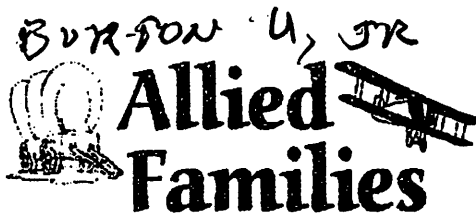

Further to yours of the 18th. I have now had a chance to visit my Valley office and have reviewed my files on your close relatives which are especially good because of inputs from your first cousin Eleanor, may she rest in peace. In reviewing the files I was reminded of the great sacrifice your family made and of your great personal loss when your father gave his life for our Country on D day in France. I hope present day generations appreciate and honor Lieutenant Howard Upchurch, Sr and his kind to whom we are indebted for so much. Here is a brief excerpt that Eleanor wrote to me on March 10, 1982 about your father: "He was an architect, was hansom, was a musician and played the piano beautifully--was a graduate of Auburn University where he performed with the "Auburn Knights"."

I also have the feeling that Eleanor did not finish her work which is generally the case with family historians. Further, their records often get put aside and eventually are lost. With the creation of Upchurch And Allied Families Association we have a Headquarters location where we can entertain the acceptance of compiled records. Perhaps it is too late to even learn what happened to her records but if there is a possibility of learning of the existence of her collection I would welcome opportunity of exploring the possibility of them being acquired by UAFA.

My Master Outline, kept manually, for the Burton Upchurch Line in the Abel U., Sr/Bartley U Subclan, to which you belong, is in good shape. If you are interested and will provide a mailing address I will be happy to mail you a section of the compendium so you can see some details and learn how my records are kept. Later we could do more if you are interested.

You will note from my website that I have produced videos on several of the children of Richard U., II 1725-1798, your and my common ancestor. He established the Upchurch enclave on the border of Wake and Franklin Counties in North Carolina about 1765. Each of the children of Richard U., II headed one of the 22 Upchurch Clans. You descend from his son Abel U., Sr and I descend from another son Nathan U., I. I have produced a video on Nathan and plan to produce one on Abel. There is a lot more to learn about Abel U., Sr who left N.C. about 1820. It is my hopes that among the families we "enroll" in the plan of work for UAFA will be the Abel U. Sr., Family. This would allow the story of this family to be online at one spot sort of like a book.

I realize that individuals have different levels of interest in their heritage. I will be interested to learn of your particular interests and to work with you collaboratively in keeping with your level of interest. As you can no doubt tell my bite by the family history bug was severe.

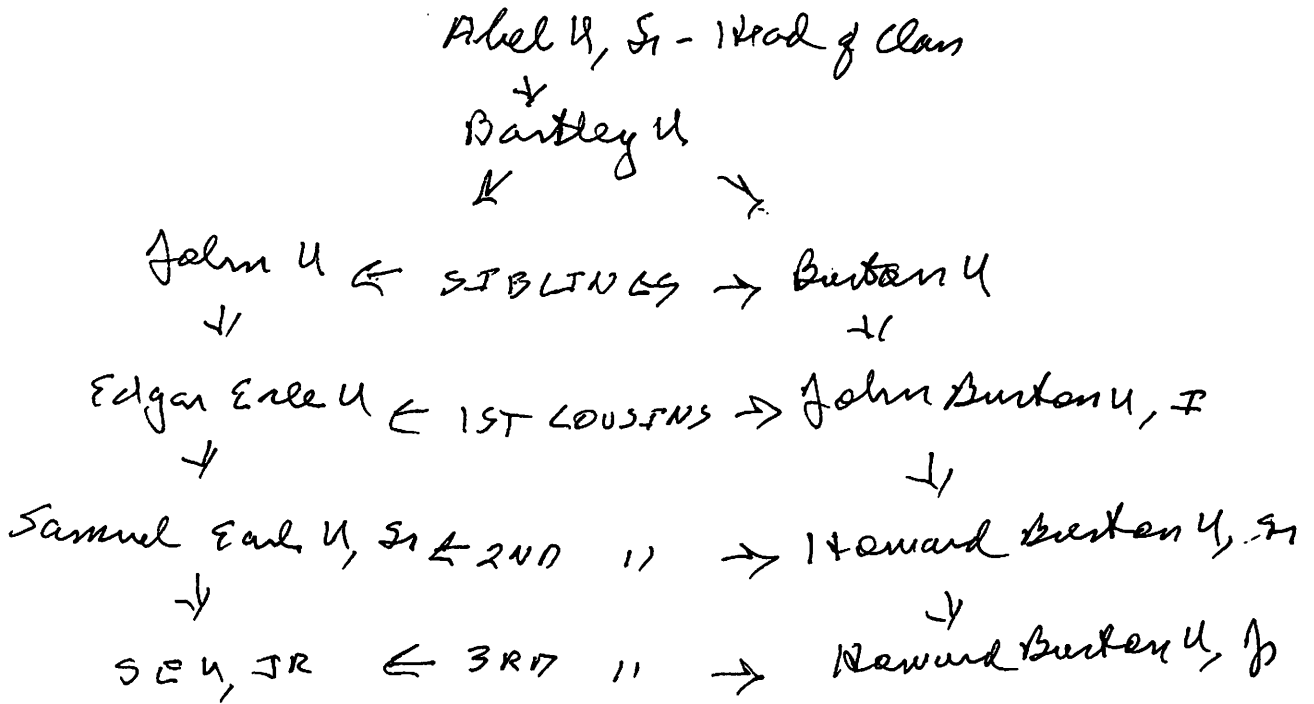
Dear Cousin Howard.

