I appreciated your letter and am enclosing a check for the 1985 bulletin. I am sending what information I have about

- my grandfather Thomas Upchurch's descendants. I have other information
- (somewhat sketchy) starting with John born in 1781 in N.C. He died in Henry Co., Tenn. All of this is from census reports. I will be glad to send it but thought you might already have that data.

The Upchurch reunion was held in conjunction with the

- Δ + □ Lampley reunion (Annie Lucretia Upchurch, daughter of Alexander, Δ married James Lampley). It is the first Upchurch reunion that I have known of, and it is there that I learned of your research. Don Upchurch of Houston traced the line from Michael. He was trying to get information on some of the people, and you will probably be hearing from him. I am, of course, sure of the information about my parents and descendants and might be able to get additional ~~for~~ places where you have blanks.

Δ One of our relatives found interesting letters to Alexander from relatives in Tenn. They were written before the Civil War after Alexander moved to Texas. The writing is beautiful, but grammar and spelling are very bad. Some are written in pencil and could not be copied successfully, so I typed some of the more interesting ones. They discuss prices of crops and animals and also slaves. One was not signed because of some inflammatory remarks about the "Black Republicans" and "no-nothings" who were in Tenn. just before the war. If you could use any of this, I will send copies. I feel that you may be getting so much that you don't want any more clutter.

Δ P.S. Alexander was the first clerk of Salem Baptist Church (1859). He served in the Confederate army and is said to have had an illness while serving from which he never completely recovered.

Thank you for your letter of 1 MAR 1995 and for your donation of \$25.00 to the Yrchurch Research Fund. Although you have not resubscribed to the U₂ for 1995 we will send you copies because of what we hope to report on early history which is of special interest to you. Please do not feel this means you have to subscribe in the future. I too am interested in our early history but feel I must offer something to present day family members in order to get them involved.

I am very proud of what we have been able to do in the last 12-24 months about our colonial and English heritage. It is possible we may have Professor Rouseme do one more round of research in England on the Yrchurch history there for the period 1550-1750. The few letters of Michael Yrchurch, I written in the 1650's were most interesting.

In retirement I am busier than ever. However, we have committed to making two trips per year of two weeks each for family history purposes. Next fall we will spend two weeks in Texas. Some preliminary plans are now being made.

Yesterday was a day of vacation so I enjoyed the entire day in extending the details provided in your letter of 31 OCT 1987. Please accept my thanks for all your efforts and for everything you have sent. The 1971 letter from John U (your note said Alexander U) to his dau-in-law Mary is a real treasure.

Enclosed herewith is a copy of my 12 page outline for the William U, IV / John U subclass (XID-100/XID-652) for the 6th generation (John U - XID-652) through the 9th generation. We have now identified 8 children of John U XID-652 and 47 grandchildren and 46 great-grandchildren - all shown on the 12 page outline. This document can no doubt be improved greatly for those 6th, 7th, 8th, & 9th generation descendants of Michael U, I. I will appreciate any further help you can provide. In due course I will want to publish a new version of this outline and it would be nice to have the best possible version.

It would be nice to have the 1810, 1870, 1930 & 1840 census records for John U XID-652 to see if we can fit his eight children into the categories

shown on the census. I do not have there. ②

You have proposed Solomon U as a son of John U XFD-652. Can you tell me what evidence you have for this?

Can you tell me which children and grand-children of John U XFD-652 migrated from Henry Co, TN to TX? It seems to me that none of ~~the~~ his children went to TX and I only have firm evidence on one grandchild going and that was your ancestor Alexander U XFD-7056.

However, in the 1871 letter from Jesse U to Mary, the widow of Alexander U he says at the end "when you write - tel me all about Brother Jack's family and present them my love..." I assume that 'Jack' refers to his brother James Jackson U. My records show that James Jackson U was buried in the Harbor Cem in Henry Co, TN (I don't know when he died) so this probably means he did not move to TX, although he could have visited there. Certainly the children of James Jackson U could have moved to TX but the only information I have is the passage in the 1871 letter.

