

ELEANOR MARKS UPCHURCH II – XID-114



Commentary

Eleanor Marks Upchurch, II (XID 114) “Ellie” was the daughter of Bartley Jefferson Upchurch of the Nathan Upchurch, I/Gilbert Upchurch sub-clan. She was born on her father’s farm in 1875 in Swift Creek Township in Wake County NC, one of 11 children. Although the children were given every advantage, only Ellie progressed to secondary education, obtaining a teaching certificate. Family lore holds that Ellie helped her minister husband, James L. Martin, with his sermons. She was the namesake of Eleanor Marks Upchurch, I, who married her cousin W.G Upchurch, a brother of Bartley. Ellie and Uncle Martin served several churches with minimum recompense. By being frugal and farming on the side they educated their six children.

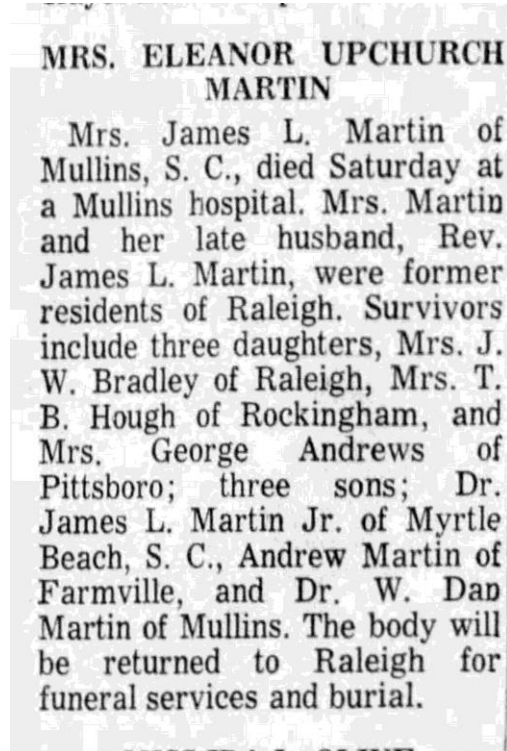

Eleanor Marks U II md 30 DEC 1896 Inwood Church Wake Co. N. C., b 20 DEC 1896 d 30 JUN 1967(RB 1968 on May 2016). Eleanor Upchurch Martin says she visited the Bartley Jefferson Upchurch family and was treated as an outcast (later Ernestine Ray U said this could have been because Bartley had to underwrite his son-in-law James Lee Martin, Sr). (Note- Eleanor Upchurch Martin's sister Mary Garnette Martin has glowing reports of her visit to the Bartley U home – RPU) Eleanor Upchurch Martin reports that

her mother had an unnamed infant dau stillborn prematurely 7 JUL 1899 in Granville, NC at Creedmoor. Dr. Sanderford, attending.

See this letter (or extract with James Lee Martin, Jr. showing that James Lee Martin, Sr. was preacher at Creedmoor, NC when he held a meeting at Inwood Church and there met, and on 30DEC1896 md Eleanor Marks U, II.)The letter details the many places the couple lived, where their 6 children were born, the religious character of “Papa” and the trials of getting the children educated. Mama was the only dau of Bartley Jefferson U to work outside of the home. She taught school.

My Mother, ELEANOR MARKS UII, told my children stories, and now my granddaughter, Ansley Fleetwood Hassell, tells her students these same stories---in Converse College. My daughter, Mary Jane, does likewise. My mother said----at first, there were no schools in the Inwood Community. Grandpa had a teacher come and teach in his home. One day, Aunt Bessie and Mama went upstairs to class and left a little negro girl to watch some candy cook. The little cook disturbed the class by yelling –done, done, done! Later, they had the one room school near the church. Mama went there under Mrs. Lilly Ballantine. I gave Mama’s teaching certificate to Mary Jane. It has her exam grades listed on it. She got all A’s. They could then go to Raleigh and take a test. Mama taught at Six Forks north of Raleigh.

