or so cemeteries in the city and county. Many of the sites are small, family operations and "if they die, nobody usually steps in to fill the void," says Rick Loessberg, planning and development coordinator of the Dallas County Historical Commission. The commission

reviews applications for state historic markers and promotes preservation of other historic sites.

"You can't call the city of Dallas and say, 'Who's in charge of cemeteries,' because there isn't such a creature," Mr. Loessberg says.

"So having somebody like Frances involved is really important."

Ms. James served on the commission for six years during the mid-1980s and was granted honorary status after her term ended. She was recognized by the commission for helping to prepare the highest number of applications for historic markers for old cemeteries.

Donald Payton, former commission member and historian, credits Ms. James for helping caretakers of African-American gravesites.

He recalls her efforts to help preserve the old Freedman's Cemetery, at Lemmon Avenue and Campbell Street near Central Expressway in old North Dallas.

When the expressway was widened in 1990, and machines were digging up bones from part of the

graveyard, Ms. James informed Mr. Payton and other supporters of the cemetery that state law prohibits the highway department from widening until the remains of those buried in the path of the expansion are removed.

"She was the one who knew the rules and the laws," says Mr. Payton, who specializes in African-American history in Dallas. "I knew it was morally wrong, but Frances had the documentation."

"We started calling her the Cemetery Lady because that's what she has worked on the most," says Mammie McKnight, founder of Black Dallas Remembered, a historic society.

George Keaton, trustee of the White Rock Garden of Memories, praises Ms. James for helping him with the logistics of getting a historic marker for the two-acre cemetery that was purchased from whites by the former slaves of George Coit,

one of Dallas' early settlers.

"If it has to do with cemeteries, it all comes back to her," says Mr. Keaton. "When she's gone I don't know what we'll do. We'll be lost."

Ms. James' penchant for cemeteries began in 1981 when, during a cleanup project in her old East Dallas neighborhood, she stumbled across an overgrown vacant lot in the 6500 block of Military Parkway. It turned out to be the old Glover Cemetery, named for one of Dallas' pioneer families. The oldest marked grave is dated 1857.

"It took us two years to get a marker there," she said. "After I did that, I realized how much history is buried there."

Her work eventually led to her appointment to the Dallas County Historical Commission, where she served from 1983 to 1989.

In 1993, as president of the Dallas County Pioneer Association, Ms. James led an effort to replace miss-

ing headstones at the Pioneer Cemetery located next to the bronze longhorn exhibit in front of the Dallas Convention Center.

Ms. James rarely lets a week go by without visiting at least one gravesite. And she goes prepared. To ward off chiggers and other pests, she keeps cheesecloth sacks of powdered sulfur handy to dust around her ankles and arms.

"That's the first thing you do to protect yourself when you get out to an old cemetery," says the energetic grandmother. "I've been bitten too many times."

She says her children find her peculiar hobby amusing but they have been supportive.

"They say this at least keeps me off the streets and out of the bars."
