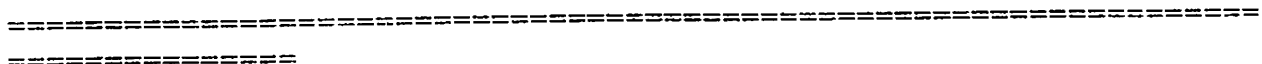

  - Was his legal first name "CHARLES" or "CHARLIE"
  - Was his death date 1 OCT 1968 or XX JAN 1967?

You offered to send TN census records. I have some of these but will be happy to have a copy of what you can send without too much trouble. If you prefer I can send you a list of what I have so as to avoid duplication. Sometimes duplication helps as one person extracting may get what

submit another missive.

You asked for the address for Elaine Morgan's daughter. It is provided in the enclosed copy of my letter of 28 FEB 1997. She gave no response to this letter. The tone of the letter was to welcome a response but not to require one. I don't know the details of the interaction between Cousin Jim & Kay but the reprinting of the book did not occur. My last interaction with KAY was a phone call to her on 26 FEB 1987. At that time her phone no was (913) 541-9166

If you pursue the matter of Elaine Morgan's papers, I hope you will be successful. Let me offer some comments in case they might be helpful.

#1. The best place to archive the papers in my opinion would be with the Wayne Co, KY Historical Society. This is because Mrs Morgan came from there and much of her work was centered on the family of George H the Patriarch of Wayne Co, KY Upland. Also, they have acquired an old hotel and are renovating it as a historical center and in due course can handle records such as Morgan collected.

4.

#2. Margaris' collection might generate a tax deduction for Kay if she donated them to a charitable organization such as the Wayne Co, KY Historical Society (Assuming the Society has a proper IRS classification).

#3 To get a substantial tax deduction the collection would have to be appraised. The receiving organization will normally not pay for such an appraisal.

You could either proceed directly to contact Kay and get a response from her. The tax issue may or may not be of interest to her. If she is at all interested, because of the tax issue or otherwise, we could somehow resolve any issues that are a bother to her.

If you want to do more work on #1, #2, #3 above before or after contacting Kay and want my help, please let me know. This would be a great project if you could make it happen.

B. WIVES OF GEORGE W b 1810: His last wife was Mary Ann - <sup>yes</sup> ~~year~~ <sup>Crabtree</sup> whom he married in 1856 and by whom he had SON #5. His previous wife was LOUISA - who is reported to have died (presumably between 1850 & 1856) leaving George W b 1810 with 2 small sons. There is an open question as to whether George W b 1810 had even earlier (making possibly 3 wives) a wife by whom he could have had SON #1

- ② The item below is an excerpt from a 12 DEC 2000 ltr from Laura Joanne (Margan) Bass to RPA. She is a GGD of George U b 1810 head of the George U Line in the George U / Shadrach U subclan. The names provided by Joanne in the excerpt are shown in context below.

I've been very interested in the research Melva has done, and have been fascinated by the possibility (probability?) that George Upchurch (1810) had another child. The only children I had ever heard of was Shadrack - the older half brother of Giles, and William Alfred. My mother knew very little family history - she said she thought Giles was an orphan and that he might have been raised by a brother. I had supposed that brother was Shadrack, although now I'm wondering! I have heard of "Uncle Alf" from Will, Palmer and John.

The enclosed e-mail I copied from an internet list spurred me to write tonight. The information this lady describes, is near the stories I had heard about what happened to the Upchurch farm in Wayne County, and the reason John Henderson became interested in tracking down the heirs. My mother had told me that for several years after they came to Missouri, Giles received royalties from oil on the land and "then they just gradually stopped coming."

During the late '40s or early '50s Will Upchurch and his wife Hettie made a visit to Wayne county. Hettie said "thousands of dollars of virgin timber" had been cut and sold off. The impression was that because there was no one around to keep them from doing it, the lumber company just went in and illegally cut the timber. John was interested in running down all the information and tracking down all the living relatives, but I think it was more an interest in the history than in actually making claim on behalf of the heirs. My mother raised John and Avanel after their mother died, as well as Laurie who was born in 1901. John tragically contracted tuberculosis of the bone and lost a leg when he was about 11 or 12 years old. After graduating from high school, he went on to Chillicothe (MO) business college, and upon graduating, took a civil service exam. While waiting for an appointment, he worked at Longview - a large horse farm near Kansas City. The owner, Miss Lula Long, showed horses around the country, and always at the American Royal in Kansas City. He didn't keep in close touch with the family for several years after he went to Washington DC, however in later years he did. His lady friend corresponded with my mother from time to time, and I wrote to her after my mother's death and heard from her once or twice. She had several old family pictures - tin types, etc, and Giles 'gold watch.' Unfortunately I haven't heard from her for 25 or more years, and I can't remember her last name - first name was Garland. I'm sure she is dead and it would be anyone's guess as to what happened to the family pictures, or the papers he had developed from his family research.

