Well, thanks for keeping on this. I'm more certain after my digging around that Calvin C.U. is my guy. I was able to piece census records together from 1850-1930 of Calvin C. Upchurch and associated family members that are recognizable and make sense. First occurrence in the records was in 1850 in Marietta, Ga. He was between 6 and 7 years old which made him born in 1844-1845. He was the son of Keaton U., brother of Elbert U. and married Mary Ann (Polly) Daniel in 1865. (My grandmother Ruby had pictures of Polly and Calvin and told my mother that Polly was her grandmother.) She was about 5 years older than Calvin. She died in 1914 at which time he moved in with his daughter and son in law, Lucy and Manson Jackson. He later lived with his grandson Marvin and his wife Helen (all in Henry County, Ga, Tussahaw District) and then die in 1932...No record after the 1930 census which corresponds with his 1932 death record.

Now, that doesn't answer the mystery of Calvin E. whom I cannot find after the 1860 census. He appears to be the son of H. (Henderson?) Upchurch. He enlisted in the CSA in 1862. I'm wondering if he died in the war since he doesn't appear again after the 1860 census...The problem with this is that findagrave.com shows Calvin E. buried in the Bethany church cemetery in McDonough, GA which is where Mary Ann is also buried, with different but similar dates than Calvin C. (Calvin E. 1833-1931; Calvin C. 1844-1932) If Calvin E. died in the war, then he didn't die in 1931. And if Calvin C. was 6 years old in 1850, then he wasn't born in 1833. If this is truly Calvin E. then why doesn't he show up in the census records after 1860?? I think someone got the findagrave.com record wrong, so I will have to go to the cemetery in McDonough and see Calvin's grave myself. This is the fact that has thrown me and Rita off for so long.

Anyway.....I updated my record of Calvin in ancestry to reflect what I found in all the census records. And, my father and older brother were also named Calvin - so the family name persists! Looking forward to any facts you might have found!

I will be visiting with 3 other GGG Granddaughters of Calvin on April 5-6. Three of the daughters of Hildred Perry Fitzgibbon (great granddaughter of Calvin and one of the babies in the pictures with him) will be in Georgia for a little reunion, so I'll be getting all of their family information caught up and documented.

We have been working together on various aspects of the Charles Upchurch Clan. For some parts of the Clan I have huge amounts of information but for other parts there are voids. Together we hav been gradually filing in some of the voids. I have done quite a bit of followup on items you have provided me recently and will give you this sketchy report. There is so much more left to do that it seemed best to give this little report knowing that we should/can /will do more.

10 20MAR 2013. CONTENUED

My records on Thomas Gay U., Sr and Charity U, two children of Charles are quite good. For sons Eaton and Keaton we were behind but are catching up. The records in Upson County, GA are especially useful an I am about half through a good strong look a them. I have started a file on upchurches of Upson, County which will serve as a guide to what has been done and what remains t be done. We know that Keaton and Eaton both had a presence in Upson. What is a little tricky is the another Upchurch Clan was also involved--that of the Harmon U Clan.

Here are some things I can report.

- 1. The Charity U who married Hughey Russ on 5 JAN 1837 in Upson was not the daughter of Charles. I still have to fit her in.
 - 2. Frances U who Md in 1842 in Upson was the daughter of Keaton U.
 - 3. Osborn U who Md in 1836 in Upson was the son of the aforementioned Harmon U.
 - 4. The marriage of Charles U to Mary Gay as reported on the Internet is wrong in my opinion
- 5. I know the two Calvin's are important to sort out. My current approach is to build the records firmly starting from a later period and going backwards. I have used the data you each have provided and have gone on line for additional batches of information. Much is coming together. I would have done more on this set of families but I did not have willing cooperators. I hope we can continue
- 6. I note a Sariah M. Upchurch buried in Good Hope Baptist Church. Does anyone know of thi church ? I am anxious to find it to see if other Upchurches are there. Names and dates of anyone buried there would give me a lead. Don't know if it is in Upson.

I am sending this interim disjointed message so you will know I am still working on this as time allows from several other equally important projects. Over time I, with your help, we can come up witl a more coherent story. Please let me have comments and questions.

Do we have any other prospective cooperators? Best.

Good Hope Primitive Baptist Church

Although the first 25 pages of the minutes book is missing, it is believed to be one of the earliest churches in Upsons County as this is one of the first settled areas.

The home of Zachariah H. Gordon, father of John B. Gordon, was about two miles away, only a short distance from the Flint River.

From Thomaston Courthouse square go South on Highway 19 South 4 and two tenths miles, turn right onto John B. Gordon Road, go 2 and nine tenths miles. The Cemetery is on the right side of the road.

