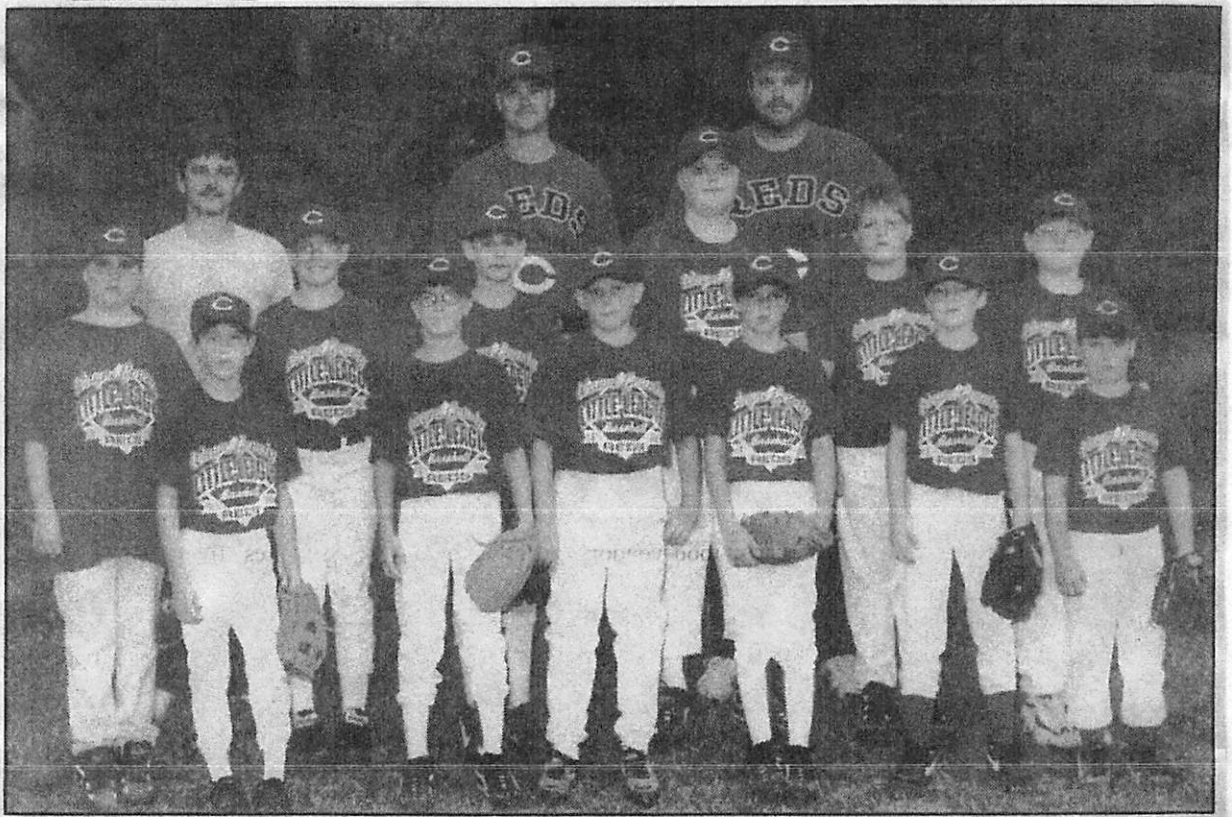

LELAND STEWART & HIS
GENERAL STORE

On January 27, 1959, every seat in the Buies Creek Baptist Church was filled and people were standing in the back to attend his funeral. There were so many flowers that they overflowed the church and many were taken directly to the grave site. Since his death, there had been a steady stream of traffic through my grandfather's home of people paying their respects. Telegrams and letters from all over the country arrived from those friends who could not come to the funeral.

I was 11 years old, but I still remember people saying, "You'll never know what Leland Stewart did for us." Without exception, everyone I talked with said, "Leland Stewart was one of the finest men I ever knew."

On October 14, 1897, Leland Lorenzo Stewart was born to Charles Rufus Stewart (4/30/1873-3/30/1956) and Emily Lenora Kennedy (3/23/1876-6/14/56) in his father's house on the Old Wire Road just outside of Buies Creek. Seven years and six days later his only sister, Florrie Mae, joined him.

By the time Leland reached 17, WWI had begun in Europe. He was too young to go to war, but he and two of his best friends, Cleveland Ennis and Hendricks Kivett, went to New York. It was said that Leland worked in one of the first airplane factories in the United States.

