

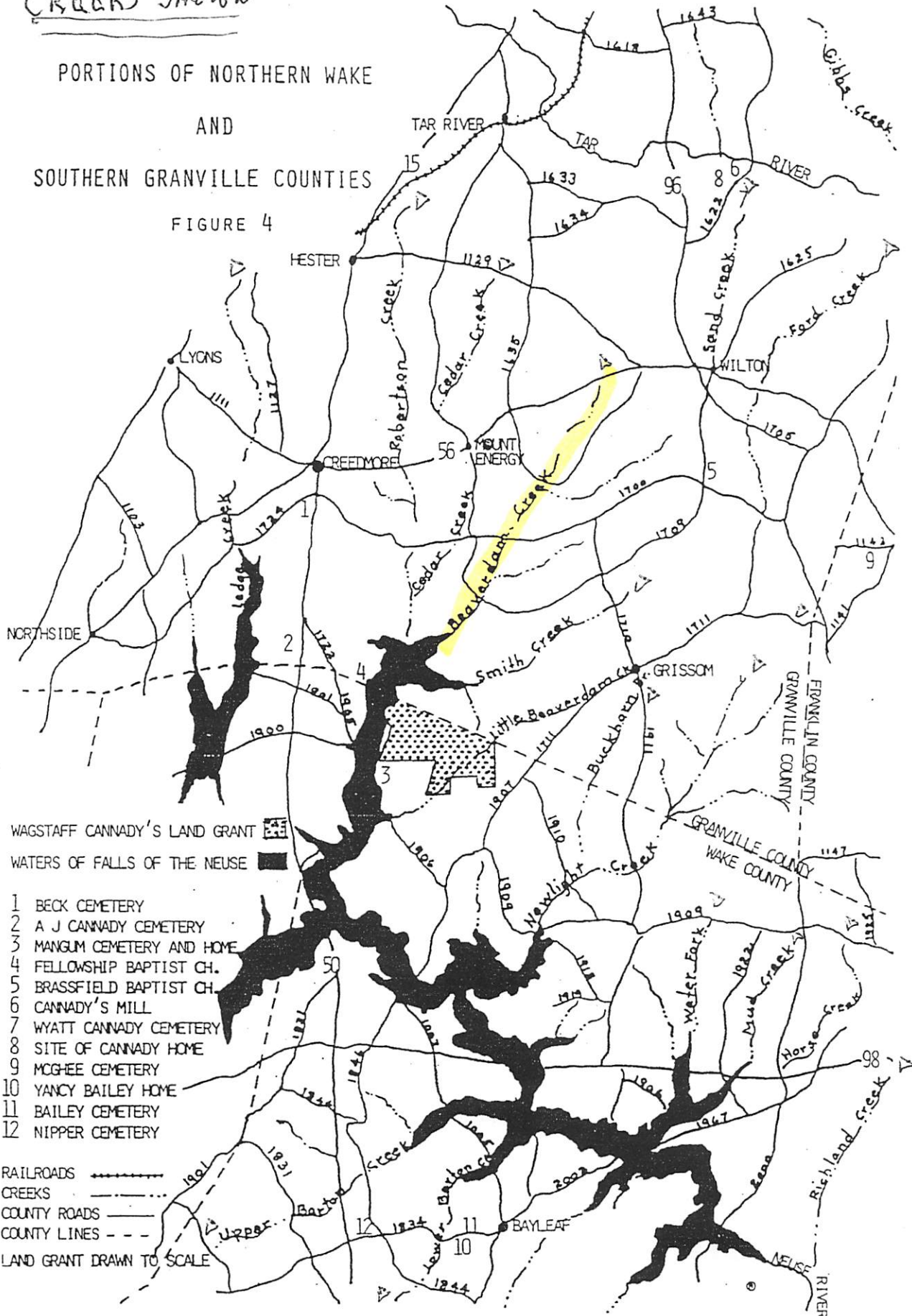

Corbitt's History, "FORMATION of NORTH CAROLINA 1663-1943" gives us some additional information on Granville County, NC. "GRANVILLE COUNTY" was named in honor of John Carteret, Earl of Granville, who owned the Granville District. He was Prime Minister under King George II. It was in the Northeastern Section of the state and is currently bounded by Vance, Franklin, Wake, Durham and Person Counties and the State of Virginia. The first county seat was called Granville Court House. That location became unsatisfactory in 1748; Therefore, it was ordered that the courthouse be located on a branch of Tar River, called Tabb's Creek. Oxford was made the county seat in 1811. Oxford was incorporated in 1816 and is the county seat of Granville County today.

