For Eleanor Upchurch, stopping to smell the roses is just a pleasant bonus to her job. During the fair, Upchurch works as an assistant to the flower show superintendent. "My main responsibilities are assisting the judges when needed, getting employees the supplies they need, and making sure things run on schedule." She loves her job and sometimes can't believe that she gets paid to work.

Her work supports the busiest general competition show at the fair. Last year, the flower show had 4,402 exhibits spread out over three shows and offered almost \$40,000 in prize money. Upchurch stays busy receiving entries and assisting judges with three shows during the fair. "The flower show is the only competition that has three shows," she said. "The first show is potted plants, and it is the biggest. The next two are cut flowers and they are not quite as big." Turning over the flower show building three times during fair week is a tough job and means that the workers in this part of the fair stay in competition mode all week long.

Upchurch has been working with the fair since 2000 and has seen a lot of changes in the past 14 years. "When I first started with the fair, the entry staff had to hand write every entry tag," she said. "Now people can enter online and it has really sped up the process." This year the entry office saw another significant change as the **State Fair premium book** transitioned to an

online-only publication. Instead of mailing out premium books or encouraging people to come to the fairgrounds to pick one up, the fair is encouraging people to go online to register. The entry office has also set up a computer for people who may not have access to the premium book online. Her advice for people who want to enter the flower show, or any of the competitions at the fair, is to call or come by the entry office and learn about how to enter. "Better yet, just come on out to the fair and see what's there." Last year, 10,552 people entered competitions at the fair.

"I used to enter flowers before I began working in the flower show," she said. Now she has grandchildren that enter the shows. "My 13-year-old grandson has won a special award in the junior division for flower arrangements and my 16-year-old granddaughter has entered cut flowers over the years, too," she said. They have always helped me with growing flowers." Upchurch has six grandchildren and two great grandchildren. Her first trip to the fair wasn't until she married and moved to Raleigh in 1979. "Before then, I would always go to the county fair in Greensboro," she said. "My children grew up coming to the N.C. State Fair."

Of course the flower show is Upchurch's favorite part of the fair, although when pressed she'll tell you that her next favorite area is the handicrafts and hobbies located beside the N.C. State University ice cream booth. "It's also not the fair without getting out on the grounds for a hotdog and a ham biscuit," she added.

Working on the N.C. State Fair keeps Upchurch busy during September and October. During the rest of the year, she helps with the year-round events at the fairgrounds. "Three days a week, I help with contracts, invoices, filing and answering phones," she said. In her spare time she likes to read, knit and play canasta and bridge. "In fact, I often have ladies that come over on Fridays and we will play cards all day."

James Henry Carter, presumably, the son of William Carter and Ruth Bean, was born the 27th of January, 1826 in White County, Tennessee.

(The census records show his birthplace as the state of Tennessee and when he recorded the birth of his daughter, America, born March 1856, in Wayne County, Kentucky, he stated that he was born in White County, Tennessee.)

He evidently grew up in White County, Tennessee but was living in Wayne County, Kentucky when his first child, Shrewsberry (Susberry), was born in November of 1849.

No record of the marriage of James and Eleanor Upchurch has been uncovered but it probably occurred in Wayne County, Kentucky ca 1848-49.

Eleanor, or "Nellie", as she was known by, was the daughter of John Upchurch and Sarah Bertram. She was born the 7th of July, 1829 in the Little South Fork area of Wayne County, Kentucky.

Her parents were from Virginia originally and relocated from North Carolina to Kentucky ca 1812.

James and Nellie were the parents of eleven children --

INCLUDING 2 UNNAMED INFANTS BUR LOWE CEM, WAYNE CO, KY

James was a circuit rider minister for the Methodist Church and was mentioned several times in a book by Rev. J. C. Wright, titled "Autobiography of Rev. A. B. Wright", which was a diary of his ministry listing marriages, funerals, baptisms, etc.