He was back at home in 1918 and worked for a while as a mechanic in Cleveland Ennis' garage across the street from Jeff Upchurch's house.

Jeff Upchurch owned a general store; farmed and had a house full of kids — nine of them! Eight of these kids were relegated to the fields, but Rosa helped her father in the store.

It was Rosa who captured Leland's romantic interest and the two were married on July 22, 1922. They lived with Rosa's parents until they bought the house on what is now Judge Taylor Road sometime in the mid to late 1920's. The distinguishing feature of the house was that it was one of the first in the area to have indoor plumbing!

The 1920's must have been an exciting time for the young couple. Leland joined Rosa and her

father in operating the store. They divided up chores and scheduled around the different duties each had: Rosa cooked and the men farmed. When both Rosa and Leland had to be out, Mr. Jeff used a kind of shorthand of marks he had devised (he couldn't read or write) to keep up with who had bought what and how much. When Rosa returned, she recorded the transactions while he read from his marks. Even though the local economy was fairly depressed because of the heavy concentration of farming, the store flourished and grew with Leland's flair for business and his easy, laid-back style that appealed to everyone. And the three of them made a formidable business team.

On April 30, 1923, their first son Jeff, arrived. On January 20, 1927, their second son, Charles L. (Mutt) was born. But even with two young sons, Rosa's life still revolved around the store and under Leland's hand, the store evolved into a focal point of the community.

There were several reasons for this. The store was a general store and Rosa and Leland sold everything from thread and cloth to groceries, hardware and fertilizer. They obtained much of the goods in bulk. Products like molasses and vinegar came in kegs and people brought their own containers to take them home. Flour, sugar, and dried beans were put into bins in the counter and dispensed by scoop, sold by weight. Cheese came in hoops and was sliced for each customer.

Leland and Rosa usually slaughtered a couple of cows each week plus a couple of pigs in cold weather under an old oak tree where the Campbell University laundry now stands. This supplied their meat department. They kept several dairy cows with at least two giving milk. Rosa put the milk in glass pint bottles and sold them for five cents each.

They also went to the Farmer's Market in Raleigh to purchase oranges, bananas, etc., in season. Fertilizer would come into Lillington by train, and Leland hauled it to Buies Creek in a truck that held 6 100-lb bags at a time. The store had something for everyone in the community.

Leland was very astute in understanding the farmer's need for credit. He extended credit from spring planting until fall harvesting. Buies Creek Academy became and remained his largest single customer. The Academy (Campbell College as of 1926) bought most of their food from the store.

The store became a gathering place for the community at night. The men gathered around the potbellied stove in the winter, sitting on the nail kegs, swapping stories and gossip, and talking politics. In the summer, they moved outside to the sidewalk and talked. The women grouped together

er in the back of the store. Leland furnished a pan of roasted peanuts for the people to dig into while they were there. (They had to buy their cokes!)

These gatherings became informal "town hall" meetings. If a member of the community was needy, the people in the store would contribute whatever they could, and take it that night.

The store stayed open at night until 10 or 11 o'clock when the last person left. After the theater opened in Erwin, a group from the store would pack themselves into several vehicles to catch the 9 pm movie. Leland and Rosa were delighted not only to go to a movie but to get to close the store early, too.

The 1920's was a prosperous time for the couple. But the tide turned in the 1930's and there was family tragedy. About 1930, Rosa prematurely gave birth to their third son who lived only five or six days. According to a family member, Rosa "did everything she could to get the baby to live," (an understated way of saying that Rosa was devastated).

The full effects of the Depression hit the area in the early 1930's, and the people of Buies Creek were financially devastated. They resorted to bartering when they could, and Leland and Rosa extended credit to anyone who needed it. The store barely survived.

Then came another family tragedy when Rosa's father died in 1933. The elementary school closed so that the kids could attend his funeral. Mr. Jeff had provided a warm fire in the pot-bellied stove at the store before school every cold winter morning and had given candy to those who couldn't afford to buy it. The children had grown to love him.

Recovering from the Depression, Leland began to expand his business interests. He and Wilson (Red) Roberson started a service station where Roy Lee's Auto is now located, as well as a hammermill to grind grain. The station housed the bus station for the town. Later in the '30's, Leland and Red moved everything downtown on a two-acre lot Leland purchased when the house on the lot burned.

Leland bought a huge Buick that seated eight people and a trailer and began to haul tobacco (and the farmers) to market. He then expanded the hauling business and hauled almost anything he could, going as far north as Pennsylvania. With the exploding demand for cigarettes, he began farming tobacco, leasing as many as twenty-five

acres. As the trucking business began to get too competitive, the old worn-out Buick was used to haul tobacco sleds from the field to the barn. Jeff, the oldest son, was given this job.

