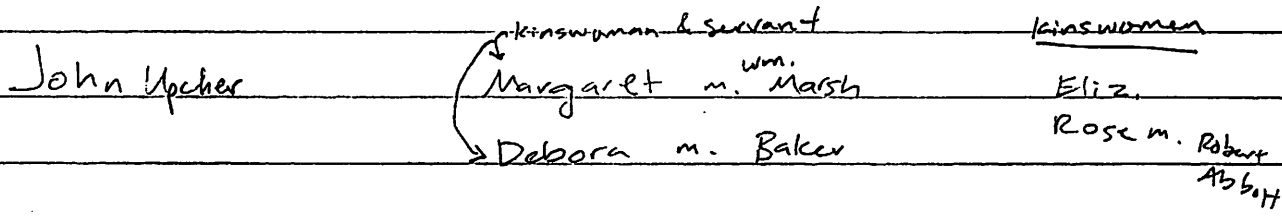

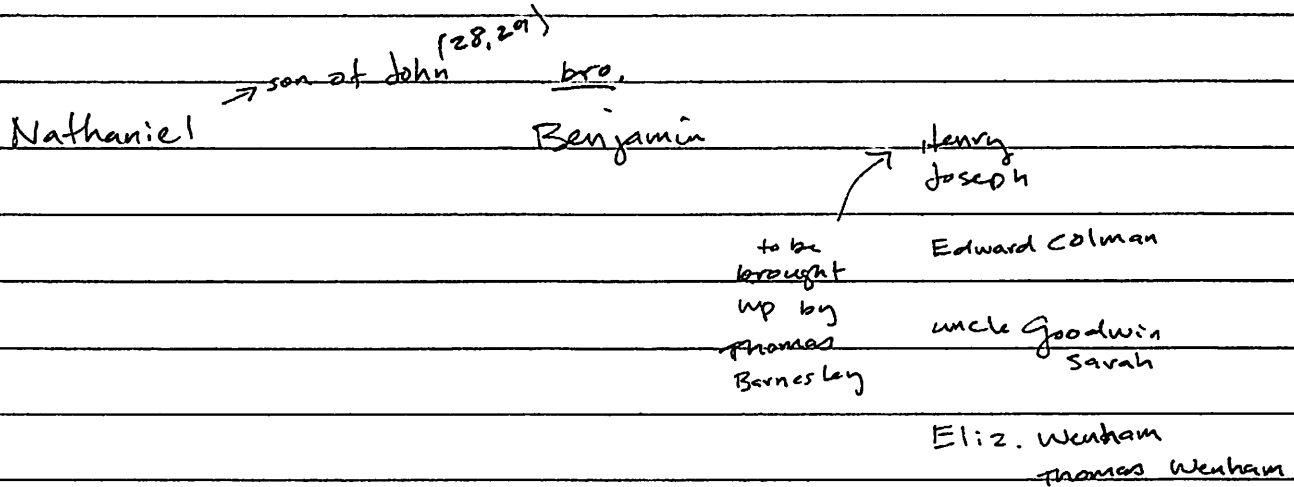

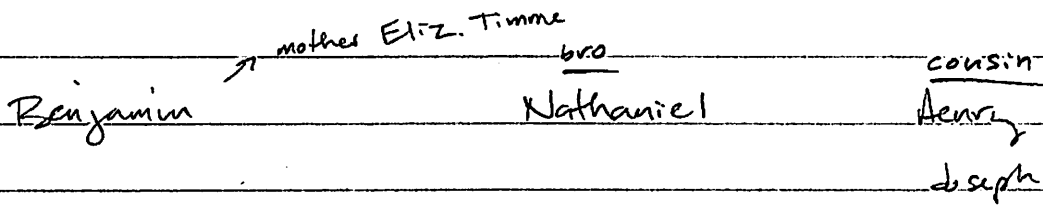

Dear Phil,

Thank you so much for the gift of the Upchurch Bulletin. you have no idea how much that means to me! I didn't want to do without it but things have gotten so out of hand it's unreal. Yes, my back is slowly improving but the Dr. says I still have a long way to go. I won't be able to play softball again until 1993 - that is BAD news to me. (I used to play 6 days a week) So mainly I have to ~~lay~~ ^{lie} around at home - but that will give me time to go through the 42 pages. I will work on them & let you know how it comes out. Thanks for sending them.

