Turn south on Kennebec Rd (SR.2754) and go 2.8 mi. to Bud Lipscomb Rd (SR.2758) which forks off to the east from Kennebec Rd. at Fellowship Baptist Church. About 1 mi. ahead, on the right the small cemetery is visible.

A small roadside cemetery in Wake County, no longer in use. Enclosed by a wrought iron fence, neatly kept, no place to park.