I'm your email of 17 JUN 2015 you asked about the Upchurch Drug Store in Clanton. In the interim we have made two out-of-state trips - hence some delay in getting back to you.

I have Upchurches documented in many ways - by name, geography, dates, professions, ownership, etc, etc & I like to embellish when I can. Your inquiry prompted me to augment my files on the Upchurches of Chilton Co, AL. and otherwise.

The Drug Store was owned by EDGAR EARLE (EARL) U and the story is best told via the Biopile of his son Samuel Earl U, Sr - A copy of the 5-Page 10-Item Biopile is enclosed. Note where I have highlighted a passage in Item (3). I corresponded with Ann, the wife of SEU, Sr but never met her.

Your relationship is as follows:



You will note & probably already knew that SEU, Sr & his wife Ann used real money and shavers - looking at the name of an UPCHURCH BUILDING on the Auburn campus. I have more detail on this.

I am serious in not being moved more boldly to get the SEU, Sr more involved in our Lynchburg history project. But then I only created Allied Families in 2013. We face a deadline to keep our wonderful Lynchburg heritage from slipping into obscurity.

Dear Cousin Howard,

First, thank you for your \$250 check in support of our Allied Families program of work. This qualifies you as a 2014 member of UAFPA at the "FINDER" level. It is nice to have members enrolled above the \$20 Subscriber level so others will get the idea.

It is always my practice to work with cooperators in keeping with their own interests. Over time I will send you several kinds of documents and your response will guide us along a pathway.

My Master Outlines are kept in loose-leaf notebooks by Class & Subclass. So it is easy for me to send out small or large segments to cooperators. You belong to the Burton U Line in the Abel U, Sr / Bartley U Subclass. So, I enclose the five page of the Master Outline pertaining to Burton U, his children, and

grandchildren. The descendants (if any) if known are covered in Continuation Sections "CS" as indicated on the left hand side of the five pages. There are 15 of these Continuation Sections (so far). I enclose only 1 of them CS-16 - after the orange sheet. **Should** you desire any or all of the Continuation Sheets please let me know. I have similar computations for the siblings of Burton U.

You are under no obligation to correct or add to the Master Outline but improvements are always welcomed. Many people have helped put my Master Outline together. I have had well over a thousand cooperators - many now deceased. Note that designates a cooperator.

We are now working to substantially upgrade our UAFPA website including having a linked database. We need an expert to do the mechanics for us and we have a candidate to be a "fontist".

