Thank you so much for your card which arrived 16 JUN 1993. I am most pleased at the prospect of us picking up in our exchange again. I have continued to publish the U B on which details are enclosed.

We have continued to make progress on the Sherwood Upchurch clan to which you belong. However, there are some errors in published work on this family and we still need to resolve this matter. One of these problems concern your ancestor John U (XID-8313), who is the father of John Sandrum U. Published records show that John U XID-8313 was the son of Sherwood U. However, our strong belief is that John U XID-8313 was a grandson of Sherwood U. Further we think John U XID 8313 was the son of Elias U but we need more proof of this. I have spent a fair amount of time on this issue without

resolution. Perhaps you will have some insights that will be useful. Once this piece falls into place other aspects of the Sherwood II clan will probably be resolved also. I'll be glad to send more details on where we stand on these issues if you are interested.

From our previous correspondence I have a good record on the family of Robert Arthur Upchurch. I assume your parents are still living. Can you confirm that your brother, Michael Dennis, has just two children and that you have just two (both adopted)?

I enjoy working with family members on our Upchurch heritage and look forward to hearing from you again soon.

Dear Cousin Angela,

Thank you for your nice letter of August 24, 1982. I continue to work on all the sections of the upland family moving from one to the other. There is so much to do. I appreciate your willingness to help.

On the Wade family I have some suggestions. Since your mother was born in Ft Worth, TX in 1929 there is a fair chance your GF or GGF was in the county where Ft Worth is located at the time the 1900 census was taken. (The 1900 census is the most recent one available to us. The federal people keep them under lock for 75 years). Go to your nearest public library and order the Federal Census for 1900 for the County Ft Worth is in. This will cost \$32<sup>14</sup>. You will have to use their microfilm reader to study the film. Just go through it looking for Wades. Another option is to go to the ~~or~~ office in ~~the~~ Ft Worth where wills are recorded (County Recorder office) and check under the wader. Also you can

check deeds that are record in case any  
of your Wunder bought or sold land. It  
will be a little confusing at first but  
you soon learn your way around. Another  
approach is to go to the nearest  
Mormon (Latter Day Saint) library. They have  
people who will help you get started.  
They can also order the census records.

There are two ways you can help. One  
would be to call any Upchurch lists in  
the phone book and get their lines (father,  
grandfather, etc., their children, brothers & sisters,  
aunts and uncles, etc.) and send this to me.  
Addresses including ZTP codes are always very  
useful to me.

Another way is to get information on  
your close Upchurch relatives. Here are

to locate:

In the meantime please keep sending me any additional details you can get.

As soon as I can get to aerox or else I will make copies from the Morgan Book on the

Sherwood Uplands <sup>2</sup> Clan to send to you.

I really appreciate the effort you are spending on your line and the interest you show. Looking into family history is very interesting and satisfying.

From the Uplands Bulletin you should be able to construct your entire family history in due course. I enter bits and pieces about each clan on each issue and certain issues contain special sections on certain clans. It is likely that an outline on the Sherwood U. clan will appear in Vol 3 Issue 3 which will be mailed in September.

You asked about the XID numbers. These numbers are assigned so that each individual will have a distinctive identifying number. XID really means "identity number". ~~The~~ The 2nd & 3rd letters (ID) come from the word identity and I just put an X in front to have a distinctive code word. In each issue of the Bulletin there are 600 new XID numbers with name and a definition of the relationship to an earlier family member. By the end of 1982 I will have published 7200 names in the Uplands family and identified their place on the family. Your XID is 8380 and you are daughter of 8358 who is the ~~son~~ son of 8345 who is the son of 8333 who is the son of 8313 who is the son of 166 and 3772. I would think you should want to order the Uplands Bulletin when it is convened. I suggest starting with Vol 1 (1980) which is \$10.00.


