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


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

Named for the creek flowing W to E (includes Lake Wheeler), this township touches seven others. Raleigh Twp, to the N starts at US1/64 and I-40 E, again N at SR1319. Bounds go E again via Walnut Ck. (& northern shores of Lake Johnson and Lake Raleigh) to SR1371S, I-40E to Wilmington St.(no access) which on the S joins US401. Townships on the E are Saint Mary's, Panther Branch, and .75 mi of Middle Creek which also is S. That line goes W at SR1503, doglegs N on SR1375 and W on SR1390, turns N at SR1389. To the W is Holly Springs Twp.: at SR1152 the line doglegs N to SR1305, continues N on SR1300 - in a half-mi crosses SR1010. On the W for 3 mi is White Oak Twp. At SR1009 Carv Twp. is N. Going E to SR1423, the line goes N to SR1313; then briefly E to US1/64 N and to the beginning at I-40E

On SR1379 .1 mi E of Swift Creek Baptist Church. S on dirt road about .3 mi to last house. Walk forward same distance or more; edge of woods on E.

- BUFFALOE, Wiley L. (reported but not precisely located) On N side of SR1009 and near Trailwood Dr. (S of I-40)
- CAMPBELL, Donald 2nd family (he is buried at Raleigh City Cemetery) From SR1009 (1 mi E of SR1382) take SR1350 S .8 mi (beyond deep curve)
- CATAWBA SPRINGS CHRISTIAN CHURCH (to be inventoried; church has names only) NW quadrant of SR1010 and SR1377
- CRAYTON/CREIGHTON (in or near original Macedonia church cem; not inventoried) From SR1009, take SR1372 S .1 mi. Cem on W side before creek.
- EDWARDS, William-Cemetery destroyed; graves removed to Swift Creek Church From SR1009, N side between #5309 & #5409, uphill west of Silver Lake.

FRANKS, Robert J. family members (he is bur at Catawba Springs Cem) On unnamed road N of SR1010 (Deer Meadow Dr on S) go ca .2 mi. E side.

FRANKS, James D. - moved to Macedonia Methodist Cem Original site: E side SR1386 less than .1 mi S of SR1379

# GULLY, William/CAIN, James

SE quadrant of SR1009 and SR1423

#### HOWELL, Sewell

NE quadrant SR1300 and SR1379 on grounds of St. Francis Methodist Church. Right side of church next to parking lot. White picket fence.

# **INWOOD BAPTIST CHURCH**

W side of SR1371 some .9 mi S of SR1009

#### **JERIDAN** (as named on map; not yet visited)

From SR1010 go S .3 mi on SR1404; W side .2 mi. Reported as unknown (if same one) in Belmont Estates subdivision; on left between several houses.

#### JONES, Barney

From SR1152 go .2 mi W on SR1379. N side close to road

## JONES, Theophilus

E on SR1379 from Swift Creek Church just over 1 mi. S side at curve

#### JONES, William Rufus

From 1010 take SR1387 ca 1 mi S. W side down drive (acroos lake on E side)

#### KEITH, Lemuel-destroyed (on SR 1664, another township);

graves removed to SE Quadrant US1/64 & SR1319 at end of parking lot of first building

# \* LANGSTON, James G. (plans are to install a marker)

From SR1010 go S on SR1387 to Langston subd. Cem at end of 1st cul-de-sac.

# LORBACHER, Rudolph

From SR1010 go S on SR1388 ca .6 mi. 30 yds from W side of road.

# MACEDONIA METHODIST CHURCH (see also Crayton/Creighton above)

Current cemetery is across SR1009 from present church on NW quadrant with SR1313. August 1986 WCGS newsletter (p. 86-44) lists burials.

# PATRICK, James R.

E side of SR1152 and .35 mi N of SR1547 (1 mi S of SR1152)

#### PENNY, James

From SR1371 turn W on SR1381; .4 mi to Penny house, N side. Dirt road to cem some hundred vds; W side, probably invisible but has wire fence.

# PINEY PLAIN U CHURCH OF CHRIST (CHRISTIAN)

- From SR1009 go .1 mi on SR1423. E side; cem on S side of church. Burials listed in September 1986 WCGS newsletter (p. 86-57).
- **POPE/HARRISON** (three graveyards in the general area were removed to this site) From SR1009 take SR1300 S. Cem 100 yds past SR1423. E side. Iron fence.

