Hi Anna----

Good to hear from you. I will try to answer your questions.

- 1. Archivist--etc. These are terms to give visibility to those who go the extra distance money-wise in supporting the vision of Allied Families. So far we have about three dozen of these. We hope to have 200 regular paying members in a year or so but at \$20 that only brings in \$4,000. This is not enough to provide the needed funds so we count on those extra distance people. And yet if a person is really interested but on a very limited budget I make them a Corresponding Member at no charge. When people give more than \$20 we plan to put much of the sum over @\$20 in a long term support fund for their enrolled family and Allied Families. So far that support fund stands on a pooled basis at about \$6,000. At \$10,000 it will reach endowment status.
- 2. Allied Families is based on 60+ years of research done on the Upchurch family by Morgan, West and me and others. Along the way data was collected on a great many non-Upchurch families. The most important of these would be candidate families to be enrolled under the banner of Allied Families. We consider each family on it's merit and can only proceed to enroll a new one if we have at least a minimum of support from descendants--- time, money, expertise, data, etc. However, in theory any family could be enrolled.
- 3. As we enroll Upchurch families headed by a patriarch who lived about the time of the Revolution we will embrace all the families that joined by marriage, the Dishman family is a good example. Go to our website an look up the enrolled family of George U. You will see that we bring his daughter Lydia into the story. To enhance this story we plan to transcribe an post on our website the Biofiles of Lydia and her husband and their children and their spouses. Maybe you are in a position to help with these transcriptions. Of course we could enroll the Dishman family separately if the was enough interest and support. The gold standard would be for each family to have its own enrollment. We have about 22 families now scheduled to be enrolled and and could have 40 sometime in 2017. The progress on each family will depend on the support we get. I can see us have as many as 50 enrolled families but beyond that we have to make sure we do not exceed our resources.

I trust you will have noticed that each family is supported by our resource file and our set of projects. These will grow over time. Also note that sharing and preserving the records on-line for the long term is a key to our operation.

Let me know if you have more questions. Do come aboard.
