Dear Douglas,

Thanks for the family history packet which arrived on 22 DEC 1997. I was able to identify the three Upchurch intermarriages with your family

#1 - William Ernest U and Lula F. Markham. The profile for him (2 pages - 6 items) is enclosed as is the master outline for his father's family.

#2 Alpha House. She and John Lee U, Sr for whom a master outline is enclosed as is a profile sheet for Alpha (1 page 3 items). I am well acquainted with the son of this couple who lives in Raleigh, N.C.

#3 L. Urline Talmage Shepherd and Charles Franklin U, II. Her profile sheet (1 page 2 items) enclosed as is the master outline for him

If anyone needs more detail on the Upchurch ancestry of these three, please let me know. If anyone can provide more detail for the Master outlines or for the Upchurch ancestry involved I would be happy to exchange.

I have enclosed a sheet on your Ancestry so far as I have it. To the extent that more individuals could be added that were present at some point in Central NC, it would be easier to learn if we can link up more families of mutual interest

I have entered the Marcum/Marcum/Markham details you provided as a "family" unit in the Profile System maintained for each of these three families. A count of the individual profiles within each of these spelling variations revealed the following

MARCOM - Have Profiles for 4 individuals - not in Central NC - All are members of the Extended Upland Family

MARCOM - Have Profiles for 24 individuals - most in Central NC - Four are members of the Extended Upland Family

MARKHAM - Have Profiles for 56 individuals - most in Central NC. 26 are members of the Extended Upland Family. Many of these are of the Moses U/Sims U Subclan and the linkage commenced when Ada Henderson Council (a granddaughter of Sims U) married Hiram Wesley Markham
b 6 JUN 1855 & 10 NOV 1923

If there is enough interest I could provide copies of these Marcom/Marson/Masham Biopics.

I made a fair effort to find Upchurch linkages to the HIGHT, WALTON, UTLEY, EDWARDS family members mentioned in your packet but could not establish a linkage. There is probably such a linkage in there somewhere.

Our exchanges so far indicate that our family interests cross in several cases in central NC. If you or anyone else wishes to continue to explore the more complete documentation of some of these families I would be happy to be involved. On the other hand, I realize we all encounter more opportunities than we can pursue and we have to make choices. This is especially true in family history work.

