my extract on the will of Lawrence Williams is enclosed. I have highlighted some items. Any comments will be appreciated.

Enclosed is a copy of my summary extract sheet on the Greene Co, AL records. Most of it I had but some was new.

We did not go to New Orleans but had a delightful visit to Natchez, MS. on the way back we had a great day visiting descendants of Abel U, Sr in Yalobusha Co, MS. on 27 MAR 2001. Since returning I have prepared the enclosed 2 Pages on Abel U, Sr & his children. The Upchurch family that came to Yalobusha Co, MS about 1876 had close connections to a Williams family in Yalobusha Co which had also come from Greene Co, AL. - maybe related to your Lawrence Williams family ???


Virginia, I am excited about having you as a cooperator and hope we can work together at whatever pace and on whatever segments of family history that are of mutual interest. Enclosed is a "Relative Interest" chart. If you think it would be useful please enter your rankings and return to me. This could help give some focus to our cooperation.

Enclosed is a copy of the W.K.U letter of 3 SEP 1980 [William Kendrick U, Sr of the Abel U, Sr clan]. Note the error - his ancestor Abel U [Abel U, Sr] was the son of Richard U, II not the son of William U [William U, II]. This was an error put in place by Lynchwood researchers in the 1950-1980 era. I visited W.K.U Jr in Montgomery, AL about 1979 and spent a night in his home. At that time he was recovering from a severe stroke & he died not too long after that. His son W.K.U, Jr is still a subscriber to the U.A. They had/have a very successful construction business. I expect

He was a really bright person and had a keen
interest in his Lynch history. He & Belle

I Laurance Williams Sr. of the County and State aforesaid being in my
perfect mind, perfectly capable of making disposing of the goods and chattels
that God has given me charge of here in this world, I make this my last Will and
Statement to Wit: First after paying all my just debts and funeral expenses I then
give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Hales Wife of James Hales a Negro
Woman Andy and Child Accompanied about five, somewhat old, Hardy about twenty
three years old, Samu twelve.

Item 2, I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Chury Jones, Wife of Woodson Hedges
for thousand dollars to be paid to her by any Executor at the final Settlement of
my Estate bearing Interest from the time of division of my Negroes with the others said
Mary.

Item 3, I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Majner Hales Wife of Wirt Hales
and Negro Woman Sarah and two Children, Rose about six years old & William
about three, Sarah about twenty two years old, and a Negro boy Brock about six

W. & the said Carpenter to sign the same as subscribing Witnesses which they did as sign in his presence and in the presence of each other as appears in the said paper, That the said Lawrence Williams was then a Citizen of & resided in said County, about 60, or 70. Years of age & of sound mind but in feeble health, The said Williams died about ten days afterwards.

Dear cousin Virginia,

Thanks for your letter of 5 MAR 2001 as a
follow-up to our earlier phone conversation.
Thanks also for your subscription to the UB
for 2001 and for the data you supplied which
has now been fully processed.

UB Vol 22 No 1 (JAN-JUN 2001) has been mailed to
you. The second issue will be sent this fall.
I have discovered that my wife mailed the
UB to Catherine rather than Virginia and hope
this causes no confusion. She picked up
Catherine off the check. We now have our
records straight.

Enclosed are details on the Upchurch
Publications. I have made a quick check of
issues that might especially interest you as
they contain some reference to Benjamin
U & family. There are 5 issues as follows:

Vol 18 (1997) #2 ; Vol 12 (1991) #4 ; Vol 15 (1994) #2 ;
 Vol 20 (1999) #4 ; Vol 13 (1992) #3. These are available
 at \$5/issue or \$25 for the set of five. From
 1980 - 1999 we published 4 issues/year so surely
 the above you would get one issue in each of
 5 years. This would give you some insight
 into Benjamin II and also a good sampling
 of what the UB is all about. We have all
 back issues in case you wish to proceed on
 a broader basis of purchase.

I am prepared to work with you on
 our mutual interests in Yelburch heritage in
 whatever way you would like. There is a
 huge amount yet to learn about the Benjamin
 II Family and I am always anxious to
 have active collaborators.

Let me tell you a little about the Yelburch
 Family so we can more easily focus on
 the part that would be of greatest mutual
 interest. The common ancestor of 99.9+% of
 the Yelburch American Family descended from
 Michael II, I who came to VA from England
 about 1638. Over the next 100-200 years they
 gradually moved south. By the time of

the 1790 Federal Census all 11 known Lynhurd households were located in NC. You and I are descended from Richard U, II who started his family in Brunswick Co, VA and then in 1755 we find him in what is today the southern tip of Franklin Co, NC in what we call the Moccasin Creek Area. There are today several hundred thousand descendants of Michael U, I. About 1/2 of these trace back to our Richard U, II.

Richard U, II had 11 children and we have varying degrees of information on them and their descendants - more on the boys than the girls as a general rule. You are descended from son Benjamin U and I am descended from another son NATHAN U, I. Another son Abel U, Sr enters the picture significantly as will be clear later.

The family of Benjamin U has been really hard to pull together but over the years a lot of progress has been made. Only in the last several years have I been able to document Willie U as a son of Benjamin U. I think the records are quite clear that Benjamin U had a daughter Elizabeth U

who named John Carpenter, these two being your ancestors.

The "children" of John & Elizabeth require some discussion. Enclosed is a sheet comparing your records and mine. The birth dates on the 9 you list run in a nice sequence but we need more confidence in these dates. Note that my list A-J includes one child you list did not. Also note there is uncertainty about the parents of B-F, the five who had their names changed from Yrnluch to Carpenter in 1803. Like you, I am treating these as children of John & Elizabeth for the purpose of organizing family records but I do not yet assign XIB (Identity) numbers to them because of the uncertainty. Any comments you have on this puzzle would be appreciated.

Your packet provided me with certain details that are new to my records which I appreciate very much. I hope we can continue to exchange information.

Do you have any information already organized on the children's grandchildren

of Josiah Water & Mary Ann Williams you could send me. I would love to see how you fit in. Also all these records properly belong under the Upchurch banner as they descend from Elizabeth (Upchurch) Carpenter.

I normally collect full name (full maiden name of females), dates of birth/marriage/death and places of birth, marriage, death & burial. For place I like to include town/county/state and name of cemetery if available. Of course I rarely get all this detail but it is well to try.

Let me return to the matter of Abel U, Sr, one of the 11 children of Richard U, II and a brother to your Benjamin & my Nathan. Abel U, Sr started his family in Franklin Co, NC but in the early 1800's moved to Greene Co, AL as did his niece Elizabeth & her husband John Carpenter. I have a large amount of information on Abel U, Sr and his descendants including a lot of Greene Co, AL information. Other neighbors of Abel U, Sr in Franklin Co, NC also moved to Greene

co, AL about the same time as Abel U, Sr. I have always thought we could learn more about our Upchurch heritage by a greater awareness of these migrations of related & non-related individuals from one spot to another. For example, are some of these folks buried in the same graveyard? Did the families continue to intermarry, etc.?

I will look forward to hearing from you and to such activities as we find mutually attractive.
