From the intersection of Blue Ridge Rd., (SR 1664) and Reedy Creek Rd., (SR 2400) at the traffic light in front of the NC State Museum of Art, turn NW on Reedy Creek Rd. Go exactly 1 mile on Reedy Creek Rd. You will cross Edwards Mill Rd., (SR 2300) at .6 mi., and continue on Reedy Creek Rd. which is a gravel road after you cross Edward's Mill Rd. Take a left turn onto State Farm Rd., a dirt road no SR number, and go .1 mi. to the cemetery on your right. Behind the cemetery is state property, with a sign "Schenk Forest".

One can park on the side of the road and enter through a gate. This is a pleasant small Baptist Church cemetery, tidy and cared for. There is room for more burials.

It is located near the burgeoning growth around the RBC Center, (home to the NHL Hurricanes), it is surprisingly untouched and surrounded by green rolling fields. Originally a log cabin church stood next to the cemetery, long since moved and now, no longer a small log cabin church, Mount Olivet Church is located at 3500 Edward Mill Rd., about 5 miles away. The cemetery belongs to the church and contains about .5 acre.

From Raleigh, drive north on US1 North (Capitol Blvd) passing under the interchange with I-540 and turn left on Greshams Lake Road. Take Greshams Lake road about 1.5 miles to Harps Mill Rd. Turn right on Harps Mill and then take the second left at Goudy Dr. Park at the end of the street (1 block).

To access Greshams Lake Road from I-540 requires going north on US1 to a cross over and coming back south because there is a barrier preventing a left turn on Greshams Lake from the I-540 ramp.

The cemetery is directly behind the house on the left. There is a path through the trees along the edge of the house which is a deeded access to the cemetery.

I counted at least 28 graves in this cemetery, but only three have engraved headstones. Some of the others have un-engraved headstones, rock or metal markers or are obvious depressions.

I surveyed this cemetery in Mar of 2004.

Developer seeks to move abandoned

More than a dozen people lain to rest, some for nearly a century, will be moved elsewhere to make way for new homes if a development firm's request is approved.

The Claridge Development Corp., which owns a 6.76-acre tract at U.S. 1 and State Road

1010, has petitioned the Wake County Commissioners to move several graves from a half-acre site in a wooded area within the subdivision property.

The graves, nestled in the woods about 200 yards behind the nearest development, are referred to as "abandoned" in the company's petition.

They contain the remains of

members of the Passmore and Womack families, buried between 1894 and the 1920s.

Marked graves bear the names of Mr. and Mrs. H.B. Rhodes, Arthelia Frances Rhodes, H.B. Rhodes, N.L. Mann, L.J. Wilson, M.J. Wilson, Marthie E. Johnson, E.T. Wilson daughter of L.T. and N.I. Wilson, Dillie Passmore Womack, Marshall H. Womack,

Paul Womack and others whose names cannot be determined.

Some headstones have been toppled and some apparently are missing.

Lawyer Walter N. Rak of Hatch, Little & Bunn, a Raleigh firm representing the developer, said the company proposes to

move the graves to Apex Cemetery at the company's expense.

Several steps have been taken to ensure that the move would not offend remaining relatives. Rak said research indicated there were 38 potential heirs to the people buried there.

All 38 were written, he said, informing them of the company's plan. All but one gave their permission to move the graves. The other said he had no knowledge of the graves and thus had no feelings

about moving them.

The present state of the graveyard, overgrown and only a stone's throw from a makeshift appliance junkpile, indicates that the move to Apex Cemetery will make the markers much more accessible for relatives.

Rak said the development company purchased the land without knowing about the cemetery and discovered it as the subdivision was expanding. Claridge was started about two years ago, and about a

dozen homes are completed or under construction.

Wake County is unique in that it requires a public hearing before the graves can be moved. There is no state requirement for such a hearing.

The commissioners will hold a hearing on the petition June 17 at the Wake County Courthouse. In the meantime, relatives and others with concerns should address their comments to Rak at 327 Hillsborough St., Raleigh, 27603.
