"William U b ca 1788 NC d prior to 15 JAN 1861 in Saline Co, IL - that is the date his will was entered for probate. Know nothing of him until his 2nd marriage in 1841 in Gallatin Co, IL. But apparently he had lived in Illinois somewhere prior to that time as a son b ca 1830 was born in IL according to census records".

"Some marriages were published in the "SAGA" in summer and fall of 1974⁷ (1834-1857). Included were two or three: Upchurch - they are children of William U b ca 1788 (NC) and died prior to 15 JAN 1861 in some part of Saline Co, IL. These children are mentioned in his will - they were by a previous wife. Practically everything was left to present wife (Sarah Stum) and a son by her. The children by the 1st wife were:

Mary U md (Johnson Co, IL) 13 AUG 1842 John Newbolds (Pg 178)

Elyaheta U md (" " ") 17 SEP 1842 William Newbolds (Pg 186)

Hornson U md (" " ") 19 JUL 1855 Louisa Trammell (Pg 377)

As of today I have no definitive resolutions of how he fits into the family. There are options but with conflicts:

OPTION No. 1 - He was the 5th William U, IV under the son being born in NC (under Co, NC?) in about 1888. He is in fact carried in the master outline as a part of the William U, IV Class. He is recorded as being in Sabine Co, IL which compares with him being under the members of the W^m U IV settled conflicts - W^m U, IV died in 1887 - could not have had a son b 1888

OPTION No 2. W^m U 1888-1861 lived where the members of the John U, III / Samuel U Sabers settled - could W^m belong to the John U, III Class? John U, III d 1795 (Antrim Co, NC), had 3 known sons but no William -

Needs more study.
