



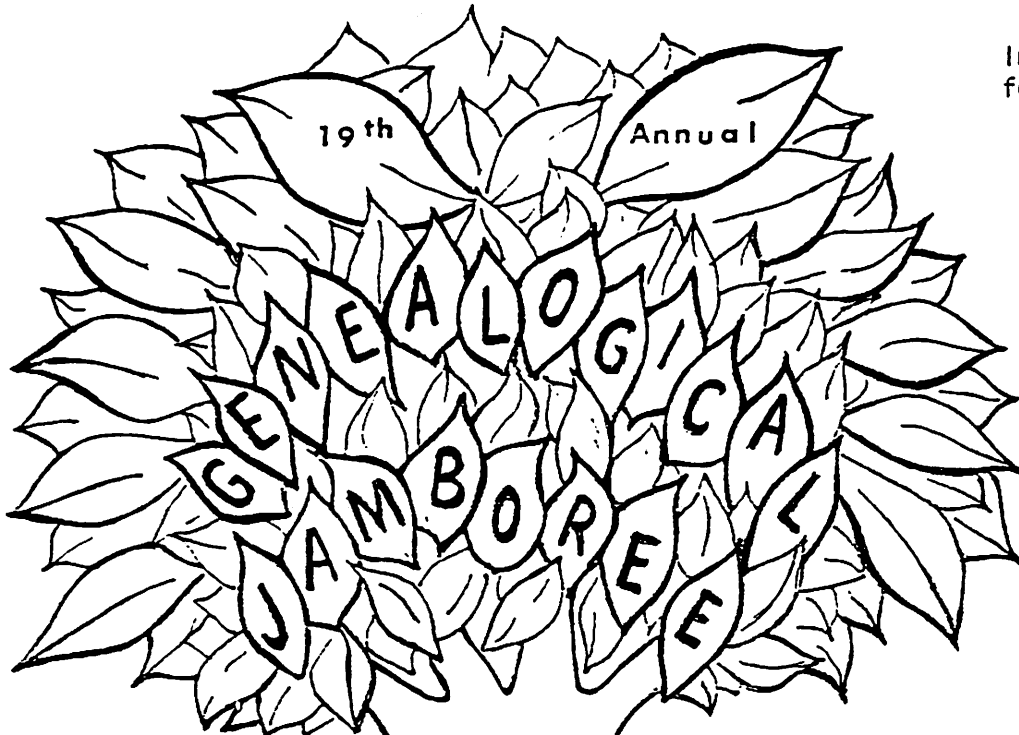

WHAT IS THE JAMBOREE?

The JAMBOREE is the annual genealogical exhibition sponsored by the *Southern California Genealogical Society, Inc.* In addition to many guest speakers there are beginner's classes and exhibits relating to every aspect of genealogical research. The JAMBOREE has been called the largest annual genealogical event west of the Mississippi River. Both levels of the Glendale Civic Auditorium are filled with genealogical displays.

WHEN IS THE JAMBOREE?

The JAMBOREE is held annually in the Spring. The 19th Annual JAMBOREE will be held 15 May 1988, 9:30 A.M. to 4:30 P.M. This all day event is held at the Civic Auditorium, Verdugo Road at Mountain Street, Glendale, California.

WHO BUYS TABLES?

Tables at the JAMBOREE are purchased by genealogical, historical and hereditary societies, family associations, and numerous vendors selling items pertaining to genealogy. These items range from genealogical charts and supplies to kilts, crafts and gifts, computer programs and photo restoration

In addition, tables are staffed by volunteers from the *Southern California Genealogical Society* providing information about genealogical research in the United States, Canada and many foreign countries.

PUBLICITY

Press releases concerning the JAMBOREE are distributed to all newspapers, radio and television stations in Southern California. Flyers are sent to all genealogical societies from San Diego to Fresno for circulation with each of their monthly newsletters. Flyers are also posted in all local libraries and local LDS (Mormon) genealogical libraries. Notices of the JAMBOREE are also sent to The Genealogical Helper, Car Del Scribe, and the Tri State Trader.

VENDORS LICENSE?

If you intend to sell any merchandise at the JAMBOREE, you are required by the City of Glendale, to purchase a Vendor's License. The fee for the license is included in the price of the table. The JAMBOREE will arrange to obtain all Vendor's Licenses.

If you are only selling memberships in a nonprofit organization, a license is not required.



JAMBOREE FACILITIES

There is ample metered parking adjacent to the auditorium. The parking lot contains handicapped parking areas close to the entrance of the auditorium.

Inexpensive sandwiches and beverages are available at the JAMBOREE. Or, if you prefer, you may bring your own lunch.

Exhibit tables are 8 feet by 3 feet. The JAMBOREE provides two folding chairs. Some sites have a wall, some have a curtain and others are centrally located without walls or curtains. Some sites have electrical outlets. Your registration must indicate any special requirements you need. You must provide your own table covering.

It is against auditorium regulations to attach anything to the walls. The JAMBOREE encourages you to mount your displays on large poster board which can be leaned against the wall or stood on the table. You may prefer to bring your own easel.

SPECIAL ACCOMMODATIONS

The Glendale Civic Auditorium is accessible by wheelchair through the use of ramps. There is no elevator on the premises.

Sign language interpreters will be available at classes and lectures.