Everyone wanted to work for Leland because he paid by the day and didn't dock anybody while they were waiting for the sleds to come. He would also bring candy and drinks from the store for everyone at break time. Rosa brought milk and they could "drink as much as they wanted," and occasionally, she made a churn of ice cream, the best this author has ever tasted! If any of the workers needed extra money, Leland would lend it to them until payday.

The store survived the rationing and hard times of WWII to thrive again after the boys came back. Campbell College's enrollment increased dramatically as the men were now demanding an education. Leland took a very active interest in the athletics program at the college, and the students in the program. He and Rosa became the parents away from home for some of the boys.

Leland's generosity is legend among the people in the community and the students who knew him. He loaned and gave people money, listened to their problems, and gave his advice if it was asked. He was a very thoughtful man, slow and deliberate in his speech, thinking before speaking. He was a man of honor and integrity — undoubtedly the most respected man I have ever known.

Rosa's personality seemed to be diametrically opposed to Leland's, but she was always there to supply milk, eggs and butter if someone was in need. No domestic situation was too bad for her to tackle. Even though she could be short and blunt with people, she would be the first to help in any situation.

In 1958, a few short years after Leland and Rosa retired from the store, Leland developed cancer of the esophagus and he was dead in three months. During those months, people from all walks of life came to see him — from the richest to the poorest, from the most distinguished to the "outlaws."

Those of us who had the privilege of knowing him are better for it and we still miss him.

His parting statement: "I've lived 60 good years."

Jefferson Davis Upchurch was born September 10, 1861. He was the fourth of five children (all sons) born to Benjamin Upchurch (1830-1910) and Arabella Medlin Upchurch (1827-1867). Benjamin

James, J. K. (Kit) Calvin, Jeff, Charlie. Following Arabella's death, Benjamin married Katie Johnson and they had three children — Frank, Will, and Mollie. The Benjamin Upchurches lived on NC highway 210 near Neill's Creek Baptist Church where they are buried.

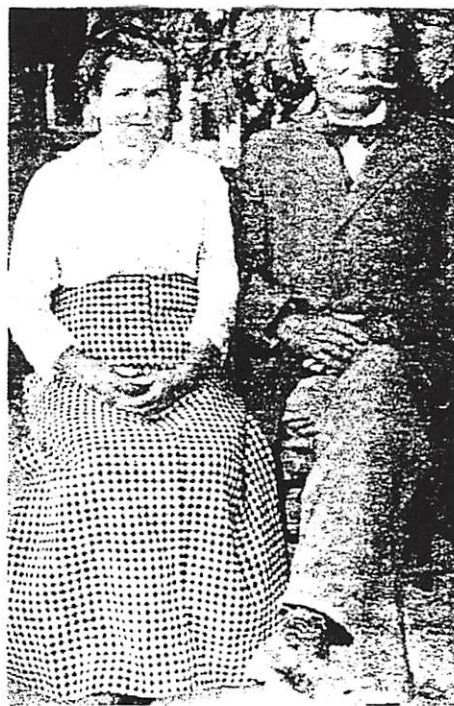
This community was also the first home of Jeff Upchurch and his bride Virginia Horton from Johnston County. She was born December 16, 1869. They were married in a double wedding. Walt and Lilly Johnson also became man and wife in that double ceremony. Virginia's daughter, Annie Bell remembers her mother recalling that she and Jeff had only one chair when they set up housekeeping. Jeff and Virginia continued to live in the Neill's Creek community for several years. Their older children were born there. These were John (1887-1959), Zebulon (1899 and died young), Benjamin (1891-1938), Lessie (1893-1963), Ezra (Dick) (1896-1936), and Bessie (1897-1973).

Later, Jeff and Virginia moved to Buie's Creek where he became a merchant. His first store was located near Kivett's brick yard along with those of two other merchants, Floyd Taylor and Sandy Stewart. Late one night fire destroyed the three wooden store buildings. Mysterious circumstances surrounded this fire. Jeff was the only one of the merchants who did not have insurance on his business. Shortly thereafter, however, Jeff and Leslie Collier opened another store on the current site of Blanchard's Barber Shop. This store was also burned out. Jeff then bought the large building across the street.