We already have beginning support to "enroll" 10 families. This will allow us to pull together at one place information on a given family. Eventually we will want to get to the family of Abel U, Sr

I'm keeping with your email request of 8 AUG 2014 I am happy to provide details from my files on your three under John Robert U, Sr, James Taylor U, Sr and William Kendrick U, Sr. Enclosed please find:

For JRU, Sr - Profile - 3 Page - 8 Items

Continuation Section 13 A, B - Mostly Dublin

For JTU, Sr Profile - 2 Page - 6 Items

Continuation Section 14 A-E Mostly Dublin

For WJU, Sr Profile - 12 Page - 16 Items + Letters Exchanges

Continuation Section 15 A, B

In addition I have for WJU, Sr about 50 pages from a larger packet sent to me about 1980 by Belle West. The larger packet contained copies of letters & documents assembled by Belle & her collaborators going back to the 1950's. They reveal how they made no gun and made mistakes. I'll be glad to send copies if you so request. I am fairly sure I have brought all good information forward to my Mother Dublin. These exchanges do reveal the breadth of interest several conspirators had in Upchurch history early on. WJU, Sr was very active.

you will recognize that the Biopiles are just a place to preserve items and not in any special order. They are useful when someone wants to verify a source, do a serious study - or likely in your case just to see what is known about family members. (13)

