I think it goes this way - when Charlie was murdered in Seymour his widow Mary Ann soon sold her store & other belongings in Seymour and your father moved her home & barn to Knox Co, TX where she had purchased 100 acres of land near where.

your father lived. It happens that Mary Ann  
was still alive at this time and she was  
already living in Knox Co, TX (with your  
parents?) and she died there in 1979. Please  
correct me if this is wrong or amplify  
as you see fit.

Could you draw me a rough map  
of Knox Co, TX - Seymour, Red Springs etc  
showing key points of interest for your  
family history - including the few Hensons  
cemetery & any other features that are  
relevant. I'll add this to my map file.

The "saga" of your GF murder is certainly

Daddy told to her - she would also come down to the store and ask Grandpa for advice. he wrapped from it was none of his business by he wrapped her every morning before breakfast

that it was none<sup>-4-</sup> of his affair - Grandpa said  
he was only trying to keep them together, less  
than a week after this Grandpa was killed.  
Maybe he was lying to Daddy - maybe he was  
infatuated with her, too, I don't know. I knew  
Daddy was lied to by him about his own Mother  
and never knew any difference and died  
without knowing. I have found out alot  
since I started this genealogy that the family  
never knew. I'll tell you that story sometime  
if you want to know. The day he got killed  
I believe it was April 14, 1917 - He and Aunt  
Ruth, his eldest daughter by Mary E., were in  
Seymour and Grandpa was at a garage getting  
something done to the car and Ruth and Beulah  
came to the garage, there was a lawyer in the  
garage also, and Beulah asked him if he thought  
it would be safe for her to stay in Seymour  
since Gilley was in town, and he told her  
no and Aunt Ruth asked her to go home with  
them and they would take her to Jim's. None  
of them knew that Mr. Breland was also in  
town and he had asked Gilley to go home with  
him. Inway Gilley told Mr. Breland that he was  
going to walk over to Jim's, I think this was the  
next morning, and Grandpa was piling up  
Jim and Beulah and Gilley walked up and told  
Grandpa he was going to shoot him, which he did,  
Jim then shot Gilley in the leg and Gilley shot  
and killed him. Beulah I think also got a flesh  
wound in the calf of a leg. It was really

- a culmination of a situation that had been brewing  
for several months. Another brother of Beulah's,  
Greg had sometime before shot at Gilley  
and the bullet hit a pocket watch that he  
was carrying and he wasn't hurt. If you  
want to know what happened - tune in  
next week - ~~he~~ I knew that this was going  
to be rambling. Beulah got pregnant by  
Matthew before the divorce - anyway she  
and Matthew got married - the baby was  
born dead and she died in giving birth.  
Gilley was found not guilty - he left Seymour  
and later married again - History repeated  
itself with that wife and he killed her and  
then killed himself. I would like to finish  
this story by telling you what a man my  
Daddy was [this Henson Cemetery at Red Springs  
where our family is buried - the land was  
given by a John Henson, another unrelated tidbit]  
my oldest brother was a yr. old and Mama  
was pregnant again and a Mr. Jim Parker  
knew Daddy would come gunning for Gilley -  
as soon as he heard and he waited on the  
road that Daddy would be coming in on  
and he talked to Daddy and he listened to  
him. As soon as Grandma <sup>[MED]</sup> could sell  
the store and settle Grandpa's <sup>[CIT+P]</sup> affairs she bought <sup>[MED]</sup>  
a 100 acres of land next to our home place,  
in Knox Co, and Daddy moved her house  
and barn out there and got her settled.

This is where Mary Upchurch Mendenhall died.  
He looked after she and the children until they  
grew up.

About the Crow in my daddy's name  
I don't think it's related to Indian - but I did  
hear a derogatory remark made toward my  
Grandmother Bettie by one of Daddy's half-  
sisters and she called her an Indian. But  
Daddy never mentioned this - Her parents  
were Hiram Weirman and Hannah  
Provence. Hiram was born in Tenn. and  
she in Virginia. He was a miller - I found  
their graves and the ruins of his old  
mill. It was in operation during the Civil  
war. My children are part Cherokee - I tease  
them about being the only one in our family  
that isn't Indian - maybe I am and don't  
know it.

My name is Mae.

There are so many questions that  
you asked that I don't have the answers -  
some of them I can find - I will try to  
answer as many as I can. I will mark them  
off in your letter as I answer them.