I'm glad you liked the photos. I made a mistake in my last letter about Allie Upchurch. He was my g-grandmother's father-in-law not her husband. I think I wrote something like that & realized it after I had mailed it. I'm sure you figured out what I meant! I think there is no doubt that the other is Bartley though. Bartley & Allie seem to have the same eyes & cheekbones - they could be father & son but then again my dad says I look like his dad so you never can tell!

About the Abel Upchurch thing:

I agree with you that Abel I & II could be the same. On the Wake & Frank. co. records ^S none of them conflict. It looks like he

bought land in Wake County in 1801 while still owning in Franklin until at least 1804 (tax list) after that he pays tax in Wake, but there is no listing of land sale in F. Co. I guess it hasn't been found yet. About that 1800 census, & the carpenters, I don't think the kids on the census are Abels' because I don't think he is old enough to make that many! If they are carpenters and were adopted by John Carpenter why didn't they stay with John Carpenter. It looks like John C. was the father & and Eliz. V. was the mother. Since they did go ahead & marry, adopt & legalize everything it seems weird that Eliz. would have 5 common-law or illegitimate kids. 1 or 2 would seem more normal. Do you know anything else on John C. was he cheating on a wife & getting Eliz. pregnant all those years & since she loved him so much she let this scandal go on & then finally his wife died and he married Eliz. & changed the kids names? ~~Did he die~~ If he died in 1800 so Abel would need to take care of them then ^{William Churchwell b. 1801-2} ~~Abel~~ would have had a different father. BUT, they were adopted in 1803 so maybe they were with Abel until then. Where was Eliz. at this time? Why not with the kids? Anyway, I have drawn no conclusions but these are my comments for what they're worth!

Richard Upchurch of Huntingdonshire

Richard Upchurch was born around 1584-5 in England. On October 23, 1608 in Huntingdonshire he was married to Frances Ingersoll. They had two children. A son Michael, born around 1620 and a daughter.

In 1626 Nicholas Ferrar established the religious community of Little Gidding in a remote part of England, about seventy miles north of London. A book bindery supported the community. Richard and his family moved there to live and work. The community of Little Gidding consisted of a church, a manor house and a few other small buildings. The Upchurchs were close friends of Nicholas Ferrar and his brother John and John's daughter Virginia. The Upchurchs and the Ferrars were all very curious about the New World and when Richard's son Michael moved there he sent many letters home to Little Gidding telling his family and the Ferrars all about America.

Michael Upchurch

Michael Upchurch was born around 1620 in England. In the 1640's he lived with his father, Richard Upchurch, his mother, Frances Ingersoll Upchurch, and a sister at Little Gidding Manor in Huntingdonshire, England.

About 1649 Michael left his home and his family to come to the New World. He was a headright to Valentine Patten and Robert Hubbard. This meant that Valentine Patten and Robert Hubbard paid Michael's way to the New World and then in exchange were granted land from the government authority that had the rights to the land. The headright provision was a good deal for everyone because the government was accomplishing its goal of populating the colonies, the headright got his ship fare paid and the sponsors were granted land. Michael was listed as a headright to both Valentine Patten and Robert Hubbard in 1654. Valentine Patten got 1000 acres of land for the twenty people he brought over and Robert Hubbard received 1600 acres for the 32 people whom he paid for. There are a few odd things about these records though; Michael had already been in America for several years in 1654 also his name is credited to two different men. A few people figured out how to claim people as headrights without actually paying their way to the New World. Lists of names of men already living in the colony were available for purchase so possibly Michael's name was bought by one or both of these men for use as a headright.

Michael landed in Yorke County, Virginia and soon after moved to Surry County, Virginia which was across the James River from Jamestown and south. Michael married a girl named Frances in 1651 and they had four children. Michael and his family lived in the Lawnes Creek Parish on the Delke Plantation on land he rented from Roger Delke, one of the largest landowners in Surry County. He grew tobacco for a living. On January 2, 1656 Michael leased some land in Yorke County, across the James River from Surry County where he was already renting forty acres from Roger Delke. Michael had the rights to "hawking, fowling, fishing and hunting, falling, sawing, making timber...for...building houses...for...twenty one years." Michael raised 150 pounds of good tobacco a year. He also planted an orchard of thirty apple trees, ten pear trees and some quince trees. They were members of the Lawnes Creek Episcopal Church.

