

DAY OF SAD INCIDENTS AT SOLDIERS' HOME

Yesterday was a day full of incidents of the saddest kind at the Soldiers' Home. Captain Brooks, the perintendent, went to Wake Forest to attend the funeral of Mr. Alexander Dunn. Captain Brooks left his wife in charge. Saturday night Greenberry Upchurch, a veteran from Ashe county, died at the home and his body was in the chapel. At dinner, in the hospital, J. J. Bryan, from Halifax county, as soon as he had finished eating dinner, lifted his feet upon his bed and died without a struggle. He had been in the home three years, and had been in the hospital practically all the time, having been paralyzed. Last year he fell and broke his hip.
