THE EARLY HISTORY OF THE MEDLIN FAMILY IN NORTH CAROLINA

The Medlin family is believed to have first settled in America from England in the 17th Century. Largely due to the sparsity of documentation that survived the first two hundred years, the early history of our Medlin family between 1635 and 1835 is hard to retrace with precise certainty.

After Sir Walter Raleigh's first "Lost Colony" of Virginia failed on Roanoke Island in the 1580's in what is now North Carolina, the first permanent English colony was established in Jamestown, Virginia in 1607.

George Medlin (Medland) (Midland), one of the first settlers in Isle Of Wight County, Virginia, arrived there between 1635 and 1642, owned land there in 1647, and died in Isle of Wight County in 1665. George Medlin had no known male sons but was survived by two daughters, Mary and Sarah.

Settlers in Virginia pushed westward and southward into the Albemarle Sound region of what is now North Carolina but what was then within the boundaries of Virginia including down to the Chowan River. In 1629, Charles I granted the territory between 31 degrees and 36 degrees north latitude to Sir Robert Heath and named it "Carolana". In 1654, Nathaniel Batts, the first known permanent white settler in what is now North Carolina, built a home on Albemarle Sound below Chowan River.

In 1663, the colony of "Carolina" was created by King Charles II of England who granted a charter to the eight Lords Proprietors for the territory between 31 and 36 degrees north latitude. When the proprietors discovered that the charter did not include the southern frontier of Virginia that was already settled, the charter was amended in 1665 to include the territory between 29 and 36.5 degrees north latitude.

Carolina was first divided into three counties: 1. Albemarle County, north of the Albemarle River; 2. Clarendon County, south of Albemarle to Cape Fear; and 3. Craven County, south of Cape Fear. After Clarendon County and the initial Charles Town settlement there on the Cape Fear River was abandoned in 1667, Albemarle County became the only government in the province of Carolina that was in the region of what is now the state of North Carolina.

In 1670, Albemarle County was divided into four precincts: Chowan, Pasquotank, Perquimans, and Currituck.

Charles Town (later Charleston) was established on the Ashley and Cooper Rivers in Craven County in 1670 in what is now South Carolina.

Richard Medlin (I), a mason, and his wife, Rachel, immigrated from England and on August 10, 1678 were granted land to be surveyed and laid out on James Island near Charles Town. On June 24, 1679, Richard and Rachel Medlin (Meadlin) abandoned their first grant and received a second grant on the south side of the Ashley River in the colony of Caroline.

According to Society of Friends church records, this Richard Medlin in Charleston, SC was a Quaker. Quakers were documented living in (South) Carolina beginning in 1666. Like many other groups, they came to America seeking freedom from religious persecution. The simple, tolerant, peaceful Quakers played a major role in the political leadership during the crucial proprietary stage of the infant colony.

To escape raiding Spaniards from Florida, Richard Medlin (I) and Rachel Medlin migrated northward from the Charleston area of Carolina to the Albemarle area of Carolina or to Chesapeake area of Virginia.

Richard Medlin (II) was probably born around 1680 near New Kent County, Virginia to Richard and Rachel Medlin.

Richard Medlin (II) (Madlin) (Maidlin) and his wife, Susanna, had at least two known sons: Nicholas Medlin, baptized on April 16, 1699 and Richard Medlin (III) baptized on July 5, 1702, according to the vestry book of St. Peter's Parish in New Kent County, Virginia. On the same two pages in the same vestry book of New Kent County are also listed Thomas, the son of Richard Melton, baptized April 28, 170[], and Mary, the daughter of Richard Melton, baptized on May 10, 1702. This may perhaps be an incorrect transcription and these last two children may indeed also be the children of Richard Medlin.

In 1702 in the same vestry book referenced above, Richard Medlin (Maidlin), John Tyler, and Nicholas Gentry are ordered to help George Alvis clear the roads in New Kent County.

On April 25, 1701, in King and Queen County, Virginia, Charles Fleming is granted a patent in Pamunkey Neck on branches of Mahixon Creek adjoining Col. Johnson, Bradley, and Ralph Wormeley, for importation of 25 persons including Richard Maidling and Susannah Maidling.

