Hello Cousin Phil,

It's great to hear from you!

>> She tells me her Uncle Paul's land is now owned by his daughter and I wonder if that includes the Mills Cemetery? Perhaps you know <<

Yes, Paul's daughter, Tempy Mills Marcum owns the 60 acres of land that her father had inherited ... a portion of the original Nathan Mills property. The road that goes by the cemetery, is a private driveway, as is the cemetery itself.

With the installation of the several concrete markers that I made during the early 1990s, along with the government military markers, it's not likely that this cemetery will be moved by a contractor in the future.

The current upkeep of the cemetery is done by a Mills descendant who lives in the Green Level area. It was first kept up (1993-2003) by my cousin Carolyn Mills Abernathy and her husband, but she is now in a senior living community, and her husband passed a few years back.

It's good to hear that your UAFA project is coming along well. Thanks for keeping me updated.

With our move to a new place and my brief stay in the hospital we have been rather preoccupied lately. The event was triggered when Staley Smith of Apex told me he had an aunt who has lived most of her adult life in south St. Louis. She is Anna (Mills) Kilzer daughter of Ulon Mills. I had lunch with her yesterday and we enjoyed recalling things about the Apex area. She tells me her Uncle Paul's land is now owned by his daughter and I wonder if that includes the Mills Cemetery? Perhaps you know. More of that later.

We are building momentum on our new organization Upchurch and Allied Families Association, Inc. Just recently we received approval for our 501 (c) 3 tax-exempt status. 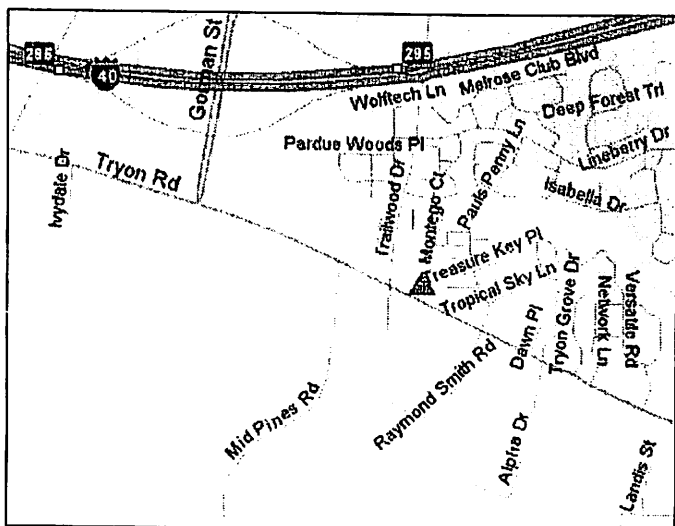

Wiley L. Buffaloe Cemetery

Directions: from SR 1371 (Lake Wheeler Rd.) go west on SR 1009 (Tryon Rd.). The cemetery was on the north side in the vicinity of Trailwood Drive. The cemetery was in a field on the other side of a barn. The cemetery was destroyed about 2000. Graves have been relocated, but location unknown. Student housing for North Carolina State University has been built on the site.



Triangle indicates the approximate former site of the cemetery

This cemetery was first reported by Dr. Phil UPCHURCH in 1993 with a map and description of the general vicinity. He wrote, "The present day main road (Tryon Rd.) was constructed in the 1940 era and lies 100 yards south of the original road. The Buffaloe home was on the north side (of the original road) and the cemetery was in a field on the crest of a hill about 100 yards east of the home. The home was occupied by the widow of Mr. (Andrew) Buffaloe circa 1938 and she must have been about 60 years old at that time. Her daughter, (Eva) Mrs. (George) Phipps lived just across the road to the south."

There is both a Wiley Buffaloe and a Thomas J. Buffaloe ---brothers. The dates are OK. T. J . was a bachelor called Tuck and lived with his brother Wiley. Wiley died in 1928 and Tuck in 1929 so I never knew either. But I knew the widow Alice well. When I was about 10 I wandered the community and her home was one I visited. She loved flowers and had a yard full. She had a front room full of crepe flowers she had created and she allowed me to inspect them. I am having trouble understanding why she took up time with a boy just rambling around. Some of this is what I want to capture in my memoirs and some in my treatment of the history of Swift Creek Township. The FAG records including those I can create blend into making a coherent picture.