This book refers to a "prayer meeting held at Brother J. H. Carter's" in September of 1866 and in 1877 mentions "Rev. J. H. Carter, a local preacher whom I received in the Church and baptised several years before", so it would appear that James became a minister sometime after 1866.

James wife, Nellie, died the 12th day of February, 1870 after giving birth to their daughter, Elen. In the book "Cemeteries of Wayne County, Kentucky" by Bennie and Juanita Coffey, it states that Elen is buried in the Lowe Cemetery, near Sunnybrook, with her mother. The stone states that she died the same day that she was born, but the 1870 Census for Fentress County, Tennessee, shows her as being five months old. To date, there has been no way to account for this discrepancy. Perhaps, as the child's birth was so difficult as to cause her Mother's death, it was assumed that she wouldn't survive, given the medical knowledge available, and when James ordered Nellie's stone he went ahead and ordered one for Elen. Elen evidently didn't survive very long as she doesn't appear in any other census records.

James was married for the second time a few months later, which was not unusual for this time period in our history. There weren't such things as "baby-sitters", "nannies" or "day-care centers" and a husband needed someone to care for the numerous children that were common during this era. If it was the husband who died first, then his wife would need someone to provide for her and her children, so she would remarry in a very short period of time, if at all possible. A woman alone, for the most part, was considered by the community, to be unable to care her children and so the courts would scatter the children out among relatives and neighbors to be raised as an "extra" hand was always welcome to help with the numerous tasks to be done.

James took Sarah E. Dawson, as his second wife. They were married the 10th of June 1870 in Clinton County, Kentucky by the Rev. Wright, mentioned earlier.

Nothing "concrete" has been found regarding Sarah, only that it was her first marriage according to her marriage application and as the census records shows her born ca 1832-39, she would have been in her early thirties at the time of the marriage and the standards of the day would have regarded her as an "old maid".

It is possible that Sarah's parents were Isaac A. and Mary Ann Dawson, as in the 1880 census she shows her Father as being born in North Carolina and her Mother as being born in Tennessee.

The 1850 census for Knox County, Tennessee shows that a Isaac A. Dawson (born ca 1810 NC) was living with his wife Mary Ann (born ca 1816 in Tennessee) along with the following children--

Sarah and James named their first-born son "Isaac"--perhaps after her Father??

The above is purely "speculation", but the pieces of the "puzzle" do fit together.

James and Sarah were the parents of six children --

According to the family stories, James was buried near Slickford in Wayne County Kentucky on what they called "Carter" mountain, which from what I have heard, was just a big hill on their farm, but no one could find the grave or knew when he had died. My husband and I were researching in the area and had stopped by the courthouse in Clinton County, Kentucky to get a copy of James and Sarah's marriage license and had a few minutes to spare so went to the local library to see what records they might have. Included in the few genealogy books that they had was the cemetery records of Cumberland County, Kentucky. As my Mother's line of "GROSES" were from Cumberland County I wanted to check the index for

information on that line, but as I picked up the book I had what I have come to refer to as my "gut" feeling and checked the index first for "Carter" and to my amazement, I found James Henry Carter and two of his sons from his second marriage, along with the wives of both and a grandson, buried in the "Rose of Sharon Cemetery". Unfortunately, we were out of time and didn't get to go to the cemetery to actually see and take a picture of James' stone.

According to the cemetery book, James, died the 22nd of April, 1900.

The only available newspaper for this period has been checked for an obituary, but the only reference was found by Mr. R. N. Smith of Burkesville, Kentucky --

He advised that in the April 25, 1900 local paper he found the following --

"Old Uncle Jimmie Carter of the Hegira Country died last Sunday of diseases incident to old age. He was eighty odd."

Mr. Smith said that Hegira was a small community near the Rose of Sharon Church & Cemetery.

Sarah does not appear on the 1900 Soundex for Kentucky or Tennessee but the 1910 Census for Cumberland County, Kentucky shows her living in the household of her son Haywood Hart Carter.

