Can you advise me as to which tree I should follow. Alternatively, if you can email me a descendancy chart that would be very helpful.

While you can help me on the descendants of Mary and George, I can help you on the ancestors of Mary and it appears

you have already had a good look at my records. Of course I have tons more in my files.

Your Abel, Sr and my ancestor Nathan U.,I were brothers. From the UB issues you can learn about their heritage going back to Michael Upchurch. The brothers grew up together in Franklin County, N.C. in the Moccasin Creek area and in the UI issues I have written of my many trips to the area and about what I have learned. I hope to visit again in June. Abel U. Sr left NC about 1820 and there is some prospect that he had two families but this needs study. Also, among his children documented in AL there appeared late on the scene a female who seems to be a not before documented daughter. All of th is from my memory and one needs to check the records to see where to go next. There is always more to do.

I forgot to answer the question you asked about privacy. On my Master Outlines I enter everything and share all as these records are closely held and I send copies only to my cooperators. In a way it is good that I did this in that many of the people for whom I collected data from cooperators and elsewhere are now deceased. Had I been more restrictive the data would not have been preserved/shared as completely. I have tended not to be so regimented in holding data close for living persons as much of it is publicly available anyway and those of us in the family history mode just handicap ourselves by giving extra emphasis to privacy. That having been said, I yield to the matter of privacy as we move to the Internet as there we are more susceptible to being taken advantage of and people are generally more concerned about privacy. We are now starting to construct family trees for enrolled families as a part of the Allied Families operation. These will be public trees and there we will adhere to the concept that nothing is shared for living persons.

Do let me have any thoughts that come to mind.

Hi Bill---

Thanks for giving me a big boost on the Mary Catherine (U.) Nelson Line in the Abe U., Sr/John U. SubClan. I was able to print and process the pdf you sent which provided me with details on 27 individuals. I assume the other attachment would simply duplicate the pdf and if not please let me know. I was left with a puzzle as to how to navigate it.

For the 27 I have made an extract sheet covering them all and have assigned XID numbers and have entered the data into my Master Outline Notebook for this SubClan. Now to file the 27 sheets in my Biofile System where there are Biofiles on several hundred thousand individuals accumulated over the last 40 years. As I file these I will be alert for any surprises.

There are several paths our collaboration could take and I will let that unfold as it will. Initially, I ask if you have any special thoughts or questions. I have some data, more or less, on the 15 children of John U. In going from him down to the 9th generation I have 46 pages and will be happy to copy and send you any or all of these as you desire. There is always more work to be done on these. The descendants (if any/if known) of the ninth generation are maintained in Continuation Sections. So far I have descendant of 91 of the GGC of John. I would propose to send these at this time. Perhaps by then you will have had a look at Allied Families.

I am gradually contacting all Volunteers who are helping create family trees for Allied Families. Some confusion has arisen due to the fact that we assigned some Active Tree Masters starting a couple of years ago and then recently we decided to downplay Active Trees in favor of Legacy Trees. So we are generally suspending work on Active Trees until we can get the Legacy effort well underway and pending the creation of good guidelines for populating Active Trees.

We have you listed as an Editor for both the Abel Upchurch, Sr Active and Legacy Trees and will leave it that way but prefer that you concentrate on the Legacy Tree. OK?

We also have you as Editor of the Tree for the first five generations. Let us leave that as it is understanding that I need to vet what you have done so that we can lock it in place as a Legacy effort. Then we can start an Active Tree of the first five generations with the understanding that few if any names will be added but that some data may be added or upgraded giving sources. I am most appreciative for your important contributions and for your flexibility. Please let me know of any concerns or questions.

Just to be clear about our Allied Families Trees I offer the following:

Legacy Trees--- These represent exactly what I placed in my manually kept Master Outline notebooks for 40 years. An Allied Families Advisory Panel recommended that these notebooks be scanned and that Allied Families recruit Volunteer Tree Masters to create an Allied Families Tree for each of the 22 Upchurch Clans. These are to be labeled, for example, "Moses Upchurch RPU Legacy Tree". These trees will become archival and never changed but will be available for off-takes to contribute to "Active" Trees. Note that sources or supplemental information such as photos are not to be added to the Legacy Trees. It is understood that the sources are the Biofiles I created which are being treated on their own separate from the Master Outlines/Legacy Trees. Creating a full set of Legacy Trees is now a very high priority for Allied Families.