I looked at your cemetery description for the Wiley Buffaloe Cemetery, and it looks fine. I also looked at the FG memorial for him at Oakwood. Was his name T.J. Buffaloe? Also, if it was, the death date is wrong on the tombstone. See attached Death Certificate for him.

I look forward to the next few videos about the Upchurch family. When posting the link in the bio area of the FG memorial pages, just exchange the url of the video, within the quotation marks in that bio. You can cut and paste the current text from the bio on Richard Upchurch, II for the basic code, then just exchange the url for the video to be used on the FG memorial.

>> Also note that I have interjected a personal note. Is this in keeping with FAG protocol? <<

Yes, as long as you post the name and date of the creator of that info.

When using the genealogybank.com website, I found it easiest to click "newspaper articles" for the very old info in the newspapers. The Probate area is also good. I use it often and have found a lot of good info. If quoting from those newspapers, anything prior to 90 years old (1923) is in the public domain. Past that, it varies, but if the source is quoted, it is usually OK. Just download the .pdf of the particular article and keep them on your computer for a printout later.

UPCHURCH BURIAL SITES IN VIRGINIA BEFORE 1800

By Robert Philip Upchurch---August 14, 2013

Michael Upchurch, I was born about 1624 in Huntingdonshire, England and arrived in Surry County, Virginia about 1638 where he and his wife died, he in 1681 and she in 1691. Their children were born, died, and were buried there. Their grandchildren were born in Surry County, VA but died and were buried elsewhere in VA. Knowledgeable Upchurch historians posit that the Upchurch burials in Surry Co., VA were in an Upchurch rural family cemetery in or near Lawnes Creek Parish. No tangible evidence of this burial ground is today extant.

The grandchildren of Michael Upchurch, I, John Upchurch, I and James Upchurch, I and many of his great-grandchildren congregated in small section of southeastern Brunswick Co., VA. Several of these two generations owned plantations in this Upchurch Enclave and evidence points to the existence of a rural cemetery to serve the Upchurch members of this Enclave who died in the area. There is no known physical evidence of this Upchurch Enclave Cemetery of Brunswick Co., VA. All evidence points to the location of the Upchurch plantations as being on the fertile plateau between the Meherrin River and Fontaine Creek in south eastern Brunswick County near the town of Fitzhugh. Upchurch researchers place the burials of James Upchurch, I and his sons Michael Upchurch, III and James Upchurch, II in the Upchurch Enclave Cemetery. John Upchurch, I and his son James Upchurch, III are most likely also buried in the Upchurch Enclave Cemetery of Brunswick Co., VA.

With rare exceptions the members of the fifth generation of the Upchurch family in America were not buried in Brunswick Co., VA but for the most part died and were buried in NC. A few of the fifth generation moved to states beyond such as GA, AL, and KY where they lived out their days.

BASIS FOR LOCATING THE NATHAN UPCHURCH, I CEMETERY AT

GREEN LEVEL IN WAKE COUNTY, NC

About 1803 Nathan Upchurch, I moved from Franklin Co., NC to the area of Green Level in western Wake Co., NC. By the time of his demise in 1835 he and his family had accumulated a large amount of land in the area including the tract on which Green Level Church and Cemetery were to be established more than two decades after Nathan died. Given the circumstances of the time we may be reasonably sure that Nathan Upchurch, I established a cemetery near his home. Mt. Pisgah Baptist Church was formed in 1814 but the practice of burials at churches was slow to evolve given the penchant of early seventeenth century rural Americans to bury their loved ones close to their homes.

Our knowledge of the Upchurch lands on the Wake-Chatham border was greatly enhanced by yeoman research done by our late Cousin John Lee Upchurch, Jr.

The product of his professional quality research was published in the Upchurch Bulletin, Vol. 4, No. 2, April 1983, pages 50-59. During the course of the research being done by John Lee, he and I took many field trips to various Upchurch sites in Wake and surrounding counties. We were constantly on the look-out for old Upchurch cemeteries and prospects for the location of the Nathan Upchurch I cemetery was high on our list and our attention focused on spots no further than 1/2 mile from Green Level Church.

