Hi Carla---

I presume the store Irene mentions is one for which there was a ledger and which Dilly Kelly had prior to her death. I saw it when I visited her home about 1975 and made notes about Upchurch entries but did not copy the ledger. My memory form 40 years ago is that Dilly had already loaned the book to N.C. Archives to copy. I was never able to learn where this store was located. My memory is that the ledger was from the early 1800's.

There was another store near Olive Chapel run by John Upchurch son of Ruffin Upchurch about the time of the Civil War. It was in New Ruin Tavern and the location of it is known.

It would be great to have a copy of the ledger for our Cary Facility or at least to have a link to a copy in the NC State Archives.

Some information about the Old Raleigh, NC City Cemetery came into my hands recently and I thought it in order to send it to you in case you can find a place for it in the Cemetery Project.

The information came to me on 7 OCT 2000 and involves 74 pages of handwritten family history compiled by the late Mrs. Marcus Wade Crocker (nee: Margaret Best Harris aka Margaret H. Crocker). will note that Margaret copied the cemetery inscriptions on 20 NOV 1957. The individuals mentioned are from important families in the early history of Raleigh, NC.

Other records I have show the following: Elisha Sims had a daughter Susan Sims, b. 1779, d. 25 OCT 1864 (15 OCT 1864 in above records) who md David Royster, Jr., b. 12 NOV 1777, d. 12 JUN 1865 (22 JUN 1865 in above records).

David Royster, Jr. was the son of David Royster, Sr. and his wife, nee: Mary Daniel.

While not reflected in the above records it is a fact that David Royster, Jr. and wife, Susan, had a daughter Adeline Susan Royster who in 1840 married in Raleigh, NC, William Clinton Upchurch I, a first cousin of my GF Bartley Jefferson Upchurch.

Provided herewith is page 61 of the larger document on which one finds the data reported above. I have also provided an enlarged copy on which I have traced over the information to make it more readable. I send this information to you knowing that the City Cemetery Monuments have been degraded. Perhaps this 20 NOV 1957 recording will serve to reinforce other records.

We hope to make a trip to NC sometime in the first half of 2001 and would enjoy a visit with you at that time if you are available.

Dear Dr. Phil,

I'm long overdue writing and don't believe I ever thanked you for the 50± cemeteries - great because many were new! Needed is money to start publishing. It's discouraging when houses, old hotels, mills, etc., receive the grants. Am working on another, but a long story and reason why not being turned over to WCGS.

The surveyor in the area of the "Beck Cem" did a pretty thorough job, but did not have it. New Bethel Bapt. Church is not in tel dir (wonder if over line in Durham Co.?). Generally, western Wake is incomplete, except for New Light north and White Oak/Buckhorn south. Barton's Creek would have the Cross Cem (my paternal grand-mother's family had a Cross connection). Jones in Leesville Twp was unreported but Edwards was (do you know an Edwards man in Smithfield into Edwardses?). Soapstone U Meth Church has been done but Six Forks and Leesville Baptists have not.

Re John Rice Upchurch Cem: Don't recall it being on early list. SR1613 is a long road and and depending which side cem is on, could be White Oak, Cedar Fork or Cary Twp. Members of Apex Historical Society hope to complete Apex/Green Level in '97. In July some 200 Morman young people and adult leaders cleaned and recorded in that general area - report is not in yet, so they may have found it. Scouts also did several. The lady for Swift Creek hopes to finish in '97 (did not have Mid Pines and Buffalo). The coming WCGS journal will list Marks Creek/St. Matthews, next St. Mary's/Panther Branch; then Swift Creek/Middle Creek. Doing coordinates has been most draining because most directions are not specific enough. The locations have to be pinpointed by contacting people within the townships - but with their help, other cemeteries have turned up. Next year I will have my own assistant (at great pay, too!) so the rest may be easier. This dropped in my lap two or three years ago when the former coordinator left the state (I helped him too much!!).