As soon as Michael had established himself in the New World he began to collect things to send back home to his family and friends, who were all very interested in America. On March 27, 1651 Michael sent a letter to Virginia Ferrar that said "I am sending you a basket of skins of animals, flying hart's head and horns, the rattles of a rattlesnake, a crowne of a burd. This is all I can provide to send you at the present time. Nixt yier I hope to be of better abilitie to serve you. P.S. I have sent you a young turtin in a glass bottel." Michael sent another letter home on May 4, 1652. This letter was written to John Ferrar and his daughter as well as to Michael's father. In the letter Michael indicates that he is illiterate and is dictating his letter to a scribe. The phrase "hitting the nail on the head" must have been used in a letter to Michael and he did not understand what it meant. Michael was probably sending samples of things from America back to England to help his family and the Ferrars understand the New World. Michael sent Mr. Ferrar principal good (very good) tobacco for his own drinking (chewing). He also sent plant seeds such as peas (pease), beans, wheat, corn and tobacco. He sent examples of different kinds of animal life as well as items made by the Indians.

Michael was somewhat involved in a tax rebellion that took place at Lawnes Creek Parish Church on December 12, 1673. Fourteen people met at "Devil's Old Field" protesting that their taxes

were "unreasonable laid and they would not pay them." The sheriff was ordered to arrest "the seditious people" and set them on trial. The trial was held January 3, 1674 and Michael was recorded as having said " he was att ye church, but denys to declare by whom he heard of yt he knew any of ye business they mett about."

In 1679 Michael Upchurch, "being old and infirm," was exempted from paying taxes. He died in 1681. In Book 2 of Surry Co., VA Records appears: FRA. UPCHURCH, granted adm. on est of MICHAEL UPCHURCH, deceased.

"On the 25th of July 1681 FRANCES UPCHURCH was ordered to present to the court of said county of Surry perfect inventory of his estate. (SURRY CO., VA ORDERS 1671-1684). The inventory: 8108 pounds of tobacco, 4cows, 2 yearlings, 1 calf, 2 young steers 3 years old, 3 heifers 3 years old, 24 pounds of pewter (@ 8¢ a lb.), 12 plates, 6 porringers, 2 small tankards, 1 small flagon, a salt & beeker, 1 small bell metal, mortar & pestle, chafing dish, 2 kettles, 1 old skillet, 1 small skimmer, 3 iron pots, 1 spitt, 1 dripping pan, ladle, frying pan, flesh fork, 1 pr. potracks, old parcel of plow gear, a fixt gun, 3 old chests, old feather bed as it stands, a flock bed, parcel of old bedding, pair of small stilliards, longs, 1 brands, 1 grindstone, 19 head of poor swine, parcel of old lumber, parcel of old carpenter's tools."

Michael's wife Frances lived ten years after him. On January 23, 1691 the estate of Michael's widow was valued at 6820 pounds of tobacco. According to her son Michael Upchurch, Jr. "this is a true inventory of the above said deceased, Frances Upchurch, except her wearing clothes and a ring given to her daughters according to the records at her death."

Loveing and kinde Father my duty with my wife's humbly I senhed to you and to my mother as alsoe to my sister trusting that you are in health as at present I am blessed bee God desireing you to remember me to all my friends in generall. These are to notifie you that as yett I have not received your letter but I here it is in ye country but I have received the letter wch Mr. Farrer sent mee as alsoe the tokens which the faire lady his daughter sent mee for the which I am deeply engaged for her favor and courtesie. Truly I am very sorry I have not had your letter sooner for I did preserve you a Hogshed of the best tobacco I had on purpose to send you but not hearing from you made me lay it out and yett if I can possible I will send you some tobacco this yeare although mine bee layd out. But however I intend God willing to send you some tobacco; the next yeare without faile and pray lett me heare from you the first shipp that come to Yorke River and pray direct your letter for mee to one Mr. James Brune liveing neere unto Esquire Ludlow in Yorke and I shall be sure to have it delivered. Pray father bee not unmindful to present my service to Mr. Farrer informing I understand that he did not receive half the tokens I sent, but it was none of my fault for I being illiterate desired him to writ my letters to send both the name of the man and alsoe of the shipp but I think that he did neglect it therefore I desire to be informed wt the meaning of the hitting of the naile on the head is and wt it doth signifie and conserning the earth it is the common mould of Virginia onely I sent a young turtle or terrapine as the indians call them and the earth was onely to pserve it alive whilst it came to London.