Following the publication of article by John Lee, he and I had the opportunity to have one more effort regarding the cemetery. Notes made to record my July 16-21, 1983 sojourn to NC included the following: "On Sunday 17 JUL 1983 RPU and John Lee U., Jr. stood at the Green Level Baptist Church in Wake Co., NC and speculated on the location of the Nathan U., I family cemetery. Looking south one sees a prospective site in a grove of trees that protrudes into the field. On the 18th Albert Murray Council, Sr. said he owned the grove and that his GF and his Uncle told him that there was a family cemetery there and that it should not be plowed. Albert remembers graveyard markers from years past but none are now to be found. He says that the frame house just west of the crossroads on the north side of the road is over 100 years old and that it was built in sections. A few years ago Albert tore down an old kitchen associated with the farm house. Albert says there was a brick kiln across the road from the farm house. It seems likely that the Nathan U., I home site was where the frame house now stands. It is highly likely that the grove behind this frame house was the Nathan U., I family cemetery plot".

There is a sequel to this sojourn. It turns out that our Cousin George Atlas Upchurch, II, a retired Air Force Colonel has as a hobby using a metal detector to discover buried metal objects. He has had success in England uncovering Roman coins. We enlisted his participation to see if he could detect metal objects in the wooded area we nominated to be the Nathan Upchurch, I Family Cemetery. We had hoped metal casket handles might be near enough to the surface to register on the metal detector.

This was a long shot which was not successful. Still, we have good information from descendants of Nathan Upchurch, I that the grove of trees just south of Green Level Church is, indeed, the site of the Nathan Upchurch I Family Cemetery.

EXACT LOCATION OF THE JAMES UPCHURCH, VII CEMETERY IN

FRANKLIN CO., NC

The late Ben Perry was a lifelong resident of Dunns Township in Franklin Co., NC. His Perry ancestors and the Upchurches lived near each other from the Revolution onward. On my periodic visits with Ben he often referred to a very old Upchurch family cemetery. The story of how we finally found the exact location of the cemetery is told in Upchurch Bulletin, Vol. 29, No. 1, January-June 2008, pages 25-27. A more personal version taken from my trip notes is as follows: "At about 10:45 a.m. on May 15, 2008 Simon Rogers, Miley Albert Perry "Monk" RPU and Elizabeth Warner Freeman parked below the pond of Dalles Pearace and walked up the hill under the utility line to inspect the Upchurch cemetery that I had long hoped to see. Monk actually found it a month or so ago. We reached the top of the hill and proceeded across a flat area about 300 feet wide. When we had almost reached the end of the flat area we came to an area of cut over land on the left. Monk led us off to the left where I saw for the first time the site. There is only one stone and it is a field stone that has a readable date of 1833. There was some writing on it but so far no one has been able to read it. There are at least 2 more stones. The 1833 stone and one other has a discernible depression. There could be other burials. We took pictures and Monk recorded the GPS position as: 35 55 22 N 0/1/11, 78 19 59 W. Distance to Little Berry Phillips house 1.09 miles bearing 015. The site is 250' by GPS (15 degrees to right of north) from the center of the utility line".

Reasonable circumstantial evidence leads us to believe that the 1833 marked stone is for the resting place of James Upchurch, VII, a son of Richard Upchurch, III, and a grandson of Richard Upchurch, II. This stone is on a 400 acre tract on which James Upchurch, VII lived at the time of his death. He willed the tract to his daughter Elizabeth Thaney (Upchurch) Phillips. On a portion of the tract still stands the John and Elizabeth Thaney Phillips "Mansion", now abandoned. The house and some acreage is now owned by our erstwhile friend and guide Simon Rogers and it has its own family cemetery.

James Upchurch, VII willed a 278 acre tract to his son Kearney Upchurch. Kearney at his death in 1914 owned a huge amount of land.

The 400 acres of land owned by James Upchurch, VII had been sold to him by his Uncle Moses Upchurch when Moses was preparing to move to eastern Chatham Co., NC about 1803.

INPUT REGARDING THE LOCATION OF THE FRANKLIN CO., NC

UPCHURCH FAMILY CEMETERY

Richard Upchurch, II, born 1725 in Brunswick Co., VA and died in 1798 in Dunns Township in Franklin Co., NC is arguably the progenitor of one-half of all American Upchurches. I along with numerous collaborators have spent thousands of hours over a forty year period researching Upchurch heritage in Dunns Township where Richard's eleven children grew to adulthood and married. A great deal of the research has been published in the 4,000 pages of the Upchurch Bulletin which are now online and searchable. We are now in a position to write about the location of the Franklin Co., NC Upchurch Cemetery. Circumstances dictate that it would have been on the 100 acre home place owned by Richard Upchurch, II as of 1794.

