

In 1882, A. J. Woodward, J. A. Woodward, Mary H. Woodward, and S. E. A. Pope withdrew from Swift Creek Baptist Church and organized Oak Grove Primitive Baptist Church. Due to declining attendance, services were discontinued and the building sold in 2001. The church building is located on Penny Road just south of the intersection with Kildaire Farm Road, about two miles west from Swift Creek Baptist Church.
