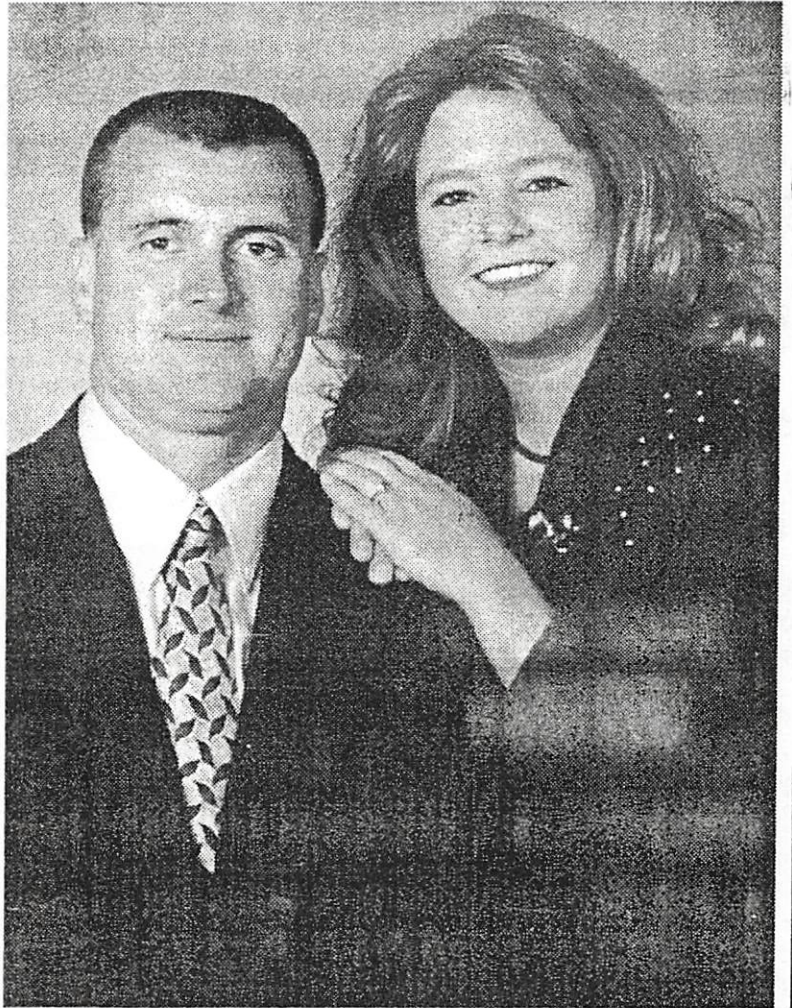

It's too bad every North Carolina county doesn't have its T. H. Pearce. The Franklin County native who say he's such an addicted southerner he gets the bends if he goes north of Washington, D. C., is also a self-confessed history buff who has consistently trained his sights on his home area. As a result the record is a lot clearer, certainly more complete.

Although he is a full-time health department sanitarian, Pearce finds time in his off-hours to research and write not only about the history of the area in which he finds himself but also the humor of its residents. He only mentions in passing that he also does free-lance photography, flies his own Cessna Skyhawk, often transporting flowers for his wife's flower shop, writes a stamp-collecting column, co-hosts an early morning radio talk show and a Saturday bluegrass segment on the same local station, and markets his own books.

He's been just a little busier than usual lately because he has just published a new title. It's "Early Architecture of Franklin County" (T. H. Pearce, P.O. Box 395, Franklinton, N.C. 27525. 149 pp. \$12.50; \$13.50 by mail).

The book is the result of an Archives and History survey Pearce helped conduct over two years ago, and it's a photographic sampling of a rich architectural heritage of value beyond the physical boundaries of the county itself.

The survey was instigated by Archives and History's survey supervisor Mrs. Catherine Bishir after she saw a slide show prepared by the county historical society, and Pearce was asked to help out.

When the job was completed Pearce, impressed with how much had been unearthed and its value to the general public, decided it was too bad the material would be merely deposited in Raleigh where few non-historians would ever see it. The book was the result.

He'd already taught himself all he needed to know about publishing to get his material in print and distributed in the process of turning out the story of the Franklin County men who fought in the Confederacy. "They Fought," and a collection of tall tales about his homefolks, "How To Sell a Dead Mule."

And he won't let anybody tell him you can't make money by publishing your own book as long as it has regional interest. The first one's out of print and secondhand copies were selling for \$16 apiece the last time he saw one in a used book store. And he only has a couple dozen copies left out of the thousand he printed

of the humor book.