To reinforce our conclusions about the Upchurch family cemetery we can make use of knowledge of local resident Simon Rogers, an octogenarian who has served as our guide on numerous tours of Franklin Co., NC over the last twenty years. Poplar Springs Church in Dunns Township dates to the Revolution and is the mother church of the area. I noted there was no cemetery at the church. Simon said "of course not, in these days people were always buried in family cemeteries".

An obvious conclusion is that Upchurches who died in Dunns Township up into the early 1800s would have been buried where the patriarch Richard Upchurch, II lived. We are fortunate to know exactly where his 100 acre home place was as of 1794. This is revealed by a deed of gift Richard made to his son Nathan on September 17, 1794 "... all my right, title and interest in the land and plantation where on I live". (Wake County, NC Deed Book 10, page 234).

The details of how we came to know the exact location of the 1794 one hundred acre tract of Richard Upchurch, II is recorded in Upchurch Bulletin, Vol. 13, No. 4, October 1992, pages 132-143. The tract adjoins a larger tract to the west owned by Richard Upchurch, III, another son of Richard Upchurch, II. State Road 1103 (Pilot-Riley Road) transverses the larger tract and both tracts lay just west of State Road 1730 (Williams-White Road). Otherwise described the larger tract is on the north bank of Moccasin Creek half-way between the villages of Pilot and Pearces.

Tangible evidence of the Franklin Co., NC Upchurch Cemetery has not yet been found but additional serious searches may yet yield physical evidence.

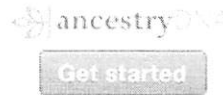

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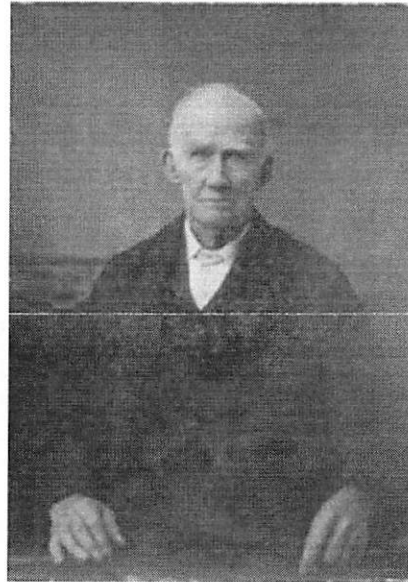

Pisgah Church for a number of years before moving their membership to Green Level Baptist Church. After the death of wife Adelia in 1893, he married secondly, Rosanah (Mrs. R. A. Taylor) on 3 February 1903. He is buried on the Old Family Homeplace.

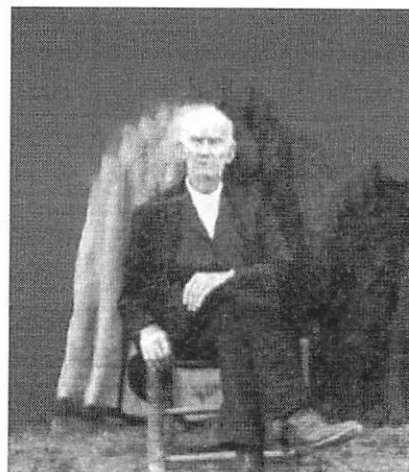

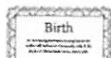

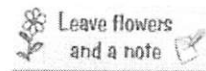

From Revolutionary War Pension File No. S 7-776 for Moses Upchurch:

"I resided in Franklin Co., NC until 1775, when I enlisted in a Company of Light Horse, commanded by Captain Jones, Lt. Medici, and Ensign Armstrong, and mustered in at Hunter's Old Tavern in said county. From thence we marched to Duplin Old Court House, from thence to Fayetteville, and from thence to Charleston. While there, the Battle of Sullivan's Island was fought, but I was not in the engagement. From thence we marched to Savannah. At Purtyzburg, I was mustered into General Sumner's Army. From Savannah, I marched back to North Carolina, where I was actively engaged in subduing the Tories until my discharge at Halifax Court House on 28 June 1776, after having served a period of at least fourteen and a half months. In 1778, I volunteered my service in a Company of Horse in the County of Wake, commanded by Captain Hunter, and served two months. My discharge was signed by Capt. Hunter, but I am unable to produce same, as it has been lost."