#### SANDERS, Edwin T.

SE quadrant SR1009 and SR1383. In August 1986 WCGS newsletter (p. 86-45).

#### \* SPEIGHT, William

From SR1152 go W 335 yds on SR1385. S side.

# \* STEPHENS, Anderson

On SR1009 across from Swift Creek School in a field

# STEPHENS, Hinton R. (he has no stone; others do)

W side of SR1152 .3 mi from SR1009 down driveway S side behind house

# STEPHENSON, Fabius Lane

E side of SR1152 and .3 mi N of SR1547 (.1 mi S of Patrick cem)

#### STEPHENSON, David

From SR1009, take SR1375 S. E side beyond Swift Creek.

# STEPHENSON-SPEIGHT

From SR1009 ca .9 mi on SR1152 to Fielding Dr. SE corner.

# \*STRAIN, John Benton

N side of house #8635 on W side of SR1371, S of SR1010



MIDDLE CREEK TOWNSHIP

This township joins Johnston Co. approx. a mile near the SE tip and Harnett Co. on the S about nine miles. Holly Springs Twp. is to the W, the line going N on SR1121 & 1101, 1/2 mi E on SR1110, N and E on SR1111. At SR1399 go northeasterly 2 mi to SR1393. E to SR1301 and go 21/2 mi NW, then E on SR1390. Holly Springs (now on N) ends .75 mi at SR1389 and Swift Creek Township begins. On SR1390 still, the line continues 3.4 mi E to SR1375 and doglegs S, then E on SR1503 to US401 N and .9 mi to SR1010 E. Going E another .9 mi, Panther Branch Township is N and also on the E when the line turns S on SR2723, intersects SR1006 and follows it S for six mi to Johnston Co.

From US401 (N end) take SR2724 E and cross RR. On N side near tracks.

BAZZEL CREEK BAPTIST (Af-Am) - Church is on SR1110 .3 mi E of SR1101 Go .4 mi E of church, then .2 mi S on SR1105 to cem. E side.

#### DUPREE, David

S of Fellowship Church, take SR2754 for .15 mi beyond curve. E side.

# **FELLOWSHIP BAPTIST**

From SR1006 go W 2 mi on SR2758. NE intersection with SR2754.

From US401 take SR1503. S side ca 100' in woods at edge of cleared land.

At cem above go W downhill 25-50 yds, before Woods of Asbury subdivision

# MORGAN, A. Sidney

From US401 go E on SR1010 .2 mi. S side behind McCullers Clubhouse.

# MYATT, Gabriel (no stone for him)

SR2759 extension N of SR2758. .2 mi on E side in curve.

# MYATT, W. A. (known as \*Mark MYATT cemetery)

- SW intersection of SR1006 and SR2747 ca 200' from 2747
- NEW PROVIDENCE BAPTIST (Af-Am) church is on S side of SR1393 E Pass church go 1 mi E to SR1404 and turn S. Cem is .25 mi on W side.
- \* OLIVE, Johnson (his young children only) location not pinpointed Going E on SR1390, then a road S after passing SR1389

PARTIN (not inventoried) - SW quadrant of SR2757 and SR2756. Fence.

# **PEGRAM** (Af-Am)

.2 mi N of SR1393 (no road now); enter by driveway .2 mi W of SR1404

# PINEY GROVE BAPTIST Intersection of NC42 and SR1101

# PLEASANT GROVE BAPTIST

From SR1393 go 1 mi N on SR1375. Cem on W side before church on E side.

# PLEASANT HILL UNITED CHURCH OF CHRIST (Af-Am)

W side of SR1375, S of SR1390 ca 2 mi (less from E via SR1503). Fence.

#### **POWELL**, Alford/STEPHENS, Lovey

From SR1110 go 1.1 mi S on SR1101. E side. Fence.

# RAMBEAUT, W.M.

From NC55 take SR2767 W (45° turn). E side after crossing creek.

\* ROWLAND, William I. - son Bennett has the only inscribed stone From US401 turn S at SR2753. E side. Cem on hilltop behind first house.