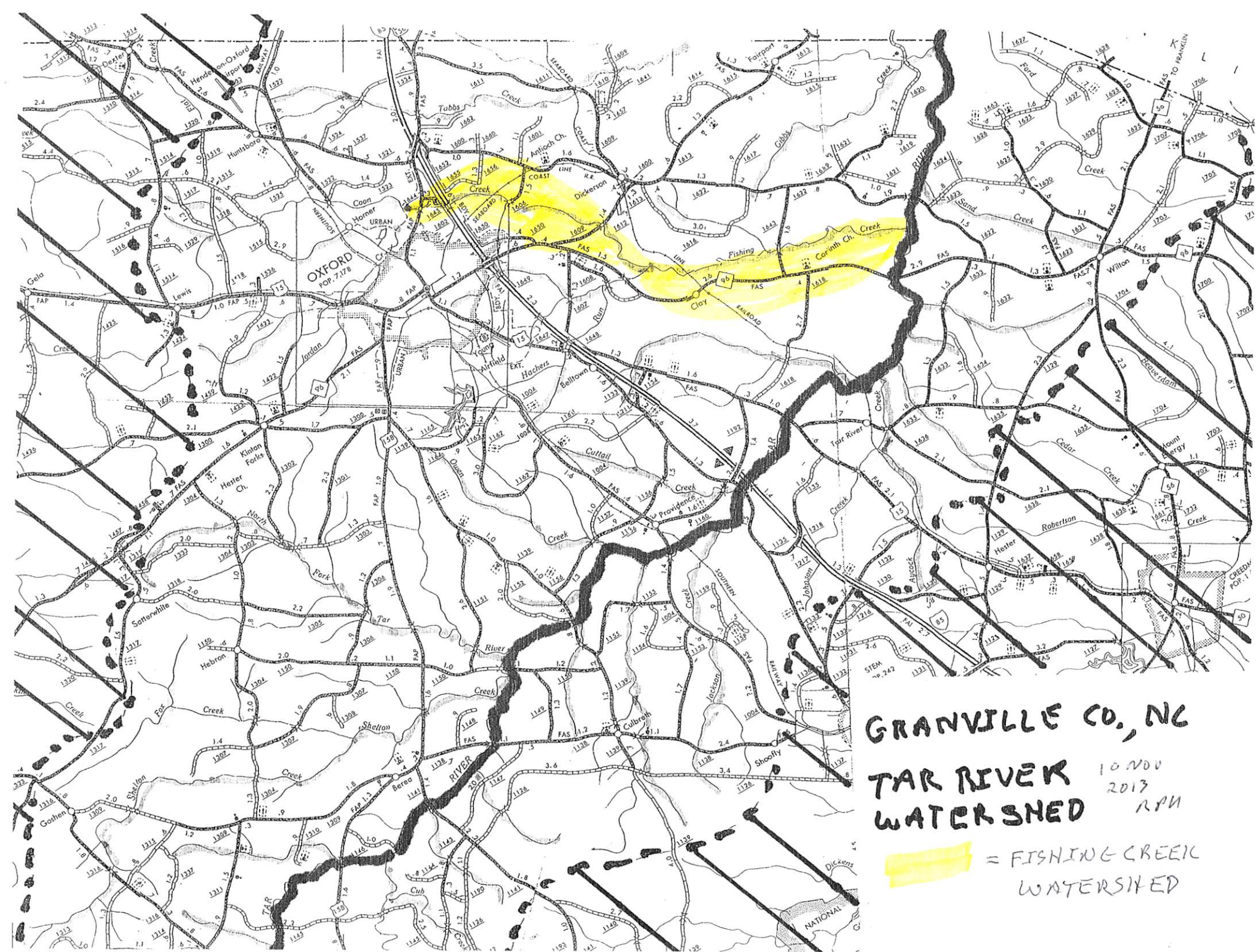