William Thomas (Shell) Upchurch left Uncle Moses Upchurch's home while still in his teens. He said that Uncle Moses' son Ahile (Hiram H. Upchurch, b. 3-16-1844, hence four years older than Shell) made him work too hard. Shell joined a group of Confederate soldiers moving through Wayne Co. He went to Cumberland Co. He first became a water boy with the Confederate Army. When old enough became a soldier. After the war he walked from Burkesville, KY to Celina, TN. He was captured (probably by two Union soldiers). They tied him up by his thumbs from a tree limb. He almost died, but was rescued by a black man. Shell later found the two men in a tavern. He shot and killed both of them. Local people never reported the incident. Shell went to the Obie River area in Tennessee and had two families.

First marriage: at age 21 Shell married <sup>Victoria</sup> Viola Bow, age 17, from Cumberland Co., KY. They had two children; daughter Tina and son James Andrew. BOWE & TX

Second marriage: married Sarah Eden, b. 8-25-1852, d. 3-30-1920. They had six children;

- 1) Ira, b. 1881, disappeared with no record after 1917; heard he was killed as a border guard on the Mexico border. *Lived in Oklahoma*

I had almost given up on finding any clues until Ruble sent me a letter which he had from Anne Keisling, a descendant of William Thomas. Her mother was Mary Pearl and she has this to say about her father, William Thomas Upchurch: She is not sure whether George Washington Upchurch was her great-grand father or her grandfather. She remembers her father telling about his boyhood-how his mother died and left the father with the two children-they were sent to live with his grandparents. His grandfather died when he was eight and his grandmother died when he was thirteen. They were to live with an uncle (who had a son named Hyle). William Thomas didn't want to live with the uncle so instead he ran away and joined the Confederate Army as a water boy. He never was enlisted as a soldier. When he was older they gave him a gun and he stayed with them until the war was over. At age seventeen he married Viola Boles at Burkesville. They had two children, Tina and James. Then he accused her of being unfaithful and left her and went west. He returned to Celina, Tenn with some men from Clay County and brought 80 ponies back, driving them from Texas. He obtained a divorce from Viola in 1877 and married Sarah Elizabeth Edens.

Dear Cousin Betty,

I am now working my way through the packet from you which arrived on 9 FEB 2001 (my birthday!) and want to thank you for it. I'll comment as I go.

you asked about a copy of the KY Vital Records. They arrived under cover of a 20 JAN 2001 letter from Charles J. Peterson. I have made a copy for you which is provided herewith, other than the cover sheet I have not processed these records. A similar copy has been sent to Melva. I'll process in due course

you asked about Margan's Papers. I am sure her daughter got them but I have no idea what has happened to them. I met the daughter once in 1975. Year later when her mother died the daughter helped me and I proceeded to pay tribute to her

mother in the US including the publishing of a picture of the mother. At that time I tried to stimulate the daughter to be involved but without success. I know others have also tried to contact her without success. It appears family history is not her "thing".

The age spread between the 5 potential sons of George U. b 1810 is a challenge to resolve. At a certain point the presence of a young wife could certainly cause the dispersal of nearly grown sons. You are correct in noting that these Wayne Co, KY families did "pass their children around". This lends a lot of confusion but in some cases the records can be helpful - as when the census records show "Grandson" or "Granddaughter".

Re the death of George U. b 1810 - I only have that he died after 1860 in Wayne Co, KY. I do not have a record of him on the 1860 census. Do you? It should give his age and Mary Ann Crabtree's age (which I do not have). & some details on children should be on this 1860 census.

The letter you sent to Melva from "Doc" presumably came from a Grandson of William T. U. Enclosed in the sheet where you report that Grandson was Herman U "Doc". Is this correct?? I find William T. U had a grandson HERBERT ELMO U "DOC". Am I correct?

You asked if the Shadrach U & Ruth who appeared twice are the same or different. They are different as shown below:

My impression is that we now have the big blocks of information in hand and processed. This should make our job easier as we come across the odd document or piece of information that needs to be incorporated.

Thank you for all your hard work on my behalf. I have been very busy with work and a re-do on the house so haven't had time to really look at all of it.

I found some things on the Upchurch site, and sent them to Melva and asked her to forward them to you. The enclosed is something I found last night. Always looking for Upchurch info. and will continue to send.