Perhaps you have information on hand which could add to or provide correction for the 12 page outline or perhaps you know where to get missing details.

Dear Cousin Phil,

I haven't written lately because I haven't had any additional information to add to the Upchurch family tree. The reunion was held in Yorktown, Texas, on June 27, and about 63 people attended. Some who had previously attended were not there, and some new ones appeared. Among those were Louise Aldrich Upchurch and her daughter Maisha Kennedy. Two of the 80+ in age have died: Ura Lee Lampley Key, Aug. 13, 1986, buried at Salem and Margie Fitzhenry Lampley, May 21, 1987, buried at Salem.

I believe you have received information about some members of the Texas Upchurches from Leola Kluck or Mary Lou Cook who know more about some branches of the family than I do. In case you do not have this information, I can send you copies as well as copies of some Henry County, Tennessee, Upchurches of pre-civil war days. In some of the information about the Thomas Lacy Upchurch family included in the above references, there are

- △ two errors: #1 Katie Upchurch Nixon is buried in Kenedy, Texas, not in California (I attended the funeral) and
- +△ #2 Thomas and Fannie Crabb Upchurch have a daughter Elorene. The latter said she sent you some knowledge she had of her part of the family. I am sure I may have sent to you incomplete or inaccurate data (or both) on some of the family, so I am not criticizing anyone for minor errors. One always knows of one's own line more than of collateral branches.

I enjoy the bulletin and am always interested in learning more of our heritage.

I did try to contact my aunt Katy Nixon's children but evidently the only one for whom I had an address has moved as my letter was returned. Presumably all of them are in California. Also there isn't anything I could learn about the Henry Upchurch family except for the clipping I am enclosing. A friend saw it in a Victorian paper and thought it was perhaps one of my relatives. I am still hoping to see my Uncle Thomas F. Upchurch soon.

There were about 65 people at the upchurch reunion June 28, mostly the same ones who were at the last one. There were 4 86-year olds and 2 small babies. None of the older ones knew if Lloyd U. had a middle name.

Florence Delany U. Hall is the one who died in San Antonio and was buried at Salem. She had divorced Leander many years previously, and I don't know what happened with him. The

Your letter of 12 MAR 86 arrived just as we moved into our new townhouse. With that and 1000 other things to contend with I am just now finishing the instructions of your letter. The details are greatly appreciated. Previously, I had no information on your Aunt Anne Florence Delaney (W) Hall.

Here are some thoughts and comments

I do hope you can or have visited your Uncle Thomas F. U (XFD-13731). He could probably shed a lot of light on missing details.

Mr. Webb was a good person and cool. I think there was some trauma some place in the system and relatives had some difficulty in dealing with it. She still might help if approached right.

As regards ~~the~~ Floyd U I have to believe there was a middle name since her parents gave the other children middle names. Perhaps Thomas F U would know.

For Florence Delaney U and Leander Hall you show "died in San Antonio, TX, buried at Salem, TX". To which of the two does this quote apply?

As for the children of Alexander U (ATD-7056) there is still a small question in my mind as to whether there were 5 or 6. The birth dates may be instructive.

1. William Alexander U b. 20 AUG 1855
2. Thomas Lucy U b. 1 SEP 1857
3. Jesse James U b. 30 JUN 1861
4. Florence Delany U b. 1862
5. Annie Furel a U b. 22 MAY 1864

We don't know when Alexander U was wed but his wife Mary was b. 12 NOV 1835 so it seems that William Alexander U was probably their first child and she would have been just about 19 when he was conceived - hence they would have been married before she was 19. - hardly leaver room for an earlier child.

Since there was almost 4 years between Thomas L and Jesse J. it is quite possible there could have been a child between the two. This could be the b. U # which my records show as a female b. ca 1859 (but I can't find my name for that entry!). On the negative side - the 1860 census for the home of Alexander U does not show a 1 year old child!

Since Alexander U did not die till 9 JAN 1867 it is possible he could have had a child born after Annie L - but we have no hint of that as far as I know. Since Alexander suffered in the war and afterwards from it this may account for Annie L being the last child. His 1864 war paper would be helpful in an understanding of the birth patterns also. Do you have these war records? I am sure you know more about Alexander children than I do.

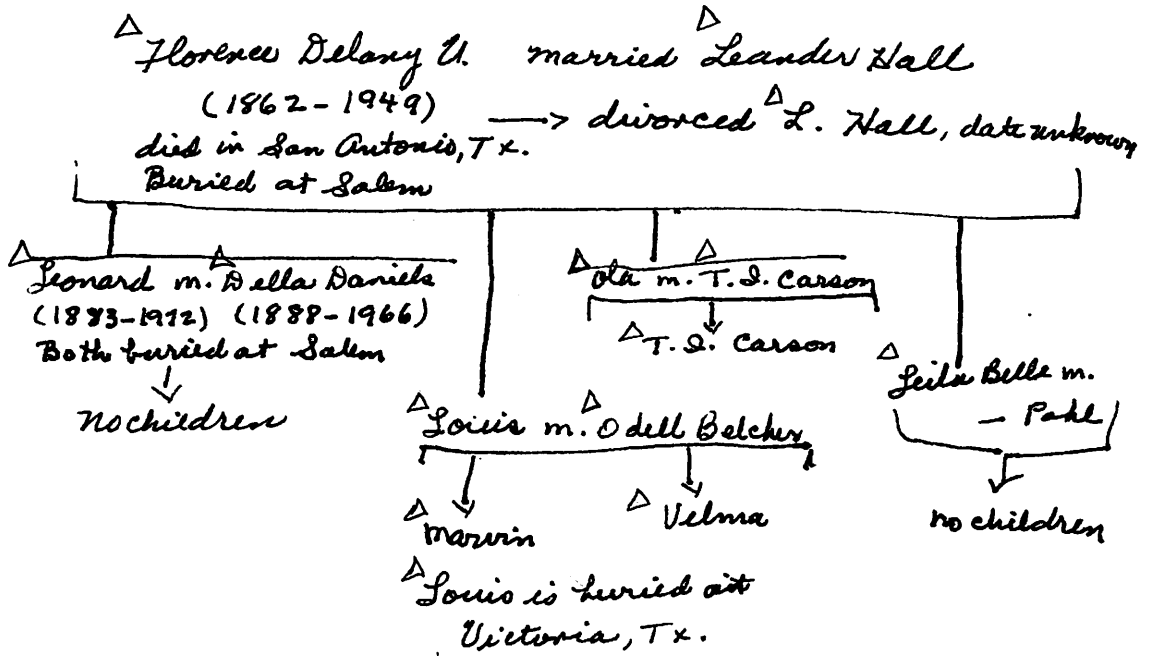

However, there were other Beshars (or variants of that name in Henry Co, TN in the mid 1800's and some of them named Upshurcker. Alexander II ~~GF~~ GF (John U. XFD-652) had an Aunt Elizabeth U II (XFD-2072) who m'd 27 NOV 1871 Thomas BATHSHARES (XFD-7069). We have no follow-up information on this latter couple but it is tempting to think that she came to TN. We know her brother [George U XFD-153] did and he also m'd a Bathshares [Rachel XFD-145]. The point is that your ancestor Beshars (Bathshares?) may have been related - just speculating!

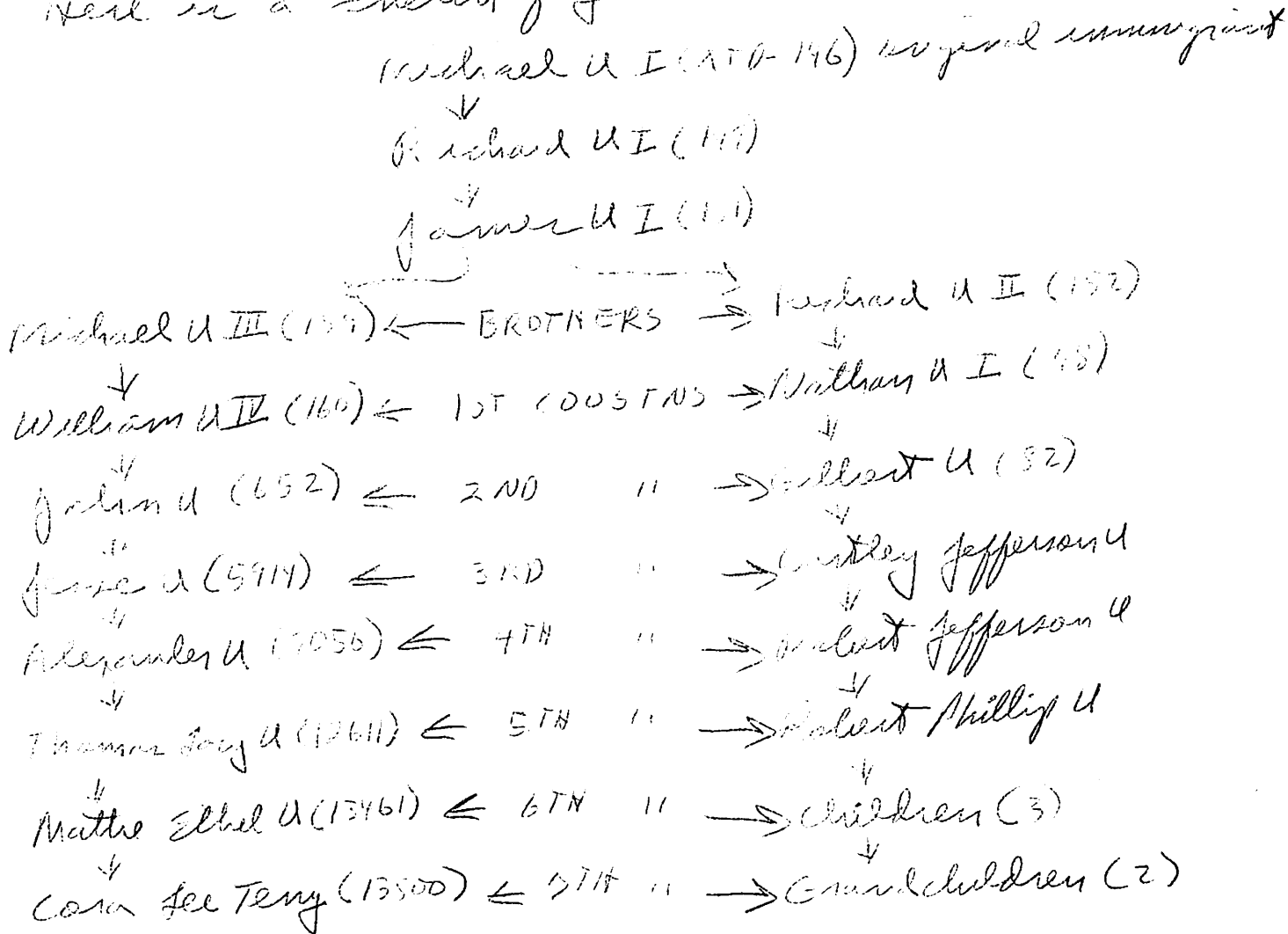

- gives date of birth only as 1860, and the 1970 census
- records her age as 10. She evidently also was known

Δ 2) As far as the second wife is concerned, I have learned
- very little. Her maiden name was Kelly, but I don't
- know what the "B" stands for. Her first husband was
- named SMOTHERS, but I don't know when she married
- Thomas K. U.

Δ+Δ 3) The youngest child of Cora + Thomas was a son named
- Ferrell Smothers U. He married Anna Valkmer and had no