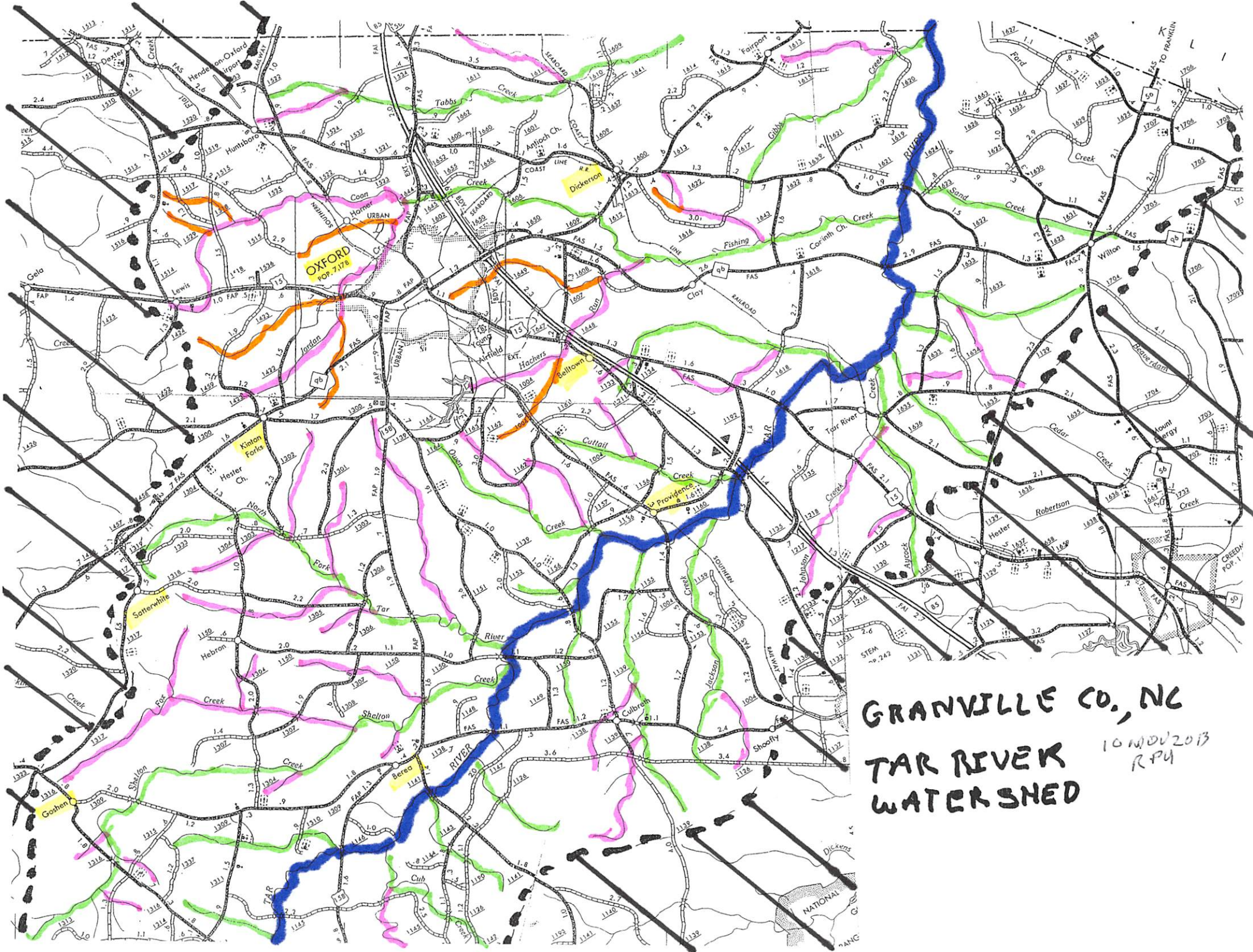

