With your input I now see I have an excellent Master Outline for you part of the Upchurch Family. I carry you as XID-3928. I had good exchanges with you stepmother Mable. We can gradually get into your heritage and I will be happy to provide a number of inputs over time based on what you tell me about your interests. Let me digress to tell you briefly the story of our progression on family history work.

In an effort to make sure my life's work was not put in the dumpster I created the Upchurch Bulletin in 1980 and put it in many libraries. Then we established the Upchurch Collection at N.C. State University with them agreeing to take all of my records and narratives including eventually my family history records. I have endowed the Collection at \$50,000 and many have made contributions to the endowment or to the processing fund. I thank you for your contribution to the latter aspect. I continue to write chapters for my memoirs and to send them with supporting documents to the Collection some aspects of which are on line as for example my oral history (just google oral history Robert Phillip Upchurch). I'll try to help you find your way. If more is need just email or call me. I tried to call you last evening bu 662-299-5626 does not seem to work??

First on the missing odd numbered pages and missing XID's. We split the UB when we put it on line. The narrative(even numbered pages) are in one file which you reached. The Registry (XID's) are in a second file which you should see listed as an option to view or download. Englandia is in a third file. The 2013 volume is in yet another file as will be the 2014 volume. Supposedly searching goes faster if you download to your computer and then search rather than trying to search online.

As a learning experience for these particular files I suggest you play with entering names in different ways to see what is produced. I tried Robert Burton Upchurch Sr and then U., Robert b. U. and a couple of other versions and each one brings a little different result and reveals different documents. I get my research block to show up by depressing control and "F" keys and then opting for a more advanced search block. It is pretty much Greek to an old geezer like me but somehow it works.

You should find tons of Upchurch and Pittman stuff including pictures although we need to upgrade the pictures. I made a special trip to Yalobusha county to give an Upchurch talk. You should be able to search and find a reference to this

I will be anxious to learn of your success in searching the UB issues for your heritage as your experience may help me guide others.