We handle transfer requests in accordance with Find A Grave policy as quoted below. Please do not request a transfer unless the request follows those guidelines. Please note that transfers are only required if you are a direct relative within four generations per the Second section below. Below is Find-A-Graves transfer guidelines:

How do I get a relative's memorial transferred to me?

First, Determine if you really need the memorial transferred to you for management. Transferring of management should only be requested if you have extensive changes to make to a memorial. You can add photos and suggest corrections without having to request management. Simply having someone in your family tree is not grounds for a management transfer request. With hundreds of thousands of contributors, we have many overlapping family trees and it would be impossible for all contributors to manage their entire tree.

Second, Transfer requests should be for

direct relatives within four generations. This would be your siblings, parents, grandparents, great-grandparents, children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren.

Third, If you have extensive additions/changes to make to a memorial, please contact the Find A Grave member who created the memorial via the "Suggest a Correction" link under the "Edit" tab on the memorial in question with your request to have the memorial management transferred to you. This will send an email request to the contributor, even if there is not an email address listed on their contributor page.

Fourth, Explain your relationship in the request! Any non-direct relatives (aunts,

Fifth, The "Suggest a correction" feature may also be used to submit corrections, an original biography, and family links to memorials that do not fall under the above definition. (Be sure to include the memorial ID#s for the family links and how they are related, father, mother or spouse. The original contributor should make any corrections and add any additional information you have for that memorial, such as links to parents and spouses, provided the information is accurate.

Sixth, Please note that it is not appropriate to request a transfer and then, after receiving the transfer, delete that page and substitute it with a new memorial that you have created. This practice denies credit to the original contributor. Please use the original memorial page to make updates and add information.

