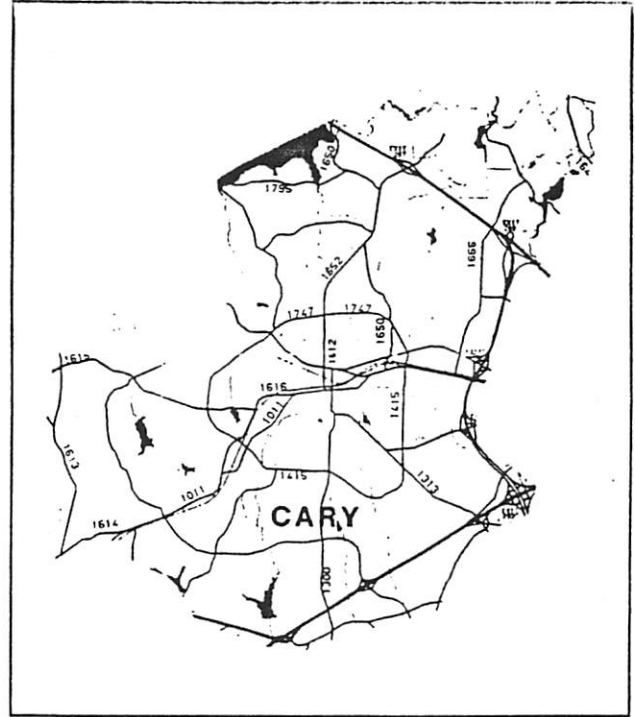

WAKE COUNTY CEMETERY SURVEY LISTING BY TOWNSHIP (PART 6)

CARY TOWNSHIP CEMETERIES

Cary Township is surrounded by six others: Raleigh and Meredith to the E; a bit of House Creek on the N; Cedar Fork, N and W; White Oak, W and S; Swift Creek, S and E. The Town of Cary "invades" ones Raleigh City does not; which city is into some of Cary Twp. At US1/64 the line takes I-40W, Expressway E, Richland Ck. NW into Crabtree Ck., W into Crabtree Lake, SE by an unnamed tributary to Lake Dr. and onto NC54W. Following town limits of Morrisville, Coles Br. W, then Crabtree Ck. going S, it takes SR1615 W to SR1613 S, the tracks of the Durham-Sou. RR spur to SR1614 E. At SR1308 it goes S, SE via Williams Ck. and into/out of Cary-Apex Water Reservoir and on US64 E. Under US1 it goes into SR1009, then N at SR1423 to SR1313 but briefly to US1/64 E and back to I-40W.

In Reedy Creek Park - Slaves also? To be located.

CARY TOWN/Hillcrest
From S. Academy St. go W on Dry Ave. one block past school to Harrison Ave. Turn left at Page St.

N side SR1656 .7 mi W of SR1664

EDWARDS/YATES

Parking lot of old Austin Food Co. N side of E. Chatham St./NC54

UNITED CHURCH OF CHRIST (Af-Am) Many stones vandalized through the years.

From Kildaire Farm Rd., turn W on Cornwall Rd. N side next to west side of Glenaire retirement community. Current restoration going on with hopes of finding names of those buried in unmarked and vandalized graves.

HICKS

Lawrence Rd. SW off Walnut St.

+ **HIGH HOUSE** - May have been destroyed with graves not moved.

Family surname and their house for which the road is named, SR1615.

+ **HOLLEMAN**, Christopher

E side of SR1300. Destroyed: paved over (no graves moved) when Cary Parkway was built. Previously a brick barn was built over the 5 or 6 graves.

HOWELL, Haimer

SW quadrant Lake Pine Dr/Helmsdale Dr between houses #1308/#1304. Saved and fenced in by garden club years ago; homeowners assoc. plan to add park.

JONES, Benjamin

At Taylor's Pond - S of NC54 going W

JONES, Nathaniel (W.P.) Was saved by efforts of Cary Historical Society

On Seabrook Ave., S of traffic circle, go one block and turn W on King Fork Ct. Next street S is Dorchester Pines Ct. First cul-de-sac on left (to its right).

JONES, Tom and others

W side Trinity Rd. just N of RR (site of old Asbury Meth Church cemetery)

OLIVE, John Wesley/**HARRIS**, W.J. - condemned; site destroyed (a park there now?)

N side of Apex-Cary Reservoir (N of US64) up from Stonehigh Ct. Only 3 of about 10 burials had stones (some already vandalized). Unknown number moved in 1988 to Oakwood Cemetery in Raleigh!

REEDY CREEK CHURCH

SR1719 E .4 mi off SR1652 Harrison Ave.

From SR1010 go ca .25 mi S on SR1300. W side (cottonwood trees, crepe myrtles and roses)

Beyond former Butane Gas Co. on N side of E. Chatham St. Walled-in area.

YOUNG, James R.
E side of parking lot after entering Reedy Creek Park from N. Harrison Ave. There are other graveyards to be recorded in the park.
