RALEIGH — Stuart Weatherspoon Upchurch of Raleigh died Monday, April 15, 2002 at Spring-moor Retirement Community.

A funeral service will be held on Friday, April 19, at 2 p.m. at The First Baptist Church in Raleigh. Internment will precede the service and will be for family only.

Mrs. Upchurch was born in Durham, NC on July 23, 1914, the daughter of James Raymond Weatherspoon and Mabel Bayard Stuart. She later moved to Raleigh and attended Peace and graduated from Meredith College in 1936.

In 1939 she married T.A. "Buddy" Upchurch. They maintained their home in Raleigh. Mr. Upchurch, who was president and Chairman of the Board of Directors of Durham Life Insurance Company, died in 1983.

In Raleigh, Mrs. Upchurch was active in The First Baptist Church, The Raleigh Junior League, the Blue Stocking Book Club, the Carolina Country Club and alumni and other activities of Meredith College. In her earlier years she was an avid golfer. She had a life-long passion for bridge and played competitively into her 80s. When she moved to Spring-moor in 1984 her bridge playing continued and she delighted in the fact that so many of her bridge partners became Springmoor neighbors.

Long involved in local philanthropy, in 1994 she established The Acriel Foundation, a private family foundation, which supports primarily health and environmental organizations in central and eastern North Carolina.

Mrs. Upchurch is survived by her daughter and son-in-law, Stuart Upchurch Buice and William T. Buice, III of New York City; grandchildren Merrill Stuart Buice Hubbard of San Francisco and Charles Upchurch Buice of Brooklyn, New York; great granddaughter, Caroline Stuart Hubbard; sisters, Margaret W. Parker of Winston-Salem and Anne W. Phoenix of Chapel Hill.

She was pre-deceased by her sister, Laura W. Harrill.

Journey to Okinawa marked by friendship this time around

Stuart Upchurch went back this summer, back to the bloody ground where he lost his youth, back to the place where a 17-year-old North Carolina boy in a man's uniform had been told to kill people he didn't know.

And they came back, too, the ones he'd tried to kill, and the ones who had tried to kill him.

They were different now, fierce young warriors grown older and more peaceful. They had questions, and they had come to this island in the Pacific to find the answers. Why had they lived when 200,000 others had died? Did they feel any hatred for those they had killed and who had tried to kill them? Could they find the places where it had happened, the places where boys had gone in and old men had walked out?

Two great armies met on the island of Okinawa during the spring of 1945 in the last great battle of World War II. They bled and died for three months, and the Americans won. Two months later, the war was over.

Now they met again, Americans and Japanese, and they had come back 42 years later, on June 14, to dedicate a monument to all of the dead. It would be the first time that former enemies had met to honor both sides in an epic struggle.

They first faced each other at a place called the

of the 6th Marine Division, remembered the battle for Sugar Loaf Hill and the Marines who had died at their sides. They remembered the innocents who had died and the people they had killed.

And the Japanese were on the other side, probably thinking of the same things.

"I never felt hatred for the Japanese even then," Upchurch said. "They were the quarry, and I shot them as freely as possible, but there was no real animosity. I didn't feel anything about them one way or the other. And I guess not feeling anything is even worse than killing a man you hate. The hatred that some had came from the propaganda they poured down our throats. I had nothing personal against them. I just shot at them like I would rabbits."

"Coming back gave me a chilling feeling. I had never thought I'd go back there again," he said. "I got off the airplane, and there was a taxi waiting to take me to the Sheraton. The first time I was there it was just a dirt strip with one tin hangar."

"We didn't find a single foxhole," Upchurch said. "Sugar Loaf Hill, where so many died on both sides, was half gone. They bulldozed it to build a housing development."

"I couldn't believe I was there again, and I'll admit it made me nervous," he said. "I kept thinking I'd

"The Japanese were there when we got off our buses," said Upchurch, a Raleigh businessman. "There were about 50 or 60 of them and 55 of us. They sat in chairs on one side, and we were on the other side. They kept us segregated. We did not sit together. Maybe it was too hard for all concerned."

There was a long ceremony to dedicate the memorial. Speeches had to be translated for all the guests, and there were a lot of speeches and prayers. It was a three-sided memorial, one side for the Americans, the Japanese and the Okinawan civilians who had died. The men who had done the killing looked at each other and remembered.

They remembered how it was then, when there was an unspoken rule that neither side took prisoners. Upchurch and his foxhole friend, Paul Panella, both

made it out of here one time, and I shouldn't push my luck. You can't go to something like that at 17 and come back again as an old man.