I am going to start with Charles Huntley  
Farham - I have looked for a marriage license  
for both his marriages - also for his divorce  
from my grandmother. I spent hrs. in the  
Courthouse in Lee County looking for this  
and I plan on going back this year, if the  
Lord be willing. I found alot about the  
Weirman - Hiram recorded everything

△ Betty was born in Lee County. I have really wondered,  
△ I have not talked this with my siblings, if he  
- divorced her. I didn't say I believed it - I just  
- WONDER - The circumstances but that would take  
△ me on another story - I know Daddy was 4 yrs.  
△ old when his parents separated - He was born  
△ March 17, 1986 - and Charlie and Mary's oldest child  
△ was born in Apr. 15, 1891. He had three by  
△ Betty and seven by Mary. When I go back, if  
- I get to, I'm going to go to Scott County and do  
□ some searching. Since John Upchurch moved  
- to Scott Co. and this County joins Lee I be-  
- lieve it's possible that the records are there.  
- I have tried to find out what the W. stands  
- for in Mary Ann U. name and haven't. The  
△ A. in Samuel Parkham's name is not an A  
- it is a H. that stands for Huckaby -  
△ Daddy told me that. I don't think I have his  
△ Birthdate. He was buried in Granville County -  
△ He died in Richmond in a Hospital from  
△ pneumonia and they brought him home to  
- bury him. That was the only recollection  
△ that Charlie had of his father, a big black  
△ boy being taken off the train and his mother  
△ telling him - his daddy was in it. Mary Ann  
- U. only had the one child. None of the family  
△ ever knew anything about Tom Walker. They  
△ didn't know she was married between Samuel P.  
△ and William M. After Grandpa Charlie was  
△ killed she told Emma Lee, one of daddy's half  
△ sisters and Mama and Granny (Mary E.) heard her

- Δ but she didn't tell his name. This was after  
 Δ+□ Grandpa Mendenhall died. He must have been  
 - quite a character, little stories I've heard.  
 Δ+□ I ~~found~~ found Grandma and Tom Walkers  
 - marriage bond in Granville County. What  
 - I think probably happened was when

