Upchurch Family Helped Make Texas History Story To Be Told

Members of the Upchurch family began to arrive in Texas before 1840 when it was still a Republic. For the 150 years since that time they have continued to strive and have helped to make Texas what it is today. Members have served in agriculture, business, medicine, government, religion, the military and on and on.

The Story of the Upchurch family in Texas will be told in a lecture to be given at:

All interested parties are invited to attend this lecture for which there is no charge. A question and answer session will follow.

The lecture will be given by Robert Phillip Upchurch, Phd. who is a Professor Emeritus, The University of Arizona. Professor Upchurch has spent 25 years studying the Upchurch family. He is editor of the Upchurch Bulletin now in its 17th year of publication and in which 39,000 members of the extended Upchurch family have been identified. The presentation will detail how all Upchurches in America descend from Michael Upchurch I, who came to Virginia from England in 1638. Upchurch family members have distinguished themselves in Texas since they started arriving on horseback and in covered wagons. They have served in high state offices, in the State legislature, in top business circles and in every walk of life.

Professor Upchurch has divided the Upchurch family into 22 clans, each headed by a greatgreatgrandson of the original immigrant. These clan heads lived about the time of the Revolution and many of them served in the Revolution. With minimum information the Professor is able to immediately place about ninety percent of present-day family members in the appropriate clan. Many family members no longer bear the Upchurch name, having descended from an Upchurch female.

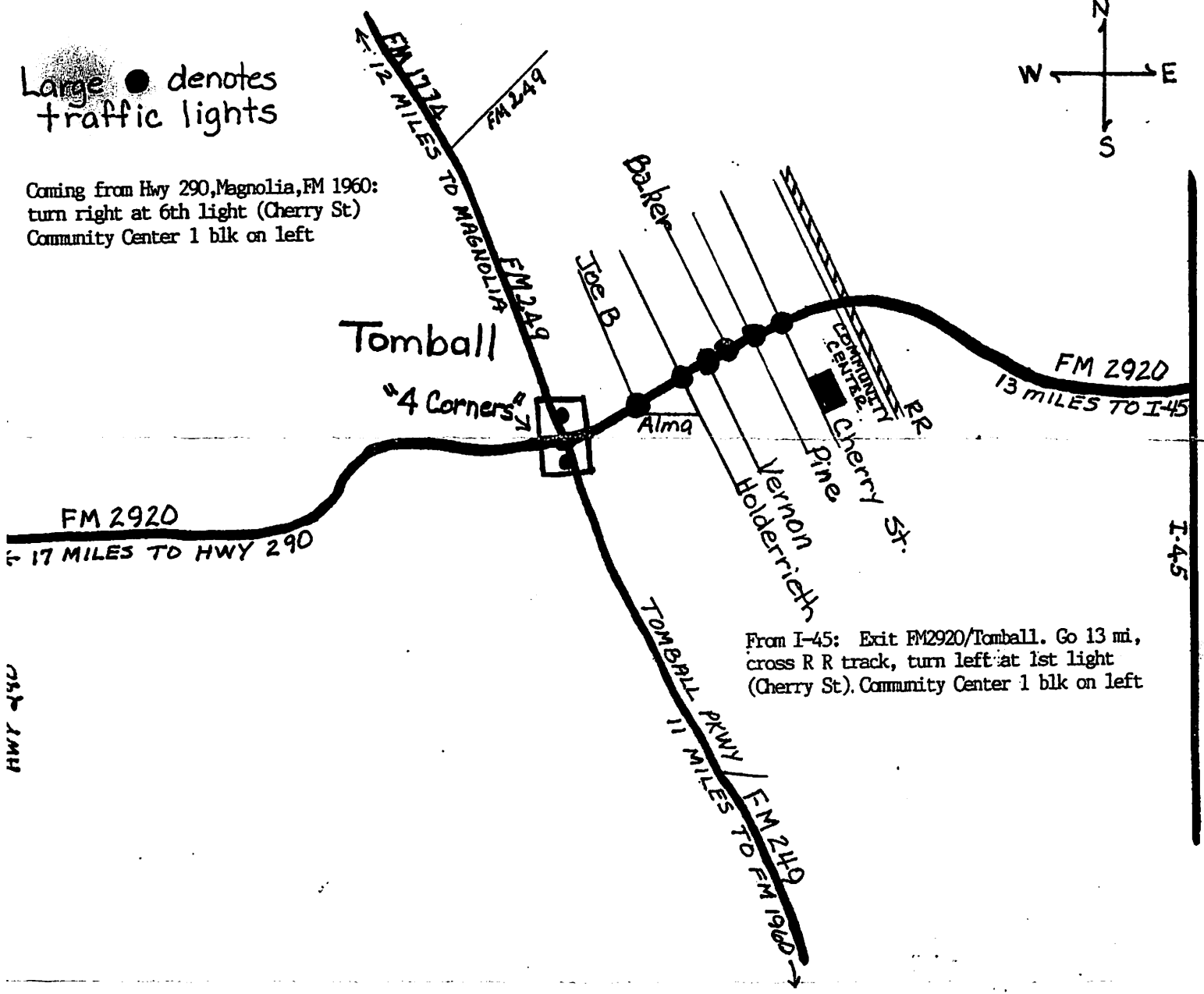
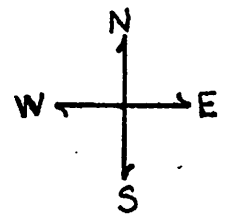