"Thomas Wolfe was right when he said you can't go home again and in a way, Okinawa was home," Upchurch said. "It was there that I'd left my youth. We had slept in that soil and it had become part of us."

"There was a banquet after the ceremony and that was the first time we got to meet the Japanese face-to-face," he said. "There was only a feeling of friendship that night. I shook hands with every Japanese I could meet. I put my arms around one old Japanese man and said, 'Friend.'"

"He looked at me and said, 'Yes.'"

"We had all gone through the same thing. We were old enough this time to know the futility of what we did," Upchurch said. "We had almost given our lives for nothing. We knew this time that old politicians make wars for young men to die in."

"All of us were victims," he said. "We were old men now, seasoned by war and seasoned by life. John Wayne was a lie."

"Now it is over," Upchurch said. "I've thought about it and dreamed about it for 42 years and now I'm finished with it. Now I can write the last chapter of that book and be done with it."

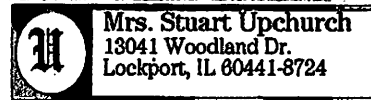

Abel U, Sr was the son of Richard U, II and all of our records now are supposed to reflect this.

Then Abel U, Sr along with my ancestor Nathan U, I, was one of the 11 children of Richard U, II who settled in the Waxhams Creek Area of Franklin Co, NC about 1755. Both Abel, Sr & Nathan U, I married in the area and started their families. Nathan U, I left about 1802 and moved to the western edge of the adjoining County (Wake). Abel U Sr left about 1820-1830 and went to Greene Co, AL. I am constantly trying to knit all this together. Collectively we have made amazing progress over the years.

Dear Cousin Stuart,

Thanks for your letter of 30 MAR 1992 and for the complete article on the Elmira Prison Camp. I have read it with much interest and have sent a copy to my 1st cousin in Charlotte, NC. He is older than I am and can recall things our GF told him whereas I was too young to remember our GF. It seems quite likely that GF did know W. B. Trammell.

I will be looking forward to the additional details on your family. I have temporarily stopped assigning X to numbers for the William U, IV / Abel U, Sr Clan until I can reorganize things. Abel U, Sr will become a Clan Head and each of his children will head a subclan. So far I am not getting any wiser that the proposal is wrong. It still looks sound to me. If things

go as it present it seems likely I will publish directions for the change-over in UB 13 No 2 to be mailed in June. I am still at home recuperating. It has already been almost ten weeks since my surgery. The surgeon expects that it will be at least three more weeks before I am ready to return. I will take another CT scan on April 9th, which I hope will show a completely healed bone graft. After that, I will be released to physical therapy and a return to work.

I have talked with my two older half brothers, John and Jerry. They both mentioned that they received your letters. I have been waiting for their assistance in filling in some of blanks. Unfortunately, they do not move very quickly. After I am able to get around, I plan on visiting the County Building and looking into some of the possible records regarding my father and mother. My next trip to Alabama will also yield a side trip to the records office of Eutaw, County Seat of Greene County Alabama. You will receive as much information as I can get.

I noticed in the October 1991 issue that I received an XID number. Do you also issue XID's for the family that I have identified? (half sisters, half brothers, brother, wives, children).

How are things progressing on the Abel/Richard II front? Have there been any rumblings? This is an extremely interesting curve. I am very interested in the outcome. When do you think that you would make the change final?

I hope you will enjoy the complete Elmira article. I will close now. Let me know if I can be of any further assistance.



