LOOKING BACK ON APEX

Items taken from the 1965 Apex Herald & Cary Enterprise

February 11, 1965 - The membership at Olive Chapel Baptist Church appointed William Seagrove and T. B. Holland to seek the needs of the Olive Chapel Community and report back to the church.

February 11, 1965 - The Progressive Grocery Store in Apex advertised Instant Maxwell House Coffee for \$1.49 pound; Crisco Lard, 3 pounds for 59 cents; Jesse Jones Franks, 12 oz. Package at 43 cents; and fresh coconuts at ten cents each.

February 11, 1965 - Apex Realty Company is now offering a great selection of homes in Apex with won-

derful designs for prices as low as \$8,500 and up to \$40,000.

February 11, 1965 - Spain's Restaurant on Highway #55 is running a special on their pizzas, buy one at \$1.25 and you get the second one for one cent. Their Friday fish special is \$1.25 and their Sunday buffet is only \$1.50.

February 18, 1965 - the Apex Lions Club honored Lawrence G. Jordan for 28 years of perfect attendance. Mr. Jordan served on the Apex Town Board for 22 years, with 14 of those years as Mayor. He moved to Apex from Wilmington in 1920 and started the L. G. Jordan Oil Company. (Note: This is one of the oldest continuing family businesses in Apex. His son Larry, presently President of Jordan Oil Company also served on the Apex Town Board and served as Mayor of Apex.)

February 18, 1965 - Apex Town Manager David Olive informed the Town Council that streetlights were being placed at the intersection of highway #55 and Hughes Street. Also, at the same council meeting, Chief of Police Ritter informed the council that January was the first month in 5 1/2 years that no traffic accident had occurred in Apex.

February 18, 1965 - At the 8th annual meeting of the Apex Jaycees, Allen Lee Lawrence was awarded the club's "Distinguished Service Award."

February 25, 1965 - Pegram Pharmacy holds open House to show off their new drug store at the corner of Moore and South Salem Streets. Mr. Calvin W. Pegram came to Apex in 1939 from Lenoir, North Carolina where he was in the dairy business. His wife was a registered pharmacist. (The Basket Tree Florist currently occupies the building.)

February 23, 1965 - At the annual gathering of the Apex Woman's Club the group was entertained with a variety show by inmates from Central Prison in Raleigh.

February 25, 1965 - The beautiful red head Ms. Betty Garmon is now the new office manager of the Apex Chamber of Commerce, which is located in the Savings & Loan office across from the Apex Fire Department. Ms. Garmon reports that the Chamber now has 74 members and growing.

March 4, 1965 - Mills Service Center opens in a building located at North Salem Street and E. Thompson Street. The business will serve Sinclair gasoline. Joe Mills Sr., is owner.

March 4, 1965 - Daylene Page of Apex was arrested by local police for practicing dentistry without a license. Page had taken the dental exam twice, but failed each time. He was doing the illegal work in his home.

March 4, 1965 - The Progressive Grocery Store on Williams Street has been completed and is ready for shoppers. The new building cost \$200,000 and is 10,000 square feet in size. There is also a paved parking lot for 80 automobiles.

March 11, 1965 - Apex Police Chief Ronald Ritter announces his department now has a new patrol car. The car was formally owned by the N. C. Highway Patrol. The car has a new radio that is connected with other law enforcement agencies in the county. The radio cost \$750. The car was purchased at a cost of \$1,500.

March 11, 1965 - During a routine stop, Apex police arrested a man from Erwin for transporting 14 cases (168 jars) of non-tax paid whiskey. The car was registered to another man with an Erwin address.

April 1, 1965 - Kaye Upchurch, senior at Apex High School was voted Miss. Yellow Jacket for 1965. The school's newspaper was called "The Buzz." There were 77 graduates in the 1965 Apex High School graduating class.

June 3, 1965 - Sandra Olive was voted "Miss Apex" for 1965. She will now go on to compete in the fall's Miss North Carolina contest. In November of 1964 Miss Olive won the crown of National Grange Princess.

June 17, 1965 - The Apex Chamber of Commerce is having a great year. Early in the year they sponsored a "Clean up, Paint up and Fix up campaign. The building downtown owned by E. L. Seagroves won the contest for "most improved business."