He printed 1,000 copies of the new one without even looking back, and it's already taken off. Besides the natural it is for libraries and private collectors there are a whole passel of Franklin Countians and people with roots in the region to make up a ready market.

Even a reader with no interest in Franklin County outside its presence in her adopted state found the attractive book a spellbinder.

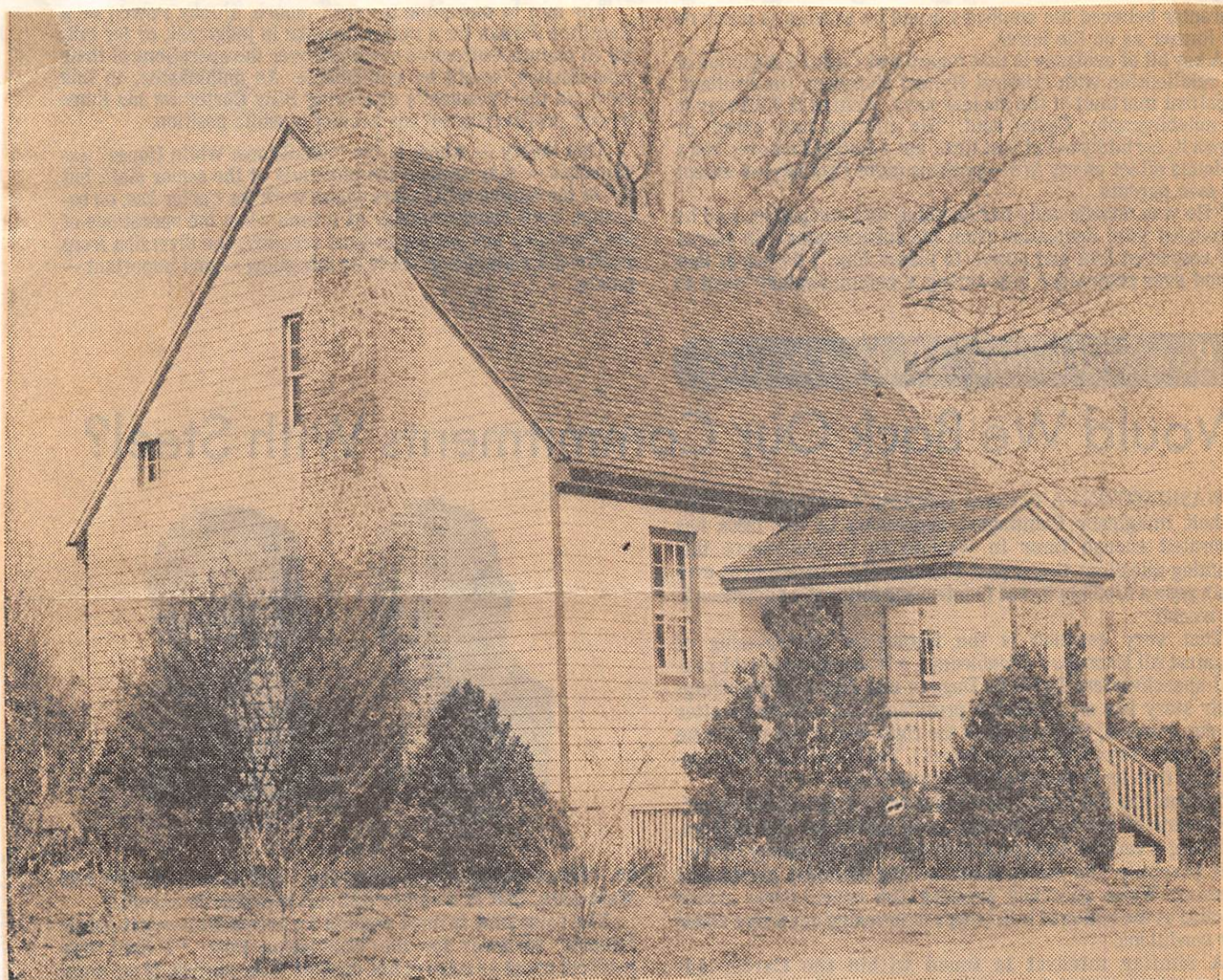
Because it traces the southern rural architectural heritage back to the first log houses through the subsequent Georgian period homes into the Federal era structures and through the Greek Revival-Italianate era, it is a revelation for all who ever idly admired the old houses by the roadside on the most casual drive through the South.