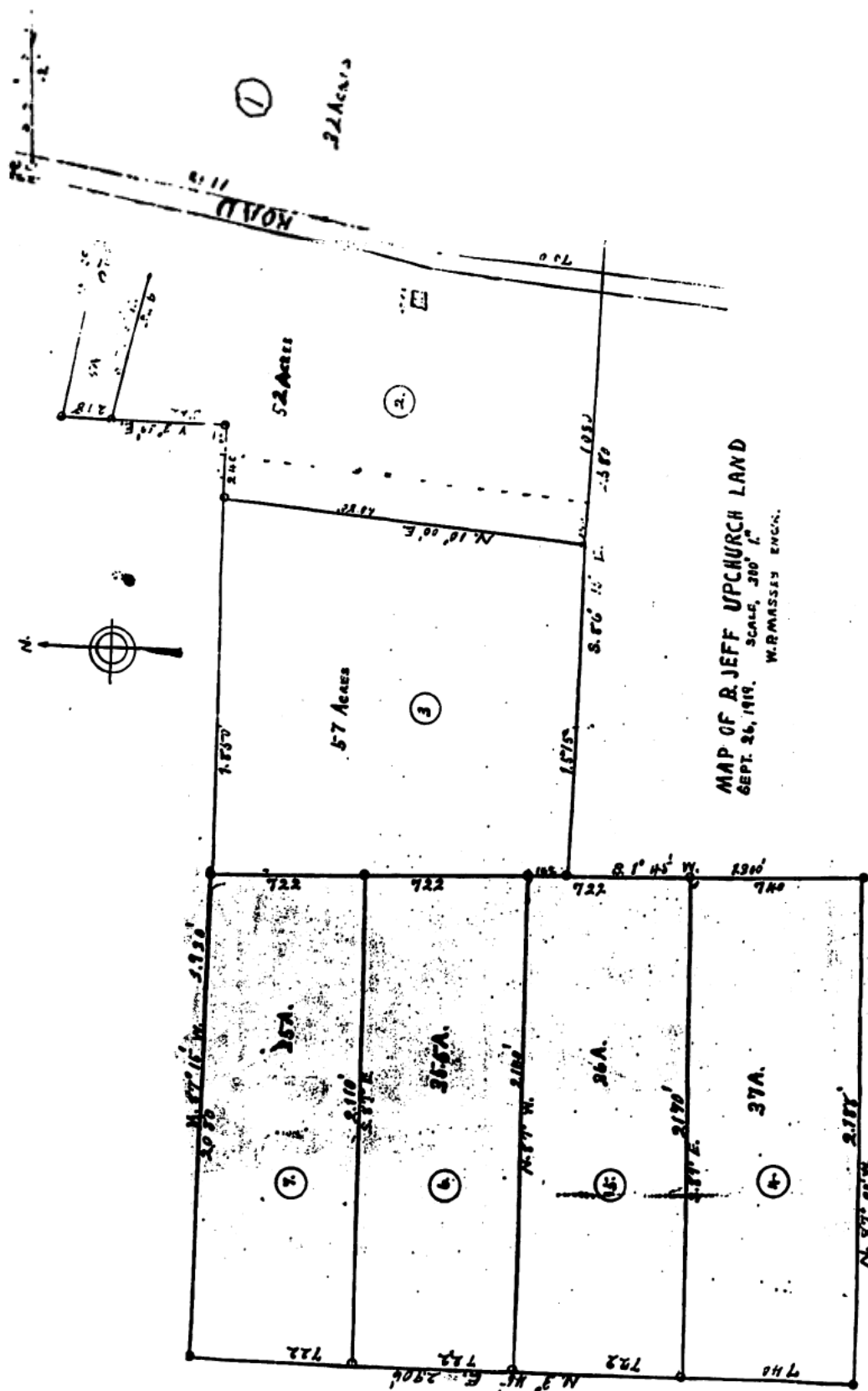

(14) Notes of RPU Meeting on 19 DEC 2013 at the Hampton Inn in Cary, N.C with members of the James Lee Martin, Sr. & wife Eleanor Marks U.,II "Aunt Ellie". Present were a GD Barbara Andrews and her sister Eleanor Jane Andrews and Richard Hewitt, a son of EJA.