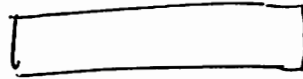

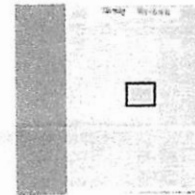

Page 3, Item 20-B, Feb 25, 1978, visit to Lena Perry: Startled to read gossip about my Aunt Sadie! Aunt Sadie married Uncle Harry on Jan 2, 1904, and their only child, John Harry Holcombe, Jr., was born Oct 8, 1904. I have a copy of the death certificate of Eleanor Marks Upchurch.[↑] It states her length of residence in Jacksonville prior her death on Oct 4, 1927, as 20 years. In the 1910 Jacksonville Census I located her[↑] living in the household of John J. and Aunt Belle. (You may already have a copy of this census record, but I'm enclosing a copy + my handwritten transcription.) Neither my cousin Jean Augur Kilgore nor Frances Register (10 and 9 years older than me) had ever heard this story about Aunt Sadie. We can't prove it untrue at this point, but I personally will be surprised if documentation is discovered. Sadie would have been over age 60 by the time of my first memory of her, but she always impressed me as cheerful and lively. (She and my grandmother Eulah both talked a mile a minute.) Uncle Harry was a hospital administrator, and Aunt Sadie was a social coordinator for hospital functions and such. She gave my mother a beautiful dress for her high school graduation which is preserved in a studio photograph. I remember her as such a proper lady that a picture of her as an outcast just won't form.

Page 5, Item 31, Dec 28, 1980, phone call to Walter Daniel Martin: I never knew Uncle Harvey, but can vouch that Sadie was not a "ne'er-do-well." I visited in her home regularly between the ages of about 8 to 15 (and maybe prior to the age of 4, although I don't remember it). It was not huge but neat and pretty, and in the nicest old neighborhood in Jacksonville.