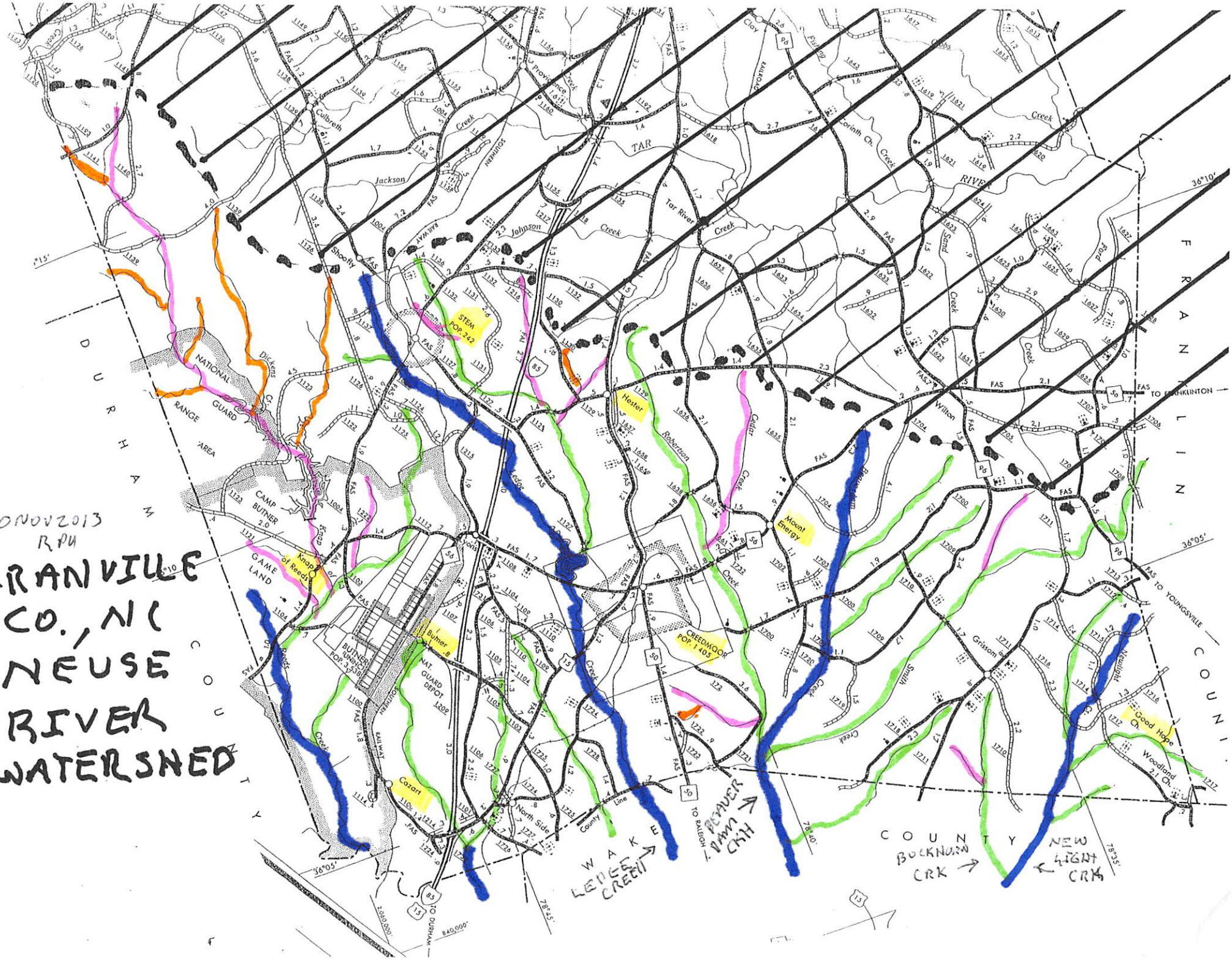