Quakers became active in Albemarle County, North Carolina about 1672 and continued to increase in numbers and influence in the region up until about 1730. They were better organized than any other religion and the Quakers held the balance of power in the province. John Archdale, a Quaker proprietor, was a very sound governor of Carolina from 1694 to 1696.

On December 7, 1710, North Carolina and South Carolina were made separate provinces. Additional settlements in the Carolinas were strongly encouraged by the proprietors who collected quitrents on the land. Increased tariffs on Virginia tobacco motivated many settlers there to migrate to North Carolina. Like many early settlers in Virginia, the Richard Medlin family gradually migrated from southeastern Virginia into northeastern North Carolina.

On March 9, 1717, a grant of 600 acres was issued in the name of Richard Melton in Chowan Precinct, Albemarle County, North Carolina, on north east side of Morratock (Roanoke) River adjoining Benjamin Foreman, the low lands of the river, and the fork of the Beaver Dam Branch. This writer believes that this is an incorrect transcription and that this Richard Melton is indeed Richard Medlin. Once his name was incorrectly transcribed on his first deed, it was misspelled on other documents referring to the original deed. Later transactions clearly by Richard Medlin with the same neighbors prove that he was an early settler in Chowan Precinct before 1728.

The Richard Medlin in Chowan Precinct of Albemarle County in 1717 is believed to be the first known Medlin to be documented living in North Carolina. Also in Albemarle County, a Richard Madren was documented in Pasquotank Precinct as early as 1694 and a Richard Melton was documented in Chowan Precinct as early as 1701.

On March 9, 1717 in Chowan Precinct in Albemarle County, John Medlin (Melton) was issued a grant of 400 acres on the south side of Ahotsky Swamp, joining John Devesson. Ahotsky Swamp is located in what is now Hertford County, previously Northampton and Bertie County.

On January 26, 1720, Samuel Sizemore sold land to John Dickinson in Chowan Precinct on the north side of the Indian swamp, joining the lands of Richard Medlin (Melton).

On April 1, 1721, Richard Medlin (Melton) was granted a land patent for 640 acres on north side of Morrattuck River and on north side of Village Swamp in Chowan Precinct.

In May 1721, John Dickinson sold land to Thomas Hart in Chowan Precinct joining the land of Richard Medlin (Melton).

On April 4, 1722, Richard Medlin (Melton), planter of Chowan Precinct, North Carolina, sold 640 acres of land to George Williams on the north east side of the Morratoke (Roanoke) River, joining George Williams and Foreman.

On October 2, 1722, Bertie Precinct was established as a separate precinct as part of Albemarle County, North Carolina on the west side of the Chowan River that had been previously part of Chowan Precinct. At that time, Bertie County bordered Virginia and encompassed a very large area including what is now Granville County and Franklin County.

On March 26, 1723, Richard Medlin (Melton) was granted 640 acres in Bertie County on the south side of Marattock River on both sides of a Marshy Branch that falls into Kehukie Swamp, joining Benjamin Foreman and crossing the said branch.

On March 26, 1723, Anne Medlin (Milton) was granted 625 acres in Bertie County on the south side of Moratock River in Bertie County, joining Richard Milton and the south side of Kehukee Swamp.

On March 26, 1723, Richard Medlin (Milton) was granted 514 acres in Bertie County on the south side of the Roanoak River and the south west side of Kehukee Swamp, joining said Kehukee and Colo. Jones at the mouth of the Kehuky.

On March 26, 1723, Richard Medlin (Milton) was granted 640 acres in Bertie County on the south side of Moratock River, joining Daniel McDaniel and the river pocoson.

On May 12, 1724, Richard Medlin (Melton) sold to John Hart 320 acres on north side of Moratock River in Bertie County, part of a patent granted to Richard Medlin (Melton) on April 1, 1723, witnessed by Thomas Futrell, Francis Parker, jurat. February Court, 1725.