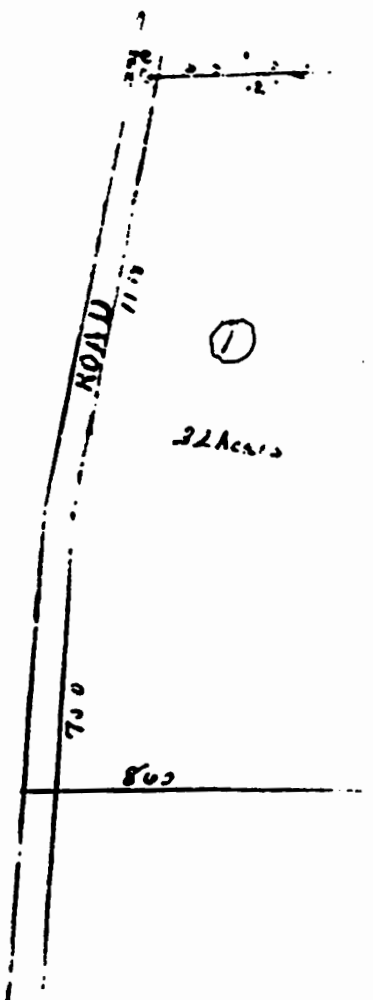

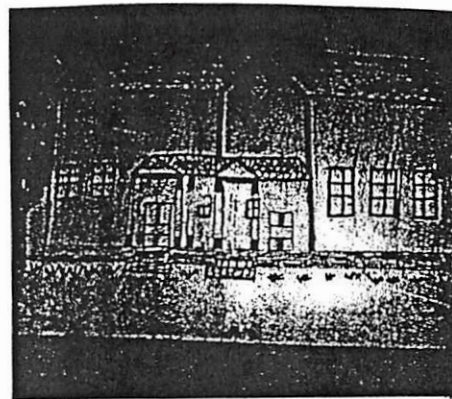

At the close of Children's Day at Sarepta, July 1905, after the Address by the County Superintendent of Education, Professor R. B. White, a movement was made toward the erection of an academy at Centerville and something over one hundred dollars in money and kind was subscribed and it was hoped the Academy would be ready for the next session of school. This evidently came to pass for on Friday December 21, 1906 the Honor Roll for Centerville Academy was announced in *The Franklin Times*. First Grade - Annie Neal, Second Grade- Bertha Neal, Ruth Parrish, Johnnie Neal and William Parrish. McIver Day was celebrated with the following program: McIver as a farm boy- Fred Tharrington; McIver's struggle for an education- Roy Tharrington; McIver's first attempt at a speech- Floyd Parrish. The song was "the Old North State", also songs "We will try to be good like Jesus" by Hattie Neal, Eleanor Upchurch, Lutie Thompson, Viola Hunt, Johnnie Neal and Bertha Neal. Prizes were presented for the best composition on McIver's life to Johnnie Neal and Roy Tharrington. Ruth Parrish and Bertha Neal received awards for Neatness and All Around Good Work. McIver's picture was placed on a large board and a sketch was placed below. The *Franklin Times* also recorded the announcement of the Honor Roll of Centerville Academy for the week ending March 1, 1907, Miss Jarman, teacher, 2nd grade: Carl Strickland; 4th grade: Ruth Parrish, Spruill Upchurch and Frank Taylor; 6th grade: Hattie Neal and Floyd Parrish. Honor Roll for week ending March 8, 1907, Miss Loulia E. Jarman, teacher, 1st grade: Dan Leonard, Alexander Edwards, Hattie Upchurch and Annie Neal; 2nd grade- Carl Strickland, Charlie Leonard, Viola Shearin, Katie and Lola Upchurch; 4th grade- Frank Taylor, Ester Taylor, John Hunt, Arthur Shearin, Flossie Upchurch, Spruill Upchurch, Ruth Parrish, Johnnie Neal and William Andrews; 6th grade - Floyd Parrish, Hattie Neal and Herndon Jenkins; 7th grade - Lillian Upchurch.

Some of the teachers at the Centerville Academy were: Ruth Conyers, Norma Belcher, Viola Arrington, Ollie Anderson, Pauline Smith, Mae Perry, Maggie Duke, Adelaide Duke, Lola Leonard, Ruth Parrish, Pattie Beasley, Nonie Bunn Hollingsworth and Loulia E. Jarman.

The Academy was located where the Centerville Baptist Church Parsonage now stands. It is unknown when the Academy closed.

The artist's sketch of the Academy shown in the picture was done by Lutie Thompson about 1909 when she was eleven years old. Several people have said that it is an accurate representation. NOTE: The identity of McIver is unknown at this time.

KENNEDY, Eleanor Upchurch, 87, a resident of Charlottesville, VA passed away on Monday, June 18, 2007. She was born in Montgomery the daughter of James T. Upchurch, Sr. and Eleanor Roche Upchurch, and grew up and lived there many years. She graduated from Huntingdon College in 1941. She was preceded in death by her husband, Colonel William P. (Red+) Kennedy; her sister, Irene U. McDonald; and her grandson, Billy Kennedy. She is survived by her daughter, Whiddon Kennedy Stephens of Salem, OR and her sons, William Patrick Kennedy III of Temple, TX and James Matthew Kennedy of Charlottesville, VA; a sister, Elizabeth U. Ausfeld of Norcross, GA; her brothers, James T. (Jim) Upchurch, Jr. of Montgomery and John B. Upchurch of Smyrna, TN; three grandchildren and five great-grandchildren. She and (Red+) were married about 6 months before World War II began, and were stationed all over the States, Alaska and Korea. (Red's) last assignment was in the Pentagon and they moved to Alexandria, VA where she lived for many years and where she was a volunteer worker very interested in those in need in that area, finally becoming Executive Director of (Route One Housing). As a result of her work, the Eleanor U. Kennedy Shelter was opened on Fort Belvoir, VA. and Fairfax County, VA. declared December 14, 1996 (Eleanor U. Kennedy Shelter) Day. 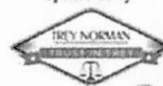