Pearce not only photographed and described around 100 of the 300 buildings turned up by the survey and adjudged of significant architectural significance, he spotlighted details and explained the changes in the way people built the places they lived in. No one taking more than a casual look through his volume will ever view his surroundings with quite the same attitude again.

His is no polished history, but he declares from the first that that is not his goal. If he only shows that there's a lot in Franklin County worth saving before it's irretrievably gone he'll be happy.

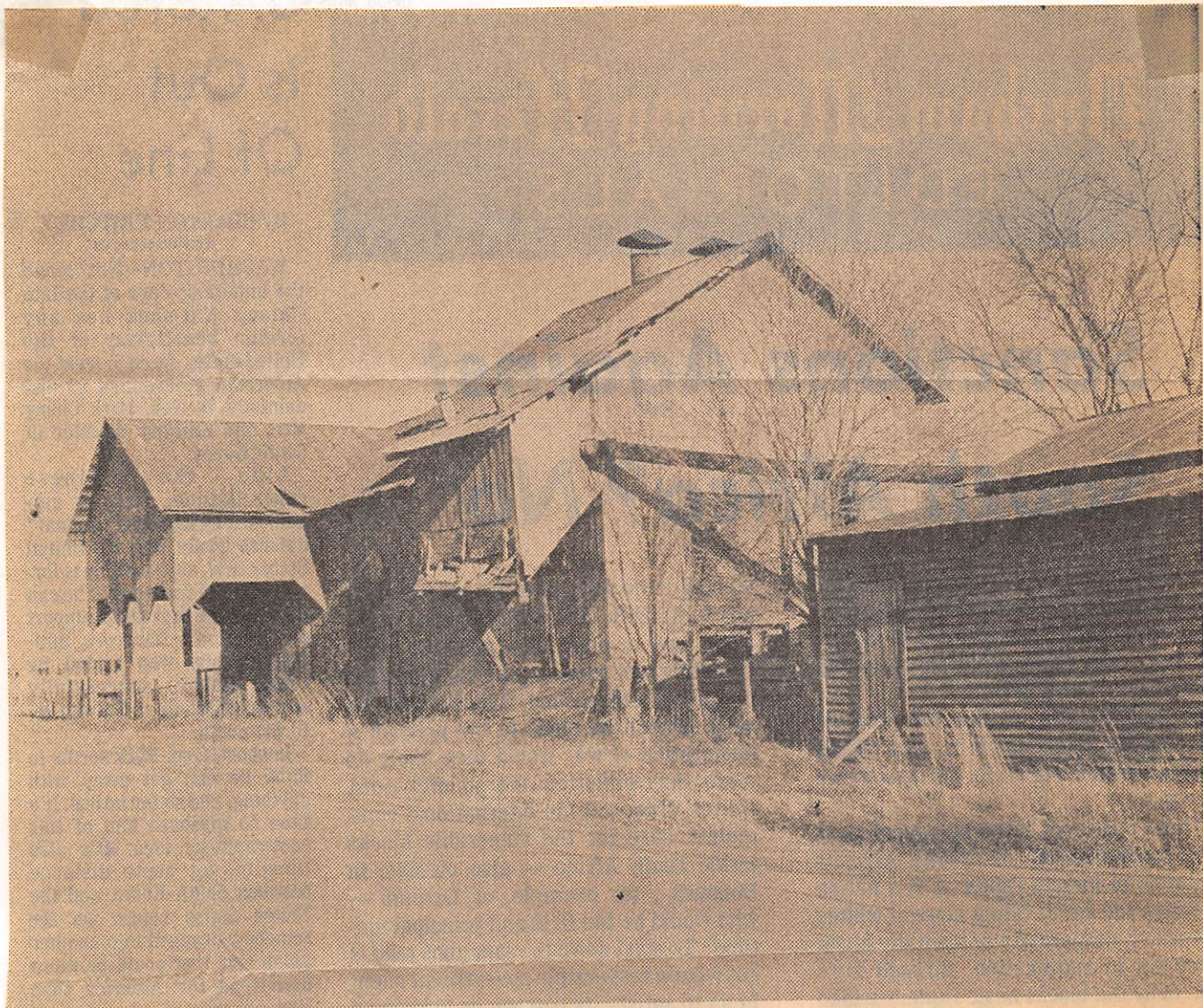
Meanwhile he's pushing forward with a straightforward history of Franklin County with the goal of publication by the county's 1979 bicentennial. And any time he has leftover he says he'll spend compiling that sequel to the tall tales book people keep asking him about.