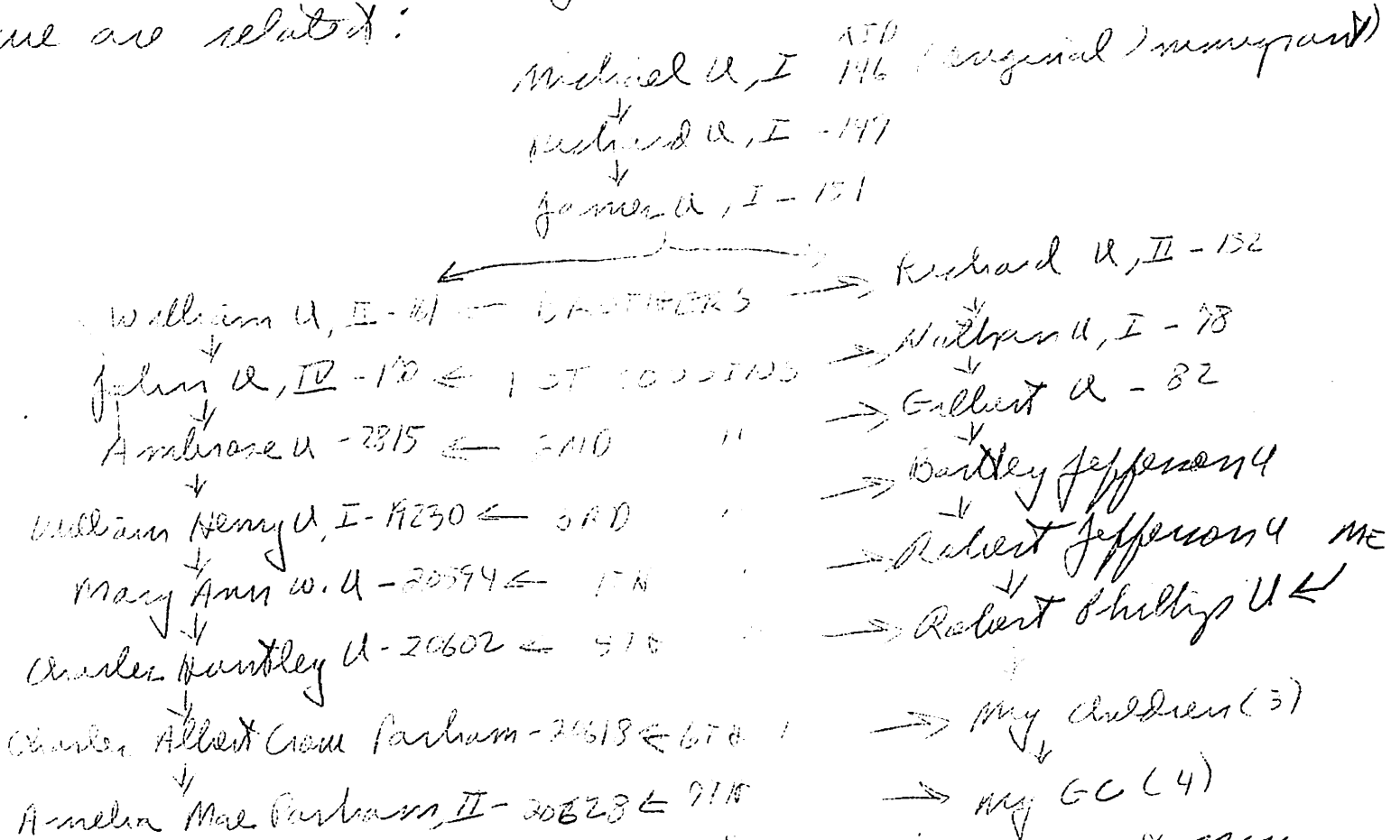

They (the two boys) were of the right age to have fought in the Civil War and could easily have been killed there although your family lore seems to indicate that they died even earlier. We will need to be alert for more details on them.

I am waiting on some info from a cousin in San Antonio for dates of her family. She is the daughter of Charles Parham's oldest child, Amelia. I also have to go to the Courthouse in Baylor Co. for death dates of his younger children. I attended their funerals but did not record dates.

I have quite alot of information gathered for you, when I get it all, I will have Mary Ann Upchurch Parham to the present.

I was thrilled to find her fathers name recorded with her death record

in the Knox County Courthouse. I think we have established enough proof that there is no doubt of who she was. In review of what we have: The old Upchurch Bible, youngest child William H. (Incidentally my brother is copying that sheet hopefully it will be readable and I will be sending it to you) The marriage bond of Henry and Mary Parrish. The 1850 Census of William with Elizabeth in his household, The marriage bond of Mary Ann and Samuel Parham, her death record with Henry Upchurch as her father. I believe her line is established without question maybe not enough to stand in Court but there is not a doubt in my mind.

There is one surviving child of Charles Parham, Mary Ann's only child, she remembers her Grandmother. She told me that she was a small woman

with red hair. My father must have carried this gene because he had a red-haired grandson and a grandson with red hair. They are the only two in this household of people and I thought it was interesting.

I enjoy your letters hopefully I will have all this other to you by the end of next week.

I plan on attending an all day seminar Sat. of a Dr. Schweitzer, his first subject is Virginia Research. I am looking forward to this maybe I will find out some way to find my grandparents marriage and divorce. I have found my grandmother Betty in her parents home, Hiram C. and Hannah Weisman, in 1880 Lee County Census. I have been unable to find their marriage-

neither one of Grandpas marriages, in Lee or Scott County. I found her quite by accident, they, the parents, had a ten year old granddaughter in their household and it was because of her that ~~st~~ they were on the Census. Seems Social Security did some of this for proof of age in the 1940's. That was what the people at the Dallas Public Lib. told me. I was not going to look at this microfilm and this lady told me, "it will not take you but a few minutes and there might be a child ten or under in the household". I am much to old to assume anything - I learned better than that many years ago but sometimes I forget.

Dear Cousin Amelia,  
Our recent exchange of phone calls and your letter of 4 OCT 1937 have been a great delight to me and I hope we can continue to help each other document Upchurch's history. I have spent most of the last two week ends processing your letter and upgrading my Upchurch & related files for Granville Co. NC. There are some parts of the Granville Co records that fall into line beautifully and other parts that we do not yet fully understand. The bible record you provided represents a significant find.

