far no records prior to 1950 have been found.  
In 1950 a former member <sup>△</sup>Bruce Barlow was to  
be buried but the cemetery was much overgrown  
and had to be cleared. Since 1950 there have been  
4 ministers.

My initial interest was to see if this was the  
burial site of Richard Cross + wife (my Great Uncle  
& Great Aunt). Found no sign of them. There are about  
50 gravesites - last from 1880's but one 1845.  
Recorded one RAY couple. Noted Bud Brum whom  
I once rented.

A church member cutting grass said the church  
had been vacant for 10 years but is now very active.  
(One family uses nearly a grave site) A mother of  
"Melissa" gave me Larry Brum's phone NO & said  
he or his wife would know about the church  
history. Saw one sledge. No upholsterer one RAY  
couple.

○ Notes of RPA Call 11 OCT 2004 to Everett Henry Cross

Carol (Roberson) Brum of Six Forks Baptist Church had suggested I call Everett in the history of Six Forks Baptist Church & Cemetery. He is a 2nd cousin of RPA. He does not recall much about Six Forks Baptist Church as his parents moved from the area to

the Poole Road south of Raleigh, NC about 1933 when Everett was 5 years old (b. 1928). However his Grandparents

Lorenzia J. Cross & John Richard Cross were members at the church. However they are buried at the CROSS CEM on DURANT RD, Wake Co, NC. This road is just North of the Outer Beltway & runs from Six Forks Rd to Falls of the Neuse Road. The cemetery is preserved in CROSSGATES Subdivision. There are few if any monuments with inscriptions but in addition to Lorenzia & Richard those children Everett recalled as being buried there are:

Ida Louis Cross {confirms with other info}

+ her son who died age 3

+ others but Everett used nicknames.

Everett implies that Richard & Lorenzia had a homestead where the Cross Cemetery is located.

Everett is a brother of Mary Clara Cross who was a valuable correspondent of RPA in the 1885-1995 era.

Everett was cordial & agreed it would be nice to visit when I visit NC.

Everett does not know who was the Father of John Richard Cross; his GF

Dear Phil,

Thanks for information sent. Although I have Frank Marshall Bunn in my files, I do not know the name of his father. Perhaps his death certificate will provide the answer. Will have to check it out next time I am in Raleigh.

I do not have a marriage certificate for Frank, but information I obtained from a register I saw on microfilm indicates that in 1947, at the age of 28, Frank married Annie Mae Rudd, age 19. Franks address was shown to be Raleigh, and Annie address was shown to be Wake Forest, NC. I have documentation that Frank and Annie had at least one child. Enclosed herewith is a copy of a marriage certificate for Betty Carol Bunn and Joseph Lee Rigsbee wherein the names of Betty's parents are shown.

I am almost certain that Frank is a descendant of Owen Bunn of Wake County. George Bunn, son of Owen Bunn, had three son that lived in the north Raleigh area. George's son, Absalom, and his wife Annie Barlow are buried at the Six Forks Baptist Church Cemetery on Baleywick Road. Another of George's sons, Morris B. Bunn (and his wife Clellie Pool) are buried at the same cemetery. Still another one of George's sons, Budd Bunn (and his wife Etherl Ferguson) lived in the same area as the others. So, I feel that Frank Marshall Bunn is probably the son of one of those mentioned.

What I have written here probably does not assist you very much in your research, but though I would send it to you anyway.

Again, thank you so much for remembering me whenever you run across information pertaining to the Bunn surname. If I can ever complete the Bunn book that I am working on, I hope to get back to plotting the land grants along the Moccasin Creek and surrounding area.