This certainly turned into a busy hobby, think it is going to be going on for a long time.

On the info you sent I noticed the two Boys - Will.† + Will C. born 14 months apart. Rather unusual, especially if 1st son Shadrack was born 1839 - that would be 11 yrs. between children. Is it possible that one of the three ~~was~~ is not their son? Maybe being raised by Geo + Louisa. These people appear to pass their children around to others. For certain the marriage to Mary Ann Crabtree and son Giles. Why was Giles raised by Shadrack + Ruth? Where is Mary Ann? As you pointed out only 2 sons are listed at any source.

I have placed some queries on the Upchurch site, looking for anything more on Upchurch in Clay and Onerton Co Tenn.

The road Herman Elmo Upchurch, when 911 system started they named the roads for people

The Civil War Museum in Hillsboro is only 15 miles from my daughter - in fact she will be taking classes there in summer semester - As time permits I will check it out for all my our names - I got the book Champ Ferguson, found the Upchurch in it. I never knew much about the Civil War in Ky, except the battle at Mill Springs and of course Morgan Raiders -

This is really my busy time of year, but I will check all you sent and correct and add to it before returning to you. Again Thank You!!

If you have anything else that will make a possible to postime please send it.

Don't plan a trip to Ky & Tenn this year - We have spent so much time there the last 2 yrs, think we need to see some other parts of the country. Would love a week or two in Salt Lake City - Don't think it will happen, but wish for anyway.

About the St John's Cemetery - enclosed is an extract sheet I made for my people & my flat cemetery file systems. The daughter Alyene was new to me. on the back of one of the photos (copy enclosed) you wrote that St John's was in Overton Co, TN. I am sure you meant Clay Co, TN. To make sure about this I enclose a copy of part of the map for Clay Co, TN. Can you confirm that the highlighted area is in fact the Jollydale Area of Clay Co, TN. Note that the short spur road has a cemetery symbol . Is this St John's? I take it Shell lived in this area a long time so there must be a lot of local information about her & her family there. Did you run across some of this?

While we are on maps - I enclose a sheet / map for Overton Co, TN. Note ELMO UPENBACH ROAD North of Livingston. Do you know anything about this. which Elms, etc?

Re Herman Elmo U - Enclosed is a copy of my master outline sheet for his family. You will note I have added ALIVE. There has to be an error on this sheet as the 6 individuals listed as stepchildren of Herman U were all born before Herman Elmo U was born. Since they are stepchildren that could be true but note they are also born before Miller Jean (Miller) U so could not be her children.


You asked about a source of Confederate information. When I was in TX in 1996 I visited the Confederate Research Center at Hill College in Hill Co, TX. A sheet on this is enclosed. They have a good collection of Civil War stuff and for a small fee will arrange to get details from archive records elsewhere. I am not sure this is the best place to get Civil War records but it is a nice place to start. I am not really well informed on this subject but do have considerable interest.

you asked if I needed more information on your part of the family. The answer is yes to the extent you can provide same without too much work.

you will have noted that I collect full names (full maiden names of females), dates of birth/marriage/death and places of birth/marriage/death/burial. For places I like to include TOWN/COUNTY/STATE and where available the names of cemeteries. We rarely get all this stuff - but it is well to try. Enclosed is my master outline for the family of your GF James Andrew U. I would welcome any upgrade you can provide for this - again don't go to a lot of trouble. I know you work and you have lots of interest. Later I can send master outlines for other parts of your family where upgrading might be in order - and in some cases there might be new information for you.

you asked about computer/Internet search for vital statistics. I am no authority on this matter but several cousins are made up to speed and send me stuff from time to time. Enclosed is a copy of a 20 NOV 2000 letter from cousin Charles Peterson which is one example. I am in the process of creating several thousand Bioplo sheets for placement in my Bioplo system based on the records he has sent. I will soon ask him for the KY records he mentioned and will be happy to share a copy with you if you are interested - and assuming he sends same. I enclose 2 sheets from his letter which give some indication of where he got this on the Internet and may give you a clue as to how to proceed.

Betty, it is always nice to hear from you and I look forward to continued collaboration.

Don't know how you keep all those Upchurch's straight, especially the branches and twigs.

A little background - when I go to Ky & Tenn I try to check the libraries, do a quick index search then make copies of anything with Upchurch. Most of it is forwarded to Melba, she looks at it then forwards to you. That way you both get a copy to add to your growing pile of papers. A lot of it doesn't mean anything to me but could be of some help to others. Also I do use the computer, micro film at the library and books that I find at local libraries. A lot of looking, sometimes a long shot pays off. The computer has a lot of good info and some not good. People are too quick to post information, not proving the facts. Example I passed on a lot of my Bow info that I know was correct, that person has it on a web site with errors. Next person will not check etc. Learned my lesson!!

