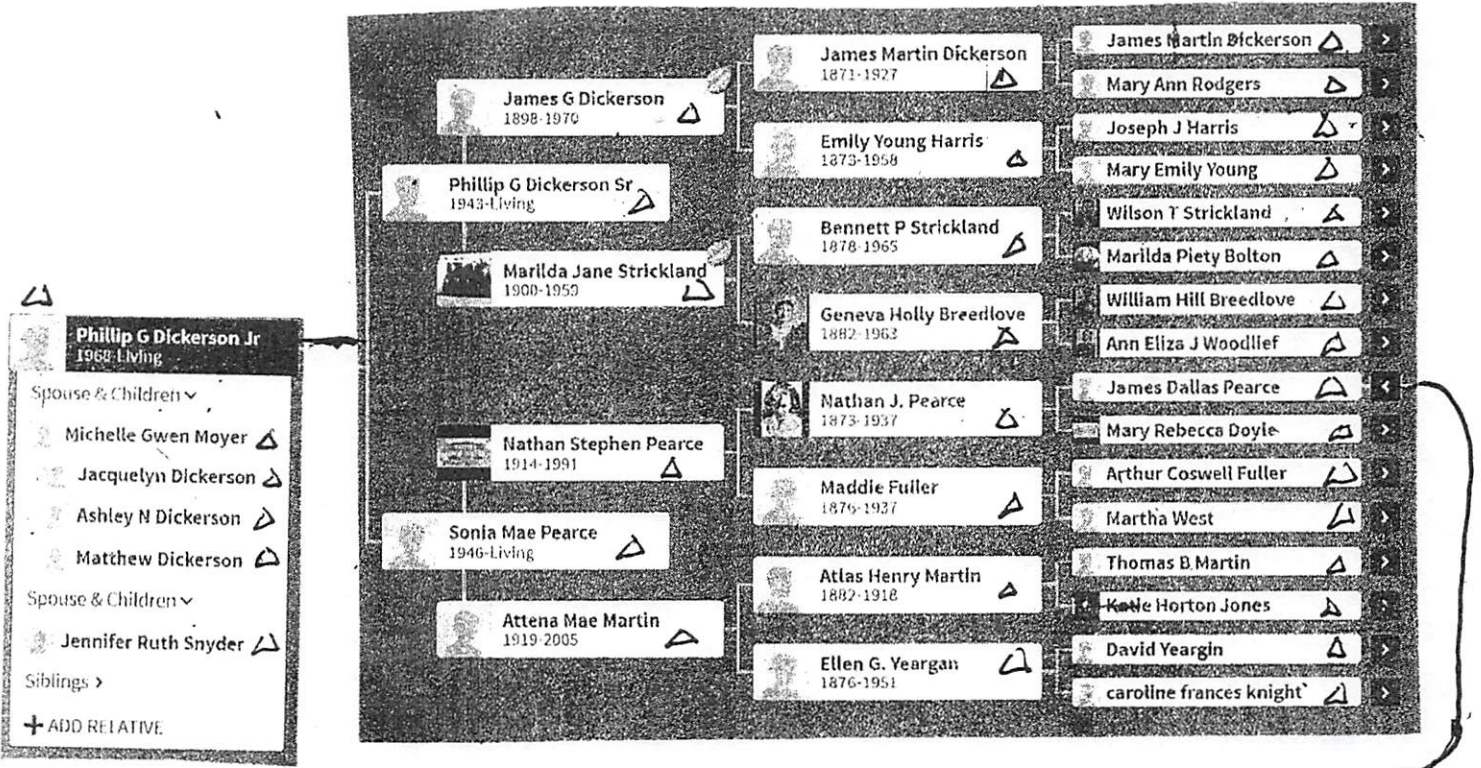


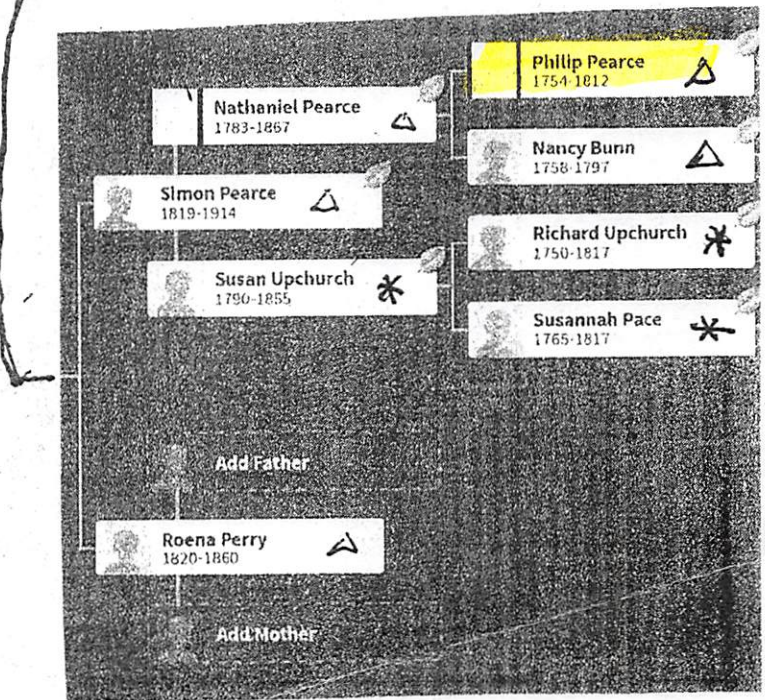

△△ Deed from Isaac Strickland to Phillip Pearce 12-10-1802

This Indenture made this tenth day of December one thousand Eight Hundred and two Between Isaac Strickland of Franklin County and State of North Carolina of the one part and Phillip Pearce of the State and County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the Said Isaac Strickland for and In consideration of the Sum of three Hundred and Ten pounds five Shillings Currency to him in hand paid the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge hath given granted bargained Sold Confirmed and Convey'd unto the Said Phillip Pearce his heirs and assigns or ever a Certain Tract or parcell (sic) of Land Containing Two Hundred and fifty acres of Land be the same More or less lying and being in Said Franklin County on the waters of Monsanson (sic) Creek & bounded as follows - to wit - Begining (sic) on the No prong of

- △ Moncanson (sic) at a Corner white oak in Stephen Pearces line thence So along Sd Pearces line to the south prong on Moncanson (sic) to a Corner Live Oak in Sd pearces line thence up the run

- △ Corner pine James Pearces orphan land line thence East along Sd line to a Corner ash on the Bank of Said Creek thence down the Said Creek to the first Station Including by Estimation Two Hundred and fifty acres be the Same More or Less all which Sd Land the Said Strickland for himself his heirs Executors administrators and assigns hath hereby given granted Bargaind (sic) Sold Conveyd (sic) and Confirms (sic) unto the said Phillip Peace his heirs and assigns for ever Together with