Let me set aside for the moment the first listing in the bible - Martha Alice U b 4 OCT 1858 and turn attention to the other four listings. They are (with my additions):

1. Priscilla M(W) U b 2 APR 1819 d 1913 md 14 FEB 1855 (Granville Co, NC) Turner Laurens b 1815 d 1881 (I have some details on their children)
2. John Jordan U b 26 MAR 1820 d 19 JAN 1887 (Steelville, MO) md 4 JUN 1841 (Kale Jr, NC) Angelina Green. (I have a fair record on their children)
3. Mary Ann Elizabeth U b 13 APR 1822 md Ralph Parrish.
4. William H (A) U b 29 OCT 1824.

From a receipt of your bible records I had always thought that the 4th child was Ambrose A. U. who was 1811-340 (1841) Harriet Bond (The conclusion was incorrectly drawn by other researchers in the 1960's & 1970's). From your bible records I now know that the fourth child was William H. (A) U. b. 29 OCT 1824. These four children are offspring of Ambrose U. b. ca 1792 and Elizabeth (Hall) U. Ambrose U. was the son of John U. II (XFD-170), gr of William U. II (XFD-161), ggr of James U. I. (XFD-151), ggg of Richard U. I. (XFD-149) and gggg of Michael U. I. (XFD-146), the original U immigrant to come from England in 1649. Among the four children is John Jordan U. (XFD-4806), the most famous of all. I will ship that part for now as you will read all about him in the various issues of the U B as you acquire them.

Our records are clear in showing that Ambrose U. (XFD-2815, b. ca 1792) had only 4 children. Ambrose was murdered in 1824. In 1830 we find our four children in the home of their CF John U. II (XFD-170) and the known ages of the children properly match the age brackets shown on the census. This still leaves us with the mystery of the identity of Martha Alice U. shown in the bible. I agree with you that we should consider that the birth date of Martha may have been hard to read and that her birth date could have been other than 1853. However we should keep an open mind on 1858 or 1828, 1838, etc. We need to find her on the 1850, 1860 or 1870 census.

The 1800 Census in NC census is critical for us. Let me list the only two Yorkville households found on that census and tell what we know and provide some speculation

William U Household [WILLIAM U II, XFD-161]

1. Male < 10 = 1
2. Male 16-26 = 1 → WILLIAM U II, XFD-162
3. Male 45+ = 1 → WILLIAM U III, XFD-161
4. Female < 10 = 1
5. Female 10-16 = 1
6. Female 16-26 = 1
7. Female 26-45 = 1
8. Female 45+ = 1 → WIFE OF XFD-161

John U Household [JOHN U, IV, XFD-170] [SON OF XFD-161]

9. Male < 10 = 1 → MARY ANN U, XFD-7315
10. Male 16-26 = 1
11. Male 26-45 = 1 → JOHN U, IV, XFD-170
12. Female 26-45 = 1 → MARY ANN HARRIS, XFD-999, wife of XFD-170

I have filled in details on 7 of the 12 people on the list and we need to spread D on the other 6.

[First, let me add more uncertainty - There is a WOOD U (WILLIAM U?) on the 1800 census in Wake Co, NC. Certain records show that a William U did obtain land in Wake Co, NC right after 1800 and we have some reason to believe that he came from Granville Co. Still he should not be on the 1800 census list in both counties - but such has been known to happen.]

As regards Person 10 I think that has to be a person we will call John U II, son of XFD-170. There was a John U, Jr in the Granville Co, NC records

about these times. I don't think we have records  
of a family for John U. V. Need to study that  
some more.

In the 1800 household of William U. XID-161  
we find children too young to have been the  
offspring of XID-161 and his elderly wife who  
apparently is still in the household [unless you  
want to speculate that the older female in the home  
is the mother of XID-161 and that Person #6 or #7  
represents a younger 2nd wife of XID-161?]. Let us  
assume that a more likely circumstance is that  
William U. III has died and is living in his father  
home which could account for Person #6 as being  
the wife of William U. III. Continuing this  
speculation Person #1 and #4 would be young  
children of William U. III. Person #7 would be  
an older dau of William U. II who has remained  
in the home. Person #5 does not fit well being  
perhaps too old to be a dau of William U. III. or  
balance Person #5 would fit best as a dau of  
William U. II. If there are illegitimate children in  
the home as if a dau of William U. II has  
had a husband and returned to the home,  
other explanations can be considered.