On May 12, 1724, Richard Medlin (Milton) sold to Samuel Williams 320 acres on north side of Morratock River in Bertie County "upon ye Long Meadow", the other part of a 640 acre patent granted on April 1, 1723 to Richard Medlin, witnessed by Francis Parker, Thomas Futrill, jurat.

On January 3, 1725, Richard Medlin (Milton) sold to Francis Parker 640 acres of land patented in 1720 adjoining John Blount and Thomas Busby in Bertie County.

On January 10, 1725, Richard Medlin (Melton), carpenter, deeded for love and affection to Ann Yelverton, daughter of John and Elizabeth Yelverton, 200 acres of land on south side of Conaro Creek at mouth of Cabin Branch adjoining John Yelverton, with surviving rights to go to her eldest sister Elizabeth, recorded in May 1728, Bertie County Court. Ann Yelverton was probably the grandchild of Richard Medlin by his daughter, Elizabeth.

On January 15, 1725, in Bertie County, Richard Medlin (Melton) deeded power of attorney and also deeded 26 head of cattle, 3 mares and 1 horse, all to William Medlin.

On March 7, 1726, in Bertie County, William Gray sold to Robert Hodges land adjoining James Williams and Richard Medlin (Milton).

On March 10, 1726, Anne Bird and husband Barnabee Bird sold to Benjamin Foreman land on south side of Kehukee Swamp in Bertie County, adjoining land of Richard and Ann Medlin (Melton).

The long standing boundary dispute between North Carolina and Virginia was settled when the survey was run in 1728. On July 25, 1729, seven of the Lords Proprietors surrendered their grants back to the Crown. John Lord Carteret, who became Earl of Granville in 1744, retained his one-eighth interest and George II ordered that his share be surveyed. The Granville District, a sixty mile strip in upper North Carolina, was surveyed in 1744 to Bath, to Haw River in 1746, and finally to the Blue Ridge Mountains in 1774. During the American Revolution, the new sovereign state of North Carolina confiscated the Granville District. The South Carolina boundary was also disputed and the survey was not run until 1735. Disputes over the border with South Carolina continued until the Revolution, especially in Anson County.

In February, 1728, Richard Medlin (Madling) and Peter Cone witnessed the sale of land in Bertie County by Henry Rhodes to John Page at Cashie Swamp on Busbe's line.

On May 14, 1728, Richard Medlin (Meadling) purchased from Jacob Oadham of Nansemond County, Virginia, 640 acres of land in Bertie County at a branch of the Cashie River adjacent to Francis Parker and Thomas Busby.

On December 30, 1730 in Bertie County, Richard Medlin (Melton) sold to Richard Williams 600 acres of north side of Morratock River adjoining Benjamin Foreman that had been granted to Medlin on March 9, 1717.

On June 23, 1732 in Bertie County, the estate of Richard Melton, deceased, was inventoried by Jonathan Melton, administrator. The estate included horses, cows, farm tools, shoemaker tools, felling axes, one tomahawk, four drawing knives, carpenter tools, and cooper tools.

On April 11, 1732, as recorded in the vestry book of St. Paul's Parish of Hanover County, Virginia, Nicholas Medlin (Madelin), Henry Tyler, Joseph Gentry, and others are ordered to help Peter Harrelson clear his road. Nicholas Medlin married Ann Owen, daughter of William Owen of Hanover County, Virginia. Their marriage record in Virginia is missing both the date of the marriage and her husband's first name. On September 17, 1731, Ann Owen had been granted two land patents in Hanover County on both sides of Hickory Bear Creek. Her father died around 1753 and part of his will recorded in 1752 is missing.

Nicholas Medlin and Ann Owen had at least three sons: Nicholas Medlin (Jr.) born around 1720, William Owen Medlin (Senior) born circa 1723, and Joseph Medlin born ca. 1730.

In 1733 in the provincial executive council meeting of North Carolina held at Edenton in Chowan Precinct, a petition was presented protesting the proposed relocation of the province seat from Edenton. Signers of the petition from Bertie Precinct included Richard Medlin, John Medlin, a second Richard Medlin, Francis Parker, Thomas Busby, Benjamin Foreman, William Carter, John Maner, John Page, Jethro Butler, Thomas Fussell, Theophilus Williams, Needham Bryan, and Timothy Ryall. These men would remain neighbors of the Medlins as they migrated.