I do a lot of guesstimation - that is how I finally found St Johns Cemetery and graves for William & Sarah Upch. A local lady actually went out there and found them she along with 2 others sent directions. We had already made 2 trips to Tenn, one in April then again in Sept before locating it in Oct. Did Melba tell you about my fun with shaving cream on the stones, this was Halloween day and I looked like a ghost.

Tenn. did not start recording deaths until 1908  
 and then so is the case in Texas a lot were  
 never sent to the state. I checked in Cumberland Co Tenn  
 for Upchurch, found none yet there are some living there.  
 In Texas I sent for 5 certificates from 1910-1927 - got  
 one, even tho I had names, dates etc. The death of  
 Martha Ang. Upc was listed on the master list on  
 micro film. So bad it didn't give father or mother.

My resource for St. Johns told me Overton Co. not Clay. None of my queries for Clay were answered except for one that told me to check Overton. He missed listing a lot of graves, ex. Will T + Sarah even tho the stones are easy to read and right behind Herman Up & his wife - don't know where he gets his info but don't think he does actual search and record. He does respond to query with offer to sell his books. interesting??

There are a lot of Irish men looking for info - I usually read the ones on the Upchurch site but so far haven't paid a lot of attention to them - will do better in the future.

The grave of Elizabeth Up. B 1809 - D 1869 @ Upch. Cemetery is unknown person to me. I think I saw it and may have a picture. At the time (April) that we went there we (4 of us) crawled all over the place reading stones. At that time I was still looking for Will T. + Sarah. A lot of the old stones there

Today we finish planting 500 acres of soybeans - so that will be out of the way - but we do have other farm projects we have to keep an eye on including the other 700 acres of corn/beans planted by our operators.

I'll hope all of these matters get taken care of properly and that I can get family history back on the front burner again soon. In the meantime I'll try to give a little attention to everything.

Household #2 fits into the line headed by John f. U (X50-297). See [ ] for the line of John f. U including his children. (1 Page). It is possible John f. U could have had a son William S. U b 1848 although the Master outline [ ] does not reveal such a son. It appears that after John f. U died in the Civil War his widow moved to Clinton Co, KY where you find her in 1870. Your extract shows her as "MINNA" which could have been a nickname. However, I suspect she told the census taker "WINNEY" as he wrote MINNA or something that looked like MINNA.

My Upchurch census records for KY are presumably complete for 1850 and 1880. For 1860 & 1870 they are fragmentary. If you could find time to extract the complete set of Upchurch records for 1860 or 1870 it would be a significant contribution to Upchurch Family History. Enclosed is a copy of my 1880 extract [ ]. You will note we have been able to locate all households except 32/46 (bottom of page 1) back to a line in an Upchurch subclass.

You can see we are gradually closing in on the George Upchurch clan. There are still questions that pop up such as who is the father of William S. U. b. 1848 (your ancestor). Olive Morgan did pioneer work on this clan and in the last 20 years I have extended her work significantly. This has involved hundreds of cooperators and hundreds of sources of information. My files on the George U. Clan are in excellent shape but they require constant attention as illustrated by several hours work triggered by your letter. It does not seem like it ought to take that long but one thing leads to another. I am always happy to have another piece of the puzzle in place.

I enjoyed a visit to the Upchurch Polo Ranch when I visited TX in 1976. Jesse told me some neat stories - wish he were more interested in his heritage.

but this would have been a "late-in-life" child and would not have been by a first wife. John U had his last child in 1846 and Joseph had her last in 1848. These dates are in the same ball park as your William A. U b 1848 - but there is no record of John & Joseph having had a son William A. U b 1848. On the other hand Shadrach, Moses, John & Joseph (sons of George U) had grandchildren born starting between 1826 and 1845. There could easily have been a William A. U b 1848 among this batch - but if so we as yet have no record of same.

The trick now is to find a William A. U age 2 on the 1850 census or age 12 on the 1860 census - or to find some other odd bit of information that will solve the puzzle.

Let's keep up the momentum.

The more complete we can make the Master outline, the better. As you can see, I collect full names (full maiden names of females), dates of birth/marriage/death and place of birth/marriage/death/burial. For place I like to include town/county/state and name of cemetery where available. However, not all of that is critical. The most important facts would be those related to Shell U & his children and his parents. Still, you never know when the odd fact might help in solve the puzzle as to the father of Shell U.

Your research on the related lines of BOW, SKIPWORTH and PAUL could well be fruitful.

