My very good friend Hope has sent me the query about Alexander Upchurch as I am the long time Upchurch researcher. See my website www.upchurchstory.com. After some delay I have looked at all of my Alexander Upchurch Biofiles and am not able to provide anything additional on Alexander Upchurch died May 2, 1848. This same query was in my files as of August 31, 1983 from a cooperator in Arkansas it being a puzzle to him as well. I do have considerable information on a Wynns family of Henry County, TN where they intermarried with the Upchurches who arrived about 1805 from Wilkes County, NC via Greenville County, SC. I am not clear from the Bible record as to whether there is more of an indication of the location of the Wynns-Cherry-Barnhill families at some given times. With locations and times and names of specific familt members it might be possible to identify more lines of investigation. In any case be assured that any aspect of Upchurch history or heritage interests me.

As to Pitt County, NC, I have had a connection in that my niece Patty Janet McGee married first Bobby Johnson of Ayden and secondly Michael House, DVM and erstwhile Mayor of Ayden, sadly now all deceased leaving me with no connection to the Collard Festival or to Bum's barbeque.