# **ROWLAND**, Oscar (Af-Am) - inscribed stone(s) were seen turned over later On SR1006 go S .5 mi or more past SR2723. W side. Now behind houses (was by woods on cleared land when first inventoried).

# ROWLAND, Alfred E./STEPHENS, Robert Henry

From NC42 take SR2751 N about 1.5 mi. E side past Terrible Ck. Fence.

# SAINT AUGUSTINE CHURCH CEMETERY (Af-Am) - An old church site In Fuquay-Varina via Vance St take SR2770 SE to road on right (now Judd Rd?), 100' from town limits. Go 15 mi. Cem on left near top of hill.

#### \* SLAVE? (Af-Am)

In SW quadrant of SR1393 and SR1375 (ca 100 yds S/200 yds W behind houses)

SMITH, Alvin J./SEXTON, Rufus R.

On NC42 E side of Fuquay-Varina go S .1 mi on SR1301. W side. Fence.

# SMITH, Durham Hall

Take SR1100 W off US401 S of Fuquay-Varina. Go .5 mi and turn N - before the creek. Cem ca .1 mi on right.

# SORRELL, W.A.

From SR1390 go S on SR1391 .3 mi. Front yard of house #8626 (W in curve).

# STEPHENS, T.J. and 3 others moved to Greenlawn Cem.

US401 E side across SR1392 and 20 yds off hwy (now a church property)

# STEPHENSON, B.T.

N of SR2758 on Stephenson farm road .2 mi from SR2760. E side. Fence.

STEPHENSON, James W.

On SR1006 go .2 mi S of SR2759. Middle of field .1 mi on W. Fence.

TAYLOR, Jordan (Af-Am) - informant knows only this one name of those buried On W side of SR1386, not too far N of intersection with SR1404

Off NC55 inside town limits of Fuguay-Varina on its NW side at RR

WEATHERS, Ernest C. / BANKS\*? From US401 take SR1010 E. On S side near road and McCullers Clubhouse.

From US401 go E .5 mi on SR1010; S side

#### WILLIAMS, Charles I. (Af-Am)

E side SR1404 ca .1 mi N of SR1393 near within housing area in a wooded area. Wire fence.

# WILLOW SPRINGS PRIMITIVE BAPTIST

Cem on SR2748 S of church at junction with NC42 (SR2751 is N of church).

**WOMACK** (name on map; not visited)

From SR1390 go S on SR1404 .3 mi, then E .2 mi (in field?)



#### WAKE COUNTY CEMETERY SURVEY LISTING BY TOWNSHIP (PART 6)

#### WHITE OAK TOWNSHIP CEMETERIES

This township is bounded on the W by Chatham Co. starting S at Beaver Ck. and on the N by Durham Co. for ca .9 mi going E. The Durham-Sou. spur RR tracks is the line S; Cedar Fork Twp. to the east. At SR1615 the line goes E; at SR1613, S. Cary Twp. is on the east. Again the RR becomes the line, which at SR1614 goes NE to SR1011 for .1 mi, S via SR1308, SE via Williams Creek in/out of Apex-Cary Reservoir, then US64. Under US1 it goes into SR1009 and at SR1300 turns S - Swift Creek Twp. to the east. From SR1010 W, Holly Springs Twp. begins a wrap-around via SR1302 S, SR1301 W, NC55 N, US1 S. The line takes SR1170 N (no access), the Atlantic Seaboard tracks NE, then SR1163 NW to Beaver Ck. and its course W back to Chatham Co. Buckhorn Twp. adjoins south and southwest from Big Branch on US1 S.

#### APEX FIRST BAPTIST (Af-Am)

From NC55 go S on S. Salem St. and turn S on SRII53. Proceed .6 mi. E side.

# APEX TOWN/HILLCREST II

From S. Salem St. go NW .2 mi on NC55 to Upchurch St. on right. NE quadrant.

# BALDWIN/STEWART (Af-Am)

From NC55 go S on S. Salem St. and turn S on SR1153. Proceed .4 mi, just beyond school. E side.

# BULLOCK, Wm R./MILLS, John Addison

On US64 go 2.3 mi west beyond NC55 and turn N on SR1601 and proceed easterly to SR1603. On SR1603 go north miles to last house on right before SR1605. Two-part cemetery back of house.

