Thank you for sending the copy of the obituary for cousin Robert E. Lee Upchurch, II. From everything I have heard he was a very interesting person. I am sorry I never got to meet him. We exchanged letters and phone calls. He had a deep interest in Upchurch Family History and we have lost a dear member of our family.

You mentioned Ray White. It seems he is very busy with his job and raising his family but he still works on family history. His daughter is now in school in North Carolina. He takes her back and forth and I have encouraged him to stop and see me in Missouri as it is right on his way. So far this has not worked out

but he did take time to call me this ^③
past spring when he passed through. However
he did not have time to come to the
house for a visit. He promised to stop
by next time. I hope so.

The weather has been peculiar here which
seem to be the case every year. First
the winter was tough on wheat and
we lost 340 out of 370 over. Next, in the
spring it was too wet to plant crops
for six weeks. Now it has turned off
too dry. We will need some good rain
in the next six weeks to make a crop
of soybeans and corn.

This is an exciting time for us. I
have bought another farm and with some
hired help will operate this one myself.
Yesterday I bought a tractor, a disk and
a mower. My wife says I am crazy -
but I need the exercise and the whole
process is fun for me. I need to stay

Mr. Upchurch died Wednesday.

He was a prominent landowner and rancher in Grimes County. He served in the South Pacific during World War II.

He returned to Bedias and worked for First State Bank. He retired in 1989 as president after 43 years with the bank. He remained chairman of the board until his death.

He was a lifelong member of First United Methodist Church of Bedias.

Survivors include his wife, Mary Kathryn Dyer Upchurch of Bedias; two daughters and one son-in-law, Candi and John Barousse of Galveston and Kathryn Upchurch of Richardson; two grandchildren; and two cousins.

For about the last two weeks all my spare time has been devoted to getting records on the Harmon U) James U, II Sabolan in order. These records will appear in the next U B. In the meantime other correspondence has piled up including your letter which arrived on 11 SEP 93. Thank you for the check. I am using it to mark you paid for the 1994 issue. I had not realized you had dropped off the 1993 list. In any case Issue 2+3 of the 1993 set have been sent to you (Mailed 12 SEP 93) and the #4 issue to be mailed in November will be sent to you - all out of appreciation for your help with the family history records and especially for supplying the photos of your grandpa which appeared in U B Vol 14 No 3 (July 1993)

I know you must be glad to see the fall come, it is such a nice time of the year. Gallaine and I took a stroll around our village this morning after breakfast. Our village is one of the few place in Tucson that has grass. It is very nice.

On our trip to Missouri in late August we contracted for a lot in the town of Lake Saint Louis and for a house to be built on it. We have to go back in November to appraise the lot after the area has been graded and the streets put in. The house plans are being drawn and are to be sent to us for review by the end of September.