I sent my father tow roundes of tobacco; the matter of 20 lb and I sent my Mother an Indian baskett and a pepper box. And I sent to Mr. Farrer 8 lb of principal good tobacco for his owne drinking and a half dozen of Indian Pipes and a box full of tobacco seeds and I sent to Mrs. Virginia Farrer a muskrat skin two musk codd's an Indian baskett two woodpeckers crownes wch were redder than any scarlet and with all I sent a paire of flying hart's hornes and a pair of burds hornes and peases of mine several sorts and beans of all colors wheate and Indian corne of all sorts and I sent some heavy earth and a peece of fullers earth and as concerning the Indians makeing of bowes and arrowes they make there bowes of Locust and there arrowes of reeds and their arrow heads bee of glass or else from turkicock spurs or tips of deer's hornes and they do gett glasse from the English and make tryangle just  as this mark is and they did not cut it with diamonds only with a conce knife or a pipple stone and as concerning mettles I am ignorat there is diverse sorts of mettle stones but I cannot gett any because the Indians are at war one with the other but I shall promise some against the next yeare. however I know not how to make Mrs. Farrer amends for all her manifold favores bestowed upon mee howsoever I shall remaine very thankful for her kindness though unknowne soe at present I comitt you to God and your dutiful sonne

Richard Upchurch

Richard Upchurch was born around 1658 in Surry County, Virginia the oldest son of Michael and Frances Upchurch. He married and moved to another county where he and his wife had three sons named John, William and James. After a while he reappeared in Surry County . On June 10, 1694 he was on the Tithes List reported as living with his brother Michael probably on their father's property in Lawnes Creek. On June 9, 1699 Richard was listed again as living with Robert Reynolds, who was possibly his mother's half brother. Richard died around 1700 in Virginia.

James Upchurch

James Upchurch was born in 1685 in Virginia. He married Elizabeth and had four sons. He lived and farmed in Brunswick County, Virginia. On June 27, 1739 he was granted 117 acres of land for 15 shillings on the south side of Fountain's Creek (later called Rattlesnake Creek) in Brunswick County. Fountain Creek is a little north of the North Carolina border.

In 1748 James Upchurch was on the Poll List of residents of Brunswick County voting for representatives for the House of Burgesses.

On May 27, 1755 James and his wife Elizabeth sold land to the west side of Fountain's Creek for 27 pounds. In 1762 James bought 200 acres of land in southern Brunswick County near Lizard Creek for 10 pounds. James died in 1765 in Virginia. This 200 acres of land was left to his youngest son, Michael, whom he refers to as Myal in his will. The rest of his estate was left to his wife Elizabeth.

Michael Upchurch was born after 1735, the youngest son of James and Elizabeth Upchurch. He had three sons and one daughter. He held 200 acres of land in Brunswick County, Virginia which his father left to him in his will in 1765. Michael was most likely a minor and still living on this land with his mother at the time of his father's death. Michael was listed as having been paid for provisions for the Militia for 1756-1758. He served in the Virginia Militia under Captain Goodrich for six months and was discharged as unfit for service. Michael died in 1795 before he reached the age of sixty. His estate was settled by his son-in-law Thomas Bathshears.

William Upchurch

William Upchurch was born in Brunswick County, Virginia, the oldest son of Michael Upchurch. He moved to the Granville District in North Carolina. He and his wife Sarah had ten children. The family moved to Wilkes County, North Carolina to the Morgan District where William died in 1787. Some of his children were minors at the time of his death. He was probably in his fifties when he died.

His widow Sarah is listed in the 1790 census for Wilkes County, North Carolina. In 1794 Sarah bought 105 acres of land in Wilkes County and sold it on October 1, 1802 while she was living in Greenville, South Carolina. She was listed in the 1800 census for Greenville as the head of a family.

Also I give and devise to my son Able Upchurch, Jr. all my personal property viz, my servant man, Nelson (his wife Amy, her son Tom, Lenny, Mary, Harriet, and Jane, being children of the said black man, and his wife Amy) to have and to hold to my said son Able Upchurch, Jr. his heirs and assigns forever.

Also I give and devise to my son Able Upchurch, Jr. all my horses cattle and stock, and all the house hold furniture.

Also, I do hereby appoint my trusty friend and son Able Upchurch, Jr. Administrator of this my last will and testament and do direct that he shall receive pay for all his pains and trouble he will have in the execution of this my will.

Also, For the better security of my wife, Theny, I de declare that the property shall all stay together after my death, if I should die first, untill her death, befor the said distributions as I have bequeath them, shall take place.