It was as merchant at this location that he is best remembered. Jeff also had a farm where women's campus, the fine arts building, the maintenance plant, and laundry of Campbell are now located. While he was establishing these ventures, Jeff and Virginia had the remainder of their family. Born in Buie's Creek were Rosa (1901-1968), Annie Bell (1906 to present), Lala (1908 to present), Issie (1908-1925) and Woodrow (1912-1971).

Jeff Upchurch's general store was an important establishment in Buie's Creek. His stock of provisions was wide and varied and provided for most of the needs of the citizens of the small town. Uncle Jeff, as the community children called him, provided for the other needs also. Daughter Annie Bell recalls that he always got up early on cold mornings to go to the store to start a fire in the big, pot-bellied stove that heated the building. He just wanted it warm when the early school bus arrived with its first load of children. He wanted his children to have a comfortable place to wait until the school house opened. Uncle Jeff also gave the children candy while they waited.

A merchant all his life, Jeff Upchurch was one of the founding fathers of Buie's Creek and later served as its last mayor. He and Virginia were instrumental in the building of Buie's Creek Baptist Church. In addition to contributions of material, money, and labor made by her husband,

— quite a task with a house full of children. Jeff also substantially helped his friend J. A. Campbell get Campbell College off the ground.

All of the surviving children of Jeff and Virginia were respected and contributing citizens of Harnett County. John, a merchant in Raleigh and Buie's Creek, married Lutha Stewart. He also carried the mail. Deliveries were made to Lillington in the morning and to Coats in the afternoon. John and Lutha's children are Ernie Mae, Thurman, Clyde (who was also a merchant), and Daisy Lea. Ben, a merchant as well, married Lela Parker. Their three daughters are Winifred, Nellie, and Frances. Daughter Lessie married Son Mitchell. Their family includes Graham, Hazel, Bob, Mack and Sarah, Ezra (Dick) married Salie Mae Wallace and they had four children: Earl, Louis, Helen, and Ruth. Bessie married Jesse Wood and they lived,

until retirement, in Littleton where Jesse was a merchant. They spent their retirement years in Buie's Creek. Jesse Jr. was their son. Rosa married Leland Stewart and they ran the store after her father's death. Their children are Jeff and Charles (Mutt). Lala and Herbert Betts married and their children are Ruth and Nina Belle. Annie Bell was sixteen when she married Levy McLeod. Only a year older, Levy said he would join the army if she did not marry him. She quit school and married him. Frank and Joyce Lee are their children. The baby of Jeff and Virginia was Woodrow. Like his older brother, Ben, Woodrow was a great baseball player — a left-handed pitcher. Woodrow played organized baseball and made it to major leagues briefly. In one game with Connie Mack's Philadelphia Athletics, Woodrow struck out Babe Ruth three times. An arm injury in a traffic accident ended his baseball career. He married Agnes Avery and their son is Woody.

Dear Mrs. West:

△ I have received your letters and the copy of your book. My son Brian and I are overwhelmed by your generosity and willingness to help us in our family research. I read the book through without putting it down and was fascinated by the information in it. I hope we can trace our family back far enough to tie them in with some of the lines you have researched. A check is enclosed for half the price of the book, as you offered. If this isn't satisfactory, please let us know.

△ + △ We know very little about our family yet. As you must know, we are rank amateurs in doing this kind of research. So far all we've done is interview one of my late father's (Jefferson Woodrow Sr.) older sisters. She was able to give us my great grandfather's name (Benjamin) and the names of some of my grandfather's (Jefferson Davis Upchurch) sons.

△ We have visited one cemetery in the community where the family was located (Neil's Creek Township north of Lillington in Harnett County).
△ There we found three of the Upchurch family, one of whom (Joseph Calvin) I have since learned was my grandfather's brother. Another (Willie Frank) I'm sure is a half brother of my grandfather. One of our next projects is to go back into the community to see if we can find Benjamin's grave. I'm sure it's there somewhere.

△ We have made only one trip so far to the State Library and State Archives. A friend of mine who is experienced in this sort of thing showed me how to use some of the resources there and Brian and I plan to go back this Saturday. On the first visit, we found Benjamin as a 20-year-old in the 1850 census living in a house with all young men. This is a puzzle to us. Listed next on the census were Temperance Medling, 42, and Areabell Medling, 22. Benjamin married Areabell soon after the census was taken in 1850, and the 1860 census shows them in the same household with four sons and Areabell's mother. Areabell bore a fifth son in 1861, my grandfather. Apparently she died, because she is not shown in the 1870 census. Benjamin remarried and had two children, Molly and Willie Frank.