#### CLEMENT

From US64, go N 2.7 mi on NC55 to SR1615, then W 1.8 mi. Beaver Dam Rd. is right fork of SR1615. Still unlocated; longtime residents have no knowledge of cemetery.

# **GREEN LEVEL BAPTIST**

From US64 go N 2.7 mi on NC 55 to SRI615, then 2 mi W. Take right fork on Beaver Dam Rd. to SRI600. Church on W side. Cemetery on S side of church.

#### HILLIARD, Ezekiel family

From US 64 go N .3 mi on NC55 to SRI621 and go W 1.6 mi. N side.

# HORTON/RICHARDSON (Af-Am)

To be located.

#### HOWELL, Jesse Jr.

On US64 go W 3.8 mi beyond NC55. In field 100+ ft. N side of road (obelisk).

# HUNTER, Trubie

From NC55 go S 2 mi on S. Salem St./Old US1. Turn left on private road across railroad tracks to farm house; on right of house. Ask permission.

#### JENKS, Hinton/MILLS, Sidney N.

On US64 go 2.3 W of NC55 and turn N on SR1601. Proceed .5 mi easterly to SR1603 (dead ends from NW). In field (on easterly diagonal opposite SR1603) some 100 ft. on S side of SR1601.

# JENKS, John

From US64 go northerly on SR1600, cross SR1601 and proceed .7 mi. Cem on W side some 50 yds, to the right of upgrade of fairly open land; not easily visible. Some stones appear to be missing that were on an earlier survey.

# JOHNSON, John Samuel; son Wm C. "Kit" and others

From US64 go N 2.7 mi on NC55 to SR1615, then W .2 mi to heavily wooded area on S side. Walk ca 165' into overgrown path; turn right on overgrown truck path and go ca 30'. Cemetery on both sides of path.

LEVEL GROVE - perhaps once a community cemetery (Jones/Thomas/Stephens/etc.) From US1 go 2 mi S on NC55 to SR1301 and proceed east 1.5 mi to SR1302. NW quadrant.

# MANN, Silas Q.

From N. Salem St., go E .3 mi on Hunter St. to SRI435 and proceed .3 mi to house #1210 on S side. In back of house. Private property; ask permission.

# MATTHEWS, C.W. (Af-Am)

From N. Salem St. go 2.6 mi E on Center St./SR1010. Cem on N side of SR1379 near where it forks off SR1010.

# MATTHEWS, W.C. (Af-Am)

From N. Salem St. go 3 mi E on Center Street/SR1010. N side; wooden fence.

# MAYNARD, Amos

From US64/N. Salem St., go 1.9 mi N on SR1613 to Park Village subd., west side. Turn in and go one block, then right on Halls Mill Dr. and at end of block, right onto Silk Hope Dr. Go some 50' and up slight embankment on right. Wooden fence.

# MILLS/GOODWIN

On US64 go 3 mi W past NC55 to first dirt road/private driveway beyond SR1602, N side, cinderblock house. Go through yard but ask permission.

# MILLS, Hilliard/SEARS, John Barbee



Surrounded by Middle Creek and Swift Creek townships to the E, White Oak to the N and Buckhom to the W, this township joins two counties on the S - Chatham for 1½ mi and Harnett. Starting S to N at Harnett, the eastern line is the most complex one in Wake, involving 11 state roads: 1121. 1101, 1110, 1111, 1399, 1393, 1301, 1390, 1389, 1305, and 1300. At 1010 the northern line starts W, drops S at 1303, then 1302, W again on 1301 to NC55, N to US1 and SW to Big Br. The western boundary is 95% water: S/SW via Big Branch and White Oak Creek (nuclear plant is to the W) up to SR1127 and on it .8 mi SE to Cary Creek, then flows SW. At Chatham Co. the line turns E, continuing E along Harnett Co., back to the start.



