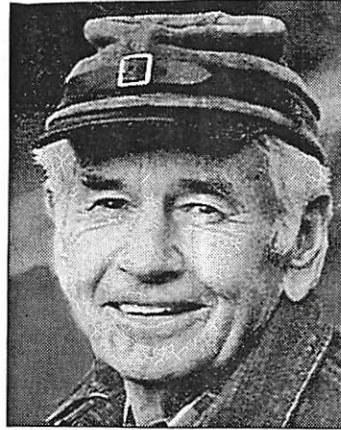

APEX — Joseph Earl "Joe" Montague, 87, of Wake County, died Saturday, March 16, 2002. Joe was born April 12, 1914 in Granville County to the late Archibald Montague and Pearl Hunt Montague where he spent his early childhood. He moved with his parents to Wake County in 1920. There he farmed with his father until he joined the U.S. Navy in 1935. Shortly after his discharge from the Navy, he married Hallie Verna Upchurch of Wake County in 1940. Soon thereafter, they established a home on the Upchurch Farm in the Wake Cross Roads Community. He was employed Pine State Creamery in a number of positions for 38 years.