On January 8, 1734 in Bertie County, Lewis Bryan sold land to Nicholas Thompson on north side of Sandy Run, adjoining William Gray, Owen MackDaniel, and Richard Medlin (Melton).

On May 12, 1735 in Bertie County, Henry Avera sold to Joseph Thomas land on north side of Roanoke River adjoining John Blunt, Thomas Busby and Richard Medlin (Melton).

On November 20, 1736 in Bertie County, Nicholas Tompson sold land to Green Hill on north side of Sandy Run adjoining William Gray, Owen MackDaniel, and Richard Medlin (Milton).

On August 7, 1738 in Bertie County, Michael Hanley sold to John Johnson 340 acres on south side of Mahering River which was part of a patent of 640 acres granted on May 17, 1731 to Richard Medlin (Melton). Matthew Sellers and John Bardin witnessed the sale of part of the tract which was recorded in August Court, 1738, with Benjamin Sellers, Jurat.

On May 17, 1739, in Bertie County, Richard Medlin (Modling) was a witness to the sale of land at Village Swamp by Theophilus Williams to Thomas Barker.

On December 5, 1739, in Bertie County, Nicholas Medlin (Medline) and his wife, Ann, sold to James Stewart 440 acres of the 640 acres of land whereon Medlin lived on the north side of the Moratock (Roanoke) River, adjoining Francis Parker, to a branch of the Cashie River, adjoining Thomas Busby.

On July 20, 1740, Richard Medlin (III) and John Yelverton were listed as owing notes to the estate of John Page in Bertie County.

On February 7, 1742, Richard Medlin (III) witnessed the will of Owen MackDaniel at Chowan in Bertie County. Owen McDaniel left his manor plantation to his son-in-law, Jethro Butler.

On September 10, 1742, Theophilus Williams sold to Jethro Butler 500 acres to be laid out per the will of Thomas Busby on the northeast side of Morattuck River at Beaverdam Branch, adjoining Robert Melton, witnessed by Needham Bryan.

On May 10, 1743, in Bertie County Court held near Red Bud Branch, the will of Owen McDaniel was proved by oath of Richard Medlin (III) and John Campbell .

In 1741, Bertie County was divided and the largest part of Bertie County became Edgecombe County. In 1746, the largest part of Edgecombe County in turn became old Granville County.

On May 20, 1747 in Northampton County, John Medlin (Modglin) purchased from William Aycock a grant for 300 acres on the north side of Arthur's Creek, joining the Great pocoson at the mouth, John Avent, other land of William Aycock, and the creek. Northampton County was formed in 1741 as that part of Bertie County north and west of Sandy Run, to the head of Beaver Dam Swamp, down the swamp, Meherrin Creek and the River.

On February 9, 1748, Richard Medlin, Jr. is listed as a chain carrier with William Cade on a survey of land deeded on April 30, 1753 to Lodowick Alford for 600 acres on north side of Little Creek in Granville County and Johnston County. △+△

On October 8, 1754, Joseph Medlin and John Medlin (misspelled Meldey) were included on a muster roll of the North Carolina Militia Regiment in Granville County, North Carolina, under the command of Colonel William Eaton. Joseph Medlin was enlisted in Captain Osborn Jeffreys' Company along with his neighbors William Maynard, Julius Alford, James Bolton, and William Cade. John Medlin was enlisted in Captain Benjamin Simm's Company along with neighbor Lodowick Alford. The house built in 1770 by Osborne Jeffreys, the first sheriff of Franklin County in 1779, is still a current well-known landmark in the southern part of modern Franklin County, between Crooked Creek and Little River, just above the Wake County line. △+△

Bradley Medlin was drafted in 1780 in Franklin County, North Carolina and served two tours as an American Revolutionary War soldier from 1780 to 1782 enlisting under Captain William Ferrell. Bradley Medlin and his descendants moved to Tennessee in 1793 where he received land grants for his service. He lived in Wilson County in 1832 when he applied for a pension and he moved to Madison County, Tennessee in 1839 where he died on August 18, 1843.