#### **CEDAR FORK TOWNSHIP**

Imagine Cedar Fork as a butterfly heading NW! Within outstretched wings is Durham Co., the Seaboard Coastline RR at the NW tip and US70, the NE. Adjoining townships along US70 going SE are Leesville, then House Creek. The boundary turns southward on Sycamore Creek (E side of Angus Barn) to SR1647 and on it a short distance, takes SR1650/1775 to Crabtree Creek. Behind the butterfly, from SE to SW, is <u>Cary Twp.</u>, the boundary following Crabtree Creek (I-40 will cross) into Lake Crabtree and out by an unnamed tributary to the S onto SR1785. Next, via NC54W, the line goes to the town limits of Morrisville at Wilson Dr., turns S with a tributary to Coles Branch - on it northwesterly to Crabtree Creek. and south on it to SR1615, then westward again. At the Seaboard Coastline RR the line follows it N to the beginning point at Durham County. White Oak Twp. joins on the West.

More than a fourth of Cedar Fork Township, the northwestern section of its original square, helped form Durham County in 1881 (as did about half of Oak Grove on the north and in 1911, most of the remainder; no such township in Wake anymore but the name is carried in Durham). A bit of Cedar Fork's original northeastern lands became part of a "new" Wake township, Leesville (in 1911?), along with some from old Oak Grove and from Bartons Creek and House Creek townships. Wake's original boundary with Orange and Chatham counties was a straight line, N from Granville County to Chatham on the SW. The line began east of where Flat River joined the Eno River and became the Neuse River (now Falls Lake) on into Wake. Ancestors in the area, formerly Wake, would be listed in Durham County's survey, if any family graveyards are left or in church cemeteries.



# **CARY TOWNSHIP CEMETERIES**

Cary Township is surrounded by six others: Raleigh and Meredith to the E; a bit of House Creek on the N; Cedar Fork, N and W; White Oak, W and S; Swift Creek, S and E. The Town of Cary "invades" ones Raleigh City does not; which city is into some of Cary Twp. At US1/64 the line takes I-40W, Expressway E, Richland Ck. NW into Crabtree Ck., W into Crabtree Lake, SE by an unnamed tributory to Lake Dr. and onto NC54W. Following town limits of Morrisville, Coles Br. W, then Crabtree Ck. going S, it takes SR1615 W to SR1613 S, the tracks of the Durham-Sou. RR spur to SR1614 E. At SR1308 it goes S, SE via Williams Ck. and into/out of Cary-Apex Water Reservoir and on US64 E. Under US1 it goes into SR1009, then N at SR1423 to SR1313 but briefly to US1/64 E and back to I-40W.



#### LEESVILLE TOWNSHIP

One of the smaller townships in Wake, its shape is somewhat like a slice of pie - a first bite taken and the crust fallen away, taking some of the filling with it! Both sides leave Durham Co. and go SE, along the way becoming encompassed by House Creek Twp. The southwesterly side follows US70 (Cedar Creek Twp. on the southwest as far as the airport) to just before SR2018 (on east side). The northeasterly side follows SR1831 (Bartons Creek Twp. on the east as far as SR1829). SR1831 meets SR1830 by which the line goes east ca .1 mi and at Hwy 50 goes south to SR1828 and by it, westward onto SR1826 and south again to SR1822. On this route, the bounds go southeasterly to SR2018 and west on it. At Pleasant Grove Church Road, N/NW to SR1824; south thereon a short distance to road's end An invisible line extends to US70. N of SR2018, to complete the township.

Leesville became a "new" township (in 1911?), formed from a bit of old Cedar Fork's northeastern lands along with some from Oak Grove, former Wake township, and from Bartons Creek and House Creek townships. More than a fourth of Cedar Fork Township, the northwestern segment of its original square, in 1881 helped to form Durham County (as did about half of Oak Grove on the north and in 1911, most of the remainder; no such township in Wake anymore but the name is carried in Durham). Wake's original boundary with Orange and Chatham counties was a straight line, N from Granville County to Chatham on the SW. The line began E of where Flat River joined the Eno River and became the Neuse River (now Falls Lake on into Wake). Ancestors in the area, formerly Wake, would be listed in Durham County's survey, if any family graveyards are left or in church cemeteries.



