2) Charles Richard Upchurch was born in Wilkes Co. NC in 1875. He was the son or possibly the grandson of Greenberry B. Upchurch. It is thought that Greenberry is the son of Hubbard Upchurch, who was the son of Nathan. The facts as known to the family are:
 There is a record for Green B. Upchurch in the Archives of Raleigh who was a private in the CSA. He was taken prisoner by the Union Army while he was a prisoner in the hospital in Richmond, VA.
 His address was given as Elkin, NC which fits the census of 1880 for Wilkes Co. His name was given as Green B. Upchurch.

 He may have been twice md. If Greenberry were born in 1825 he would have been 50 years old when son Charles was born.

The basis for this search is that in 1859 Hubbard children decided their right in their late father's property to their brother Parker U. In the process they reserved unto themselves a cemetery plot. The entire property is now owned by Lewis Smith and it is being developed as "Upchurch Subdivision".

(28) COMMENTS ON THE FAMILY OF HUBBARD U 1800-1859

These comments are derived largely from RPH 25 FEB 2011
 the will of Hubbard written 31 AUG 1858 probated MAY 1859 and
 from a deed made by the heirs of Hubbard on 22 NOV 1859
 both preserved in the Profile of Hubbard, the deed of RPH
 by Kenn L. Hutto on 11 FEB 2011 via email.

- △ The will gives all of his land to son Green Byrd U on condition that he care for his parents for their lives.
- △ Daughter Lorena^{given} has real estate items of equal gifts already given to his other children - not named.

The NOV 1859 deed is not exactly in line with the will in that it indicates a dowry of land has already been set aside by the widow nee Esther

- △ Byrd (she died in 1864 leaving a will) and the remainder of the property is in the hands of Hubbard's children
- △ who sell their undivided share to their brother PARKER U.

The sellers are styled as follows:

- △ 1. ARMEALLY^{HER} MARK HUDSON [ARMELIA U]
- △ + Husband HINTON HUDSON
- △ 2. TABBITHA^{HER} MARK HOLLEMAN [TABBITHA ESTHER U]
- △ + Husband - shown as WILLIE HOLLEMAN
- △ but signed as [WILEY W. HOLLEMAN]
- △ 3 G. B. U [GREEN BERRY U]
- △ 4. LINDERMON^{HER} MARK U
- △ 5. LORENA^{HER} MARK U [NOTE BORN 1824, STILL SINGLE 1859 AGE 35]

Note that the deed does not mention a daughter of Hubbard named OTELA U [BORN 1840 PRESUMED DIED < 1859
 Note that the deed in fact P mistakenly lists Wiley W. Holleman as W. W. UPCHURCH

Note the deed reserves a one acre cemetery where Hubbard rests
 Reed land adjacent LEVI BAUCOM, HINTON HUDSON, ET. AL,
 witness GEORGE L. BARBEE

Hubbard purchased land in 1823, 1834, 1837 - how the three tracts relate to the NOV 1859 deed is unknown. It is presumed to lay just SW of Lynchburg Station and is probably what is now UPCHURCH FARMS SUBDIVISION.

On 18 JUL 1983 RPH & John Lee U, Jr walked the tract looking for the cemetery without success.

Proof that TABBITHA ESTHER U had the middle name ESTHER is lacking. Hubbard had a sister TABBITHA & his wife = ESTHER.

△ Billy does not remember the store in operation

△ but Jesse Fearington, Sr. told Billy there was quite a complex at Upchurch. That he would head to Raleigh for farm supplies and service his mules/horses at the complex.

△ Billy recalls that the beds for his present home was delivered at Upchurch Station and hauled by wagon to the home site.