A working hypothesis would be that Shell U md about 1870 and had two children (at least) - TAVY (TAINY) U b 1871 and James Andrew U b 1873. Sometime before 1880 Shell U died or drowned and his widow md Jesse Bow. If you could take a closer look at the 1880 Census for Cumberland Co, KY you could learn at least the first name of Jesse's wife and the name and ages of their children (if any).

I don't have any special information you should look for on your upcoming visit to KY. Perhaps you will come upon just the right details. It is great that you are making the trip and that you have two weeks to explore. We only had two days.

Please let me know if you have any corrections or additions to make to what I have enclosed. I'll really be interested to get a report on your trip.

○ Prospects for the parents of Shell Udench who was the father of James Andrew U b. 1873 - An analysis by Robert Phillip Udench on 3 SEP 1999 since Shell U and his descendants lived in Cumberland Co KY & Adair Co, KY it is my opinion that there is a 90%+ chance that Shell U descended from George U who arrived in Wayne Co, KY about 1812. Since James Andrew U was b. 1873 it is likely his father (Shell U) was born between 1820 and 1853. The four sons of George U who could have been an ancestor of Shell U and their birthdates are as follows:

<u>Children of George U</u>	<u>Birthdates of 1st &amp; last known children of the 4 males (GC of George)</u>	<u>Earliest Expected Birthdates of Greatgrandchildren of George U</u>
Shadrach U b. 1784	1806 - 1829	1826

John U b. 1799	1825 - 1846	1845
Joseph U b. 1800	1824 - 1848	1844

So if Shell U was born between 1820 and 1853 he could have been one of the Grandchildren of George U born between 1806 and 1848 although no such grandchild is known at this time. Shell U could also be a Greatgrandchild of George U or they could have started being born between 1826 & 1844 and beyond. I would guess Shell U is a Greatgrandchild of George U.

Dear Cousin Betty,

Your nice letter of 2 AUG 1999 and your order for the 1999 issue of the U B arrived yesterday and I have spent a couple of hours trying to sort out your line. We have more work to do.

The first three of the 1999 issue of the U B are provided herewith. The 4th will be sent when it is produced later this fall.

Thanks for all the details you provided. They have all been placed in my huge Profile system and new Profiles were created where necessary. I tried to call you several times last night and this AM but your phone was always busy. I wanted to see if we could exchange notes by phone and thereby speed up the search to link your GF James Andrew & earlier Upchurch generations.

Based on what I know about the Ypslurch Family of the 1800's I would say there is a 90%+ chance that James Andrew is a descendant of George U, Head of Ypslurch Clan No 5. He came from Iredell Co, NC to Wayne Co, KY about 1812 and gave rise to many thousands of descendants of whom you are likely one. From your viewpoint did you already have an idea that your GF Ypslurch descended from George U or is this a new idea for you?

In our search to link your GF to earlier Ypslurch generations we can proceed along two paths - #1 work backwards from the known existence of your GF - #2 Start with George U and work down through his children, grandchildren, etc. to see who might have been the father of an Ypslurch male b 5 JAN 1873 (KY). I have already had a look at path #2 and can share that approach with you in more detail later.

We only need a tiny bit more information to allow us to get a better sense of who the father of your GF could have been. There are several approaches you could take on this such as:

- Get a copy of the Death Certificate of James Andrew Upchurch - perhaps it shows his parents.
- Get a list of the children of James Andrew U & details about them
- Learn more about the siblings of James Andrew U. - maybe a death certificate for his sister - Elizabeth (Ziggy) U.
- etc, etc

Are you aware of the James U age 6 on the 1880 census of Cumberland Co, KY. - Copy evident Note that he has a sister TAVY U. Is this new to you or is she the same as Elizabeth?? Note that James & Tavy were stepchildren of JESSEE BOW. Is this new to you? Perhaps deserves follow-up. It would appear that the mother & the father of James & Tavy

separated sometime prior to 1880 (They could have divorced or the father - a Mr Upchurch - could have died). Subsequent to that separation the mother remained to a Mr JESSEE BOW. Note that my extract of the census does not include all of the members in the Cumberland Co, KY household. If you examine that you should be able to learn the first name of the mother of James + Tang and her age & possibly birthplace plus maybe other information.

Enclosed in the extract of the material you sent developed so I could place a copy in the profile of each person named. I would guess "SHELL" was a nickname. I have several with that name or nickname but none fit your situation.

From U B Vol 20 #3 enclosed you will see my wife & I made our first trip ever to Wayne Co, KY recently and enjoyed it greatly.

I'll look forward to hearing from you and to working together. Please let me have as much detail as you can.