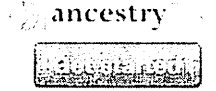

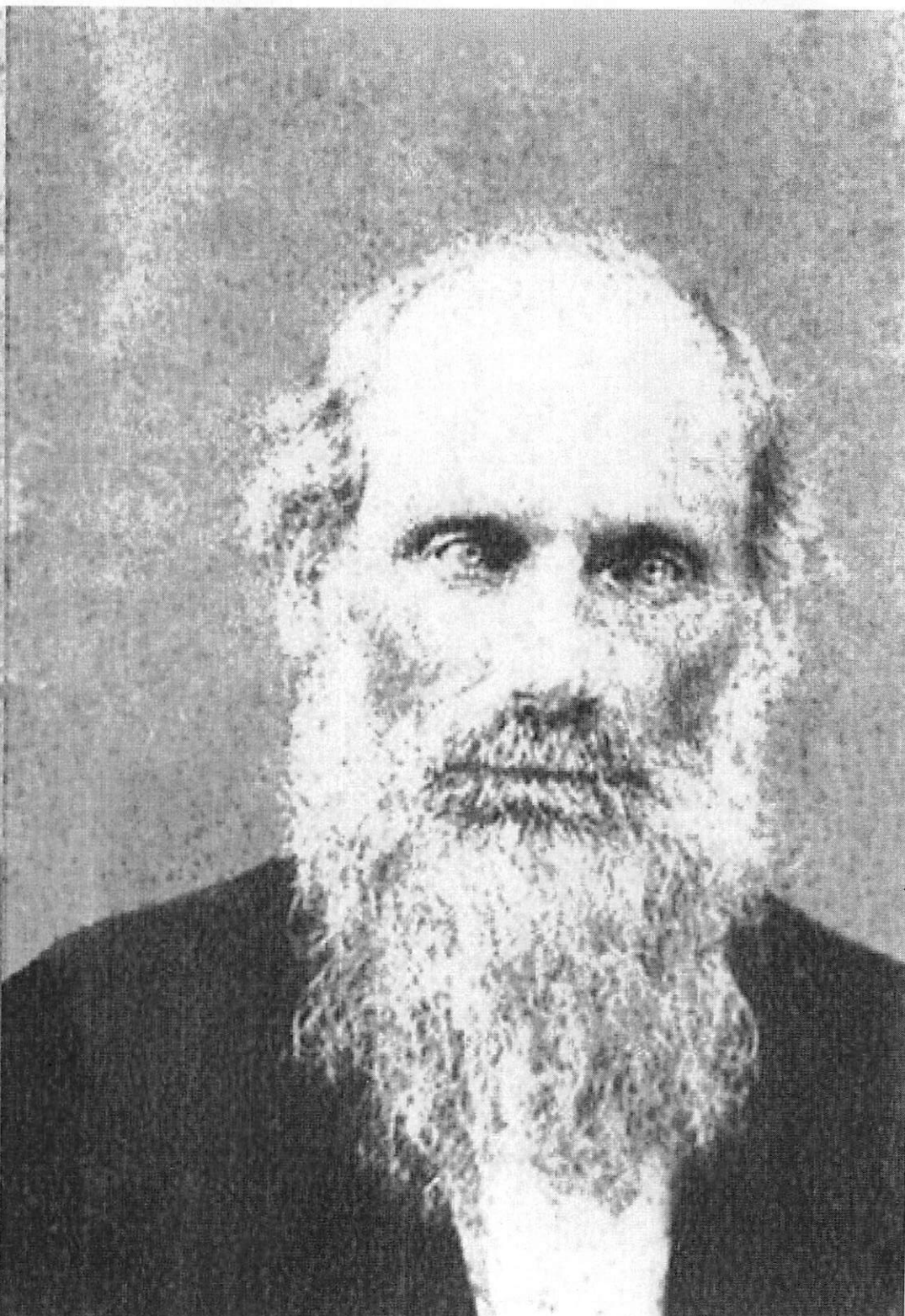

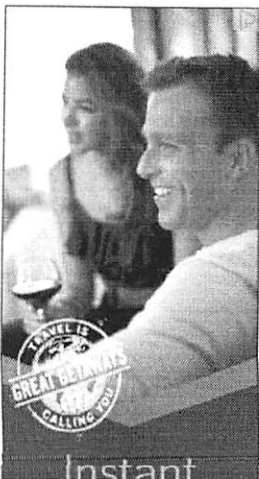

You are making great progress with FindAGrave (FAG) memorial pages ... and in only one day! You will hit the 100 mark before long.

For a basic tutorial on the overall Upchurch Project, and to keep it fairly short for first-time visitors, I would suggest showing the Main chart with the Upchurch ancestors from Michael I to his great grandchildren, and a brief listing of those clans below Richard II. It would also be informative to include a basic intro to your www.upchurchstory.com site, such as a listing of the resources there.

For now, I would list the basic plan for the new organization (ACFA) on a separate, regular length video (15 minutes) and have a link on your www.upchurchstory.com site. The basic Upchurch tutorial video for use on the bulk of your memorial pages would probably be best not to show any initial, commercial content. That can be found when they arrive at the www.upchurchstory.com site.

It would also be useful to include a link to the overall **Library of Upchurch Videos**:

The sooner the memorial pages are created for the **7 early Upchurch ancestors**, the better ... especially when more visitors to FaG memorial pages see your "hand". It might be best to go ahead and lock in those early generations, and then compile a basic description of those already established Upchurch Family cemeteries in: **Brunswick Co., NC**; **Granville Co., NC** and **Franklin Co., NC**. It would look better to have the creator of those pages, be you ... the Director of the Project.

It is possible that Richard Upchurch, I, is buried at Lawne's Creek Parish Church cemetery. However, there are no early graves listed in that cemetery (besides Michael, I and wife) ... at this time. Listing him at this cemetery, would probably be easiest and have less possible contention from other Upchurch researchers: Michael U, I - died in 1681; his wife, Frances - died in 1691; and Richard U, I - died in 1700.

Hi Cousin Phil,

I think it would probably be easiest for us to discuss some of the basic steps about FAG via a phone call. Tonight would be OK, if you would like. The reason is, you have created two identical pages for the same person at Inwood, and FAG **will flag you for that**. You now **must delete one of those pages**, and I need to show you how to do that without causing a ruckus with their computers:

You are doing a good job on the FAG memorial pages, but will need to also add links later on. You must edit your profile, so as to limit any potential problems from those who may contend with you about any of the pages you have created. You will need to **change your Public Name**, as Anonymous sounds too mysterious, and some of the other creators may ignore your requests for links. And, you **don't want your email address to be public**, because of the potential for Spam coming to your email box.

>> As matters now stand can anyone make changes in this memorial? Is there anyway I can be made the only person to make changes? <<

Yes, **only you** can make the changes.