> This township is in the very southwest corner of Wake County, joining S and W with Chatham Co. and two townships -White Oak on the N/NE; Holly Springs on the E, the bounds being 95% water. This starts at Big Branch on US1 and flows SW into White Oak Ck. At SR1127 it goes SE for .9 mi to Cary Creek, thereon flowing SW to Chatham Co. Along Chatham W and then N, the line comes to Beaver Creek by which it begins the northerly bounds with White Oak Twp. At SR1163 the line turns SE to the RR's right-of-way, by which it goes .4 mi SW to SR1170 and thereon SE to US1 (no access). 

CEMETERY FILE!

Beginning at the Neuse River and Falls Dam on SR2000, the bounds go west along the center of Falls Lake (formed from the river) to Durham Co. Following southward with Durham's boundary and turning SE onto SR1831, the line goes 4 miles to SR1830 and by it goes east .2 mi to NC50. Going south on NC50 about three-fourths of a mile, the line comes to SR1829. Up to that point after leaving Durham Co., the adjoining township is <u>Leesville</u>. Then going east with SR1829, the line is shared with <u>House Creek Township</u> on the S. At SR2000 and turning northerly, the bounds go to the beginning. To the east is <u>Neuse Township</u>. To the north, across Falls Lake, is <u>New</u> <u>Light Township</u>.

This township's name is found spelled either with or without the apostrophe. It is Barton Creek Township in Powell's *Gazetteer*. The U.S. Geological Survey map has it the Lower and the Upper Barton creeks that run easterly/westerly through the township. But then Powell spells the creeks with the apostrophe!

Surveyors: Army Corps of Engineers (CofE), Minnie Bridges, Keith Craig, Hickman Ray, Jimmy Lloyd, Teri Lee Rosario, Kathleen Wilson Shearon, Greg L. Shields, and others to be listed in the future. Barbara Bridgers Barham, who was of great help to the Corps of Engineers, has reported many of the others for our survey.

Graveyards/cemeteries for this issue are separated into three groups:

- 1. Those surveyed and inventoried by the Corps of Engineers (CofE) in the 1970s. These are divided into (A) ones moved out of the flood plain and (B) those left in place. On current maps the area west of the dam at SR2000 is now Falls Lake. Older maps show the original course of the river.
- 2. Others in the township that have been inventoried.
- 3. Ones reported but not yet inventoried, circumstances preventing completion in time for this issue of the journal.
- + Moved by Corps of Engineers (CofE). To visit most of the others, arrangements must be made through the Falls Lake park headquarters.
- Reported to have been destroyed
- \* Fieldstones or depressions only

Note: The listings below may have errors of precise location. Few inscribed markers are found in many of these graveyards. Some are named as area residents heard them called; others, from any inscribed marker, earliest date of deathor birth, or landowner. Land search might provide the best guess; sometimes a deed mentions a burial round. ### FORMER WAKE COUNTY AREA NOW A PART OF DURHAM COUNTY

Listed here are the graveyards closest to the Neuse River in the part of Durham County that previously was in Wake (see remarks under Cedar Fork and Leesville townships, Part 7). In 1881 the western part of Wake's Oak Grove Township went to Durham County, almost to the outskirts of Durham city; in 1911, the rest of Wake's Oak Grove. The second annexation stopped at the Barton's Creek line on up to the Neuse River.

The Union Chapel Baptist Church cemetery was relocated from Granville Co. to Durham Co. on the west side of SR1804 between NC98 and Falls Lake. It was originally located at the SE intersection of US15 with SR1726, which extended from Wake County's SR1903 up to US15. Reinterments of Durham County also went to Union's new site.

- BARNETT/WEBB/REVIS CofE 1839. 93 of 98 graves unknown From the end of SR1633 (E off SR1632, 1.8 mi N of I-85) in Durham Co. go NE ca .3 mi.
- **CEMETERY** CofE 940 318 graves. Due E ca 1 mi from Redwood Commuity near Neuse River. Community est. 1890 along the Neuse at edge of old Wake line. Cemetery on N side of SR1801. Burial details would be found in Durham County's report from the Corps of Engineers.
- ROGERS, Pele G. CofE 853. 29 of 32 graves are unknown Ca.45 mi W of Wake-Durham line, E of Lick Creek. Farm road leading W off SR1831 less than .1 mi N of NC98.
- UNKNOWN CofE 1807. 101 graves details in Durham County's report. Located between E side of Southern RR tracks and SR1637

UNKNOWN - CofE 728-1. 47 unknown graves

N side of farm road W ca .4 mi off SR1805, which forks NW off SR1831 in Wake Co. Near Little Lick Creek; more to the NW of CofE 728-2.