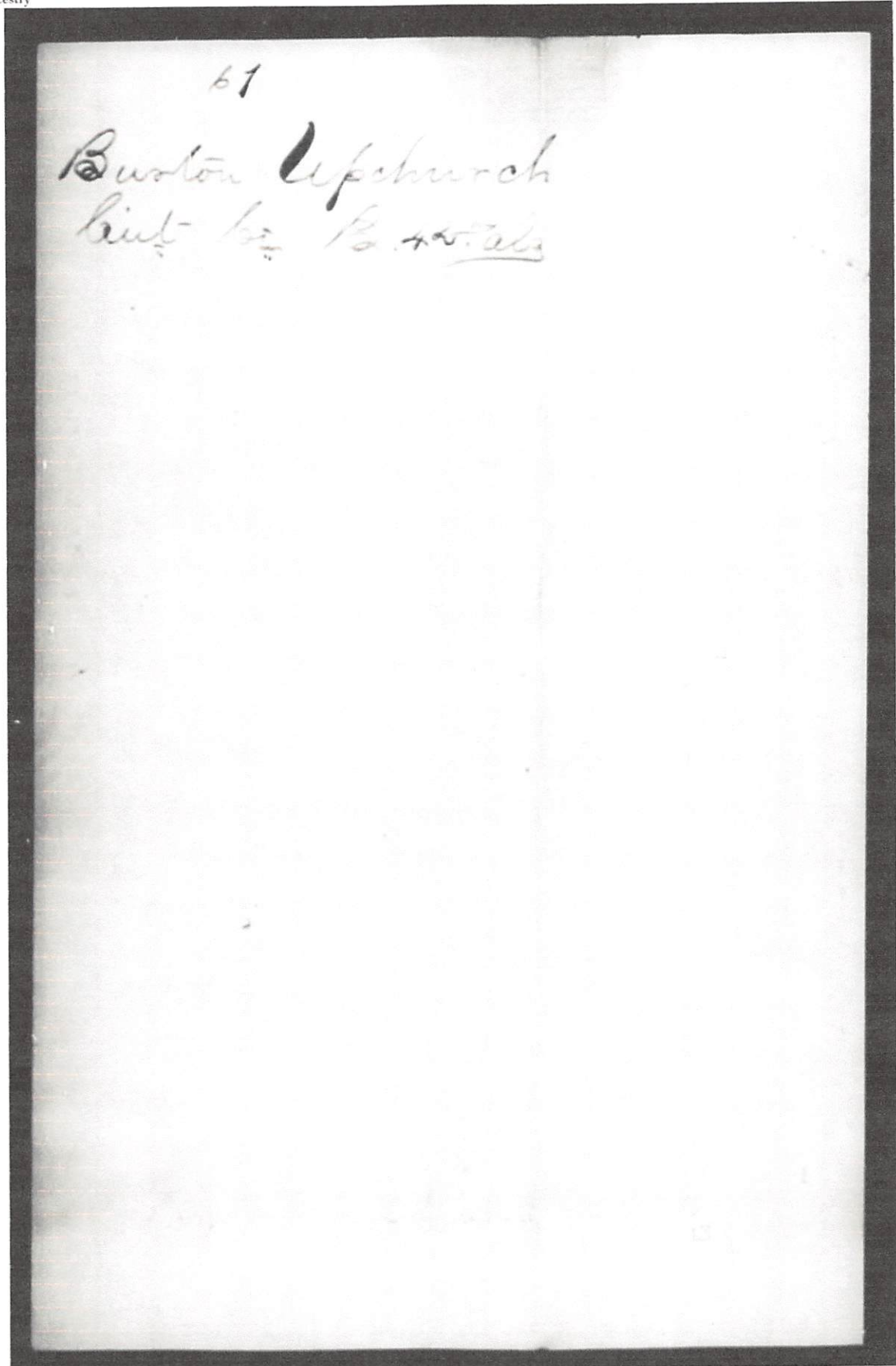

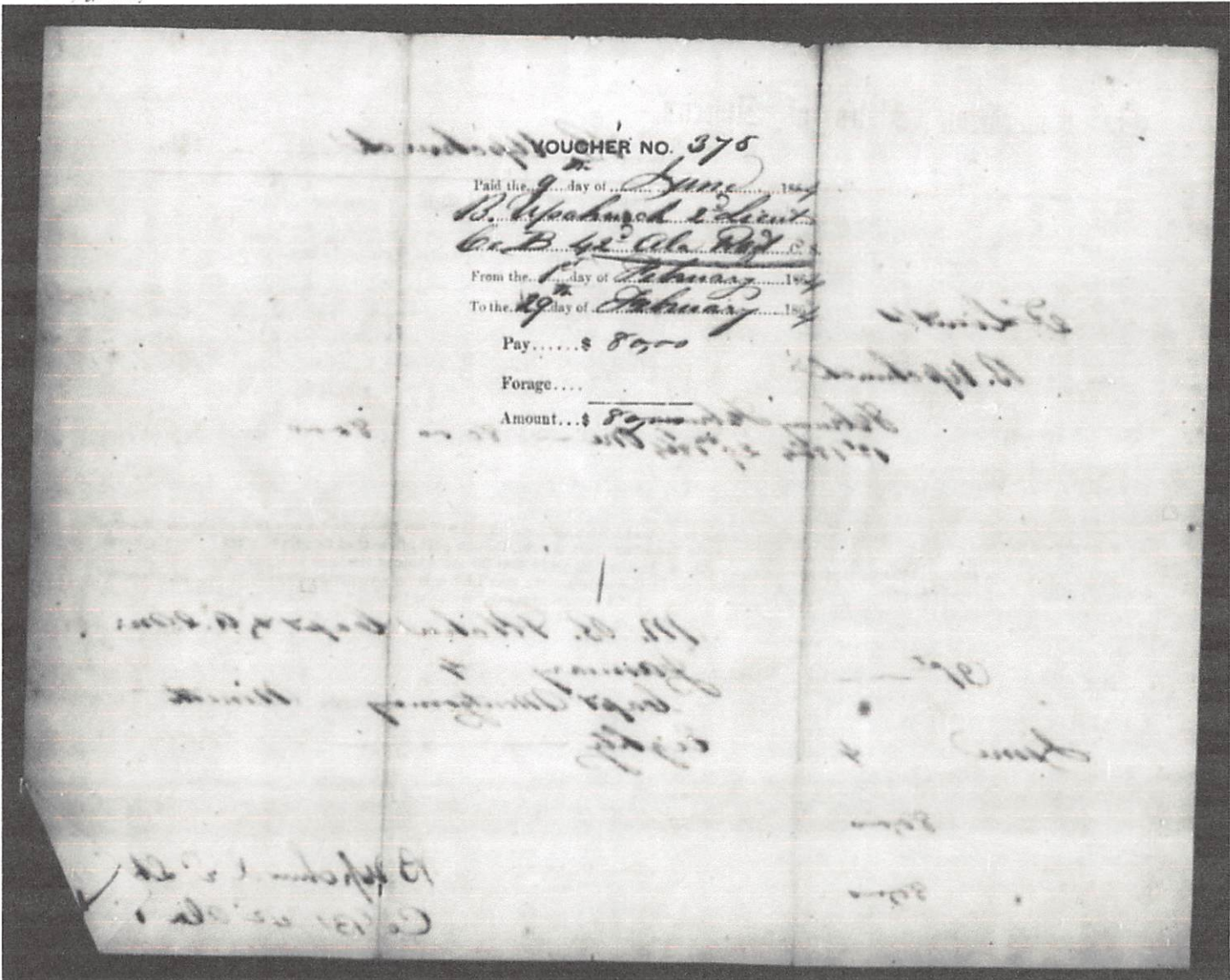