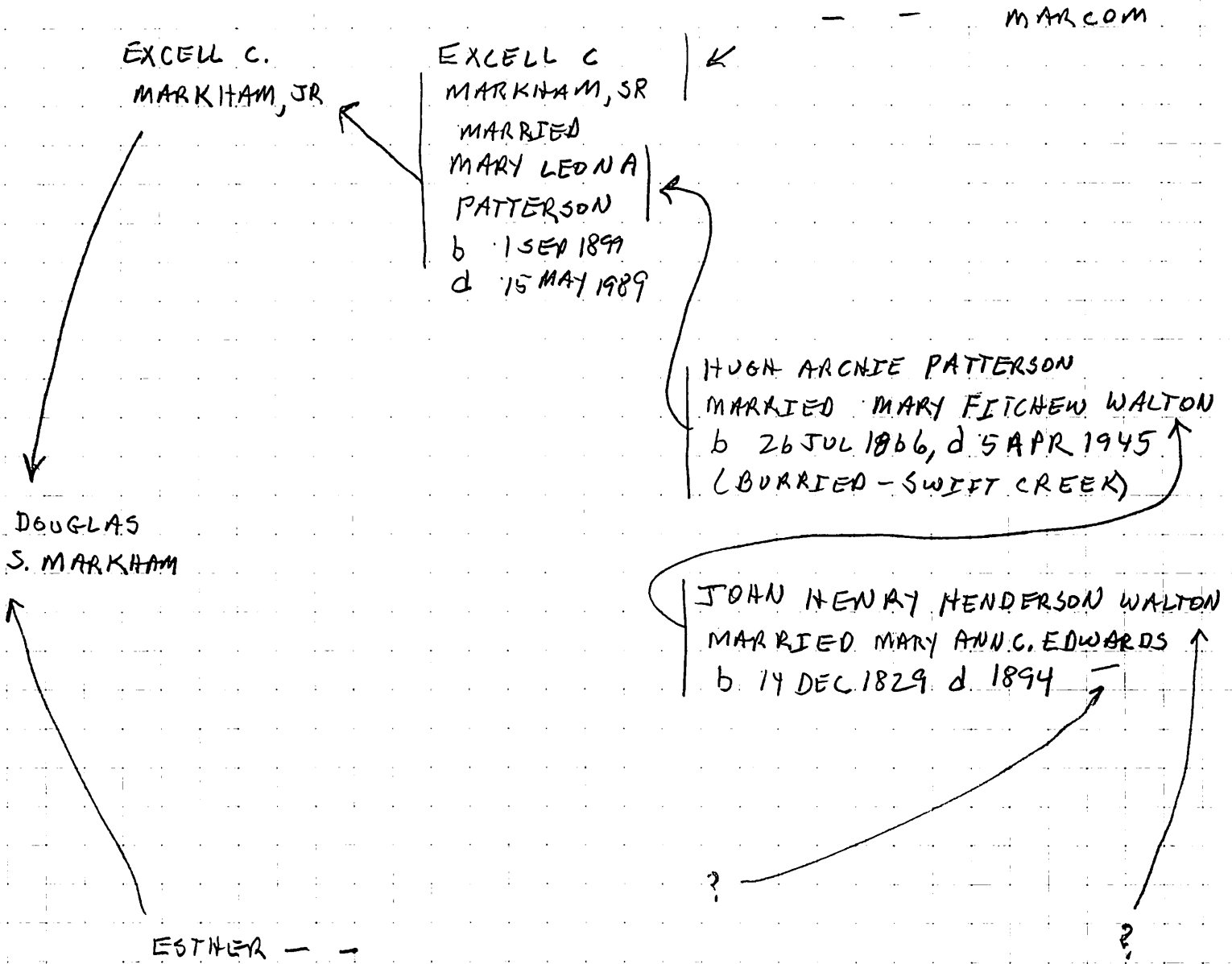
I'll be glad to hear from you if and when you think we can make a few more positive steps on family matters of mutual interest.

PREFACE
JULY, 1996

The earliest known Markham direct ancestor we had was Temesia Marcom; she was my great grandmother. Then at Carolina I had a professor named Markham; it never occurred to me that he might be a relative - but he was. It was many years before I discovered that spelling of the family surname was not all that important in tracing your family; different spellings only made the search more interesting and difficult. Early generations spelled their name Marcom or Marcum and today, the spelling of choice for this surname is largely "Markham".

In this genealogy, much of the early information was assembled by Floyd Pickett and, since publication of the July, 1994, Markham Genealogy, Douglas E. Markham has added considerable material. So far as we know, these Marcoms/Markhams lived in the Durham/Orange County area of North Carolina. Where they lived before that or when they came to this area, we don't know.

A William Marcom was appointed executor/administrator for a will in 1739, in Caroline County, Virginia, and may be the father of our earliest John and William Marcom. Brothers John and William Marcom were born in Caroline County, Virginia.

NOTATIONS AND ABBREVIATIONS

2

Each person in a family has a Family Number. This notation is assigned, based on that person's forebears and order of birth. The earliest known ancestor is assigned Family Number 1, his children have Family Numbers 11 for the first-born, 12 for the second child, 13 for the third, and continues until all children have been assigned numbers.

Each family member's line is brought forward to present day descendants, if they are known, before listing the next member. All descendants of the family member with Family Number 11, are given in the genealogy before the family member with Family Number 12 is considered.

NOTATIONS:

1114231 A typical Family Number which would be read: one, one, one, four, two, three, one. Seven digits show seven generations.

111-106 This Family Number contains a dash which indicates that the two digits following the dash should be read together. In this example, it would be read: one, one, one, ten, six. Since the 1 and 0 following the dash are read as ten, this Family Number shows five generations.