I think it is a good bet that Person  
No 1 is Henry U who was in Granville Co, NC  
in 1840.

The Elizabeth U who was William Johnson in  
Granville Co, NC is the right age to have been

Person # 4. However, the age for Elizabeth & William and the Archibald U in their home on the 1850 census in Granville Co, NC forces an additional speculation. A fair guess is that Archibald U be ca 1831 was the son of Elizabeth (Upchurch) Johnson be ca 1800. If that is so William Johnson was presumably not the father of Archibald as Elizabeth & William did not marry until 1838. The option is that Elizabeth U was Person # 4 and had Archibald out of wedlock and gave him an U name or that Elizabeth was not an Upchurch but rather married one who then died leaving her with a young son.

As regards the 9 person home where your Mary Ann U age 9 was located in 1850 I have several comments. William U, the head of the household, is the right age to have been the William in your bible and the 4th Child of Ambrose U and I have so shown him on my records. A reinforcing fact is that Elizabeth U in her home in 1850 is the right age to have been her unborn mother Elizabeth (Hill) Upchurch. The big questions are what is the relationship between William U age 26 and Mary U age 35 and are either of those two individuals the parents of the 4 children in the home? I cannot answer that yet but hope that you and/or I and/or others can resolve this issue. I have one observation and you

will no doubt know others. Please note the enclosed sheet on the 1880 census of VA. Note that one Scott Co name is headed by Christopher C. U. I am in correspondence with a descendant of this individual who informs me that Christopher C. U. was the son of Henry U. A next question is what is the relationship between Christopher C. U. and the John C. U. who also heads an 1880 household in Scott Co, VA. were they brothers? My records indicate that this John C. U. was the same John U. who was age 2 on the census and in the household with your Mary Ann U. age 9. Christopher U. was b. ca 1851 and hence would not have appeared on the 1850 census. If Christopher & John C. were brothers then could mean that William U. 26 & Mary U. 35 were indeed Mr & wife and that they were continuing to have children in the 1850's. If William U. 26 was William Henry U. the story makes even more sense. I enclose my John C. U. file for you to study.

I could ask many questions but for the present will leave you to study the above and to comment on it. I do hope you will have additional details to send so

we can keep trying to put the pieces together.  
Although this seems like a tangled mess  
we have in fact made great progress since  
the 1960's when Upchurch work was  
undertaken seriously. At this point the  
right detail could solve another part  
of the puzzle.

It is obvious that certain of the  
Granville County Upchurchs departed the  
scene. The more details we can get on  
who went where & when the better we  
will be. You can see how useful the  
Scott Co, VA records may be.

I have interviewed Upchurch descendants  
in Raleigh, NC whose ancestors came from  
Granville Co in the late 1500's. The name  
Archibald U is the common link but  
details on relationships have not been  
sorted out.

Your picture is being returned with  
thanks. The resemblance is great. However  
the W. H. U. of Oxford described in the Obit  
was not descended from the Granville Co, NC  
Upchurches of the 1800-1880 era.

It's great to have you as a  
collaborator!

The Richardson U on the 1850 Lee Co, VA census is XFD-1269, son of Sarah of the Richard U / Buchner U subclan. This does not help us with your group - except that we know you need not be concerned about him.

Ray White is an Upchurch descendant who lives in Salt Lake City, UT. He is of the James U / Burnell U subclan and not connected with your group. He sends me information from time to time.

I don't know who the J. H. U is who resided in Caswell Co, NC on 8 JUL 1862 and died 5 NOV 1862. Maybe her land was records would tell. I checked under John H. U & James H. U in my files.

Dear Phil,

This is a note until I am able to answer your letter. I cannot believe all this is happening for me, your information is opening avenues that I thought might forever be closed.

I do not want to comment, "because I simply have no idea", on Elizabeth and Archibald at the present time. I need some time to do some studying and searching on this and William U XID 161.

I want to comment on Wm. H. the youngest son of Ambrose, and a few other things.

Phil I have looked and looked at this 1850 Census and I am inclined to believe that Mary is William's wife and I do believe he is the Henry that married Mary Parrish

in 1840. I believe I sent you a copy of their marriage bond. I believe at this time his name was William Henry and he went by the name of Henry. You know when trying to figure these things out, until you have proof, there has to be space left to change your mind. I agree with you that Elizabeth is the widowed mother.

