

Many thanks for your letter of 14 DEC 1995 and for the copy of the Mekauikawa, HI Church Book with Upoluhi information. Your input is the fourth I have had on this family but we have still not "linked" them to the main body of Upoluhi. such input gets us a little closer. Four reference pages are enclosed.

Input #1 was from my 13-21 JUL 85 visit to Hawaii. See Item ① on enclosed profile for William H. I referred this in U B Vol 6 No 3 JUL 85.

Input #2 was from Cousin Ray White, Jr shown as Item ② on the William H profile. This led me to conclude the "Hawaiian H" name I coined should be replaced with William H (pb 1840-1860) as the father of former K. H. b 1878.

Input #3 was from Charles B. Bailey Jr through Cousin Robert Penny H. I assume their two headstones are the same you saw.

Input #4 was from you which I have

summarized on a single sheet, copy enclosed.

I visited the Big Island of Hawaii in 1985
and at that time did not know of Mekuaikaua
Church. It would be great to go back for
a visit to the church. The book is great
and I am happy to have it for my files.
Over time I hope we can learn more
about this interesting Upchurch group

Thanks for the update on your part of the
Upchurch family. Your and Pat Fairweather have
been my main source of information for
the Nathan Buxford Upchurch Family. It is not



Our relationship is as follows:



Your father and I are 5th cousins, you and my son are 6th cousins while you and I are 5th cousins once removed.

The information on XID-40144-2 came to me 2nd hand. I understand it came from the 1860 Census for Fentress Co., TN.

The Morgan Book was the following: George Washington U b ~~1827-14~~ and ~~17 Sept 18~~ ca 1829 (KY) and Sarah J — b ca 1837 TN. George was with the John William family in 1850 when the census was taken in Fentress Co., TN. John William seems to be a brother of Keeler, William. His wife Lydia and More, father of George, were brother & sister. In 1860 George is head of his own house on the Fentress Co Census. In 1859 George began disposing of his property, getting ready to go elsewhere. He sold soon after this to Jeremiah Smith which included the lot where George W. Upchurch now lives. A deed made in JAN 1860 seems to be the last deed. He migrated with his family to parts unknown.

Perhaps with the above information and what you have we can piece the story together. The Fentress Co Census records should be examined. I suspect that Nathan Buford it will not be found on the 1860 records (otherwise he would have been reported with his 2 sisters). Do you have any idea or to where Nathan Buford it lived at different times in his life and as to when he came to CA?

I am excited about the prospects of filling in your line more completely and have questions:


