Hi Craig---

I have now had a chance to go to my office in Chesterfield Valley and to look at my files. I find an issue I hope you can help me resolve. I also note you have visited my website www.upchurchstory.com. If you had any trouble negotiating the site please let me know.

I am able to track your family from Michael Upchurch, I who came to America in 1638 down ten generations to Dewitt T. Upchurch. There is no question but that you are of the George U./Shadrack Upchurch Subclan. I hope you had a chance to watch the video on George and on his ancestors all of whom are your direct ancestors. There is a great deal on your line in the various issues of the Upchurch Bulletin.

The issue I have is that a cooperater years ago indicated that Dewitt T. Upchurch married and had three children one of whom was your mother Donna Upchurch born 1937---So far so good. But then the reference reports the Donna married Clyde Peters and had Craig(you?), Gerald, Shirley, Lisa, and Linda. Clearly something is amiss here. Can you help me straighten this out?

In 2013 we started a new website and organization to do family history in a more powerful way. A key part of our plan is to enroll families starting with a patriarch who lived about the time of the Revolution and to treat descendants and details. Your ancestor George Upchurch, Head of the George U. Clan is a perfect example and we have in fact made a lot of progress with this family. We need financial support and volunteer time to keep making progress on this family. I hope you will join with us in this effort and a 2015 membership form is attached.

The George Upchurch Clan is one of largest of the 22 Upchurch Clans. I have spent a huge amount of time on this family and have a huge collection on them. I have gone to Wayne County, KY to give an Upchurch talk. Craig lives in Lees Summit, Jackson Co, MO
which county embraces Kansas City, MO. Craig
made the 3 hour drive just to confer on
his Lynch heritage.

He is one of five children of Donna
Dee U and her first husband Clyde Peters,
a Mormon. The children were raised as
Mormons. Dee & Clyde mg came to an end
(Death or divorce?) and Dee md - - EGGLESTON.
He legally adopted Dee's children and they have
since gone by Eggleston. Clyde was born
in UT and Donna in ID

△ Craig was born 2 JUL 1956 (spirit lake, ID)
full name Craig Edward Peters. He was in
the marine for a time, ⁽¹⁹⁷⁵⁾ which he said
is hard on a marriage. In 1986 at age
30 he was out of a job & moved to Lees
Summit MO where his folks were at that
time & has been there since. He is in
Security work.

In Craig's family there was much awareness
that an earlier generation (Joseph Gray U, I had
gone to Canada after his last child had been
born in Wayne Co, KY in 1896 and their
fae died in 1922. Went to Canada to farm.

Donna's father Dennis T. U. in 1894 Serchford,
KY and lived for a time in Canada but
migrated back to US & died 1972 in northern
ID. Craig remembers their farming operation
including milk cows.

Dennis md only once to IVA DEPEW
but she had been md before to JNE WHORT ??
and had 4 children (one = James ??)

I gave Craig a pocket consistency of 4 pages
of the children of Mour. U. b1838 and CSI general
page. He accepted these steadily without thanks

I explained Craig's Ukrainian heritage & considerable detail including the English & Colonial aspects. I started by giving a sketch of my life including my percy into family history and the evolution leading to Alfred & Ann. Craig told his story - but briefly. He is not skilled in telling a story - is more of an introvert. Says his mother was interested in family history. They had an awareness of Wayne Co, IA but never went back. Craig plans to go in 2016. He said he came across my work on the Internet and felt he had discovered a gold mine.

Still when I pressed him a bit about AF and gene his an application form he said he might come up with that too but not much more.

Craig did not refer to a wife or children but they are listed on a sheet he gave me.

As I recall, I provided you with a copy of my Master Outline for your part of the family. I hope you found that useful and that you will provide corrections and/or additions as appropriate.

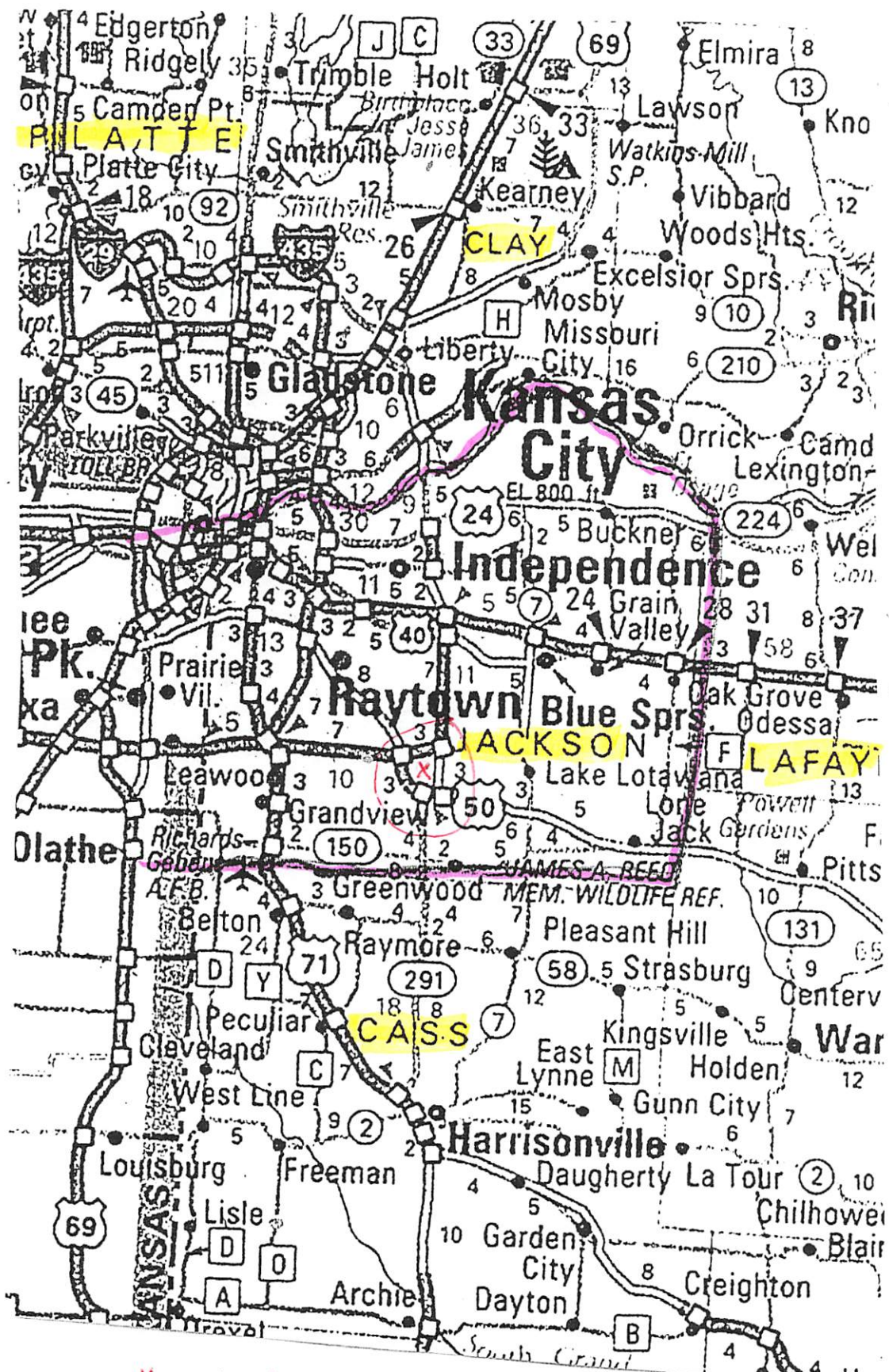

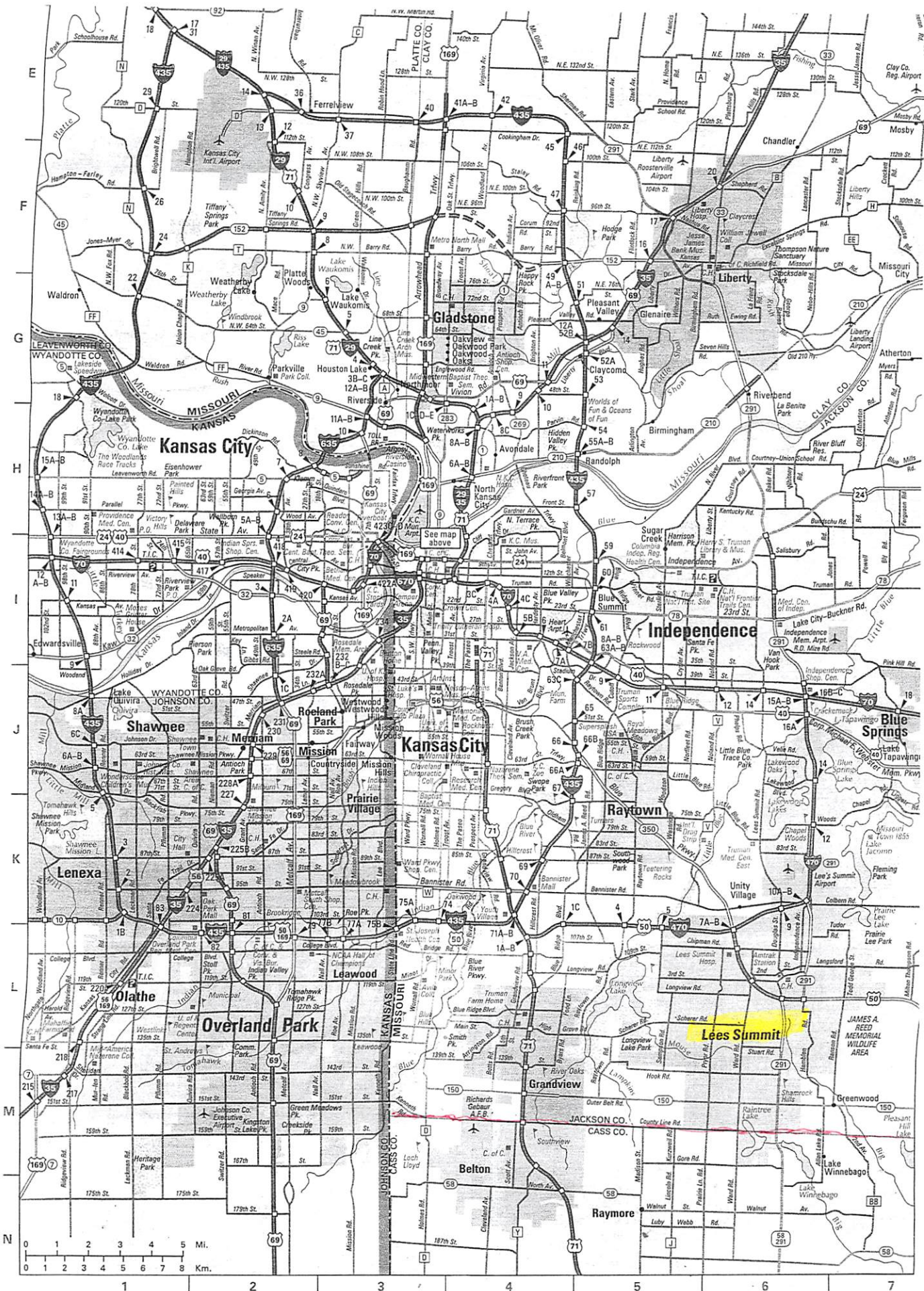

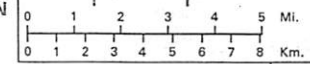
