Hi Phil,

I need some assistance locating and accessing the Allied Family William U., IV Ancestry.com file. Can you share the web address and password with me via email?

Also, I have a question regarding inclusion of historical documents within the context of the William U. tree. For example, I'd like to attach William's NC will to his individual Ancestry profile. I know how to accomplish this for the people I have on file already. However, I understand that you have a wealth of information on individuals in the family tree that I've never seen nor have access to - land deeds, marriage records, etc. I propose working slowly and carefully on the William U. IV Allied Family tree by beginning with your known and available documents on his immediate family's marriage, Bible, slave and tax records, lands transactions, birth and death certificates, law suits, obituaries, grave site locations, immigration records, family anecdotal stories, etc. In other words, the written treasures you have in your amazing Upchurch bio-file collection.

I think this would be a practical way of metering out the request for documents you already have on file. I'll simply work on one complete family at a time (so as not to overwhelm you or me) and then when I'm ready to proceed with the next generation, I'll put in a request to your office for a list of scanned documents for a particular family. This will accomplish two things: It will help confirm that the family info I have in my own personal cache is accurate and also create a systematic method to scan, save and attach important historical details to the thousands of William Upchurch IV descendants in his Allied Family Ancestry tree. I'm curious about your opinion of this idea?