All three were very chatty. Richard struggled to figure-out how he felt in such a large array and the girls throwing in comments about Mother and Mamma.

They said Aunt Ellie suffered in that she never had a home of her own after Uncle Martin died.

James Martin graduated from Med. School and took Dan under his wing to educate him. (note: Uncle Dan paid him back for every cent he paid for his education. RB May 2016) The girls Mary and Beatrice went to Meredith at reduced rates and also worked for money there...just scraping by. Eleanor was a menopause baby and went to business school.(note: my mother, Eleanor, was born when Mama was 40 years old. She graduated from Mars Hill Jr. College and worked in the cafeteria as did Uncle Dan. She was accepted to Duke's Nursing School but decided to return to Raleigh, N.C. to be with her ailing father. While there, she attended King's Business School where she met J.W. Bradley whom she later married in 1938. RB May 2016)

Aunt Ellie was a very proud person loved costume jewelry & wore too much to church.

Eleanor Jane loves Springmoor

Eleanor Jane says her mother, Beatrice (Martin) Andrews was embarrassed that Aunt Ellie wore so much costume jewelry to church.

(18) Partial Notes of RPU Visit 6 DEC 2001 with Miley Albert Perry "Monk"

Monk reports that Miley Perry owned several hundred acres of land. He had a will which set aside the home tract for his wife (my Aunt Bessie) and he gave the remainder in tracts to his children but with the restrictions that the tracts could not be sold but would pass to his grandchildren. However, Monk said layers connived to sell Percy's tract. Francis did not get a tract right away but eventually got the home place per Miley's will. Monk says he and Bryan got their increments when their father died and they bought other tracts of the original Miley Perry Farm. They traded two for NC State wooded land on Yates Mill Pond Road and build a subdivision there.

Monk says his current tract was bought by his father from a Mr. -----. Bartley Jefferson U must have sold it to Mr. -----. Monk says Aunt Ellie U and Aunt Bessie had 50+ acre tracts on Mid Pines Road.

Copied for George H. Andrews, Sr., Beatrice Roe Martin, Eleanor Marks Upchurch, II
Their father, George Henry Andrews, Sr., ran a store in Chatham Co, NC nor did his father. He was selected by the power brokers to run for Chatham Co. C Sheriff and was elected to 4 terms. When Kerr Scott became Governor he took an appointive office. He had diabetes which the family hid from the electorate. He was outgoing and loved people and his job. He and Beatrice lived most of their lives in the house where I visited Beatrice years ago. (Upon departure we visited this house-still intact) They had a colorful Andrews relative who was a hermit. At the end stayed in the Poor House for a short while.

Beatrice bathed her husband's feet which Aunt Ellie thought was gross. (Eleanor Marks Upchurch II)

They felt Aunt Ellie (their GM) was poorly served in having to live first under one child and then another in her lengthy widowhood. They were shocked when a postcard arrived from her with writing on front and back giving family secrets – such as – James (James Lee Martin, Jr.) got drunk again last night as usual. Aunt Ellie had a teaching certificate.

Eleanor says her mother Eleanor Marks Upchurch II and James Lee Martin, Sr. had two children who died at birth. One is buried at Gorman and one at the original location of the First Baptist Church of Creedmoor, NC.

A four page document given to RPU by Mrs. Sue Price (nee Nellie Sue Sanderford) on 22OCT2007. Document & this cover sheet placed in the Inwood Church File. This report consists of handwritten memories of Constance Strother spanning the period 1903-1974. Signed 26DEC1963with a postscript 2FEB1974.