And also, that it shall and may be lawful for him my said administrator in the first place to pay himself for all his trouble and all the rest, residue and remainder of all my estate and effects real and personal, whatever, after the payment of my just debts, legacies and funeral expences and other charges and deductions as aforesaid, all after complying with my will aforesaid, to be my son Able Upchurch, Jr. and his heirs and assigns forever.

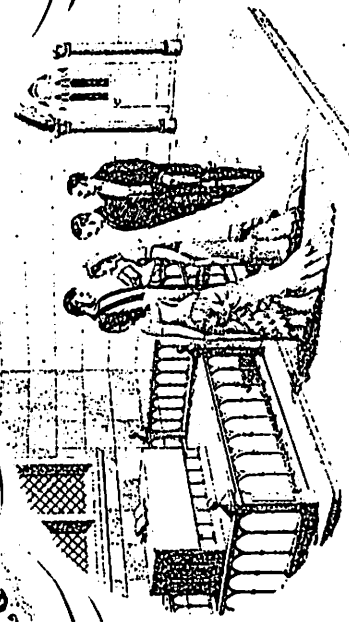

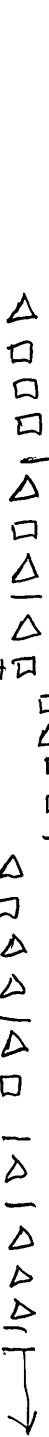

Your letter of 11 NOV 1991 is at hand. I am very pleased that you have gone through all the issues of the U B and created your own outline. This is what I had hoped people would do. I'll be interested to see what you generate.

With regard to the computer I have to plead incompetence. My wife does all the computer work. We produce the U B through our IBM compatible word processor but we have no active genealogy programs on the computer. I did have a program created an "address oriented" program linked to Clan/Subclan members but so far we have not used it. I just keep reworking my handwritten Master outlines and placing information on hardcopy Bifiles.

As regards the English documents I may have some "old English" documents but when I checked I found 42 pages of translated wills, deeds, etc from the 1500's & 1600's. These were given to me by the late Belle West in 1977. I have never done anything with them. It is hard to link the

naïve family member to one another, I have never wished that part of our history. It is tough! However, I'll be glad to send you a copy of the 42 pages if you so desire.

The book you have requested "Little Gidding Story & Guide" is provided herewith. The cost is \$4.00.

You asked about the Upchurch who was enrolled at Cambridge University. I don't know how he was related to Michael U, I. Under regard to the coat of arms/knights - I think that is not likely. These days people fabricated such things without any real basis. There is a lot of Upchurch history in England yet to be uncovered but so far no evidence of royalty or near royalty. There were Upchurches of substance in the church and in business in eastern England in the period 1500-1700. They have been little studied.

With regard to your line I must indicate some doubt about what has been published. I accepted what researchers reported from their work in the 1950-1970 period and now I have come to believe some of it is wrong. In particular I believe your ancestor Abel U, Sr was not the son of William U, IV. Rather I believe Abel U, Sr was the son of Richard U, II. Within the next month or so I will work up an article on

tho' but I will send it to you and some other key individuals before it is published in the U.B. Sorry about this confusion.

I know of no will of Richard U, I (XFD-149).

According to my records Bartley U (XFD-590) left a will but I do not have a copy of it. If you get a copy please share it with me. I don't know if Alison C. U (XFD-10430) had a will or not.

With regard to the females who marry into the Upchurch family I can say that I follow all their offspring and maintain Master outlines and Biopics. on the ancestor of such females I record information in my Biopic system for their parents, if available, but not normally for earlier generations unless there is a special reason to do so. The net result in my non-Upchurch files occupy about twice as much space as my Upchurch files. I would not choose to use the U.B. as a place for queries to appear. Our circulation is somewhat limited and I think there are other methods & places for such queries to appear. I do always try to respond to any letters which request information. I have information filed by first name & other families in probably 5,000 families - some of them just one name & some have hundreds of individuals

It is good to hear that your health
is now much improved and that your
business and school activities and other
interests are unfolding nicely. Your plan
to undertake a PhD program sounds very

good. You^{are} going about it in the right way looking into various schools. They certainly vary in what they have to offer. I assume you will be hoping for some financial help from the school where you enroll. This usually takes a lot of negotiating and some will help and some will not. You are probably well advised to pursue the route of earning some money while in school. With your talents and expertise this should be possible.

With regard to moving west, I think this is a good idea if other things work out. I took my PhD at the University of California - Davis which made a nice contrast with my earlier experience in North Carolina where I was born & raised and got my BS & MS.