#### Ones not moved:

BAILEY, G.C. - CofE 719. 12 of 14 graves unknown

Farm road on E side SR1805, just north of SR1806, at edge of Falls Lake area.





#### **CEDAR FORK TOWNSHIP**

Imagine Cedar Fork as a butterfly heading NW! Within outstretched wings is Durham Co., the Seaboard Coastline RR at the NW tip and US70, the NE. Adjoining townships along US70 going SE are Leesville, then House Creek. The boundary turns southward on Sycamore Creek (E side of Angus Barn) to SR1647 and on it a short distance, takes SR1650/1775 to Crabtree Creek. Behind the butterfly, from SE to SW, is Cary Twp., the boundary following Crabtree Creek (I-40 will cross) into Lake Crabtree and out by an unnamed tributary to the S onto SR1785. Next, via NC54W, the line goes to the town limits of Morrisville at Wilson Dr., turns S with a tributary to Coles Branch - on it northwesterly to Crabtree Creek. and south on it to SR1615, then westward again. At the Seaboard Coastline RR the line follows it N to the beginning point at Durham County. White Oak Twp. joins on the West.

More than a fourth of Cedar Fork Township, the northwestern section of its original square, helped form Durham County in 1881 (as did about half of Oak Grove on the north and in 1911, most of the remainder; no such township in Wake anymore but the name is carried in Durham). A bit of Cedar Fork's original northeastern lands became part of a "new" Wake township, Leesville (in 1911?), along with some from old Oak Grove and from Bartons Creek and House Creek townships. Wake's original boundary with Orange and Chatham counties was a straight line, N from Granville County to Chatham on the SW. The line began east of where Flat River joined the Eno River and became the Neuse River (now Falls Lake) on into Wake. Ancestors in the area, formerly Wake, would be listed in Durham County's survey, if any family graveyards are left or in church cemeteries.

Probably other graveyards not yet known about, even some from the list below, may have been moved due to the almost constant expansion of Raleigh-Durham International Airport since the 1940s. No doubt, others will be moved in the future.

Moved from one-time Adams Crossroads (now area of Army air field) to Mt. Hermon.

Near NC54 at Perimeter Park Dr. Had rocks which were moved; no graves moved

### Maynard/Nutt/Castleberry

On SR1613 turn E onto SR3014. Cemetery on left beyond 3rd house.

#### Mills family Af-Am

Going NW on NC54 pass SR1706 ca .3 mi to an unimproved road on the E. Cemetery is down at end of this road.

### Morrisville Baptist Church

NW off SR3014 onto Church St. (SR1637). Church .1 mi on W. Cemetery behind.

On US70, turn S on SR3015 and go .3 mi. Turn E on Commerce Blvd and go .5 mi to International Dr., then .6 mi to Cemetery Road. Original church site and cemetery were moved in the 1950s for airport expansion. In 1986 their new brick building was destroyed, but the cemetery was left alone. Congregation relocated in Durham Co.





### **NEW LIGHT TOWNSHIP CEMETERIES**

New Light is Wake County's most northwestern township. Granville County joins across the north. On the south is Barton's Creek Township. Falls Lake, created from the Neuse River, separates the two. To the west is Durham County, most of it also separated by Falls Lake (W and S). The eastern boundary is shared with Wake Forest Township. Starting on SR2000 at the Neuse R. bridge (Falls Dam at its west), that line runs northeasterly to SR1967 (Old NC98) and by it goes eastward .15 mi, then again to the north on SR1923. Crossing SR1909 the line is SR1924 and apparently for a half mile is the same road going into Granville County.

The area along the Neuse River in Barton's Creek and New Light townships and in parts of Durham and Granville counties have one thing in common: Falls Lake. When the lake was created in the 1970s, graveyards that fell in the flood plain had to be removed. Several road changes occurred in New Light. Some were closed, abruptly ending, meaning the other end may now have a new name and a few numbers were changed. Some roads were extended to connect beyond where once connected. A new 3-mile stretch for NC98 was built. Names and numbers are given as they are today.