11116*8 An asterisk in a Family Number designates a female family member that married, took her husband's surname, and, in this example, is the eighth child born to the female family member, 11116.

In most instances, children of a female family member will be listed: *1, *2, *3, etc. Subsequent descendants will be numbered: *11, *12, etc. for second generation children beyond the female family member, and *111, *112, etc. for third generation children beyond the female family member.

When you find a "/" between dates or names, it indicates multiple dates or names have been found and it is not known which date or name is correct.

(Their parents were likely Ethelbert and Frances Jones Watson, reared by Dr. Josiah Ogden). John William Watson first married a Cooper, and then married her niece Caroline Carter, b. Nov. 23, 1840 and d. Oct. 23, 1927, and had Lena, Frances, and Gaston Walton. The latter married a Mauldin, and had Walter, Myrtle and Beulah. John is buried on the side of the road on the old Watson place, "out Hwy 103 North". He fought for the Union. Gaston married Nancy Ward and moved west to Fannin Co., TX, but had no children.

We arrived here as I think I stated in my other letter to you on the 4th May, we had a long and (lonesome?) journey and suffered a (?) on the roads. I and my family stopped 13 weeks in Kentucky in consequence of high water.

I have seen an abundance of rich land since I saw you, and am at this time? living in what is called the Barrares?. It is ? as with your land a rich county. It will produce from 10 to 1200 pounds cotton per acre from 6-8 bushels corn, this best land in the

.....Dr. I Gaston Watson has taken the run of the country . . . and very fair as a practitioner of medicine. there are a great many North Carolinians in this country and daily arriving. Nothing more that would be interesting to you.

Very respectfully your son,
James C. Edwards.

The following documents tie Nathaniel Jones into the lives of my ancestors:

A promissory note to Nathaniel Jones from Joseph Edwards, William Laine, and Thomas Swain (Edwards?) dated Dec. 29, 1815 for \$50. This is among scores of receipts which I have never categorized, probably indicating a store run by Jos. Edwards.

A deed dated Dec. 25, 1817, wherein Nathaniel Jones sold to Joseph Edwards (thought to be spouse to Cally Edwards, my known ancestor) 100 acres on Reedy Branch for \$150 adjacent to Thomas Jenks, and bordering Jones' line. Witnesses were William Lane and Aron Mathews?.

A deed dated Dec. 2, 1818 from Minton Jones to Thomas Swain (or Severn) Edwards, for 103 1/4 acres for \$225 adjacent to John Taylor, Sr. and William Atkins. This is thought to be the land adjacent to the first tract, and just south. William Segraves and Joseph Edwards were witnesses.

A survey, more probably of this second tract, dated Oct. 1783, mentioning Camp Branch, Reedy Branch, and Rocky Branch, and with the name of Moses Harvill is witnessed or signed by Lewis Jones and Landman Short, and also by John Humphries.

A tax receipt from J. Rogers to Joseph Edwards for 1831

An account dated Dec. 15, 1843 in which Cally Edwards bought the homeplace for \$25 and the household goods from A. Turner, trustee for Jos. Edwards. (whom we presume to have died, but perhaps was jailed or bankrupt). Neighboring landowners at time were Burt Brown and a Jones. Burt Brown and William Jones were witnesses.

A government document issued Jan. 2, 1844 commanding the surveyor for Wake County, pursuant to an Act of the Assembly, to survey 50 acres of vacant land adjoining that of Burt Brown and Swan Edwards on the waters of Middle Creek to be given to Nathaniel (MC) Edwards. On the back, this document is signed over to Mary Ann Caliniy Edwards on April 8, 1844 by Nathaniel Jones, and witnessed by William Collins.

A purchase of 4 1/2 acres by Calley Edwards from the State on 11-12-1844 for 22 cents.

A loan from Joshua Rogers on Oct. 10, 1844 to Cally Edwards to allow her to pay off the debt due A. Turner, witnesses by Briant Taylor.