Tucson would be a nice place to get a "different" experience. (I can't say anything about the PhD program here in your area of work). Tucson is hot in the summer with temperatures 105-115°F for a three month period. Part of that is

a dry heat but in JULY & AUGUST we tend to have rain and the humidity goes up. For 9 months we have lovely weather. It rarely freezes here and a light jacket is all you need for the winter. We have a lot of vegetation in Tucson. It is a "lush" desert, as nearby Mount Lemmon we have large pine trees. Arizona in general is a unique state - weather, geology, plants, people, etc. Tucson is "western" in outlook compared to Phoenix which is just a big city.

The prices here are about average. There are a lot of discount stores and some very large grocery stores. Housing is also medium priced - not expensive like California or New York or Washington, DC. If you choose Arizona for your school [The University of Arizona in Tucson - Not Arizona State University in Phoenix] I think you will be satisfied with the prices.

④
Finding a part time job in Tucson would probably require you to take aggressive action. The problem is that a lot of people like to live in Tucson and they tend not to worry about how to make a living. Therefore, a lot of people with good skills work cheap. I am sure you could find something.

I hope we will be here when you come for a visit. We have not yet announced our plans at the University but we have decided to move to Mexico sometime during the first half of 1994. It will be an exciting venture for us. It would be a pleasure to meet with you and you would enjoy experiencing Tucson even if you did not decide to come to Tucson. Do keep us posted on your plans.

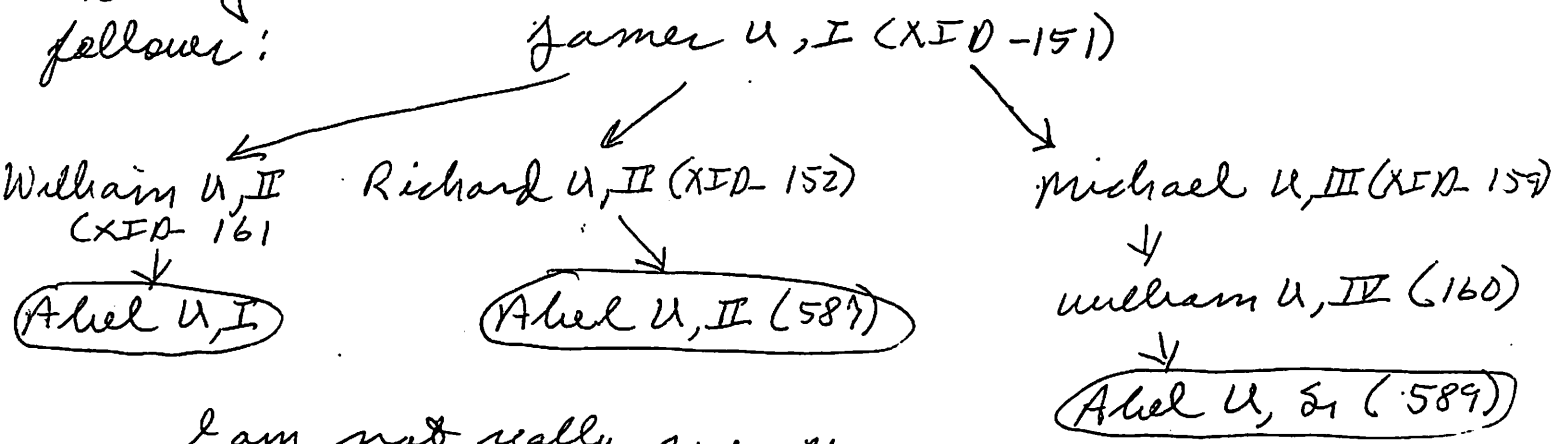

Actually there are three ABEL U's in the picture as follows:



I am not really sure that Abel U, I exists and I have never given him an XFD-number. Need to study this prospect some more. Whether Abel U, I exists or not does not have a bearing on the issue of XFD-587 vs 589. The AL story on Abel U has always been portrayed as if he was a son of William U, IV. My own view about the A. U who was a son of William U, IV is that he was Asal U (or Afal U) and that he has never appeared on the record except for being listed in the estate papers of William U, IV who d 1787 in Wilkes Co, NC.

We know a fair amount about the Abel U who was the son of Richard U, II but not much has been written about this Abel U. My view is that the Abel U in AL was in fact the son of Richard U, II and not the son of William U, IV. It seems that you tend to agree with me.