Moccasin (Mockerson) (Mockoson) (Mockason) Creek forms the present day boundary between Franklin County and Wake County and between Johnston County and Nash County. Wake County was formed in 1771 from Johnston, Cumberland, and Orange Counties, with most of the territory coming from Johnston County including the area around Moccasin Creek. Nash County was formed in 1777 from Edgecombe County. Franklin County was formed in 1779 from Bute County. —

Moccasin Creek starts in Franklin County (formerly Bute/Granville/Edgecombe/Bertie/Albemarle County) and flows southeasterly to Wilson County where it joins Turkey Creek (from Nash County) to form Contentnea (Cotechney) Creek. Contentnea Creek flows through Greene County to Lenoir County where it dumps into the Neuse River down from Kinston. The Moccasin Creek/Contentnea Creek waterway is the largest tributary of the Neuse River and was sometimes known as the Moccasin River. A second and smaller Moccasin Creek starts in Johnston County near Selma and flows into the Neuse River in the southeast corner of Johnston County. It is apparent that Bryant Medlin, Sr. followed the watercourse of the Moccasin Creek/Neuse River basin in his early migration from present day Franklin County to present day Lenoir County.

In 1787, the northeast portion of original Wake County around "Mockason Swamp" east of Moccasin Creek was annexed into Franklin County. The dividing line between Wake County and Franklin County was disputed for many decades, causing much uncertainty over land deeds, voter registration, and census reporting. Surveys in 1805, 1806, and 1810, failed to resolve the agitation over the border. This border dispute continued unbelievably until 1915 when a survey acceptable to both counties was finalized. Several Medlin families lived in, and adjacent to, the disputed region and the confusion affected them for over a century. During the 128 years of boundary dispute, many Medlins who lived in Franklin County were reluctantly forced to go to Wake County Courthouse to perfect official transactions.

Numerous Medlin families were raised at the origin of the Moccasin Creek basin where the four corners of present day Franklin, Johnston, Nash and Wake Counties meet in a point. This area is bounded by the communities of Youngsville and Bunn in Franklin County, Middlesex in Nash County, Earpsboro in Johnston County, and Zebulon and Rolesville in Wake County. Many Medlins were raised inside the current limits of Dunn Township in Franklin County, especially in the area around the current communities of Riley, Pearces, and Pilot in Franklin County.

In 1790, in the first Federal census of the United States of America, twenty Medlins were listed as head of a family in North Carolina. Bryant Medlin (Jr.) and Shadrach Medlin were listed in Nash County. Joseph, Bradley, James, Matthew, Nancy, and William Medlin (Medlong) were listed in Franklin County. On April 18, 1833, a marriage bond was issued in Davidson County for Ryal (Rile) Medlin and
Elizabeth Floyd (Floyade), with Adam Shuler as bondsman.

On November 6, 1835, Elijah John Medlin purchased from Peter Owen 7.5 acres in Davidson
County next to Younts, Crotts, and the public land.

Since he did not appear in the 1840 census, it is believed that Bryant Medlin, Jr. probably died
between 1830 and 1839 in Davidson County, North Carolina, between age 66 and 75.

On April 14, 1842, a marriage bond was issued in Davidson County for Ryal (Riley) Medlin and
Tabbitha Floyd, with John Thompson as bondsman.

Many of the Medlin family groups first migrated in circles in eastern North Carolina and then
gradually migrated to western North Carolina before spreading to other states. From these early
migrations, large families of Medlins are still concentrated today in Franklin County, Johnston
County, Moore County, and Union County, North Carolina.

Most all of the Medlin families had early origins in the area of North Carolina which was first
part of Albemarle County, then Chowan, Bertie, Edgecombe, Granville, Bute, and finally
Franklin County after 1779. It is believed that all of the early Medlin families descended from
the Richard Medlin that settled around 1717 in Bertie County. Unfortunately, due to so much
documentation being lost forever, it is doubtful that the early Medlin lineage in North Carolina
can ever be completely and exactly traced.