Now then Mr. Robert Phillip Upchurch I want to ask some questions, What happened to Alexander and Ambrose of the 1850 Census? If Christopher was Mary's and William's child, why is he not enumerated on the 1860 Census? Has Mary and Elizabeth both died? Mary Ann was married, I knew where she was. Who is the Richardson H. age 49 of the 1880, Base Hill District, Lee Co., Va. Census? Who is the 'Rey White' that sent you this info? If

he lives in that area, and if he and I are related, may I have his address?

I Xeroxed this from a book in the Oxford Library -

North Carolina State Troops  
 ▲ Upchurch, J. H., e. July 8<sup>th</sup>, '62;  
 Granville Co.; d. November 5<sup>th</sup>, '62.

Do you have any idea who this might be? "and" Do you think this might be my William?

□ Upchurch, Wm. H. e. May 16, 1861; dg. August 19, 1862: Co. E 15<sup>th</sup> Reg.

I am not positive but I believe the J. H. U. was in Co. G, 23<sup>rd</sup> Regiment, the same that Grandpa Samuel Parham was in.

I never knew that my father knew (personally knew) any of the Upchurches until I received your letter. I had always thought his was a vicarious relationship

through his grandmother. Thinking back on things he said, I believe that John G. helped his sister Mary Ann in the raising of her only child, my grandfather Charles W. Parkam. I know now that Bladdy knew him.

I have so many thoughts on this that I probably will never know for sure. They pertain to my family but I would like to share them with you if you do not mind. [CHARLES ALBERT CROW PARKAM]

I think I told <sup>you</sup> that my father was born in Lee Co., Va. Gibson Station to be exact. He came with his family to Baylor Co., Tx. when he was 13 or 14 years old. His parents were divorced when he was very young. He said, I thought, four years old but he had to be younger than that. His oldest half sister was born in 1890- or 91 - he was born in '86. He

told me when I was a little girl that his mother never loved him and that she did not want him. This has haunted me all these years and I have <sup>now</sup> reason to believe that it was not so. His <sup>[CHARLES HUNTLEY PARHAM?]</sup> second wife was a young-girl, only ten years older than his oldest child. She was from Rockhill, this is where brother John was living and if I was a gambler, which I am not, I would bet that Gran Mary lived there and she had something to do with the break-up of his marriage. From what I can glean of her personality she was a dominating person, I know that the Mendenhalls (I do not know when she married Grandpa Mendenhall or where) came out to Texas, too. They did not come at the same time because they are not listed in the Baylor Co. 1900 Census but Grandpa died there in 1904. She then made her home with her son until she died in 1919.



Now back to this divorce - I am having a hard time getting this <sup>written</sup> down where it does not sound so disconnected, but bear with me.

I have a first cousin that has told me somethings that does not jive with what my dad remembered. Her mother was the oldest child and was raised by Grandma Mary Ann after the divorce. Her story was that Grandpa told Grandma that he wanted a divorce and she told him that she would be to embarrassed to go to court and he told her that she did not have to do anything, that he would do it all. He sued for custody of the children and when she did not appear to contest this, he was awarded them. My father was never told this.

All he remembers is his ~~father~~<sup>mom</sup> getting his clothes together in a bundle and making him get into a wagon with his father and

when he cried and clung to her she spanked him and made him go, along with his older brother. I do not know if he ever saw her again until he was grown. His mother came to Baylor Co. somewhere around 1905 and lived with his oldest sister who was married by then. I heard him say many times that his stepmother was better to him than his own mother but I think he was taught from little on to think this.

I want to know what really happened and that is the basis of this genealogical search and along the way I am getting to know my family and what wonderful people I come from.

Do you know how and why Ambrase was murdered? Grandpa Charlie was also murdered, but that is another story.

Please disregard the first line of this letter. I did not intend to do this, I hope that I have not bored you with it. For some reason I feel I have not.

I am enclosing a check for two more years of back Bulletins. I guess the years of '81 and '82 unless you have a story on Ambrose in another year - then send that year and I will pick up the other one later because I intend to get them all.

I bought a battery powered gadget from Radio-shack that magnifies 30X I want to look at that Bible with it. I called my sister-in-law and asked her to see if someone could by chemical means bring out that faded writing, she said she would. It does not stand to reason that the parents names and wedding date would not be there. I enjoyed your letter -
