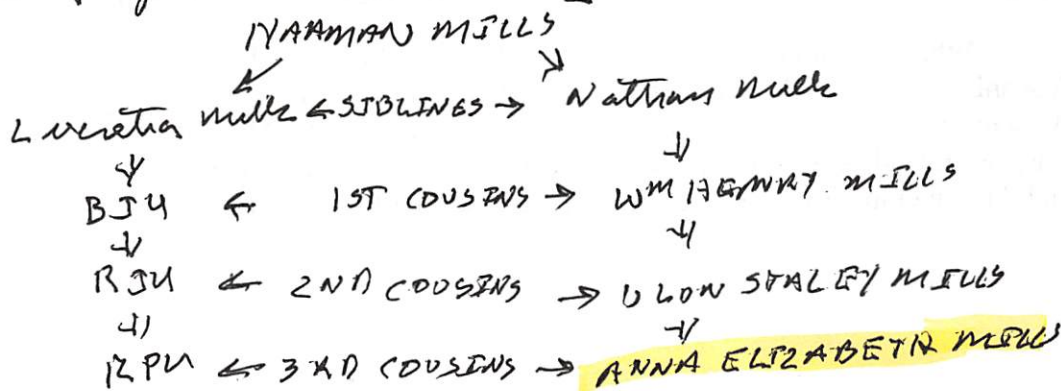

ANNA DORA MILLS

Anna Dora Moore Mills, 90, a former resident of Apex, died Thursday evening in Lillington. She was born in Hong Kong, China in 1905 and moved to the United States at the age of 12 with her Southern Baptist Missionary parents, Anna McIver Moore of Moravian Falls, N.C. and Samuel Robert Moore, Sr. of London, England. In 1965 she organized and directed Apex's first children's day care program and kindergarten. It was named Jack & Jill.

She was a member of Olive Chapel Baptist Church where she served in the children's departments of Sunday School, missions and music.

Funeral services were held Monday in the Olive Chapel Baptist Church. Rev. William Mills and Rev. O. Phillip Qualls officiated. Burial followed in the church cemetery.

Surviving Mrs. Mills are five children; one son, Norman Mills and wife, Pat of Trinity, N.C.; four daughters, Dorothy Mills and husband William, Nancy Olive and husband Ross, Jacquelyn Smith and the late Earl, all of Apex; Anna Kilzer and the late Robert of Missouri; three brothers, Felix Moore of W. Va., Rev. Frank Moore of Charlotte, Dr. Donald Moore of Coats; 15 grandchildren and 16 great-grandchildren.

The family received friends at the Apex Funeral Home.

Her Uncle Louisa Mills was known to be an alcoholic. We agreed to talk again after our Mills books arrive. She has ordered one.