The interesting architecture of the meeting house has a high pulpit gox with a door for entrance very similar to Episcopal

Rude wooden benches put together with wooden pegs, placed in as close juxtaposition as possible, and coming very close to the pulpit box, indicate that at one time this congregation was a large one.

Hi, Phil...more information. I went to the cemetery in McDonough, GA where there is a marker for Calvin E.Upchurch. Next to him is buried Mary Ann Upchurch. The marker for Calvin E. is a military marker placed much later than the actual burial. I am going to speak with the church historian for Bethany Baptist Church, Pat Rosser, and see if I can confirm what I think is a major headstone mistake.

Right now this is all deduction, however, here's what I think happened.... Calvin C. was married to Mary Ann (Polly) Daniel - married 20 Sep 1865 (daugher of Albert and Terrisia Daniel).. Albert and Terrisia are buried close by Mary Ann as well as several other Daniels. There is no "original" headstone on the husband's gravesite, just a military headstone noting Calvin E. U.'s service in the CSA and birth and death dates (1833 and 1931) that don't even correspond to the census records for either Calvin! Calvin C. U. died 08 Aug 1932.

Calvin E. was 21 in the 1850 census living in the household with Henderson and Eliza Upchurch. Eaton was also living in the household with them (age 78), so Čalvin E. U. was born in approx. 1839. He doesn't appear in any census data I can find after 1860. He enlisted in the Confederate Army in 1862, and I can only assume he died in the war, and body probably not recovered. I have no marriage record for him, nor any children.

Calvin C. and Mary Ann had children that I know and recognize (W.T. was my great grandfather) and he lived to a ripe old age! I believe when someone did the research to place the military headstone for Calvin E., they mistakenly got the cemetery record for Calvin C. and placed the headstone there next to Mary Ann. This would make sense as to why there is such confusion around the Calvin C. and Calvin E. families.

I hope to know more after I talk to the church historian and see if any further light can be shed. Will let you know.

Phil, I am SOOOOO excited!!! During lunch today, I went back out to Fold3 and renewed my membership. While searching the CSA records, I finally found the proof I needed for C.E.Upchurch! He enlisted in the Confederate Army and was assigned to Co. F, 53rd Ga. Regiment out of McDonough, GA. He was injured and captured at Sharpsburg/Antietam (Sept. 17, 1862), and then paroled. He suffered a gunshot wound to the leg with a compound fracture and was admitted to the Chimborazo hospital in Richmond, VA on Oct 24, 1862 where he died on November 17, 1862. It was stated that he was "very feeble and much emaciated" when he was admitted. I don't know, but assume he was buried in Richmond. I will get the copies of the records and send to you...I can't tell you how exciting this is to finally figure out. I will also get with the Sons of the Confederacy with the corrected information.

Hi Patti---

I have failed to interact adequately re your recent emails for reasons I will later explain. First, let me see if I have your current position properly in my mind. It seems to be solid. You posit that Calvin E. U. was a son of Henderson U. and a GS of Eaton U. who was a brother of Keaton. Calvin E. U. went off to the Civil War and died in the conflict. As far as is known his body was never found for burial and as far as is known he never married or had children. Many years later someone arranged for a CSA marker for Calvin E. to be placed in the Bethany Cemetery and it was placed near your ancestor Mary Ann (Daniel) Upchurch leading later researchers to presume that these two were married. Your latest evidence shows that Calvin E. and Mary were not husband and wife but that her husband was actually Calvin C. U. 1845-1932 and that this Calvin C. is the son of Keaton U. My records, fortunately have for a number of years carried Calvin C. as a son of Keaton. Thus I say that you are a member of the Calvin Z. U. Line in the Charles U./Keaton U. Subclan.

Your emails led me to conclude I should do a thorough review of my records for the Charles U. Clan to which you belong. I had done his a number of times over the last 30 years but with new resources such as Ancestry including you excellent Zimmermann tree and incompletely processed information in my files the time was ripe to do an upgrade. I neglected your emails (sorry) and other projects to the extent possible to do the upgrade. This has resulted in a much improved Master Outline for the Charles U. Clan which I am anxious to mail to you if you can provide an address. All of my Master Outlines are kept manually. (We are working to change that but that is another story).

I am anxious to learn if you spot errors in the Master Outline and to learn if you can add to it. I'll probably send certain parts first and get your reaction and the send other parts for more interaction. At some point I will go back over your emails to see if I have missed extracting anything to go into my Biofile System.

I am thrilled that you have been so active and effective in researching family records that are of so much interest to us both. Best.
