Cousin Phil,
I want to thank you for your efforts and the Upchurch Bulletins. I know I owe you money for the extras, so tell me how much. I wish to purchase those Bulletins that have the Upchurch Register numbers from 9000 to 9400, this includes my immediate family.

Last Thanksgiving I took my children and grandchildren to Green Level Baptist Church to show them graves of their ancestors. I got them interested about our history.

△ My memories of my great grandfather (George Eugene, Sr) included a federal case that accused him of tipping the scales at a tobacco warehouse during market sales. It was later determined that the scales were faulty, at least that what I was told.

△ I read about a cousin in the civil war that was killed named Tobias Turner.

△ FOR PROSEA I read online the revolutionary war accounts of Nathan, Moses and Charles Upchurch which led me to the Battle of Camden and a better understanding of the Revolutionary War and information of a no-count General named Gates. I read were Moses Upchurch walked through Moncks Comer SC and on thru Charleston to Savannah and probably passed within a mile of where I live today.

△ I have the military serial number of my late Uncle Bill (William T) and I hope that will lead me to what army division he was in. I would like to find someone that was around the Battle of the Bulge in his division that may have known him. He is listed as DOW (died of wounds), so he survived the battlefield, but my original question is about his history. The family said he died during the Battle of the Bulge, but the Battle started Dec 1944 and my uncle is listed as dying Nov 1944.

△ I have learned quite a bit so far by the passion is just beginning. My Uncle Hunter Kelly (married to Margaret Lee U- # 918) was a descendant of the Moses Upchurch Clan (as stated). Now I need to find out if my mother (Margaret E Pruitt) whose mother was Bertha White (from Granville County NC) had any ties to the Upchurch clan. Many Upchurch's existed in Granville County NC.

In 20 years in the US Submarine Force I missed alot of funerals and other family gatherings; I missed alot of historical knowledge.

Thank you again for your efforts in helping me find the past and its ever unfolding history.
