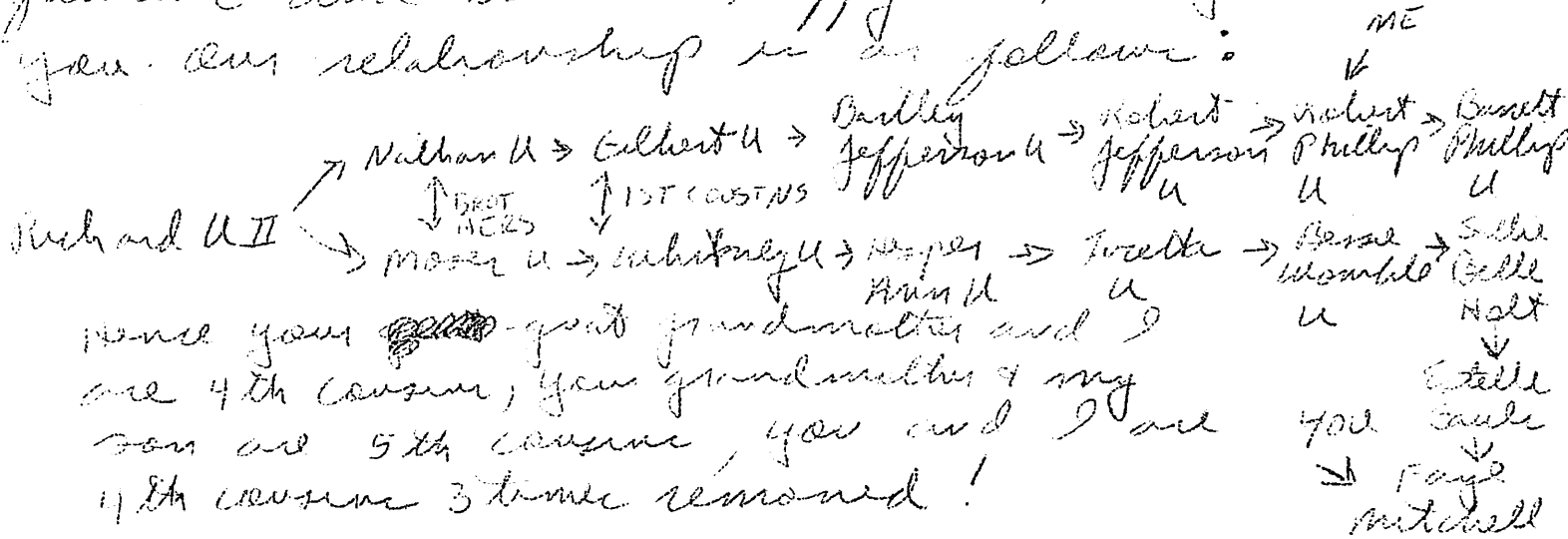

Mrs Belle West has sent me a copy of your 16 FEB 1980 letter in which you provided certain facts and raised certain questions. Belle and I have been working closely together for several years. My files on Upchurch and related families in NC and elsewhere are rather extensive and as perhaps you know I am now publishing the Upchurch Bulletin to get some of this info out to interested parties. I have information on Wamble, Holt, Mitchell and Sauls families and will be happy to exchange with you. Our relationship is as follows:



Hence your ~~great~~ great grandmothers and I are 4th cousins, your grandmothers & my son are 5th cousins, you and I are 11th cousins 3 times removed!

I have a substantial amount of information about the western part of Wake County (Creen Pond) where Whitney U + Elliott U were raised. My Grandfather was born and raised there and left to go to Civil War and upon return settled in southern Wake County (Yale Mill Pond area - Inwood Church) where my father + I were born + raised. I have found a lot on Whitney U line which I hope to put in Upchurch Bulletin. I hope you will subscribe.

I can help some on Esperanza U. I am convinced her name was Hesper Ann. Records show she was b. 1856 (Wake Co, NC) Alfred Daughtery. Hesper Ann U was born about 1858 so could have been the legitimate daughter of Alfred and Hesper. However, both Hesper Ann and Gocetta appear in the home of Whitney U on the 1860 census records and they both use the name of Upchurch, not Daughtery both continued to use the Upchurch name in later census records. No doubt diligent research will reveal more about this. Please let me have any comments.

To answer your question on Squire Holt - yes that's the one in my records. I had often wondered just who Luisa Upchurch was after seeing that in the census, but at the time I was concentrating on my other lines and just didn't try to figure it out. I have to question your idea about this Luisa Upchurch being married to Nathan because of your record on P. 11 of Vol. 1, No. 1 of the UB stating that Mackey died in 1831. The age certainly could be right though, if she didn't die in 1831. I have not done any research on the Johnsons at all. I have been afraid to tackle it since there are so many of them and I have absolutely no information.

There is a family cemetery on what was Squire Holt's property in Chatham County. We have been there before, but some of the stones were difficult to read and we didn't have the necessary materials for doing rubbings. Of course by the time we found it, we had wasted four hours just looking for it! We plan to go back when it gets cooler.

Question: Who were Elizabeth Goodwin's parents? Or are you going to deal with that in the next UB?

From just looking at the notes you sent me I am not able to tell if any of the Womble's fit in.

Again, thanks for the information and I really enjoyed the UB. I am looking forward to hearing from you and receiving the next issue.

If I can be of anymore help, please let me know.

After I finished my letter to you yesterday I was working over the Upchurch listings for the 1850 and 1860 Chatham Co, NC Census. They will appear as Batch Records in Issue 3 of Vol 1 of U.B. In the process I noticed LUISA UPCHURCH age 100 in the home of Esquire Tolt. At the time I took these notes from microfilm I added a comment that "Tolt" probably should be "Holt" or other Helters were nearby. Still ~~the~~ "Tolt" was clearly written.

I assume the Esquire Holt age 50 in 1860 is the same as the Squire Holt in your records. I assume the Rebecca Holt (age 5 listed probably should be 45 or 55 as microfilm was hard to read) was nee Rebecca Johnson as shown in your records. The question is - who was Luisa U age 100? I am guessing she could have been Mackey Luisa Johnson who md Nathan U in 1780. Mackey Luisa Johnson could have been an Aunt of Rebecca Johnson - Any comments?