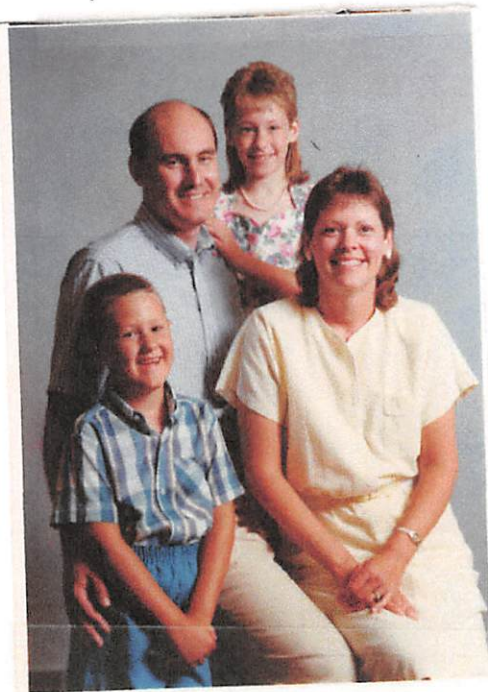

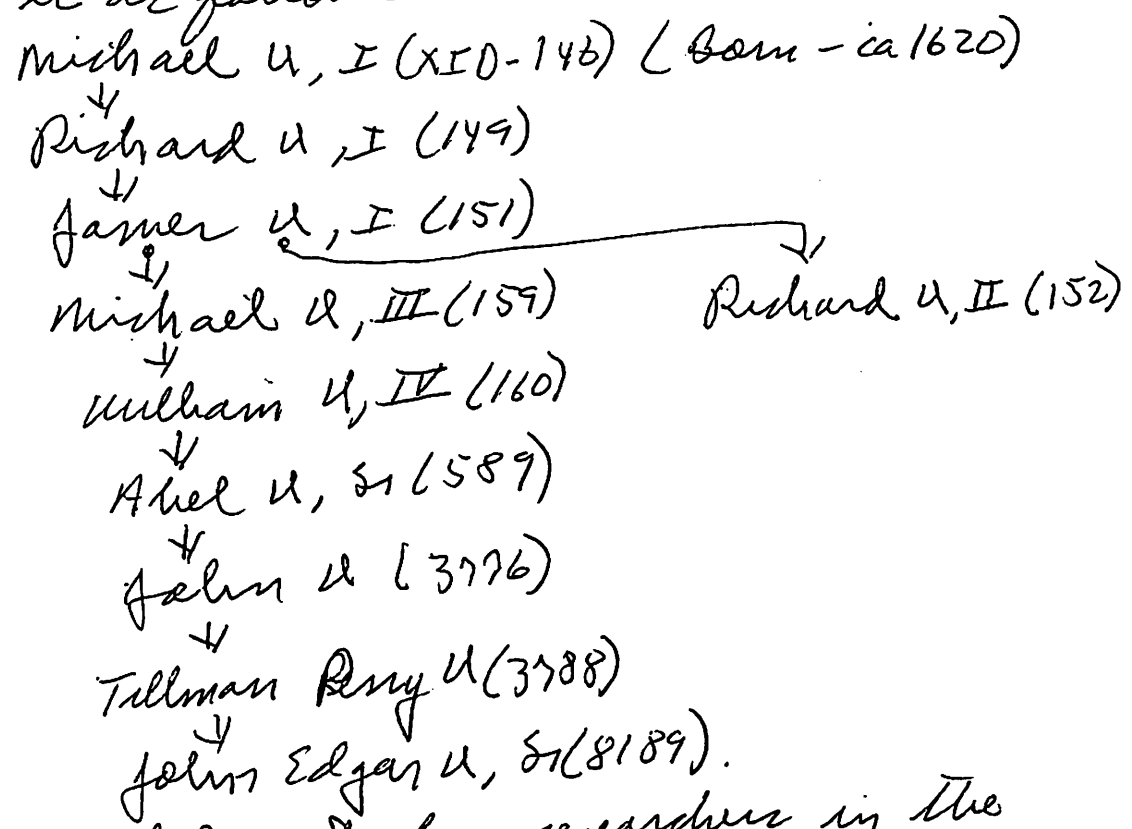
Many thanks for your letter of 28 SEP 1991. I have just finished processing it. Have also just written to the four individuals you suggested. Sent them a copy of the 7 page Master Outline for John Edgar U, Sr (copy enclosed) and posed questions on their direct lines (as I have for you). Street for Scott David U appears to be 2101 DEER RUN COURT. ZIP for Jerry Edward U appears to be 60621 - we will see if they come back undeliverable.

I have had very nice contacts with your Uncle Robert Perry U. In fact he seems inclined to support the Upchurch Endowment I proposed to create within the next several years. However, he has supplied very little data. Maybe the 7 page outline will encourage him to add a few details.

Don't get discouraged. We'll gradually improve the outline one way or another. In the final analysis one can start making contacts

with the official state or county offices for death certificates, birth records, etc. The details are all out there somewhere.

Let me give you a sketch of your line - we can fill in details later. As it stands in the record it is as follows:



This line was worked out by researchers in the family in the 1950's & 1960's and I accepted it as I have many other relationships (Almost all of which stand or correct). However, in this particular case my continued study of the family since 1970 has gradually led me to believe that Abel U, Sr (1589) is not the son of William U, IV but rather is the son of Richard U, II. This will come as a shock to many people. I need to be careful about how this information is spread.

over the next several months I propose to search the records more carefully to see if the ^{proposed} change merits serious attention. If so, I will circulate a draft of a write up to about a dozen key people for comment prior to publishing in the U B for comment. If my suspicions are well founded your line would be:


□ + □ + □ children, Kristen and Jordan are both in school now. Kristen is in 5th grade and quite a history buff, like her dad.