"I don't do anything I don't want to do," he says with revealing seriousness.

He is a charter member with the department and has 32 years of service.

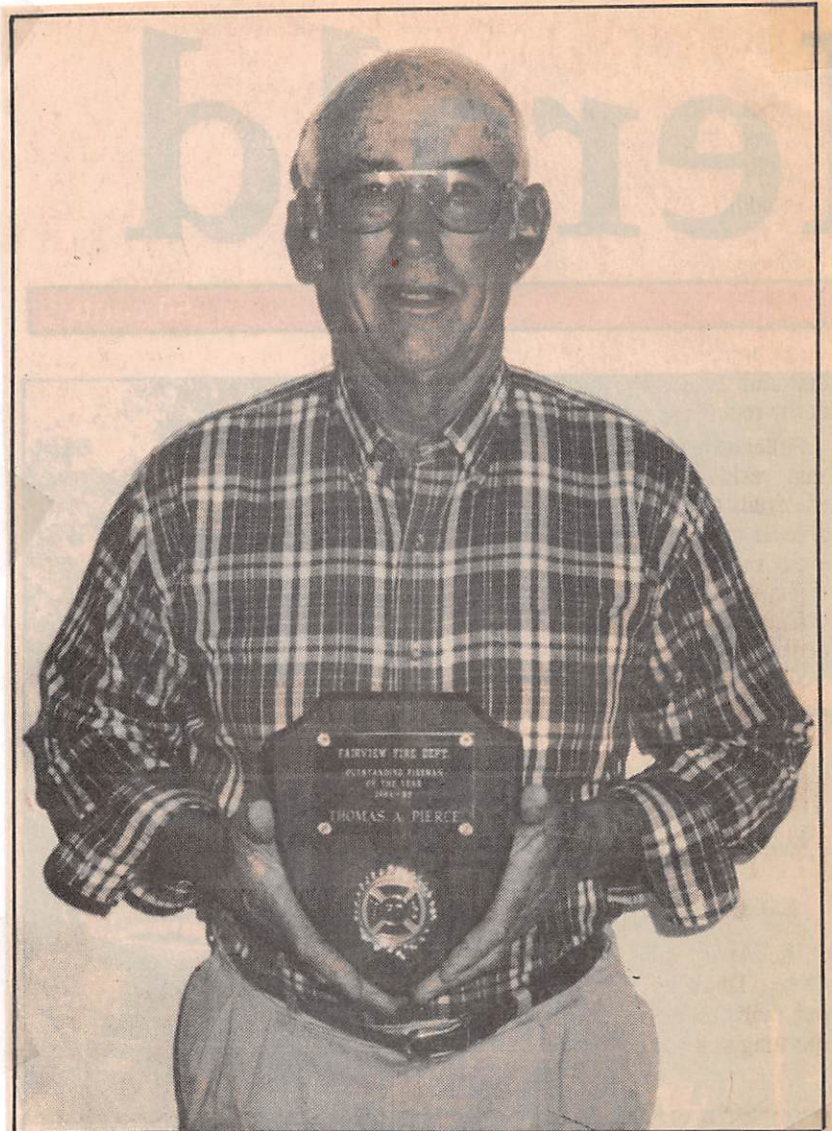
His wife, Ellen, said she's proud of her husband's years of service. "He knows when they need him and when they need him, he's there," she said.

How the Fairview Rural Fire Department Began

△ The Fairview Rural Fire Department, Inc. originated in the summer of 1962 from an idea proposed by Gene W. Ogburn. Gene sold fire equipment at the time, and he recognized the need for the community to be prepared to handle fire emergencies.

□ △ Gene talked over his idea with Thomas Allen Pierce, who was the president of the Fairview Community Club. Allen invited Gene and his family to come to a picnic hosted by the Club and asked Gene to present his idea at the business meeting after the picnic. Gene explained how valuable it would be to have a tanker truck ready to put out local fires--brush or tobacco barn fires, for example. Sally Beard thought that was an excellent idea, so she made a motion for the Club to give \$100 toward the purchase of a tanker truck. She stated she would match the Club's contribution with a personal donation of \$100, if the Club members would vote in favor of the motion. The motion was approved, and that was the beginning of the Fairview Rural Fire Department.