>> I note someone else has entered my father Robert Jefferson Upchurch 1880-1948. Does that mean I cannot make changes but must go through them? <<

In actuality, if you didn't know the FAG rules, that could be the case. However, you should request that the page for your father be **transferred to you**: "Please transfer this memorial page to me, as this is my father. Thank You." OR: "Please transfer this memorial page to me, as this is my great grandfather, my direct line ancestor." You can request a transfer to back to your great grandparents, unless someone in that line of direct lineage already maintains that memorial page. I have found, that you can say: "Please transfer this memorial page to me, as this is my direct line ancestor."

>> I found it a little time consuming to make the entries. That should become less of a burden over time but still I am slow. Down the road I might get someone else to make entries for me but right now I just need to learn the process. In order to get as many memorials under my control as possible I think at first the very minimum should be added for a given memorial. Do you agree and can you suggest the minimum? <<

Yes, just their name, birth and death dates, if known. Later, you can add the places of birth and death, etc. You will probably be able to create a memorial page in less than five minutes each.

>> With your help I'll soon be laughing at those people who are afraid to make FAG entries <<

Absolutely! Can you image Belle Lewter West looking over your shoulder, as you are doing what wasn't even imaginable during her day? You are really preserving this data now. Good going!

Like I said, if you want to call me tonight, that will be fine. Tomorrow, I will be gone for most of the day, but should be home by 7 PM.

Please don't be worried about anything that you have done on FAG today, as it can all be remedied. But, ~~we do need to make some immediate changes before the computer flags your account.~~

Hi Cousin Phil,

By tomorrow, the memorial page for your father, should be transferred to your account. Then, it is time to request a transfer for the memorial pages for your mother, your grandmothers (2), grandfathers (2), great grandmothers (4) and great grandfathers (4). Those are your right to have in your account ... unless one of your direct cousins has already claimed them ... pertaining to your grandparents or great grandparents.

When creating the FAG (FindAGrave) pages in bulk, it would probably be easiest to work on one cemetery at a time. I would suggest to continue with Inwood, until you are content.

You learned a lot of the ropes about FAG tonight, so once you practice on about 5 more memorial pages, I think you will be comfortable with it. The main thing is, to check the listing in each cemetery before adding a new memorial page for someone. You can believe that your efforts will be long-lasting.

Since it will require some html code to add the links to your videos on youtube, I can practice on one of my pages, and then just cut and paste the code to you in an email. You can add that directly to the bio area of the page, and it will work instantly for anyone who visits that page. You are already getting exposure by the link to your homepage:
www.upchurchstory.com

Under the bio section of your findagrave profile area, you can provide a sketch of your Upchurch interests, such as: Editor of the Upchurch Bulletin for 40 years, etc. Keep in mind that you will get some emails that have links to your message board. Make sure to keep those cleared off, by just clicking the X in the upper portion of each message on your message board. I sometimes keep the interesting ones, but clear the others.

You are doing well, and like anything, building a foundation by practice, is what hones the skill. By the time you finish adding the pages from the cemetery surveys you have made over the years, you will be an expert before long ... and rightly so.

Because I believe we should act now to add our Upchurch lineage on FindAGrave, I have added some of my direct lines beyond Isham Sims Upchurch, son of Murry. There are many more to do, but I probably won't pursue them for now. However, I may have made an error on where Richard Upchurch II (d about 1797) is buried at. In the Upchurch book by West, on page 28 it shows that Richard U. II made his Will in **Franklin Co., NC**. And, on page 79, it shows it was in **Wake Co., NC**. I was starting at the front of her book, and working to the back, when I found this error. Is it Franklin Co. NC or Wake Co., NC?

As I establish these memorial pages, I am placing our ancestors in Upchurch Family cemeteries in the counties that they died in. All the way up to Isham Sims Upchurch, it appears that is the way the Upchurch family were buried ... **in small family cemeteries**. At a point in the future, if someone comes forward to say that a particular ancestor is buried elsewhere, we will consider the evidence that they may have, such as a reference to an old church cemetery. For now, it is either place them in the various Upchurch Family cemeteries, or show them as "**Burial of remains, is unknown**". If that is the case, if we request that a creator of the memorial pages for the descendants of that person, is linked to an ancestor in an "unknown burial place", **in many cases, they will not do it**. Some will, but most won't. That is just one reason that we need to get these early ancestors listed on FindAGrave.