The Women’s Group had various names at different times. Some even called it a “Gossiping Society”.

Original Meeting about 1903-1905. MAY ADAMS and her mother were secretary and treasurers. Members: The Upchurch Women (Lena U, Pat U, Maude U – possibly Aunt Ellie & Aunt Bessie), The Yates Family, The Perry Family, Mrs. A.F.Taylor,Sr.

Later key participants: Jessie Scott Taylor, Harriett Shearon, Mrs. H.P. Greene(who held meetings in her home)

This very sketchy history of the “Women’s Auxillary” of Inwood Church shows it had a very tenuous existence. It would almost die & then have a rebirth. In several eras the men were not sympathetic. Herman P. Greene being an exception.

An additional 3 pages are made a part of the Document – one = a picture of the Church built ca. 1935-1936 and-two pages=picture & names of 11 females- presumably post WWII who must have been members of the “Women’s Group” (Picture in Inwood History Book – processed earlier)

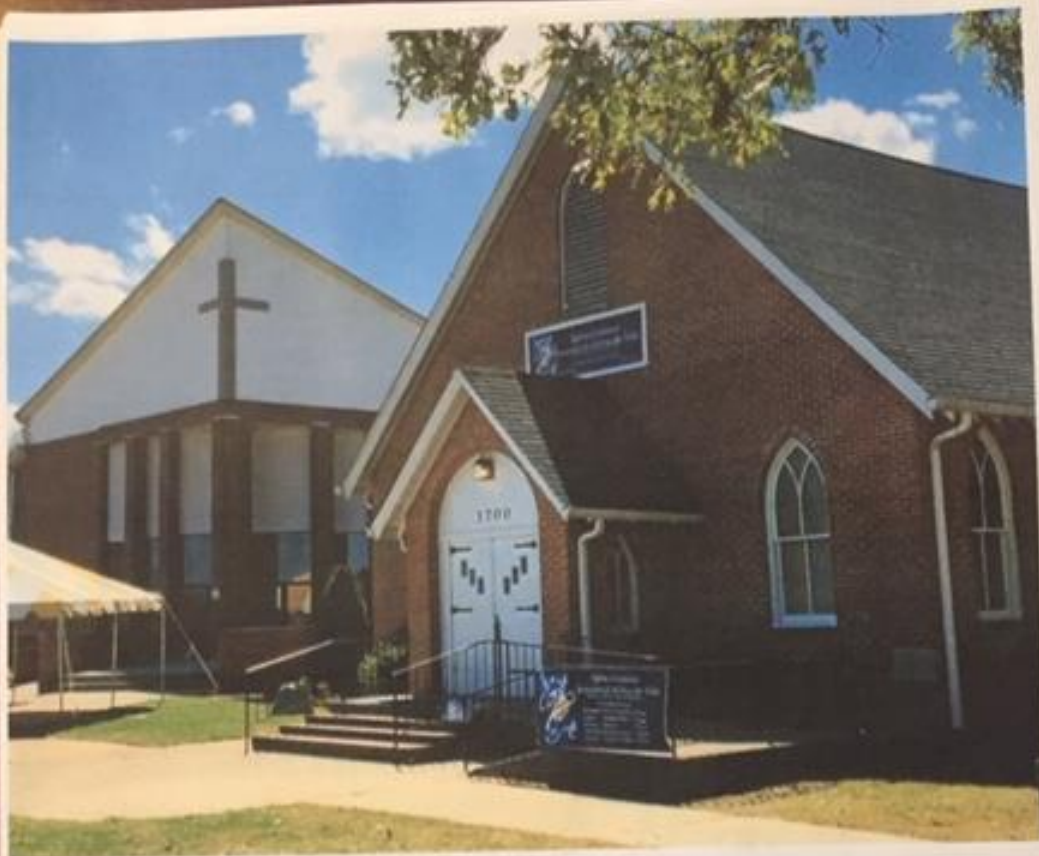