△ The only other Upchurches we can find in the 1850 census are John, 19, and Nathan, 18. This strikes me as being a little odd. In the whole of Cumberland County in 1850 (Harnett was a part of Cumberland until 1855) there are only three Upchurches: Benjamin 20, John 19 and Nathan 18, and none is living with his family. Benjamin is listed in a house with five young males, none of whom is an Upchurch; John is living with a McDuffie family, and Nathan is living with a woman named Barclay, age 70.

→ GOOD THEORY - RPU

△ I'm wondering if these three boys are brothers living with guardians. I'm going to check the Cumberland guardian records, and we'll check the 1840 census to see if we can find an Upchurch with children the right age to

— have been either Benjamin, John or Nathan. I suspect that we will not
— find Benjamin's father in what is now Harnett County. After reading
— your book, I'm wondering if we might trace our great grandfather
— Benjamin back to the one you list in Wake County on page 29.

I suspect that you can sense the excitement we are generating for this project. We are very grateful for your encouragement and assistance. I will be certain to keep you informed of any major progress we might make.

Positive Tack Taken By Wilson Farm Couple

LUCAMA—Sonny Scott watched from the tailgate of his pickup truck as the tobacco harvester made its last trip of the day down the row.

If he was concerned about blue mold, fuel supplies or climbing costs, it didn't show. The 31-year-old Wilson County farmer's conversation with a visitor was remarkably void of negativism but filled with expressions of enthusiasm and self-confidence.

His comments all but ignored the usual favorite topics of farmers—weather, plant diseases, insects, weeds, high costs, labor and an uncertain market.

"I've got the best harvesting crew in the country," Scott said of the three men and three women helping prepare the green leaf for curing.

"I can grow an acre of tobacco as cheap as anybody," he said.

Scott figured his 1978 costs at 70.5 cents per pound plus the cost of leased poundage quota. The figure will be higher this year.

"My tobacco is as clean as any machine-harvested tobacco on the (market) floor and as clean as much of the hand-harvested tobacco," he said.

Linwood H. Scott Jr. doesn't make his claims in a boastful way or as a putdown of other farmers. He comes across as a sharp, energetic man with full awareness of his own farm management capabilities, which happen to be substantial.

He has the record to prove it.

He has been the Wilson County corn-growing champion three years, and in 1977 he was elected the county and the state outstanding young farmer.

This month Scott was named an Outstanding Young Tobacco Grower in the beltwide recognition program, sponsored by Philip Morris USA and conducted in North Carolina by the N.C. Agricultural Extension Service.

"Sonny has gotten where he is by asking questions and taking a positive, aggressive approach to farming," said Connie Jernigan, chairman of the Wilson County staff of the Agricultural Extension Service. "He has tremendous ability to manage a farming business, and he doesn't hesitate to adopt new technology if he's shown that it's an improvement over the old."

Sonny and Alice Scott are harvesting their 11th tobacco crop this summer since they married and set out on their own in the fall of 1968.

They have expanded from six acres of tobacco to 105 during this time. They have about 1,000 acres of all crops this year, consisting mostly of corn and soybeans.

The Scotts, who work side by side through the tobacco harvesting season, have bought three small farms in their community over the years and now own about 200 acres of cleared farmland. They rent almost four times that much.

Essentially all of the farm earnings are plowed back into the farm in the form of purchases of equipment and land.

"We were married on Oct. 6 and bought a tractor on Nov. 16," Scott recalls. "We haven't been out of debt since, but we haven't fallen behind on any loan payments either."

Wise use of borrowed money is the only way a young farmer can get established, the Scotts believe. "We had no set goals when we started and still don't," Scott said. "I don't know how much bigger we can get, but we have no desire to get any smaller."

If further expansion comes, it will be in the present crops—tobacco, grain and soybeans. Two enterprises that have done well for many Tar Heel farmers during the Scotts' period of expansion—hogs and cucumbers—have no appeal.

"One reason is," Scott explains, "I don't want to get into a situation that requires a lot of hired labor, such as we would have to have with cucumbers."

Although he doesn't have specific acreage or income goals, Scott has one specific target he tries to stay zeroed in on all the time. "I like to see how much productivity we can get with the smallest investment, particularly labor investment," he said.

What about the constant controversy that seems to surround tobacco?

"I don't worry about that," Scott said. "Tobacco is going to be grown as long as there are people on this earth. It may be a smaller volume than we're growing today, but tobacco is still going to be grown, and I plan to be one of those growing it."