Re John Jenks: I'd been to this cem for Gaston Seagroves, wife an Olive descendant, but didn't find him. Their descendant told me about him and either had not been to look or couldn't find him, too. Your visit noted a 1'x 2' marker and "Jacobs and Segrove in this yard off a good ways in relationship" - off from where the others are buried, or in relationship!! The lady across the road who went with me over did not seem to know about the Seagroves. A mystery! The mother of Merritt Wilson Womble was also an Olive girl. How do these fit into one of your families?

Re Green Level: Mallie Jenks at above cem said he attended funeral of Mabel Clark Womble (28 Aug 1906-2 May 1956) m Gleason A. Yates (9 Dec 1897-7 Nov 1954) - they are at Green Level. "Dick" Richard Maurice (31 Oct 1923-31 Aug 1941) is an Upchurch and follows Malpheus G./Lessie H. Upchurch on our list. You did not have Josephine U. Broadwell (1853-1954) and Lewraney Upchurch, wife of A.C. Council (1836-1876).

Re Church just west of Hollomans X Roads: Bethel Christian Church was begun by some of that faith who once attended Collins Groye Baptist but finally wearied of being excluded from the Lord's Supper. Around 1960 the building was moved for a residence somewhere in the woods to the right beyond the old Lashley place on the road to New Hill. See items added on duplicate sheet you sent.

The Monument to Confederates in Holly Springs does \underline{not} have a connection with Apex. Sandy Plains Church, E of Friendship, is Pleasant Plains – 1800 Old US1 Hwy.

Re Watkins Cem Milburnie Rd/Watkins (Town) Rd where Elmer Linwood Watkins (wife Lydia Tessie Cross) bur: Have found which Watkins cem. See enclosed obit of Daniel Wayne Upchurch (24 Sep 1956-7 Jan 1988). His mother (no relation to Elmer, she says) was 2nd wife of Ivan Carey Upchurch (1904-1957). I've missed the *Upchurch Bulletin*, but I understand - they were *gratis* a long time and I did not return in kind! I know the State Library receives them. One day when I get there again, I'll catch up on 1996. I really appreciated and enjoyed them and want you to know there is a plan for whenever I release them or when the family has to do it - ha! Among several who've borrowed them, I particularly recall Jessie Ruth Norris (haven't seen her lately, perhaps not out as much - she is stone deaf and everyone worries about her driving). When will your Upchurch book be ready?

That question drives me up the wall! I just answer, "When it's done." Had hoped this would be the year or in time for June '97 reunion in Henry County TN hosted by the Jesse Olive branch. Correspondence has consumed me most of the past two years. Kit and I made a 31-day trip in '95 to LA, TX, OK, back via AR and TN. A great trip and many contacts! The original Olive book, however, may get reprinted in time. With so many into genealogy, it is in demand. Someone with a fairly clean copy was willing for it to be taken apart for copying. We tried for years to get the lady in TX who has the original pages to do this - BUT, another story! The new book will be an update of just one of the seven sons of the original Wake ancestor.

I want to do more research on Mary O. Upchurch's natal family (and her own which you have helped) but may have to throw in the towel. It and an aunt are the least-known about of 10 siblings (main chapters). Children in 1830 census could be anyone. Of 5 girls and 1 boy only she and sister Martha are identified. With no will, estate record, or widow's provision — it's as though something quick wiped out the others.

Enclosed are a few news clips. A probate date is missing, probably in early '90s - probates have not been carried for a year or so. I may have more in piles of unsorted items! Clearing the room when company comes, they get thrown in a box.

Hope you and yours are having a nice holiday season. We were in St. Louis for several Christmases. My sister and families are no longer there. Your son knew her son-in-law Chuck McElroy. After moving to San Antonio with tel co, he worked on plans for merging with Cox (it fell through) but did such a good job Cox asked him to come with them in Atlanta. Jean and Tom liked that since they had retired in Greenwood SC. Their son is also now in Atlanta and their other daughter is here.