all waters woods mines Minerals Houses Orchards Gardens and every profit and appertenance (sic) thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining by him or them to be fully or freely possessed and Enjoyed without any ___ Barr(sic) hindrance or denial of him the Said Strickland or his (sic) Moreover the Said Strickland doth by these presents Warrant and defend the right of Said land and premises to be Sure and Good to the Said Phillip Pearce his heirs and assigns or ever In Witness whereof the Said Strickland hath here unto Set hand and Seal the The (sic) Day and date above written

• There seems to be little doubt that John Pearce who lived close to his sister Elizabeth (Pearce) Ray in Randolph Co, NC was the John who married the only daughter of Richard U, III who died intestate in FC, NC in 1816. His son-in-law John Pearce + his wife drew lot #1 of 28 Acres (Need to find where John sold this). A clincher is that John Pearce in Randolph Co, NC appeared WILLIAM RHEA in FC, NC to recover his right to a portion of the estate of Richard U, III.

- The records from IN show the wife of John Pearce b 1766 was "CLARISE" hence CLARA.
- The children of Richard U, III were born from 1774 to 1795 with a daughter born in 1793. Richard U, III md 2nd 14 SEP 1796 (FC, NC). His young sons show up in his name on the 1800 census but no young dau b 1793. Perhaps she was staying with relatives.??
- In the 1790-1810 era it is unlikely you would find a female with the name CLARA & FANNES
- On balance I am inclined to say that the 1808 marriage was for John Pearce b 1787 and Frances U possible D/o Benjamin U - NOT for John Pearce b 1766 and Clara U
