I was able to access the PDF files but to be honest, the way in which genealogy is written and recorded has always thoroughly confused me! I briefly looked over the information but put my search "on hold" after quickly becoming confused and overwhelmed!

My maiden name is Upchurch and "Kidd" is my married name. I have a list of Upchurchs I believe to be my lineage but I have not been able to find definitive proof linking each generation to the other. Perhaps you could look over the information I have and might know off the top of your head if my information is correct or not. I know absolutely nothing about the Upchurch side of my family. My parents moved to Europe and became ex-patriots before I was even born. I didn't move to the States until I was 19 years old! I had no contact with either of my parents families and as crazy as it might sound, my father was a fabulous parent but he was also a very private person. Thank you so much for getting back with me so quickly! I've been anxiously awaiting your reply! I want to thank you from the bottom of my heart for all the work that you have put into researching, documenting and recording the Upchurch family history! What you've done is truly remarkable!

Now to answer the questions you have: My dad (Mack Damon Upchurch) was born in Caruthersville, Missouri. My dad had 3 brothers and 2 sisters. Their

birth order is as follows: Miller Junior Upchurch: "Junior", as he was known, was the son of West Miller (You were right about that! I was wrong!) and West Miller's first wife Laura Porter. Laura Porter died at the age of 29 in a car accident when Jr. was very young.

My grandfather (West Miller) then married Mary Grace Smith (said to have been Laura's sister but I can't find proof). West Miller and Mary Grace then had: Martha, Wilford, Billy, my dad (Mack Damon Upchurch) and Betty From what I know, I think my grandpa was born in Ridgely, Lake Co., TN, later settling in various parts of Mo. I don't know for sure but I THINK they might have moved around the area a lot because my grandfather was a share cropper. They would lived mostly around Caruthersville, Cape Giradeau and

West Miller's had a brother named Bonney (I questigned a man being named Bonney and have been reassured that, indeed, his name was Bonney) and two sisters named Alma (nicknamed Tommie) and Mary. I don't know if there are any other siblings.

Apologies for not answering your email in it's entirety! I was so anxious to get the information about Rueben/Solomon to you! WOW! You were in Arizona for quite a while! Did you ever travel up to the Phoenix area between 90 -95 to see the explosive growth that took place?

As I mentioned before, I was born and raised in Germany. In 89, when the Berlin Wall came down the atmosphere changed towards foreigners. Both East and West Germany were focused on reunification and the country, as a whole, felt foreigners were occupying jobs that should be made available to the East Germans re-enterir their society. My parents felt that it would be best if they made the move back to the United States and so we did. I was a foreigner in Germany and I was a foreigner in the United States.

Although I was American by birth, moving to the United States was just as traumatic for me as it might be for any other foreigner setting out to begin a new life.