During Celeste's fall break from college, she and Irene traveled to the Outer Banks.
- started out pretty well, but in May Celeste developed purpura...in 8 months was finally declared healthy. A few days after her hospitalization, she and Irene in Kit's car (he was in Acapulco at the annual meeting) were hit by a car...we had on our seatbelts and Celeste's quick reflexes prevented no more than minor bruises and \$2000+ damages. Six weeks later the plans to have Celeste's spleen removed (due to the ITP, not the accident) came to a halt when at 3:05 p.m. on June 20, our house was struck by lightning and subsequent fire. Fortunately, or unfortunately, we were not at home although Jacques was downstairs and made it through, but has not been the same since...Celeste's fish and guinea pig in the upstairs did not survive. Thanks to Kit's good planning our insurance has been adequate; but we had never made an inventory of the house contents and personal belongings, never dreaming this would ever happen. A bright spot in September was a nice company trip to Harrisburg PA. We stopped a short while going up in Gettysburg, also went to Reading, and on our return met Kit's cousins in Frederick MD and saw his mother's ancestral lands, churches and cemeteries.
- 1985 began with Kit changing companies after 18 years. He had traveled the eastern Carolinas, southern and western Virginia the year before, but now stays in our area again. Irene, Celeste and Dad Olive left March 1 for a week in Missouri to see the great-grandson of the family (Matt McElroy, son of Jean's Lori). Two days later the tunnel near Tennessee caved in, so we returned via West Virginia with a side trip in Indiana to Lincoln City that thrilled Dad. In the early evening of March 26 came the shock that Dad was suddenly called to his heavenly abode while planting onions in his garden. He was looking forward to Halley's comet again, having seen it in 1910 while in high school here at Cary. Jean has been back twice and we finally have the house in Southern Pines on the market. Celeste had a wonderful 8 weeks (but anxious ones for Mom and Pop) doing "Meredith Abroad" in Stirling, Scotland and in London and visiting Paris over the long July 4th week-end. This fall she has been a co-oping student at Northern Telecom in the Research Triangle Park, and will work there again next summer. In December of '86 she expects to become a Meredith graduate, majoring in math and minoring in communications. Dear "Would Be" Cousin Phil,

I decided to write rather than wading through <u>all</u> 50+ issues of *Upchurch Bulletin* - which I've done a couple of times, so I know it will take less time to write! If you ever do an alphabetical index for finding "whoever" a bit easier, do let me know.

I have a 2nd Upchurch folder where I put tid-bits I come across, but cannot find now! I was in Henry County TN last summer for reunion of grandson of an Olive girl (Mary O. Upchurch's aunt) who went there about 1810 - married a Lashlee. They are all over the USA now - first time together in 30 years. Monday I spent in library at Paris and xeroxed something for you. Am sure you have the family, but it seems there was something more when I compared it in UB. Perhaps the folder will turn up before I mail this.

As you know, I've been trying to locate descendants of Acril and Mary Olive Upchurch. Still have not heard from Margaret Alkek - either something is very wrong or I'm convinced that she's one of those interested only in her stright line. I've debated about trying to find her daughter for update of their data though.

Anyhow, I was in National Archives a few "short" hours Wednesday of this week. Located three promising Upchurches in 1900 TN Soundex - enclosed is a separate sheet. Two could be sons of Wm. G. Upchurch (1835/6-??). I think we've cleared up the fact that Wm. Garland is another Wm. G. Wish there had been time to go on to the 1910/20 soundexes and then to the actual census records.

Ike L. is surely Wm. G.'s son and maybe Bill. Perhaps you can identify the other Wm. and that it might be of help to you. I had worked on theory that possibly Mary and Acril's entire family moved on westward, but decided any who lived may have remained in TN after all. At least Jackson County and Memphis are new clues.

We're having a 3rd Olive Roundup (after our famous TX cowboys!) the very end of July at Cary's Hampton Inn. Wish you were going to be here then and could pop in.