△ □ Word went out to the community that a fire department was going to be organized. Several men came to the first meeting, and a lot of interest was shown. Gene explained that the first order of business would be to organize a formal fire fighting team and then purchase a tanker truck to haul water. Twenty-two men formed the original Fairview Rural Fire Department, and Gene became the first Fire Chief. △ □ Furman West and Gene located an Army surplus tanker truck and brought it back to Fairview. After many hours of work, the volunteers had an operational pump with water tank and hose. Filled with water from local ponds, the tanker functioned as the Department's first fire truck.

In the best way he could, Gene trained the men to run a fire department. He did a lot of research, gathered information from his work-related travel, and visited well-known fire departments. All of this knowledge he brought back to the other firemen. Many fire drills were held in the beginning, and they occurred any time, day or night. Gene saw that the fire department had a good set of by-laws, and he oversaw the department's incorporation in 1963. Soon after the fire department was organized, it received permission from the Fairview Community Board of Trustees to build a fire station on the community property. Many fund raising barbecues were held to reach this goal. The original fire station was built almost exclusively by its firemen.

The Fairview Rural Fire Department began modestly with \$200 and twenty-two dedicated charter members, but over the years the Department has expanded in many ways, to reflect the needs of a growing community. From its beginning, though, its foundation has been the generosity and commitment of many community citizens.

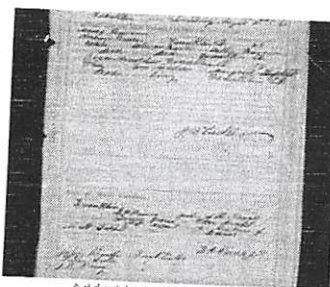

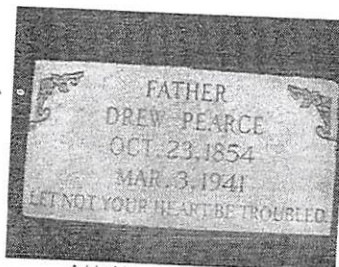

Civic leader, journalist Sybil E. Pierce

Sybil Ellinwood Pierce, longtime civic leader in Tucson, died Thursday night. She was 56.

She had suffered from cancer.

Pierce was born June 25, 1923, in Prescott and came to Tucson the next year. She attended Tucson public schools and the University of Arizona.

She had worked as a feature writer for The Arizona Daily Star and was assistant editor of the Journal of Arizona History and editor of the Arizona Historical Society's newsletter.

Her first husband, Tom Ellinwood, was the Star's executive editor for several years in the 1950s, later becoming a political cartoonist. Ellinwood's father, Ralph, was executive editor of the Star from 1924 until 1930. The Ellinwood family owned 49 percent of the Star from 1924 until 1965.

Pierce was a member of the Citizens Advisory Planning Committee from 1975 to 1977, a member of Los Padrinos de la Casa, a charter member of the Tucson Festival Society and one of the founders of Arizona Friends of Music.

She also was member of the board of the Tucson Symphony Society and a former member of St. Philip's in the Hills Episcopal Church, the League of Women Voters and Junior League of Tucson.

Survivors include her husband, Thorne D. Pierce; her mother, Lucille Budd Juliana of Tucson; two sons, Ralph Everett Ellinwood of Deming, N.M., and John Cole Ellinwood II of Tucson; a sister, Nancy Juliana Silverman of San Mateo, Calif.; a brother, Gerald Budd Juliana of Quito, Ecuador; and three grandchildren.

as an ambulance driver. Both women feel a strong sense of community spirit and a driving desire to provide help to those in need.

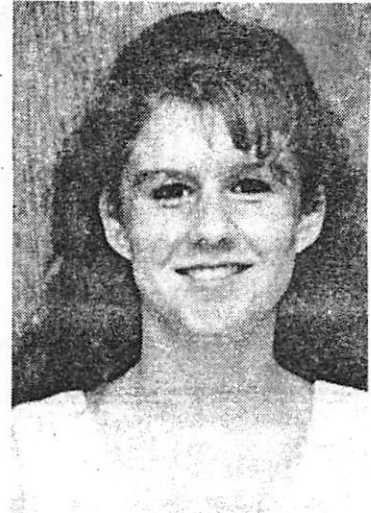
Ms. Knowles feels you are serving a worthwhile purpose when you provide immediate care to sick people and give them the best medical treatment possible until they make it to the hospital.

As you will see from the enclosed details on the Uplunds Bulletin I am a senior student of the Uplunds heritage. David Lee Pearce of Raleigh, NC, who traces his line back to the Johnston Co, NC Pearce, gave me your address. He thinks your line traces back to the Franklin Co, NC Pearce which is quite a different set than the Johnston Co, NC set.