Active Trees--- Once we are well along in creating Legacy Trees Volunteer Tree Masters will be recruited to create active trees to be labeled, for example, "Charles Upchurch Allied Families Active Tree" or some other suitable title. Once started these "Active " Trees for each of our enrolled families will be subject to continual improvement. Data to populate and Active Tree can come from a Legacy Tree or from any other source including electronic transfers. The guidelines for Tree Masters for Active Trees will be more complex than the ones for Legacy Trees and are still in preparation. Tree Masters for Active Trees will be expected to collaborate with others who are willing to contribute data. We started a few Active Trees a coupe of years ago before we committed to first doing Legacy Trees. Work on such Active trees is now being suspended or kept to simple additions.

I trust that you and your family are doing well. At my end my last Cat Scan a week or so ago showed my tumor stable which is great news. I am one lucky guy.

I have completed entering the First Five Generations into the <u>ancestry.com</u> Descendants of Michael Upchurch tree. I note the following on your handwritten chart for the first five generations:

- 1. Charles, son of Richard II has a "p" preceding his marriage date, marriage location and spouse. What does the "p" denote?
- 2. William IV, son of Michael III has arrow from "b" to 17xx (crossed out) and 1726 entered. Father Michael III has birth date of 1728, after his son's birth. Ancestry.com tree already had a birth date of 1758. Resolution is needed.
- 3. William IV, son of Michael III spouse is Sarah _____ with no birth or death data. Ancestry.com tree already has spouse as Sarah Williams and her birth of 1737. If husband William IV was born in 1758, then she would be about 20 years older than him. This is possible but probably needs further investigation.

I found it difficult to sort out each individual's data on the handwritten chart and recommend someone review the <u>ancestry.com</u> tree to validate my entries.

This email is to thank you for your participation in our Allied Families History Association and to ask for your feedback concerning your future participation. You are among fifty on our list as active Biofile transcribers or as active in helping to create "Trees" on Ancestry.com. This same email is being sent to all cooperators who have volunteered to make computer entries for our family history effort. Our focus has evolved along the way and I may have missed a beat with some cooperators. This email may even cross paths with other exchanges I have with you. Let me describe to you our current priorities to give you more background.

Biofile Projects:

Part I: We are using Volunteers to transcribe the Biofiles of the Patriarchs of enrolled families along with Biofiles of their children and grandchildren and their spouses. Our current <u>highest priority</u> is to enter the data from these Notebooks into <u>Ancestry.com</u> trees Clan by Clan and to label them "RPU Legacy Trees" They are not to be changed but the data will be available for adoption or as a source to be cited. If you are familiar with making entries in <u>Ancestry.com</u> or are will to learn your help as a volunteer Tree Master will be highly valuable.

Part IV: After Part III has been completed we will ramp up our effort to create "Living" Trees on <u>Ancestry.com</u> for each of our enrolled families. Some of this work has been started but we prefer to concentrate on Part III covering the the Master Outlines for now.

- 4. Generation 4 Master outline has Richard II father of eleven children. Suffix chart does not include Charles, Betty and Nancy.

We have very incomplete sources/records for dates/places for the five generations. I have faced this for years. With regard to birth dates, I invite you to see the framework article prepared and presented on Page 7 of UB Vol 35 NO1 Jan-Dec 2014. Note that I failed to catch the William/Richard conflict you noted.

I now realize that we need to transcribe and post the Biofiles of all our first five generations of our Upchurch family. They also need to be studied for sources for dates/places for the article outline you are preparing. These operations are important and need to be done, but I would rather you do the best you can using "unknown", if necessary. We can then post your best effort on our website with a note that more work to be done. Maybe this will encourage others to come forward with facts and sources. Is this approach okay with you?
